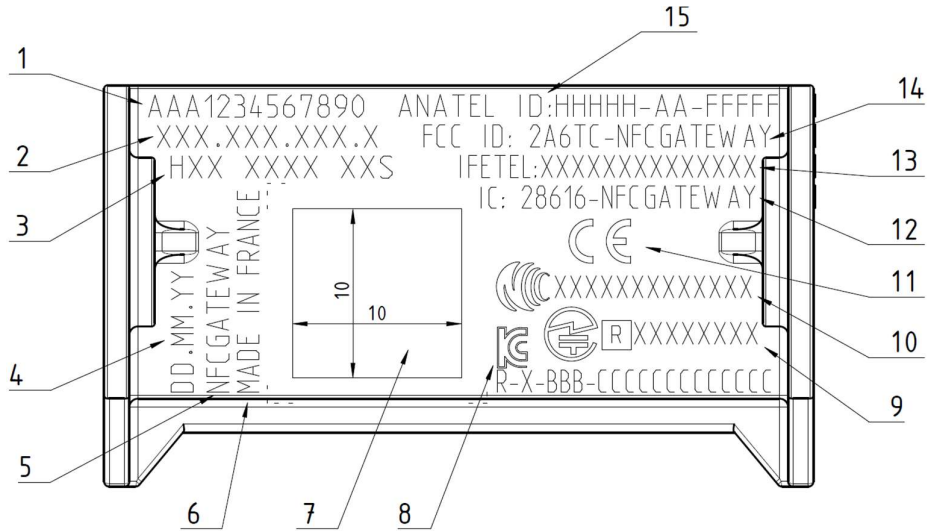

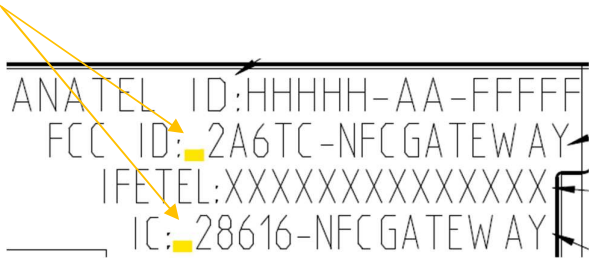

2.2 Interpretation of “must”

"**Must**," the imperative form of the verb, is used throughout this standard whenever a requirement is intended to express a provision that is mandatory. Deviation from a "**must**" requirement may be considered if sufficient data is supplied to justify the exception. The words "**should**" and "**may**" are used whenever it is necessary to express non-mandatory provisions. "**Will**" is used to express a declaration of purpose. To assist the reader, the word "**must**" is presented in bold characters

3 MARKING AREA

Marking area **must** be positioned on the flat area on Housing between ears:
