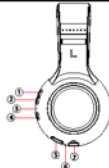

Location of Controls



- [+] button:
 - Long press - skip to next song
 - Quick press - increase volume
- [-] button:
 - Long press - skip to previous song
 - Quick press - decrease volume
- LED indicator light
- [O] button:
 - Long press - power ON/OFF
 - Quick press - play/pause music
 - Quick press - answer/end call
- Micro USB charging port
- Microphone
- Aux-in jack

Pairing the Headphones

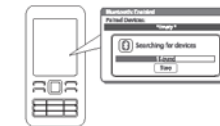
On a BlackBerry
 • Go to **SETTINGS/OPTIONS > BLUETOOTH**
 • Enable **BLUETOOTH**



On an Android Phone
 • Go to **SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH** MENU
 Search for devices (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On other Cell Phones/Devices
 • Review the instruction manual that came with your phone/device.



! If there is a device in range when the headphones are turned on, the headphones will connect to it automatically.

On an iPhone
 • Go to **SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH**
 (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



- When your Bluetooth-enabled device finds the headphones, select "SBT524" from the list of found devices.
- If required, enter the password 0000. Select OK or YES to pair the two units.
- After a successful registration, a tone and the voice prompt "Pairing successful" will be heard, and the LED indicator light will slowly blink BLUE.

! The screenshots above are typical of many Bluetooth-enabled devices in the market today, and are used to assist in the explanation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth-enabled device's interface and interaction with the headphones may slightly differ from the illustrations above.

Charging the Headphones

- Plug the small end of the Micro USB charging cable into the Micro USB charging port on the headphones.
- Plug the large end of the Micro USB charging cable into a USB port on your computer or other USB charging device.
- The LED indicator light is RED when charging and turns BLUE when the headphones are fully charged.



! Make sure you charge the headphones for at least 3 to 4 hours before using it for the first time.

Using The Headphones

Powering ON/OFF

- Long press the [O] button to turn ON and OFF.
- Check that your Bluetooth features are turned ON. If you have already paired the headphones with a Bluetooth-enabled device, it will automatically connect.
- If you are using the headphones for the first time, go to the "PAIRING THE HEADPHONES" section of this User Manual, and pair the headphones to your desired Bluetooth device.

Answering/ending a call

- To answer a call, quick press the [O] button.
- To end a call, quick press the [O] button.

Adjusting the volume

- Quick press the [+] button to increase the volume.
- Quick press the [-] button to decrease the volume.

Muting a call

- Press the [-] button for 2 seconds to mute a call.
- Press the [-] button for 2 seconds to un-mute.

Playing Music

To enjoy listening to music wirelessly on your Wireless Headphones, make sure you are connected to a Bluetooth-enabled device (see "PAIRING THE HEADPHONES"). Once connected, press PLAY on your Bluetooth device. When playback starts, control the music and volume with your connected device or the buttons on the headphones.

Play/Pause

- Quick press the [O] button to pause the music.
- To resume music playback, quick press the [O] button again.

Skipping Songs

- Long press the [+] button to skip to the next song.
- Long press the [-] button to skip to the previous song.

Adjusting the volume

- Quick press the [+] button to increase the volume.
- Quick press the [-] button to decrease the volume.

Using As Wired Headphones

- Connect one end of the 3.5mm auxiliary cable to the aux in Jack on the headphones and the other end to an external device's headphone jack (smartphone, tablet, or MP3 player).
- Open a media player on your device and click on PLAY to start playing your music.
- Use the controls on your connected device to control music playback and volume.

Troubleshooting Tips (cont'd)

! I can pair the High Definition Wireless Headphones with my Bluetooth device, but I cannot hear any music.

- Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile.
- Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
- You may have to unpair the headphones, then re-pair to your device.

! My Bluetooth device is not able to pair with the High Definition Wireless Headphones.

- Press and hold the [O] button for approximately 7 seconds. A tone and the voice prompt "Pairing" will be heard, and the LED indicator light will flash RED and BLUE.
- Keep your Wireless Headphones and Bluetooth-enabled device within three feet of each other during the pairing process.
- Check that YOUR device's Bluetooth feature is turned ON.
- Try repeating the pairing process. See "PAIRING THE HEADPHONES."
- Make sure the headphones are fully charged.

! I cannot get the Headphones into pairing mode.

- Press and hold the [O] button for approximately 7 seconds. A tone and the voice prompt "Pairing" will be heard, and the LED indicator light will flash RED and BLUE.
- The headphones are now in pairing mode.
