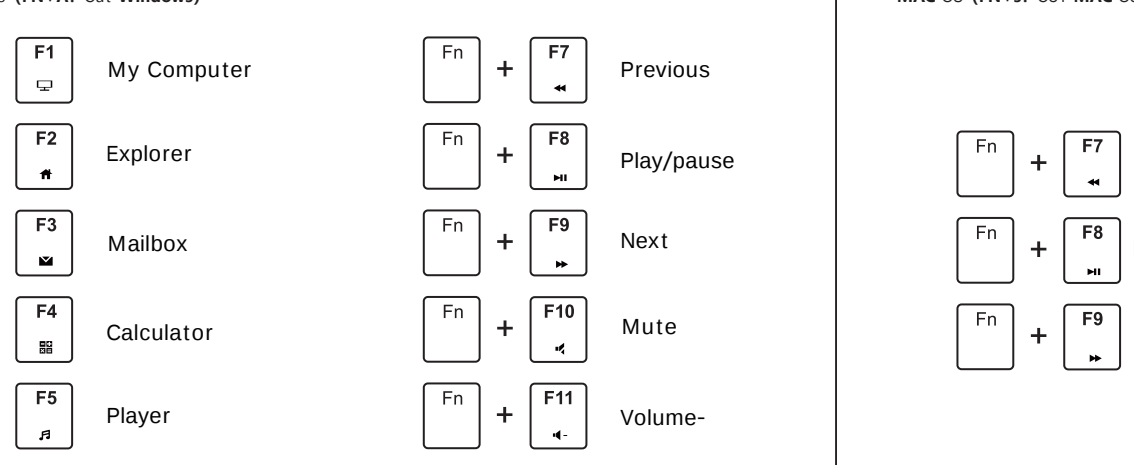

System requirement

Bluetooth mode

- bluetooth3.0,bluetooth5.1 or a later version of the device
- PC:Windows 7 or higher
- Mac:macos X 10.6 Snow Leopard or higher
- ios: iPad/iphone 5 or higher
- Android:5.0 or higher
