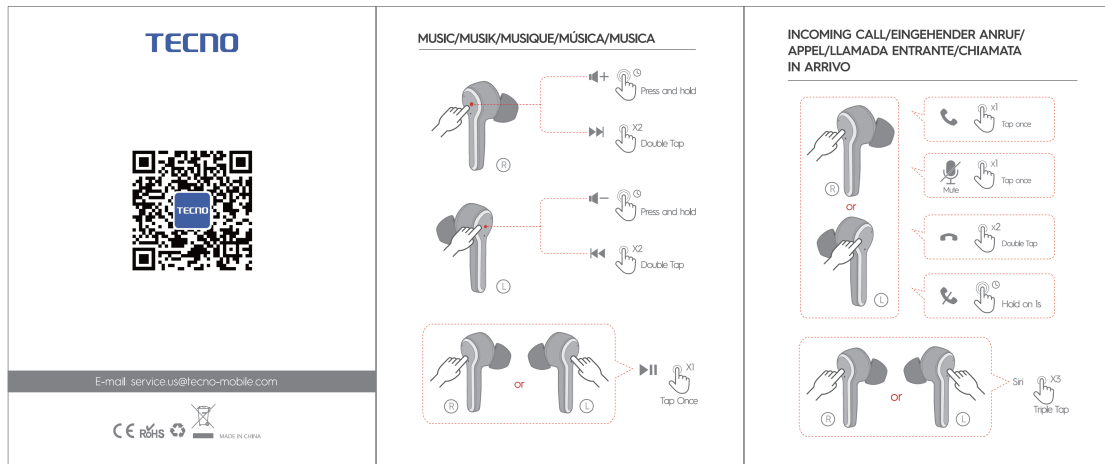

1. Put the earphones back in the charging case, and they'll shut down automatically.
2. If the earphones are not in the charging case, just press and hold the MFB of both earbuds for 5 seconds to power them off. (Mode 2 cannot be conducted during music playing or calling.)

1. Mettere gli auricolari nella custodia di ricarica e si spengono automaticamente.
2. Se gli auricolari non si trovano nella custodia di ricarica, è sufficiente tenere a premuto i MFB di entrambi gli auricolari per 5 secondi per spegnerli.
(Modalità 2 non può essere eseguita durante la musica o chiamata).
