1 Introduction

1.1 Acknowledgement

Thanks for your purchase of our product. This model is high definition tablet PC. Its MTK8312 Cortex-A9 Dual core 1GHz CPU, is based on the Android 4.2.2 operating system, dual sim, double standby support 3G.

The product is designed with various features, including 2G, 3G, WiFi, BlueTooth, GPS, FM radio, voice call functions, SMS sending/receiving and so on. With the tablet it is very easy to achieve wireless communication and internet, as you can access/surf the internet anytime and anywhere. It also has a built-in high-accuracy GPS module, that can be used for navigating through installed map and navigation software. There are many sensors that will offer you brand-new operation and entertainment. For the shutterbugs, it has built-in camera sensors for capturing those precious moments.

This user manual introduces the functions, techniques and tips in the proper use of the tablet. Please read this manual carefully before using the device.

1.2 Announcements

Proper maintenance

• Please always keep the device dry to avoid corrosion and electric short. Please keep the device, battery and charger away from water and moisture. Don't operate the device or charger when you have a wet hand.

- To avoid failure of device, battery and charger, please do not violently shake or short-circuit.
- To avoid failure of device, battery and charger, please prevent the device, battery, charger from over heating or getting exposed into cold temperatures
- Never short circuit, throw, prod, drop, or bend the device.

2.1 device Operation and Preparation

Battery Charging

If this is the first time that the device will be used, please use supplied charger/adaptor to

fully charge it.

1. Insert the power adaptor on the charging port to charge the device.

Reminder icons

When some reminder message appears in your reminder window, please click column and slide the screen to open the reminder list. Choose the menu you need, and confirm the information. Then you can close the reminder window through clicking the column and slide up. Please refer to the status icons below:

3 Quick Start Guide 3.1 Keys Function

Keys Functions Description:

Power button	Short press to sleep/wake up, long press to startup and shutdown
Volume + (up)	Increase the volume
Volume - (down)	Decrease the volume
HOME button	Click in any interface to return to main interface / home screen
General Back button	Click in any interface to return to previous menu/page
Menu button	Display menu interface
Display recently-used application	Display recently browsed history

3.2 Startup and Shutdown

Startup

Long press **POWER button for three seconds**, then the device will enter into startup mode.

Shutdown

- 1. Long press POWER, the shutdown window will pop-up.
- 2. Shutdown window contains three options: mute mode, airplane mode and shutdown
- 3. Choose Shutdown

3.3 Open and Close/Sleep the Screen

Screen will be sleep on its own when there is no device use/operation for a specific span of time

- 1. Screen will sleep on its own if no operation happens for some time to save battery power
- 2. When screen is open, press POWER button, the screen will sleep immediately. **Open the screen when it is closed.**

If the screen is closed/asleep, short press the POWER button to wake-up the screen. The screen will

wake up, but locked. It will show the picture as shown below, slide left to enter into camera, slide right towards the unlock icon to unlock the screen.

3.4 Usage of Touch Screen

device operating methods

There are methods to view the main screen, menu and application procedure in your device

Click

When you want to use the screen for keyboard typing or to choose an application in the main interface, you only need to touch it with your finger.

Press on

If you want to open some item (text box or the link in the webpage) or shortcut, just press directly on that specific item.

Quickly slide or slide

Quickly slide or slide indicates to make quick vertical or horizontal movements on the screen by finger strokes.

Pull

Before you pull, you need to hold the item within a few seconds until you pull it into the position you want.

Rotate

For most pictures, you only need to rotate the device side wise to change the screen orientation from horizontal to vertical. In instances like when you are typing words and watching movies.

3.5 Home Page

Main interface as shown below (picture 3.2). Long press any blank part of the screen and a window

The extended home page

The home page can be extended beyond the screen to provide more space, which you can put newlyadded shortcuts and widgets. Click the blank space in home page then slide right or left to extend to the right or left side of the screen. In the home page, there are two extended sides (both on left and rights sides), as seen in Picture 3.3.

Shortcut icons management in desktop Create folder icon in desktop

Drag the icons need to be put together on one icon (can also overlay several icons) Click the overlaid icons, the applications will then be organized into a folder (inside a folder icon)

Click the unnamed folder, then the on-screen keyboard will pop-up. You can rename the folder, and reposition the icons (through long press on icons).

3.6 Open Applications Menu

Click key to enter into main interface as Picture 3.6, choose the application you want to open.

3.7 USB Connection

device storage configuration

Before transmitting documents, you have to configure your device:

1. Connect the device to the computer by USB cable, a reminder pop-up will show you the notification.

2. Open the reminder pop-up; please view the device status and reminder to learn how to open the reminder.

3. In the reminder pop-up, click "USB Connected", as below Picture 3.4, then click "open USB storage configuration".

4. Now the USB is connected successfully.



Copy files/documents into memory card

- 1. Connect the device to computer with USB cable.
- 2. Set device storage configuration, and confirm it is connected with computer.
- 3. Open the "My computer" in your computer, check the items named "removable disk".
- 4. Copy the files/documents you need into "removable disk".
- 5. After copying is finished, click "shutdown the USB storage configuration".

Notice: When the device is connected with USB cable, and you open the USB storage configuration, you can't view the memory card through the device. Only after you detach the USB cable, you can view the memory card contents in the device

4.1-1 Voice call Click settings in main menu, choose SIM Management, as Picture 4.1

4.4 Security settings

Set lock screen passcode

Lock the touch screen by unlock icon or password to protect your device. Note: After setting screen lock, you should enter the passcode everytime when you open the screen

Set unlock pattern

- 1. Click **Settings** application in main interface.
- 2. Click Security.
- 3. Click Screen lock.
- 4. Choose Pattern.
- 5. Click next (following the reminder message).

6. The unlock pattern board pops up, there are nine touch spots, connect 4 points from vertical, horizontal or diagonal direction. As seen in Picture 4.10, move your finger from the screen when finished. The system will record your new unlock pattern.

- 7. Click continue.
- 8. When you see the reminder, enter the unlock pattern, then click **confirm**.

- 6. Enter new PIN code again and click **confirm**.

Set unlock password

- 1. Click **Settings** application in main interface.
- 2. Click Security.
- 3. Click screen lock.
- 4. Set password.
- 5. Set new password(letters and numbers) and then click continue.
- 6. Enter the password again and the click confirm. Installing apk from unknown sources
- 1. In main interface, click Settings.

8 Trouble Shooting

1. The first startup of device is slow

After the **device** system is upgraded, on the first startup, the system need to install the pre-installed application softwares, the lead time is around 2-3 minutes, startup afterwards will be much quicker.

2. device can't connect to Wi-Fi

- Make sure the wireless router of internet provider is working normally.
- Ensure the **device** and wireless router are both in operational distance, and no wall or other barrier is between them.
- Ensure the user name and password are correct.

3. device feels hot

When many application procedures are used in multitasking, or the brightness of screen is too high, or the phone is currently being charged, the **device** may feel hot to the touch. This is normal.

4. Email can't be set

- Ensure the device is connected with the internet
- Make sure your email setting is correct.
- Keep your system time and local time consistent.

5. The application doesn't open

When you install some third party application, it may not open. You can press **Reset key** (next to power port) to reset the system.

6. The webpage can't be opened

- Please keep the distance between from router to **device** in operational range.
- Please restart WIFI and try again.

7. device works terribly slowly sometimes

It is normal phenomenon. Please turn off the applications you don't need in task manager, or uninstall some third party application to release more system resource
