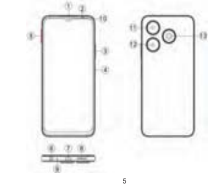

4. Basic functions

4.1 Lock and unlock the screen

Press power button to enter Sleep mode and meanwhile the screen will be locked, press power button again to wake up and then swipe up for unlock.

4.2. Make it yours

4.2.1 Home screen: It is your starting point to access all the features on your phone. It displays application icons, widgets, shortcuts, and other features. Long press home screen and drag it to the position you want.



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4.2.2 Notification Bar: At the top of the screen, the Status Bar displays the time, status, and notifications. If there is a new message, missed call, or other in the notification bar, you can drag it down to open the notification panel and click the desired one to view its content. When you finish, close it by dragging the panel up or pressing "Done".

Click and enter a complete phone number to make a call. Your phone supports smart search.



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10 Send and Receive message(s)

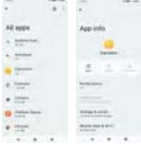
Tap to enter messaging, tap "Start chat".

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16 Face ID

Click Settings > Security & privacy > Device unlock > Face ID, follow the prompts. After completing the face recognition, you can use the face unlock function.



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15 APPLICATIONS & UTILITIES

For entertainment purposes, your device has access to several games, applications and utilities, such as Games, Entertainment, etc. Before accessing the applications, please activate the data or Wi-Fi connection.

15.1 Settings

Open the Wi-Fi setting, find a nearby Wi-Fi network and connect, then you can use Internet or download apps.



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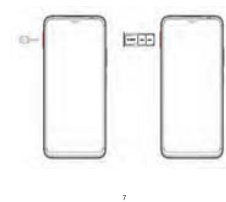
16.5 Fingerprint

Click Settings > Security & privacy > Device unlock > Fingerprint, follow the prompts. After completing the fingerprint recording, you can use the fingerprint unlock function.



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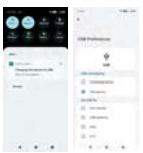
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4.2.4 Android™ and computer connection

If you connect your phone to a PC via USB, you can find the USB options, choose "This Device". For Transfer option, you will browse your phone memory in the PC, this is the same function as USB storage.



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8 Answering phone calls and rejection

When there is an incoming call, you can drag the icon up or down to answer or hang up directly.



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11 Browser the Web

11.1 Set up Internet/Data connection
Enter Settings > Network & Internet > SIM, tap your Mobile Operator name > Access Point Names, then choose the desired Internet access point.

11.2 Switch on Data or Wi-Fi connection
To browse the web, you need to switch on Data connection. If there is Wi-Fi access, you can switch on Wi-Fi and use it to browse the web.

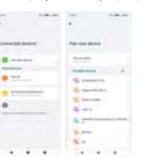
11.3 Enjoy music

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16.2 Bluetooth

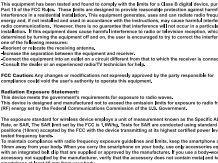
Settings > Connected devices > Pair new device
Pair to another Bluetooth device, then you can share music, photos, records, etc.



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16.3 Security

Click Settings > Security & privacy > Device unlock > Screen lock.
There are four screen lock ways for you to choose: Swipe, Pattern, PIN, and Password.



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16.3 Charge the battery

During charging, the battery indicator on the phone is a Transfer icon. If the device is switched off during charging, there will still be a charging indication on the screen that shows the phone is being charged. If the device is increased when the battery is low, the charging icon might also come true to appear.

When the battery indicator on the screen displays "Battery is full", the Transfer icon will disappear, which means the completion of charging. If the phone is switched off during charging, the screen will display "Battery is full". While charging, the battery, the device and the charger will get hot. This is normal.

Using the charger from the AC electrical outlet and disconnect the wiring between the phone and the charger after charging.

Caution: Charge the phone in a well-ventilated place in which the temperature is between -10°C to 40°C. Use the charger provided by the manufacturer only. The use of an unapproved charger may lead to danger and void the manufacturer's warranty clause.

If the temperature is too high or too low during charging, the device will automatically send a warning and stop charging to avoid damage to the battery.

16.3 Switch to Recently Used Application

Press the Menu key.

Tap to create a new contact.



By selecting the "Menu key" you can view your application history and select one of your previously used Apps.

To clear your recently used applications history, press the "Clear all" button.

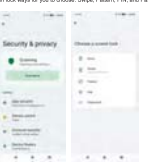
