MUSIC CONTROL

Press and hold the volume + or - repeatedly to switch the next or previous track.

TAKING / REJECTING CALLS

Redialing:

Double click the Multifunction button to redial a latest number in your call logs.

Please read this user manual carefully before using headset, also read your device's user manual regarding the bluetooth function. Pay attention to important safety and maintenance information.

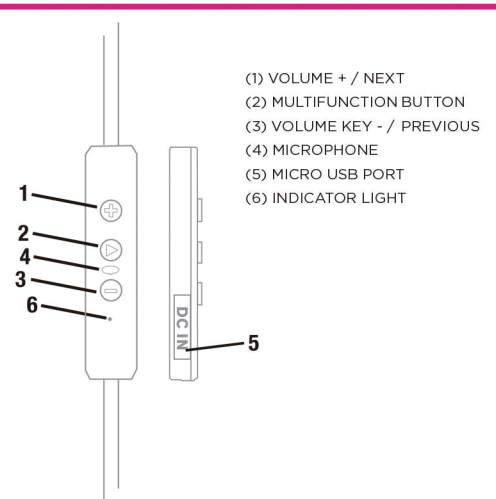

AUTOMATIC RECONNECTION

Once the headset and the pairing device have been paired together, they will automatically be reconnected if they are within distance of each other and the pairing device's Bluetooth function is turned on.

CHARGING

For first time use, charge the battery until it is full. To charge, open the headset's USB jack and plug the charging cable into the charging port. Red light means it is charging, blue light means the battery has been fully charged.



TURNING ON

Press and hold the Multifunction button of the headset for about 3 seconds, then the blue light will flash.

PAIRING

Place the headset and the pairing device within 3 feet of each other.

Press and hold the Multifunction button for 5 seconds. The **red and blue** light will flash, signaling that it is in pairing mode.

Activate your pairing device's Bluetooth feature. Search for **"MC58"**, and select it to connect. If a password is requested, key in "0000".

VOLUME CONTROL

Press the volume + or - repeatedly to adjust the volume.
