1. Product Overview

The built-in cam is a system that records video, audio, and vehicle driving data input from the front and rear cameras (total of 2 channels) of the vehicle and provides stored video.

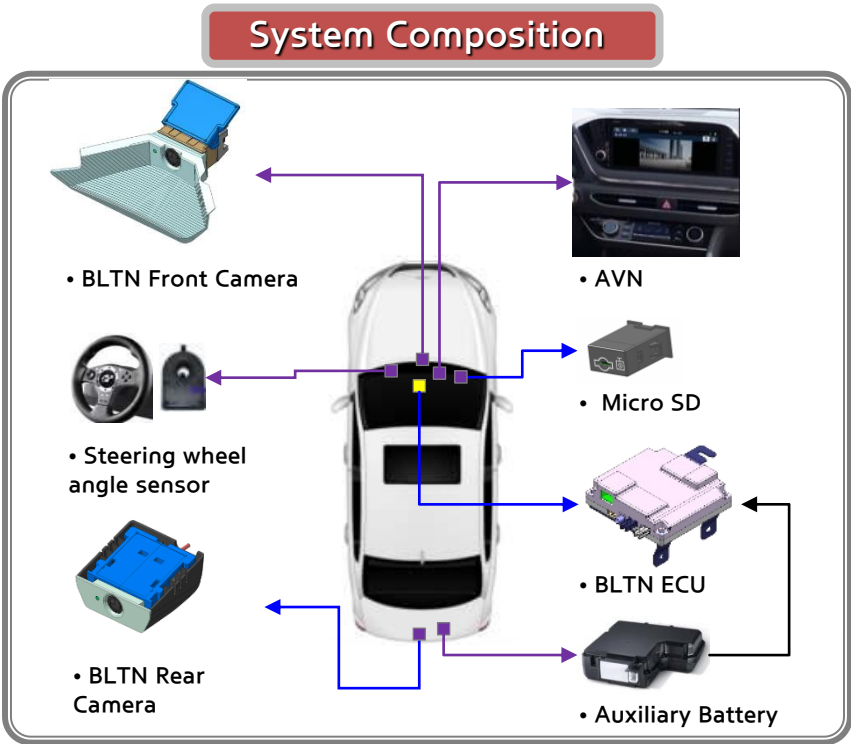
The built-in cam aims to provide convenience by recording video of the front and rear of the vehicle according to each condition when driving with the ignition turned on and when parking after the ignition is turned off.

2. How to use the product

The built-in cam camera transmits front/rear vehicle video, audio, impact detection, and motion detection data captured by the image module to the built-in cam controller.

This product cannot be installed by the general user because it is only sold at the official AS center. It automatically operates according to the setting in vehicle driving or parking without any separate operation.
