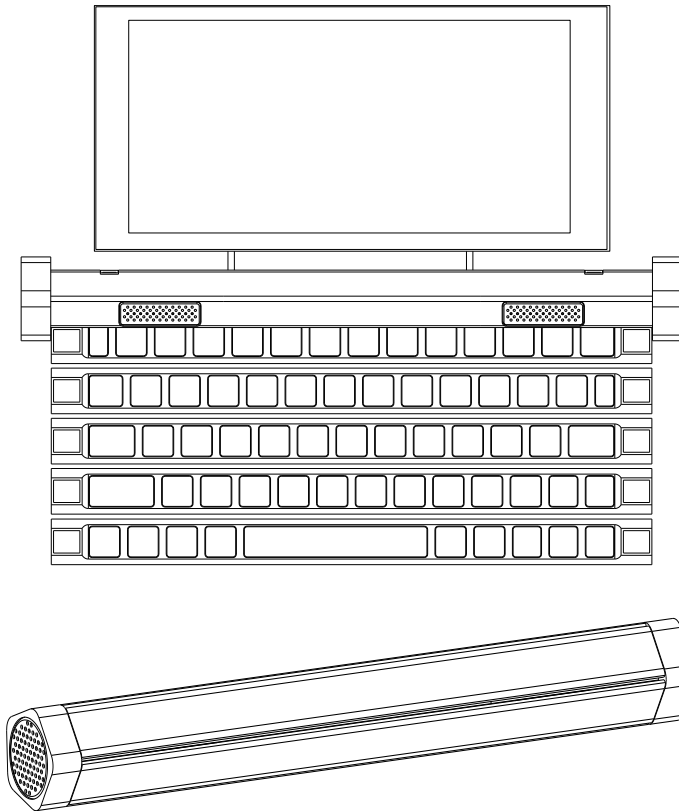
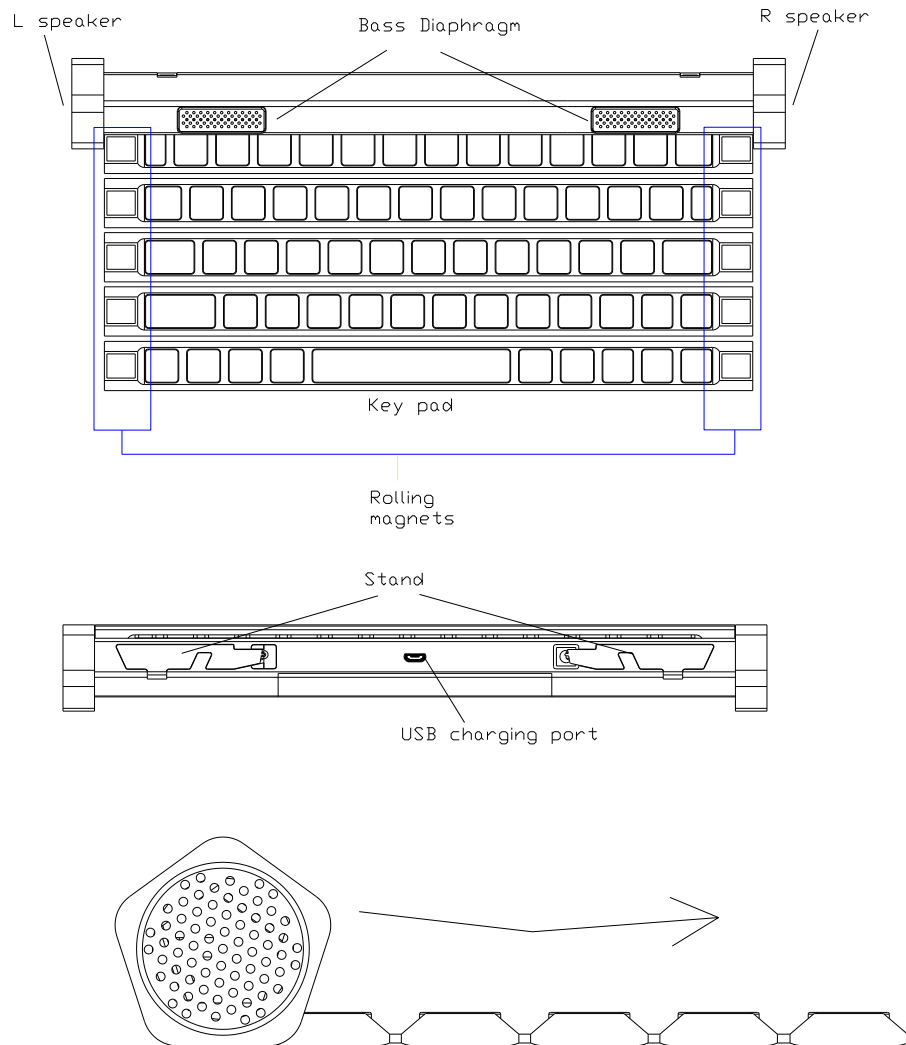


