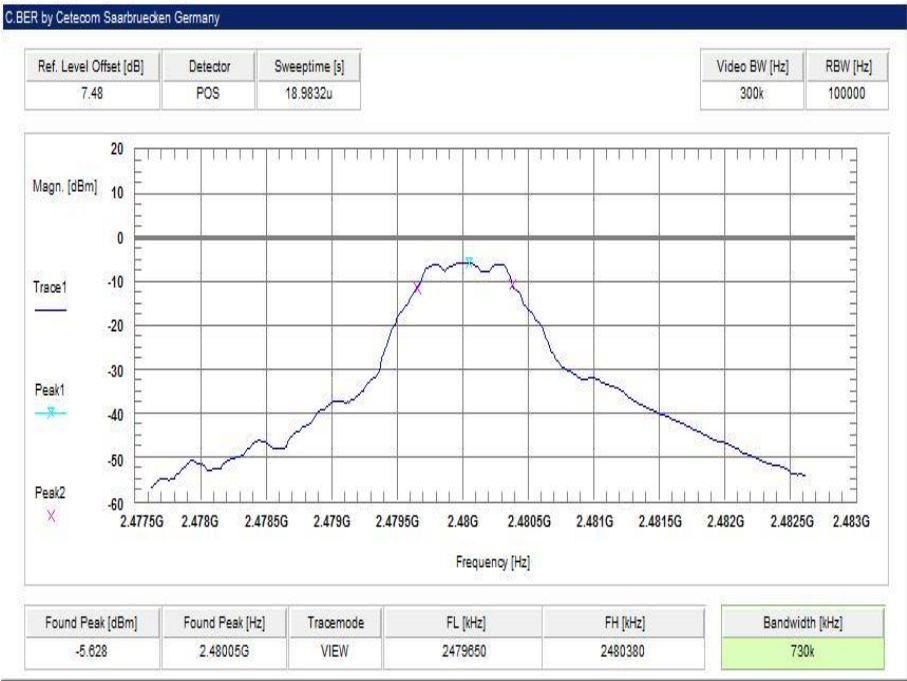
Plot 1: lowest channel

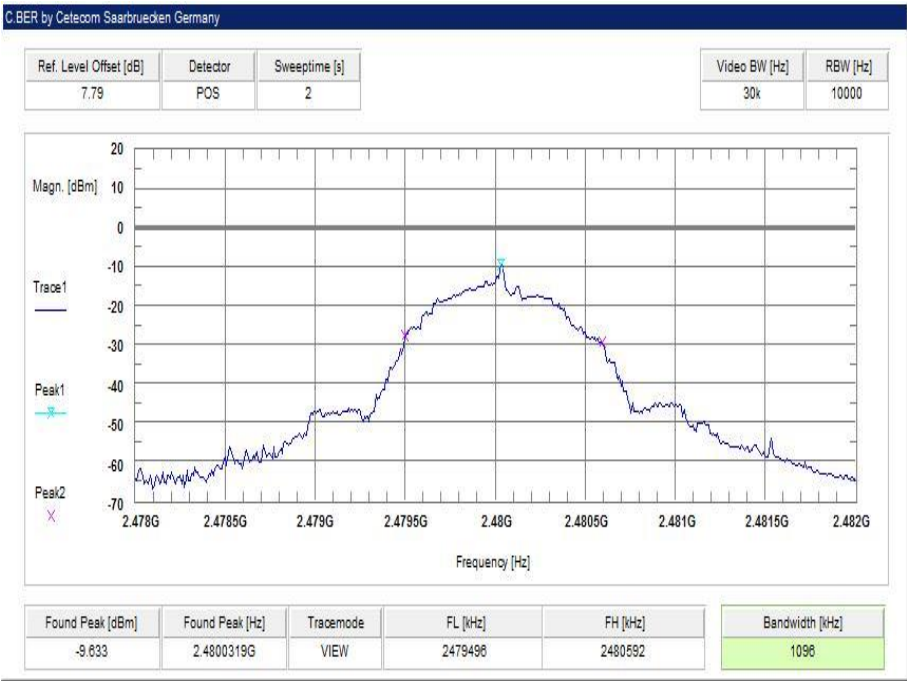
Plot 1: lowest channel

