Power switch
Power switch. (Set the switch to the ON or OFF position to implement device power on or off.)

Connect
Bluetooth connectivity. In the case of the power button to open, long press the keyboard 2-3"Connect" icon. Afterwards, the keyboard into the Bluetooth keyboard ready state.

USBs
capslock When the keyboard is in uppercase when the Orange indicator light blinks.

Bluetooth connection
Bluetooth connection. When the keyboard is in the power switch, press "Connect" button for 2 seconds, the Bluetooth indicator will flash twice. Then, Bluetooth devices are connected.

Power indicator
Power indicator. When the power switch is on the bottom of the keyboard, the Orange indicator will light up.

Charge indicator
Charge indicator when the USB cable to charge the keyboard. This indicator light glows when the keyboard is in full.
