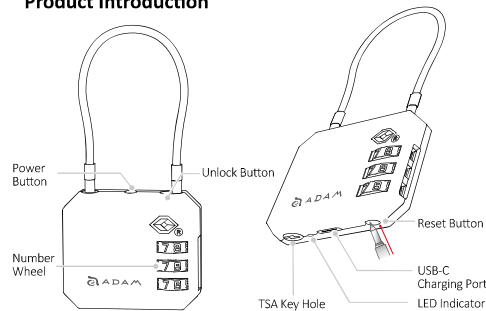

Product Introduction



How to change combination number

1. Align all number wheels to the factory default setting (000).
2. Using a pen or a pointed object, press the reset button and keep it pressed throughout the next step.
3. While continuing to press the reset button, rotate the number wheels to your desired combination.
4. Remove the pen to release the reset button. If the unlock button can be released normally, the combination has been reset.

LED Indicators Introduction

- Charging: Orange light stays on with two beeps.
- Fully Charging: Green light stays on.

How to Use

Power ON: Press the button once. A four-beep sound confirms the device is powered on.
Power OFF: Quickly press the button twice, then press and hold the third time. Two beeps confirm the device is powered off.
Reset: Quickly press the button four times, then press and hold the fifth time. Three beeps confirm the reset.

How to Pair For iPhone

1. Turn on Bluetooth on your iPhone.
 2. Make sure your **AVISTAR L01** is powered on.
 3. Open the Apple Find My app.
 4. In the **Items** tab, tap **Add Item**.
 5. Tap **Other Supported Item** (your iPhone will begin searching for the AVISTAR L01).
 6. When the padlock appears, tap **Connect**.
 7. Follow the onscreen instructions to name your padlock and register it to your Apple ID.
 8. Confirm that your AVISTAR L01 appears in the **Items** list.
- Do not leave the Apple Find My app while pairing your AVISTAR L01.
 - If your AVISTAR L01 does not appear in Items, remove the item from the app and perform a reset on the padlock (see "Reset" Settings), then try pairing again.

How to Pair For Google

1. Turn on your phone's Bluetooth and screen.
2. Power on AVISTAR L01 and place it within 20 cm of your Android phone.
3. Your phone will automatically enter pairing mode.
4. Tap the setup notification and follow the on-screen instructions.
5. Open the Find Hub app. (download it from Google Play if not already installed)
6. Go to My Devices to view the last known location and time of AVISTAR L01.

***Re-Pairing (if needed):**
Remove the AVISTAR L01 from the Find Hub app, then reset and pair it with your device again.

How to Charge

1. You can check the battery level by selecting your AVISTAR L01 in the Find My or Google's Find Hub app.
2. Charge your AVISTAR Padlock with a USB-C charger.



Unwanted Tracking Notification

If your AVISTAR Padlock is separated from your iPhone and detected moving with another person using an Apple device over time, that person will receive a tracking alert.