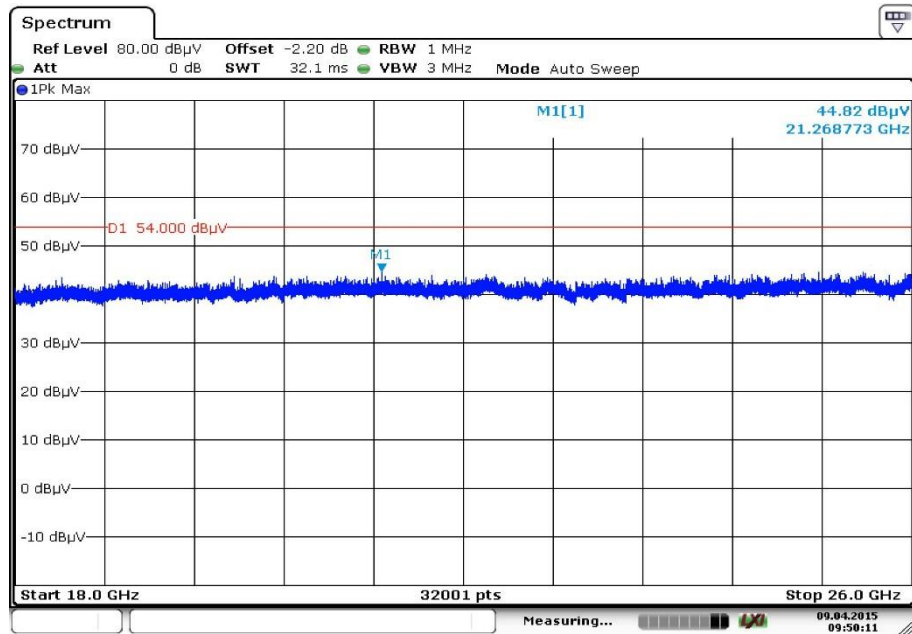

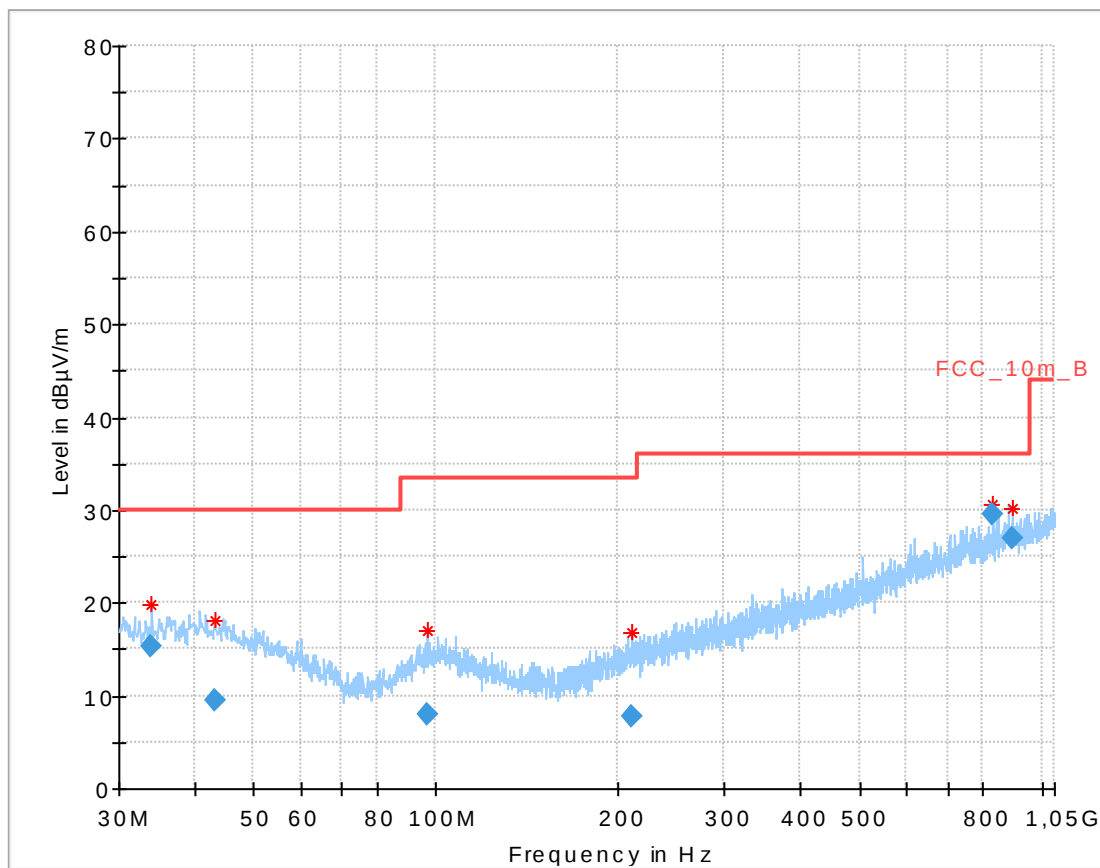
Plot 2: 1 GHz to 12.75 GHz, lowest channel, vertical & horizontal polarization

