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## Quick Guide

### Pairing and charging

#### 1 Charging pairing

Connect the charging cable to charge. If the stylus is not paired with any tablet at this time, it will enter the pairing state and the indicator light will flash blue. Follow the pop-up prompts on the tablet to complete the pairing (if the tablet does not respond, please check whether the Bluetooth function is turned on).



#### 2 Long press to pair

Press and hold the stylus button until the indicator light flashes blue to enter pairing mode. Follow the pop-up prompts on the tablet to complete pairing (if the tablet does not respond, check that Bluetooth is turned on).



Note: The stylus may gradually run out of power after being left out for a long time, and it needs to be charged for a few minutes before it can continue to be used.

# Changing the nib

- 1. Remove the nib: Pinch the nib and rotate it counterclockwise until it can be removed.
  - 2. Fit the nib: Pinch the head of the nib and insert the tail vertically into the back of the stylus, then rotate it clockwise until it is secure.
- Note: The nib will wear out with daily writing and at a faster rate on rough film surfaces.
