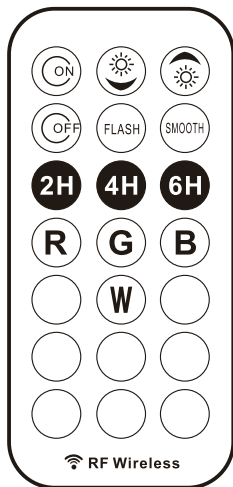

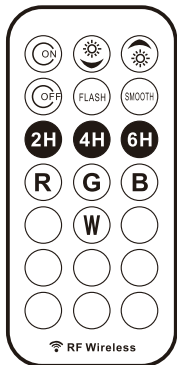

Remote Control



☾ OFF: Turn off ☀ ON: Turn on

☀ Brightness Up: 6 levels of brightness
(25%-40%-55%-70%-85%-100%)

☾ Brightness Down: 6 levels of brightness
(100%-85%-70%-55%-40%-25%)

Ⓡ R: Red

Ⓢ G: Green

Ⓑ B: Blue

Ⓦ W: White

⚡ FLASH fast jump mode (R + G + B), press ☀ ☾ to adjust the jump speed

Ⓢ SMOOTH slow gradual change mode (colorful), press ☀ ☾ to adjust the gradual change speed

Ⓜ 2H / 4H / 6H Timing function:

Press the 2H / 4H / 6H key in any mode, indicating that the light will automatically turn off after the light works 2 hours/4 hours/6 hours. (Flash 2 times after press the timing keys means it starts timing)
