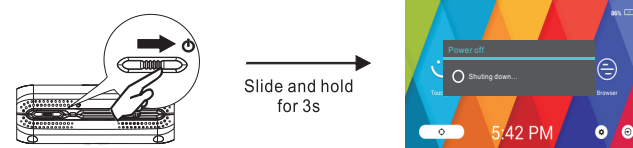
Sleep mode(when projector is on)

Slide once to enter sleep mode, slide again to awake.

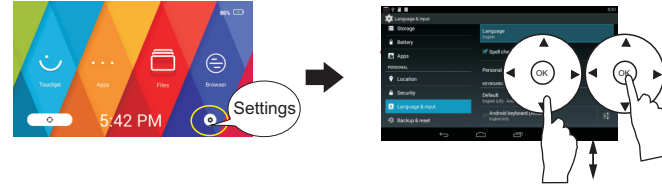

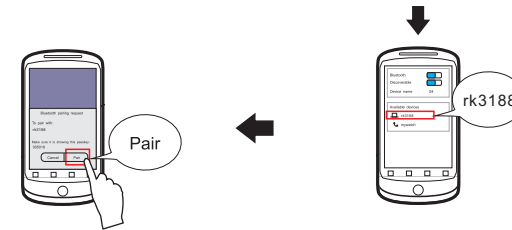
- ① Open Bluetooth in the settings of the projector



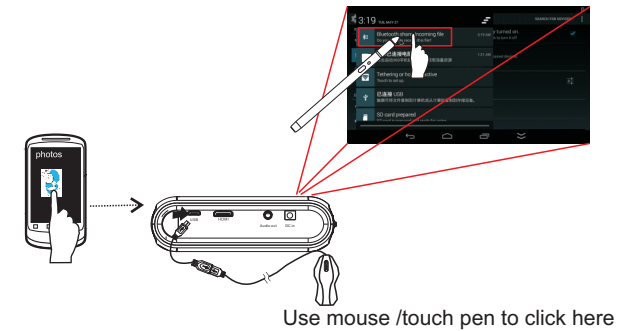
- ② Pair with smartphone



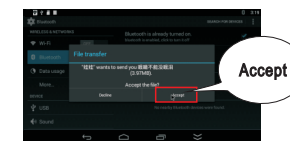

Quick Start Guide