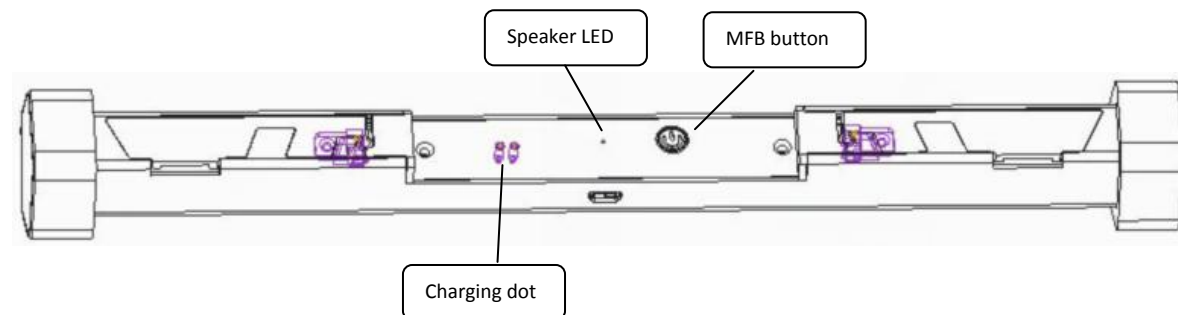
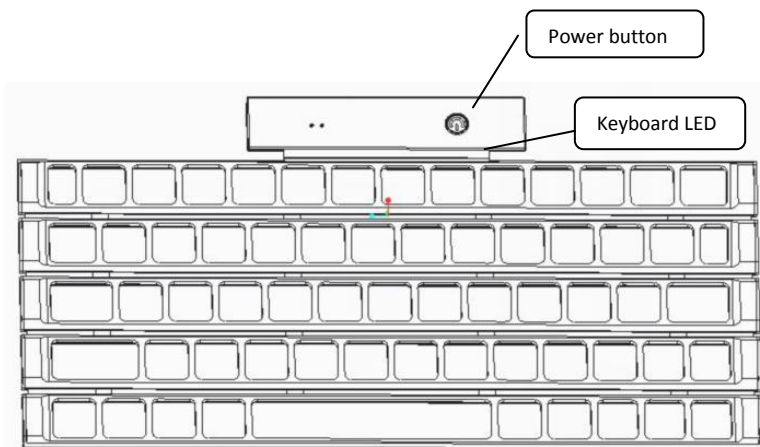
R1 User manual

Multi-function Rolly Bluetooth Keyboard and Multi-function Bluetooth Speaker



Bluetooth Keyboard

Function	Operation	LED indicator
Power on	Press the Power button for 2 seconds	Blue LED blink
Power off	Press the Power button for 2 seconds, and release it until the Red LED is quickly blinking twice	Red off
pairing mode	Make sure the keyboard is off. Press and hold FN key and press C key Blue LEDs blinking.	Blue LED blink
Caps lock	Short press Caps Lock key	Blue LED lights



Bluetooth Speaker

Function	Operation	LED indicator	Voice Prompt
Power on	Press the MFB button for 2 seconds, and release it till the blue LED is quickly blinking twice.	Blue LED blink	power on
Power off	Press the MFB button for 2 seconds	LED off	power off
pairing mode	Make sure the speaker is off. Press and hold MFB button for 4 seconds, and release it until the blue & red LEDs blink.	Blue & Red LEDs blink alternatively.	Pairing
Answer calling	Short press MFB button		
Pause music	Short press MFB button		
Play music	Short press MFB button		
Recalling	Double click MFB button		
Charging	Use charging cable	speaker red lights	
finish charging		blue lights	

How to use R1

1. Speakers and keyboard separately, press to the speaker MFB BUTTON for 2 seconds, boot into the pair mode.
2. Open the SETTINGS entry for the device to be connected, The Bluetooth for ON.
3. When the search to R1, select R1, when the display has been connected, The earphone LED into only blue in the blink.
4. Pick up the keyboard to press the power button for 2 seconds, the blue light slow flash, and then press the FN button, do not loose, press the "C" key, the blue light flashes slowly, that is into the pair mode.
5. Open the SETTINGS entry for the device to be connected, The Bluetooth for ON. when the search to " R1 keyboard", select R1 keyboard, when the display has been connected, the blue LED stop blink.
6. Start to enjoy R1