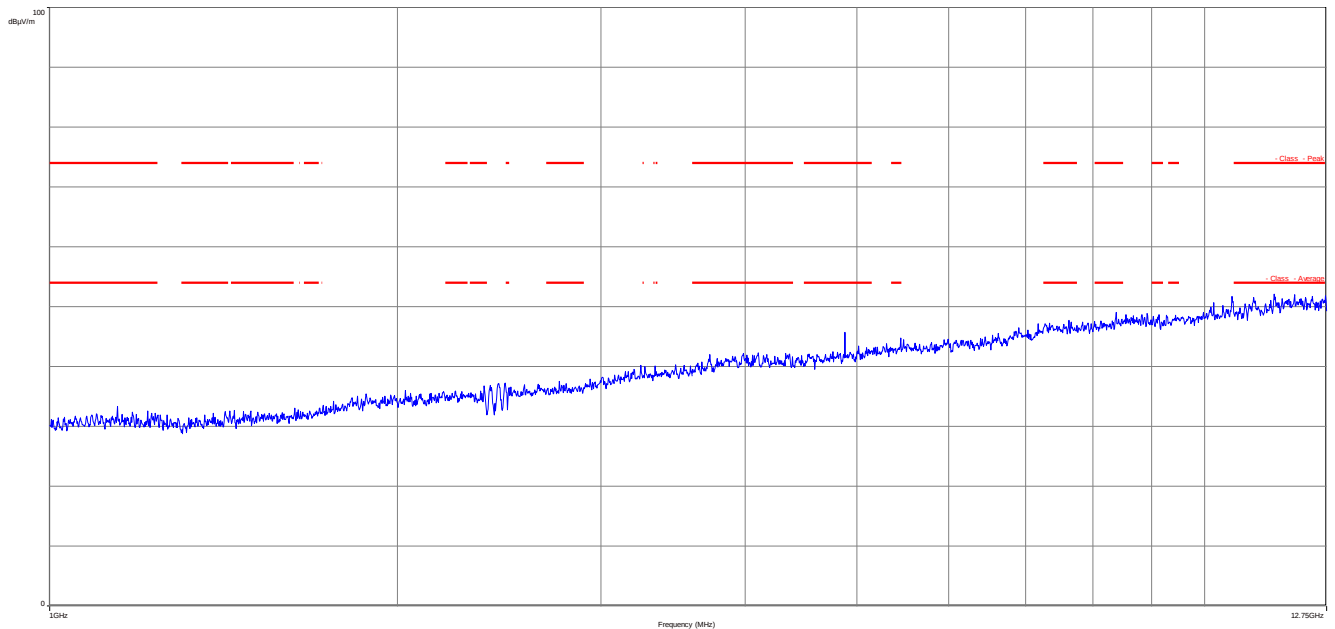

Plot 5: 30 MHz to 1 GHz, mid channel, vertical & horizontal polarization


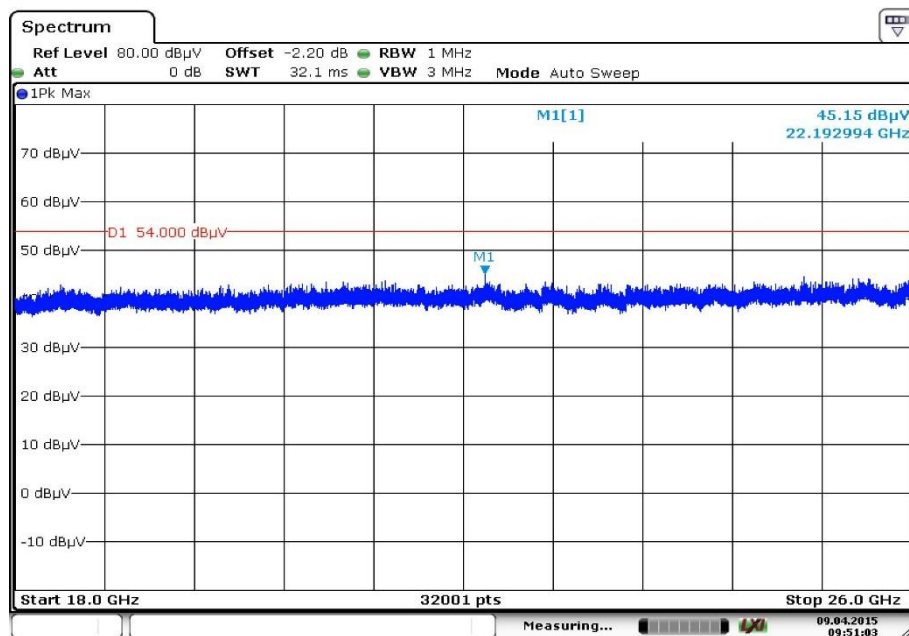

Plot 6: 1 GHz to 12.75 GHz, mid channel, vertical & horizontal polarization

