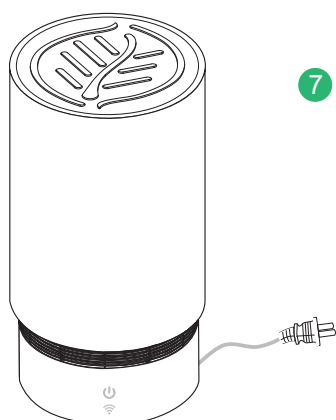
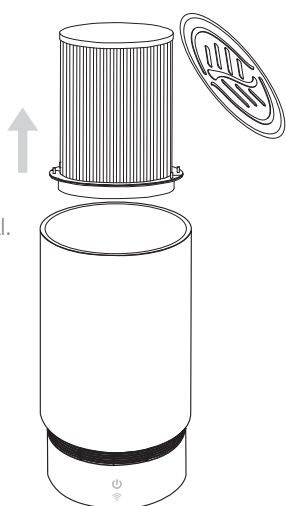


6 Replace a filter

- Wipe your Air purifier with a soft and dry cloth.



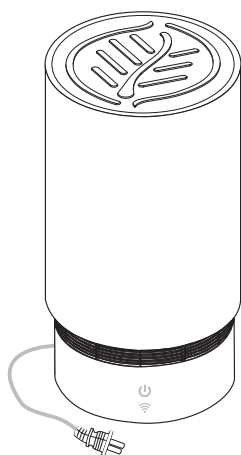

1 Start your Air purifier

- Replace the cover on top of the unit.
- Press the button “” on the device.
- The Wi-Fi light blinking when the unit is ready to be connected.



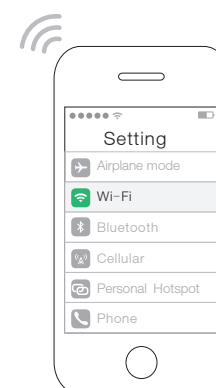
2 Download and launch the Air purifier app

- Follow the instructions on your mobile app.

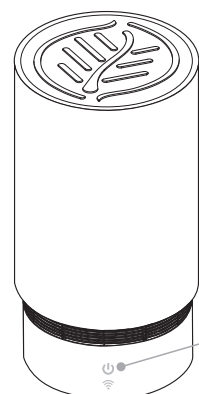
3 Set the Wi-Fi

- Select the Wi-Fi feature in the settings of your smartphone (or tablet).
- Follow the app instructions.
- The device connects to the smartphone (or tablet) when the Wi-Fi light is switched on.



4 Select the operating mode from the mobile app

- In the mobile app, go to the dedicated interface operating modes.
- Choose the mode you want: smart* / manual / automatic.
- Click “Apply” to save your settings.



5 Power control on the device

- Press the power button to turn on/off of the unit and adjust the fan power. (Pic. 1)
