3 Open Communications

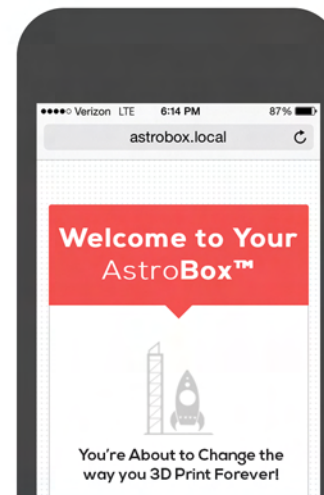
Using your phone, tablet, or computer, search for wifi networks. Join the AstroBox wifi network. This shouldn't take long, but in some cases may take a minute or two.