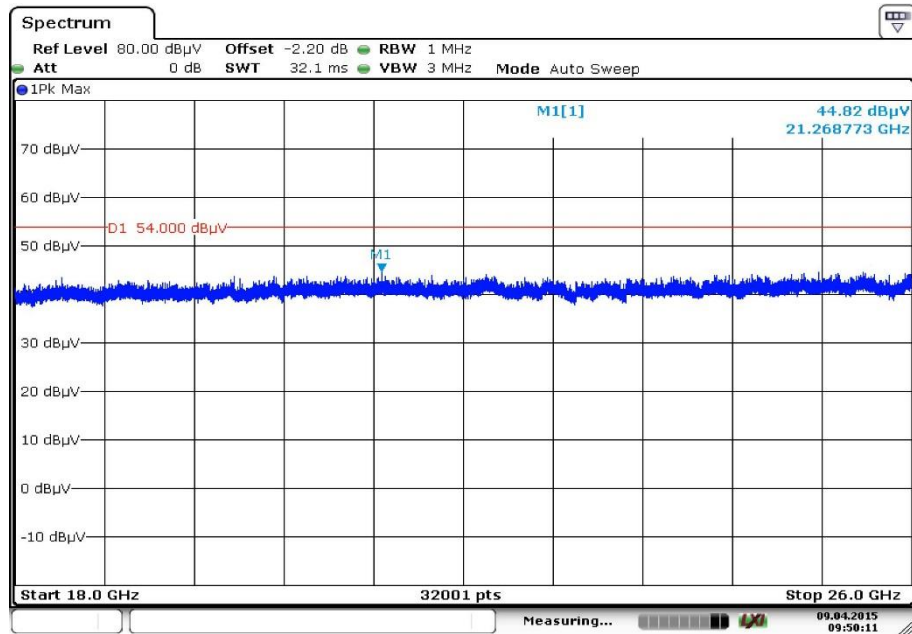

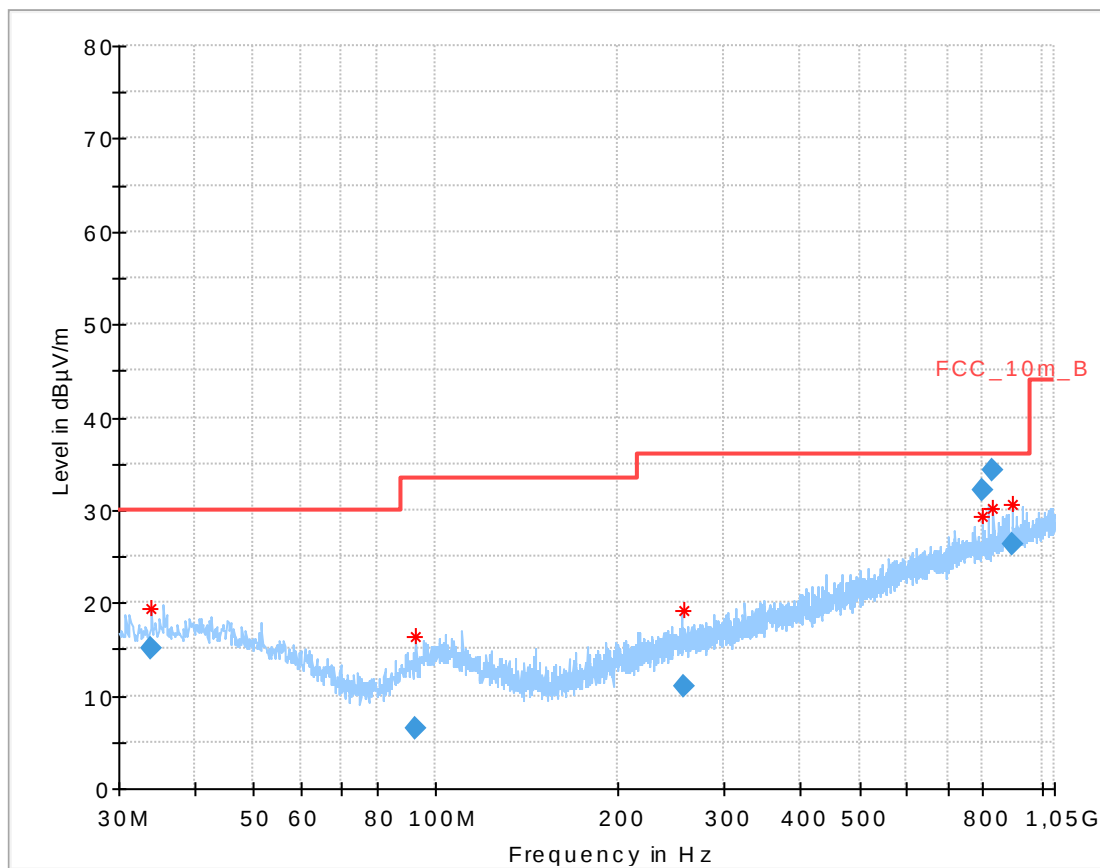
Plot 7: 12 GHz to 18 GHz, mid channel, vertical & horizontal polarization – valid for all channels



