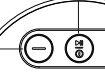
Getting Started

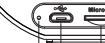
Keys and Components

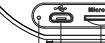
Previous/VOL-: Press it to switch to previous track, press and hold it to turn down the volume.

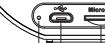
Power: Long press to turn on/off, short press to pause/playback.

Switch key: Press it 2 seconds quickly switching it between Bluetooth mode and micro SD card mode.

Next/VOL+: Press it to switch to next track, long press to turn up the volume.

Reset hole: Reset the device with thin stick when the speaker halted.

Micro SD card: Insert a micro SD card and play the audio files.

USB port: Charging

Power on/off

1 Press and hold for 3 seconds to turn on/off the speaker

Press and hold for 2 seconds to turn on the speaker, the speaker makes a ding dong sound, and the blue LED starts flashing; press and hold for 2 seconds again to turn off the speaker.

Connect to other Bluetooth devices

1 Bluetooth connection

Turn on Bluetooth on the mobile phone, tablet PC or other devices, search for Bluetooth device "BV130" , and then tap Connect to confirm.

2 Successfully connect to Bluetooth and play

After pairing successfully, the device makes ding-dong-ding sound, the blue LED stays, and then you can select and play music files on mobile phone or tablet PC.

1. If necessary, type "0000" and tap OK to connect

2. The Bluetooth speaker will connect to the last paired device automatically (when turned on)

3 Disconnect Bluetooth device

When the speaker and the device are connected, press both   to disconnect the Bluetooth connection, accompanied by a thud sound; the speaker is available for connect now and the blue LED starts flashing.

4 Bluetooth reconnection

When the Bluetooth is disconnected, you can tap  to connect to last paired device.

Playing music on Micro SD card

1 Insert a Micro SD card and turn on the device

Insert a Micro SD card with music files into the card slot, press and hold the Power button to turn on the speaker, accompanied by a ding-dong sound.

2 Switch to Micro SD music mode

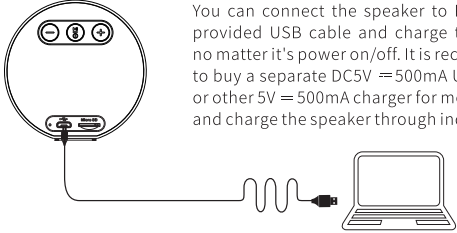
Press twice the Mode switch button  , and the speaker will make a dong-dong sound and play the music files on Micro SD card.

Tip: BT is the default mode of the Bluetooth speaker; if want to play music on Micro SD card, switch to Micro SD card mode first; if the speaker is turned on, the files on the Micro SD card will be played automatically when the card is inserted.

Charging mode

1 Charging mode

You can connect the speaker to PC with the provided USB cable and charge the speaker no matter it's power on/off. It is recommended to buy a separate DC5V ≐500mA USB charger or other 5V ≐500mA charger for mobile phone and charge the speaker through indoor outlet.



Troubleshooting

| Fault                      | Solution                                                                                                |

| Pairing failed repeatedly  | 1. Turn off the speaker and restart it                                                                  |
|                            | 2. If your device requires code, type 0000                                                              |
| Music play interrupted     | 1. Check if the device is out of effective range, or if there is barrier between speaker and the device |
| Micro SD card format error | 1. Check if the Micro SD card format is proper (speaker supports FAT32 format)                          |
|                            | 2. Check if the file formats of the Micro SD card are WAV, WMA, Mp3                                     |
| No sound during playing    | 1. Check if the speaker volume is adjusted properly                                                     |
|                            | 2. Check if the speaker is or paused                                                                    |
| Can't turn on the speaker  | 1. Restart the speaker, use the reset function                                                          |
| No reaction                | 1. Restart the speaker, use the reset function                                                          |

Tips: If the device isn't used for a long time, pls charge it before use it again. It will automatically power off after 10 minutes without connecting with bluetooth or not inserting micro SD card.
