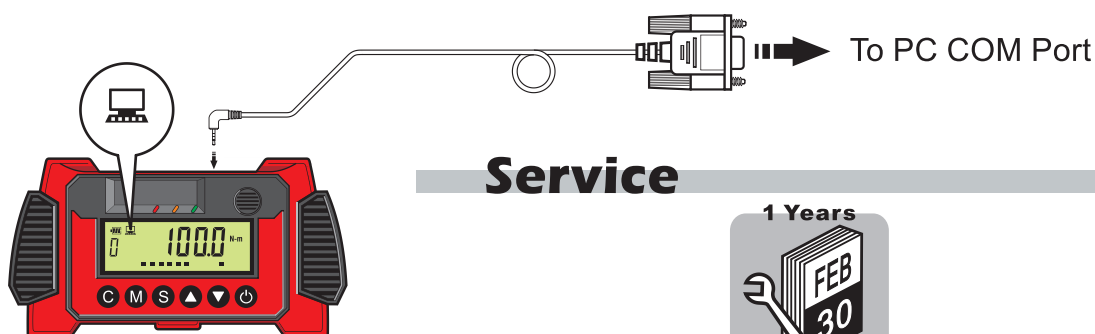
Working Diagram