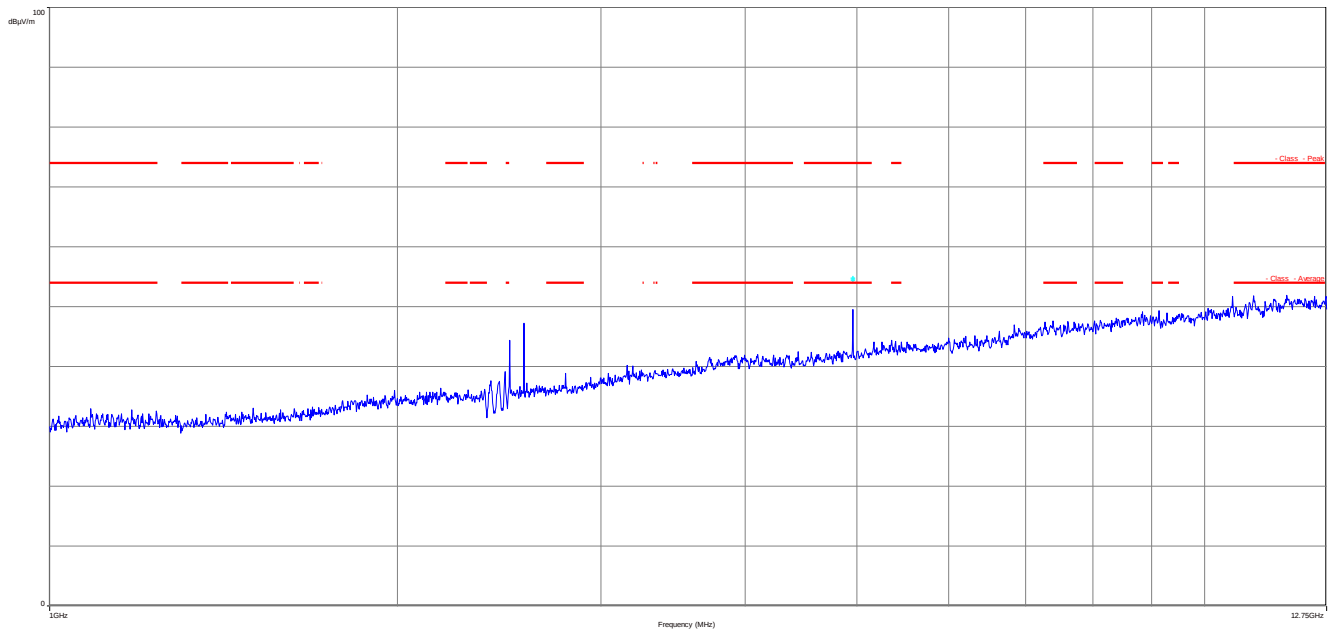

Plot 8: 18 GHz to 26 GHz, mid channel, vertical & horizontal polarization – valid for all channels

