

Prediction of MPE limit at a given distance

Equation from page 18 of OET Bulletin 65, Edition 97-01

$$S = \frac{PG}{4\pi R^2}$$

where: S = power density

P = power input to the antenna

G = power gain of the antenna in the direction of interest relative to isotropic

R = distance to the center of radiation of the antenna

MPE limit for uncontrolled exposure at prediction frequency:	1.000	(mW/cm^2)

Margin of Compliance:	8.81	(dB)

Simultaneously transmission with BT: $0.13144 + 0.00099 = 0.13243 \text{ mW/cm}^2 < 1 \text{ mW/cm}^2$
