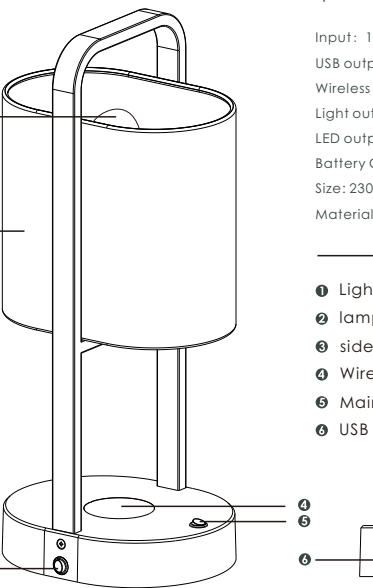

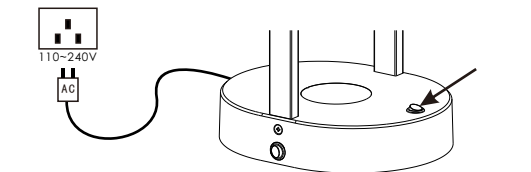

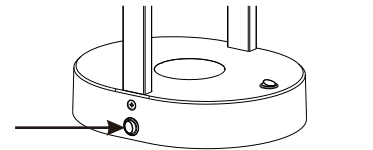
2 HOW TO USE IT

1>How to use a lamp

1. Turn on the main switch to light the bulb; turn off the main switch to turn off the bulb.



2. Turn on the side switch, and the emergency LED light will automatically turn on when the power is cut off; otherwise, the emergency function cannot be used.
3. Turn on the side switch to charge the built-in battery; otherwise, it cannot be charged.



2>How to use the Charging function

1. USB charging: Plug in the USB charging cable to charge devices such as mobile phones.
2. Wireless charging: Place a mobile phone with wireless charging function in the center of the wireless charging position to start wireless charging.

3 FAQ and Solution

When the lamp is bad, first check the AC line and whether the connection is successful. Check that the main switch is turned on.

When the wireless charge is not charged.

1. First check whether your device supports wireless charging.
 2. Position your device, mobile location, near the center of the wireless charging zone.
 3. If your phone has a protective shell, please try again after removing the protective shell.
 4. If your device has a wireless charging receiver, please confirm whether the wireless charging receiver is working properly.
- If not, please contact your dealer.

When the USB port is not charged.

Make sure your charging line is good, and check the connection is successful.

4 Safety instructions

1. Do not disassemble or throw into fire or water, to avoid causing a short circuit leakage.
2. Do not use Lamp in severely hot, humid or corrosive environments, to avoid circuit damage and occurs leakage phenomenon.
3. To take care of the children, to ensure that they won't play the Lamp as a toy, to avoid unnecessary accidents.
4. Please do not use products for a long time, for example, for more than 48 hours.

5 Warranty

We supply warranty service ,in the case of product does not work in the normal use and identified by our company service commitment.

1. Due to improper operation of the user's fault.