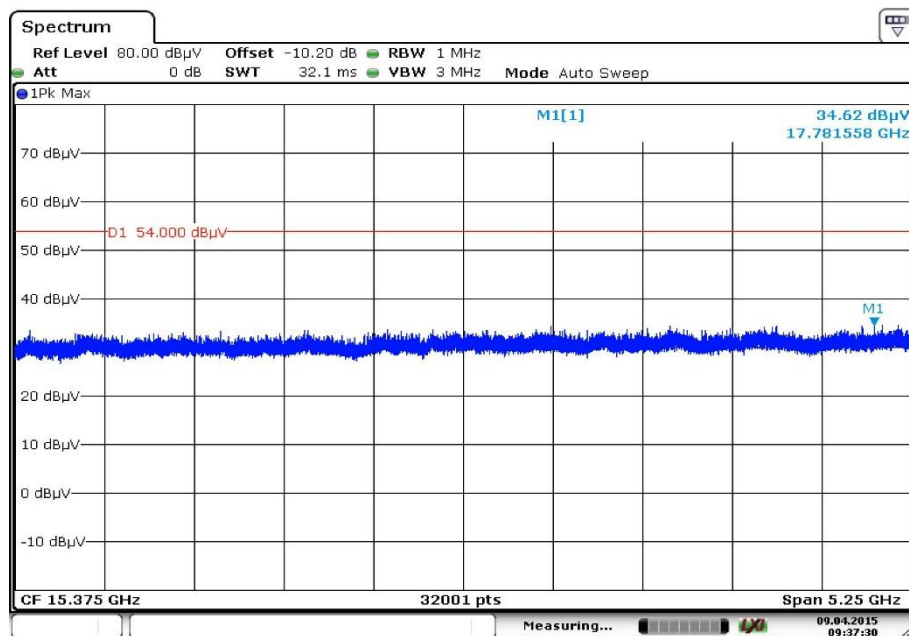

Plot 9: 30 MHz to 1 GHz, highest channel, vertical & horizontal polarization

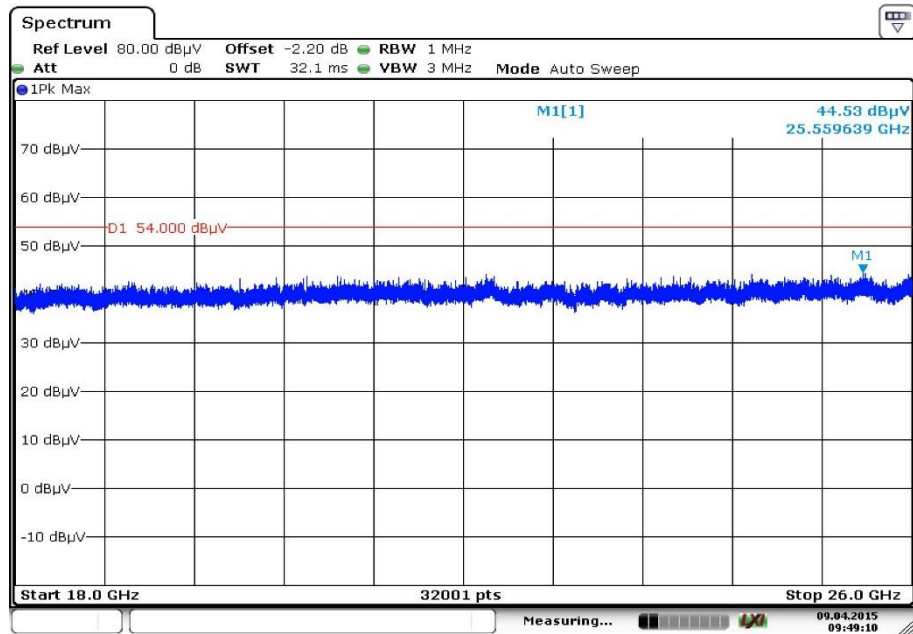

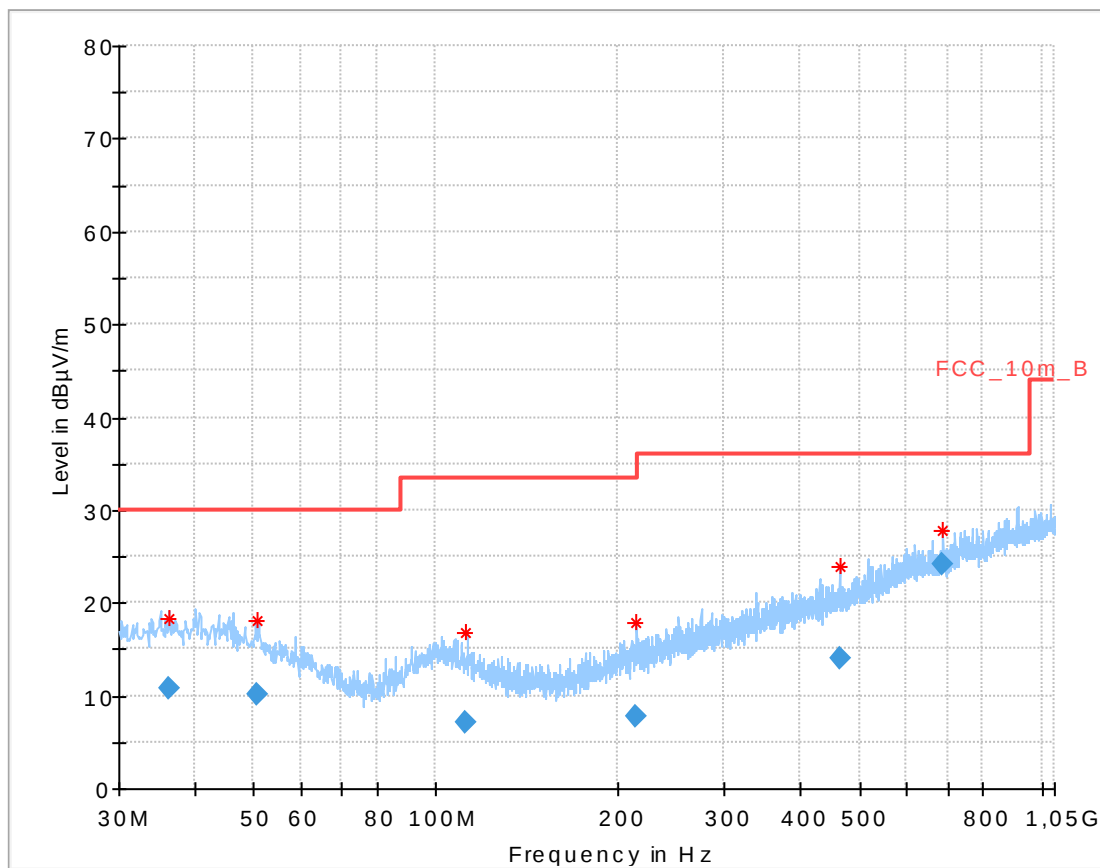

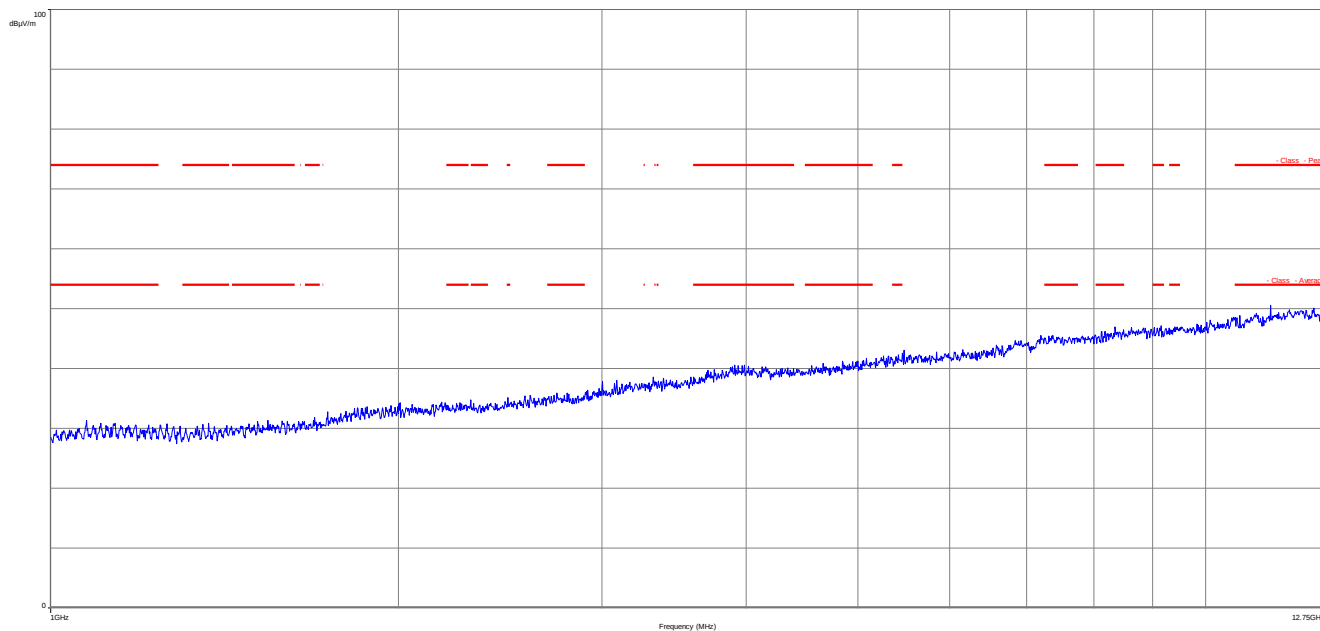

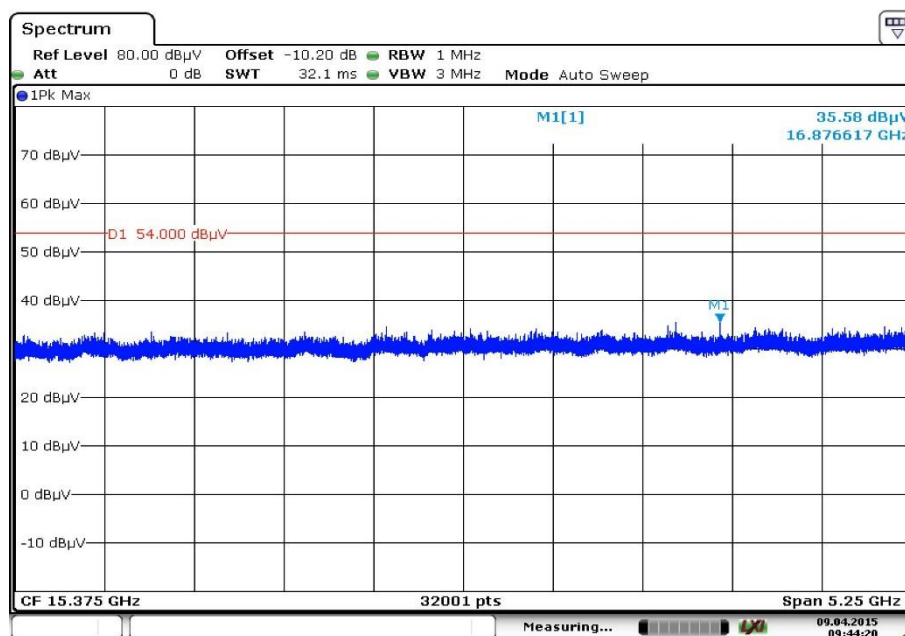

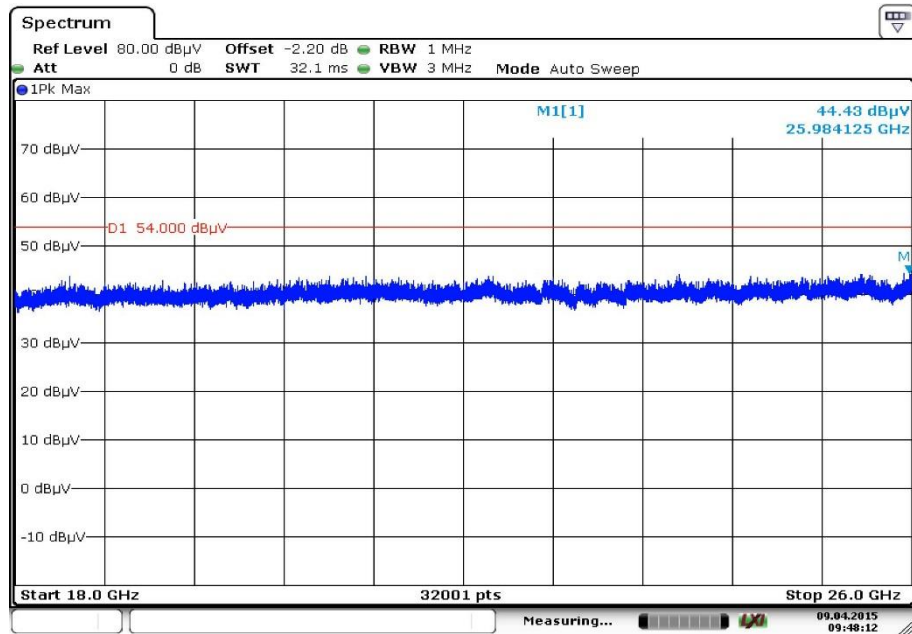
