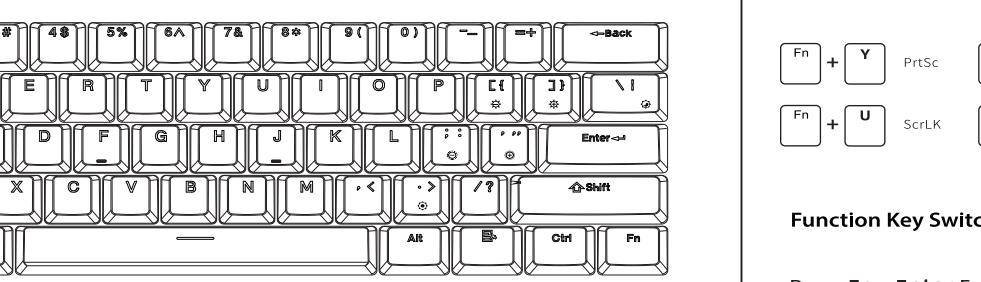
- 1 SHORT PRESS
