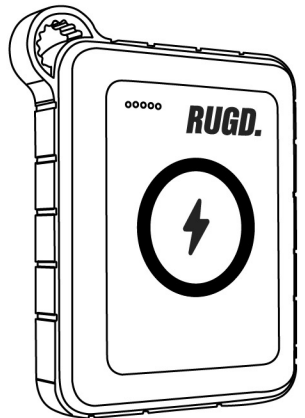

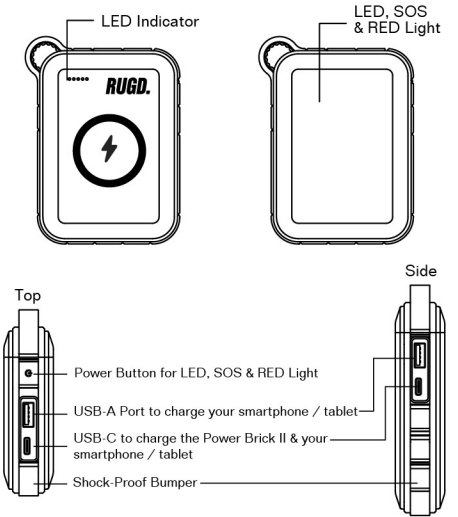

Checking the battery level

Press the power button once, the LED indicators will turn on. Depending upon the remaining battery level, the LED indicators will display as per the table below. Please note each LED reflects 20% of the power.

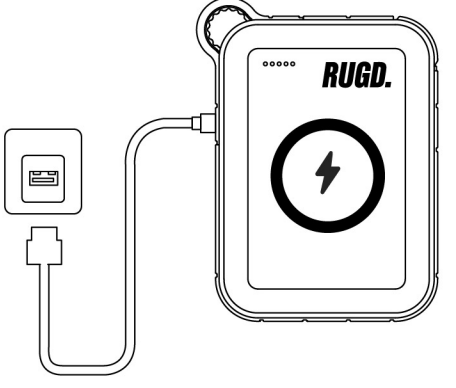

If no device is connected to the Power Brick II the LED Indicators will automatically turn off after 30 seconds.

Charging the Power Brick II

Please fully charge your Power Brick II before using it for the first time until all five LED indicators are illuminated.

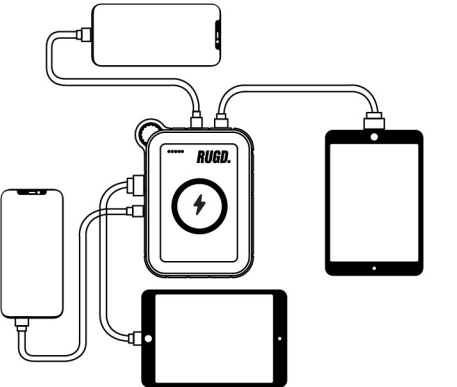
To charge the Power Brick II, connect respective ends of the USB-C charging cable to the Power Brick II and a USB-C mains charger (not included) or to your computer. The LEDs will flash and blink while charging. Upon completion, all five LEDs will remain illuminated signaling a complete charge.



Charging your devices with Power Brick II

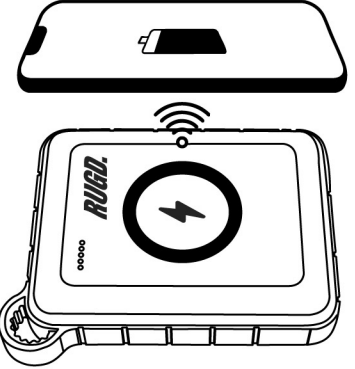
To charge your mobile device, use the original cable supplied with your device or a compatible cable. Plug the cable into the UBS-A or USB-C port in your Power Brick II and the other end into your device. When your device is completely charged, please remove the cable from the Power Brick II. You can charge 5 devices at the same time, charging time depends on the devices protocol & battery capacity.

Please note that when the last remaining LED indicator flashes, it will stop charging your connected device, indicating that you must recharge the Power Brick II.



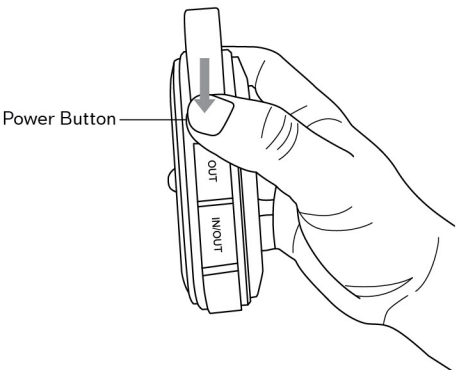
Wireless Charging your devices with Power Brick II

The Power Brick II supports wireless charging. Simply place a compatible device on top of the charging symbol to begin. Ensure the device is centered and free of obstructions for optimal charging performance. If the final LED indicator begins to flash, wireless charging will stop, and the Power Brick II must be recharged. Charging multiple devices simultaneously may affect the charging speed.



Using the LED Camping Light

1. Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds to turn the LED Camping Light ON/OFF. Once the camping light is ON, press the power button one more time to make it brighter, one more time for the SOS and one more time to turn the RED light ON. Press and hold the button for 2 seconds again to turn the LED lights OFF.



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Warning

Keep your Power Brick II away from extreme heat and flammable items. Fully charge your Power Brick II at least once every three months to avoid shortening its lifespan.

Do not operate the Power Brick II if it is wet or damaged, to prevent electric shock, explosion and injury. Do not attempt to open, modify or misuse the Power Brick II in any manner.

*Please note that 'fast charge' charging times/speed may vary depending on the spec and size of your device and usage.

Warranty

This product is covered by a limited warranty from RUGD, that covers the product from defects in workmanship and materials for 24 months from the date of purchase.