Plot 2: 1 GHz to 12.75 GHz, RX / idle – mode, vertical & horizontal polarization

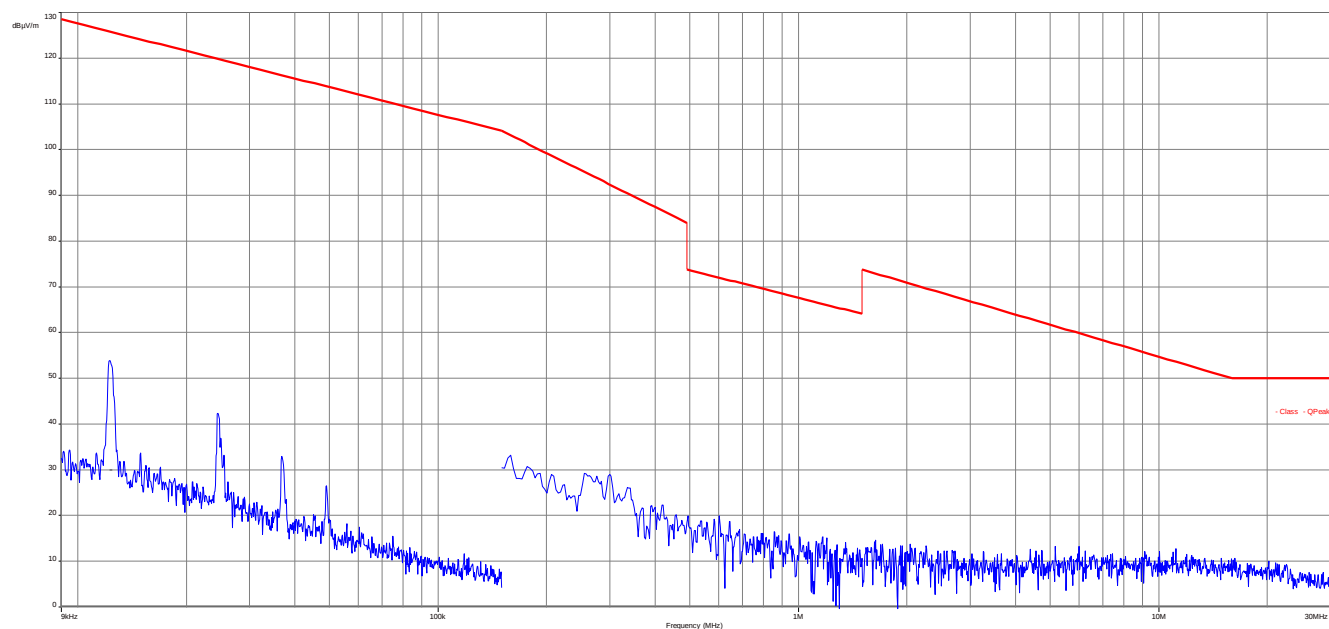

10 Test equipment and ancillaries used for tests

The calibration intervals are determined in accordance with the DIN EN ISO/IEC 17025. In addition to the external calibrations, the laboratory executes comparison measurements with other calibrated test systems or effective verifications. Weekly chamber inspections and range calibrations are performed. Where possible, rf-generating and signalling equipment as well as measuring receivers and analyzers are connected to an external high-precision 10 MHz reference (GPS-based or rubidium frequency standard).
