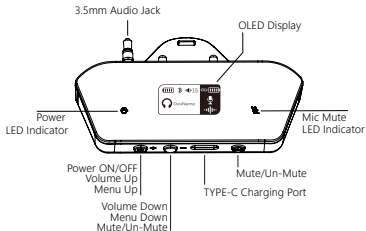

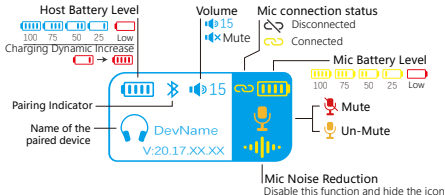

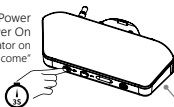


Display Information



Product Usage

- ①** Hold Power for 3s to Power On
Power indicator on display shows "Welcome"



- ②** Boot successful: On first use, it automatically enters pairing mode. On subsequent uses, it automatically reconnects to the previously paired Bluetooth device.



Search and Pairing:

1. Hold the Volume+ and Volume- buttons simultaneously for 3s to enter pairing mode. The power indicator will flash rapidly, and the screen will display "Search...".
2. Detected devices appear in the list. Use Volume +/- to navigate, long-press Volume - to pair.



- ④** Successful Pairing:
the power indicator will enter a slow breathing flash

Note: Hold the Volume+ and Volume- buttons simultaneously for 10 seconds to clear the pairing list.

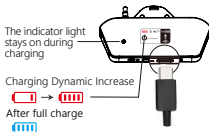
Short Press

the device list



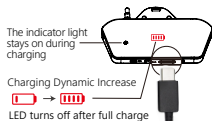
Charging Method

With a Type-C cable (attached with the package) to connect the adapter to USB port of your PC or charging source, BOX03 host or Lavalier Microphone will be charged. It takes about 1.5 hours for full charging.

Remarks:

1. BOX03 supports using when charging, so there is no need to worry about battery life.
2. When the battery runs out, it will automatically shut down, and requires charging to start up and work again.
