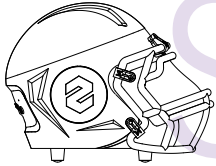

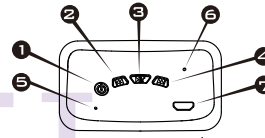

Safety Instructions

PAIRING

2. The blue LED will flash for waiting connection and keeps on while a connection is being established.
3. The blue light will turn to always on after paired. If no connect or operation duration 15 minutes will shut down the speaker.
4. Connect to the product by following the Bluetooth pairing method specific to your device.
5. Search and select model number SATTI SUPER MINI on your Bluetooth device list.
6. Once paired successfully, the blue LED will keep on. A sound prompt will indicate that the device is connected.

CHARGING
