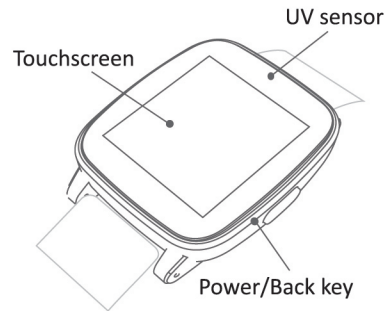

Learn the basics

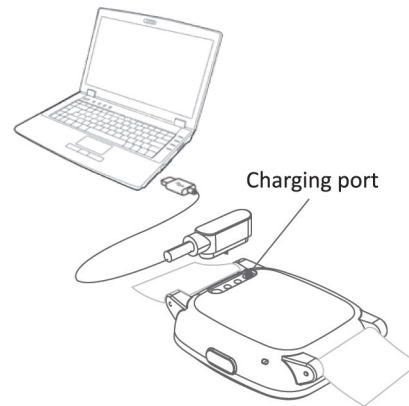


Turn on/ Turn off/ Back

1. Press and hold down power key 3 seconds to turn on/off smart watch.
2. Press power key to Home screen.

Charge your smart watch using the charging cable provided as accessory.

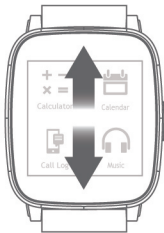
Navigation



Swipe the watchface left to view the app page.



Swipe the app page right to return watchface or return upper level menu.



Swipe the app page up or down to skim through.

Using smart watch with your phone

- Please download Sync APK into your Android phone by scanning the QR code on right side. It supports FW update and extra application installation; You can also download another APK/APP named as "Mediatek SmartDevice" from Google Play or App Store, but FW upgrade function is not available.
- Find BT connection in app page, use it pair with your phone, then start to sync!



About find my device

Requires BLE bluetooth and Android 4.4.
Switch APK connected mode "SPP" to "GATT" from mobile phone.
Switching APK connected mode should disconnected bluetooth with smart watch and turn off bluetooth of phone side.

Caution

- Only use the supplied cable to charge smart watch.
- Only use the supplied cable with USB-compliant ports and chargers.
- Do not charge smart watch in extremely hot or cold temperatures.
- Do not charge smart watch when it is wet to avoid electric shock.
- Do not dispose of smart watch in a fire. The battery could explode causing injury or death.
- Risk of explosion if battery is replaced by an incorrect type. Dispose of used batteries according to the instructions.

- This device complies with part 15 of the FCC rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) this device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.
- Changes or modifications not expressly approved by the party responsible for compliance could void the user's authority to operate the equipment.

Do not use your BT Smart Watch in damp areas (bathroom, swimming pool...). Protect it from liquids and other moisture. The max. recommended temperature is +40°C.

RF Exposure

When using the device, ensure that the antenna of the device is as least 20 cm away from all persons.
