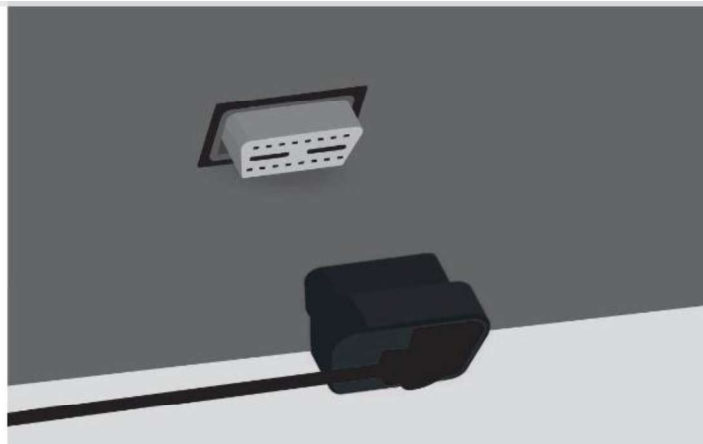




RAVEN PRO USER INSTALLATION GUIDE

Plug the Raven Pro power cord into the vehicle's OBDII port.

Continue press Enter ↵



If using an SD card: Place the SD card in the slot. Push the SD card into the slot, it should securely click into place.

Continue press Enter ↵



Gently plug the other end of the power cable into the bottom of the Raven Pro device.

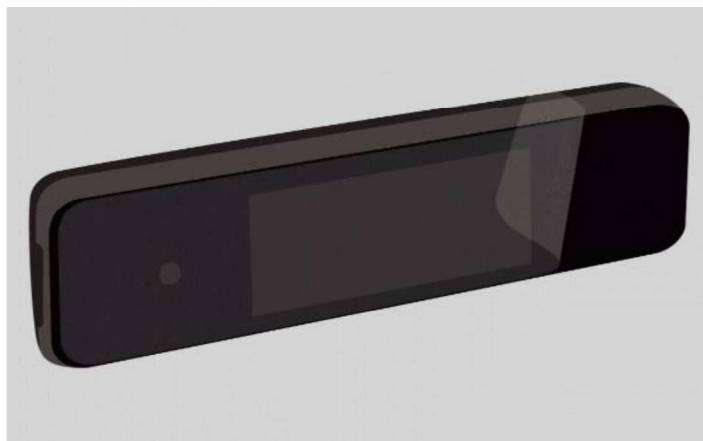
Continue press Enter ↵





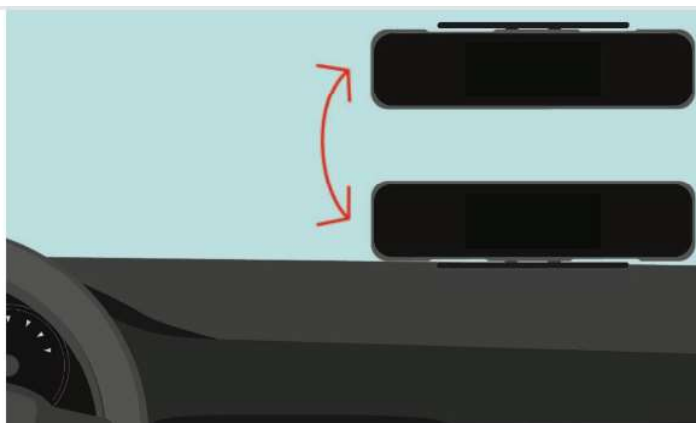
Remove the protective film from the screen and camera lens on the back of the device.

Continue press Enter ↵



Select the desired mounting location. Raven Pro can be either mounted on the windshield or on the dash. Make sure there is no obstructions in the view of the cameras. Also check that there is adequate cable length before committing to the position.

Continue press Enter ↵



Use alcohol wipe to thoroughly clean the surface and allow it to dry completely.

Continue press Enter ↵

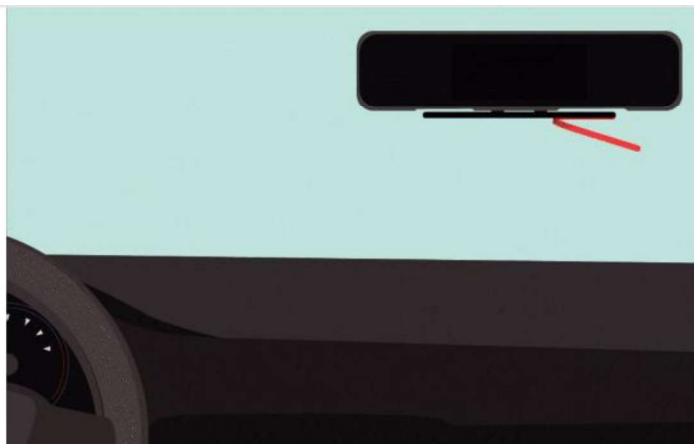




Remove adhesive covering and apply firm prolonged pressure to the mount of the Raven Pro. For windshield installations, pull back the far side of the plastic mount so the adhesive in the middle touches as much of the glass as possible.

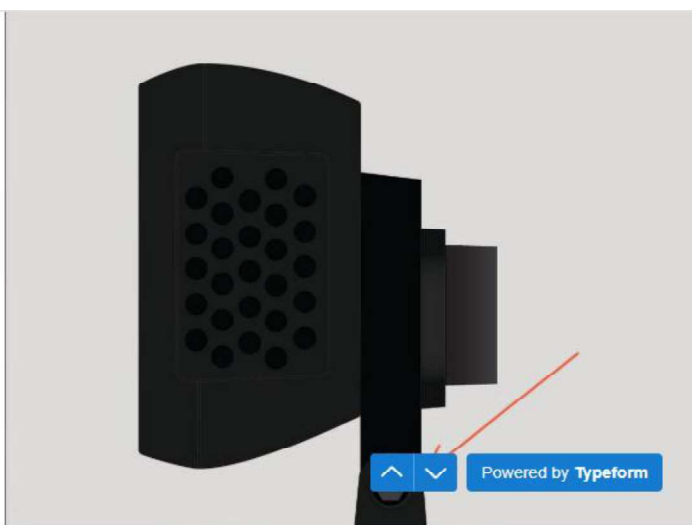

Using the allen key, tighten the mount.

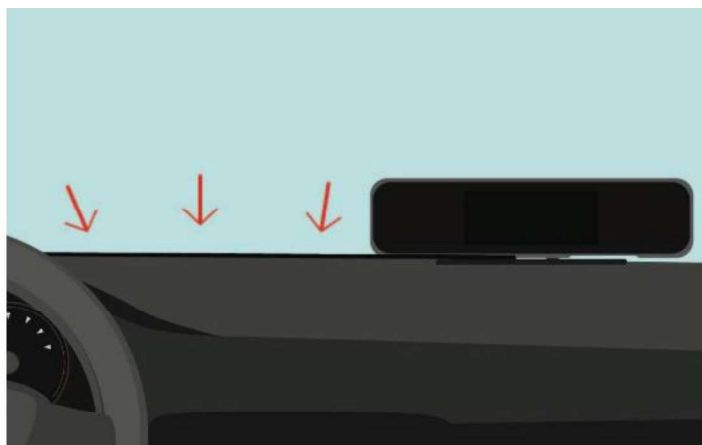
press Enter ↵



Tuck cable along the dash and/or use the cable clips provided.

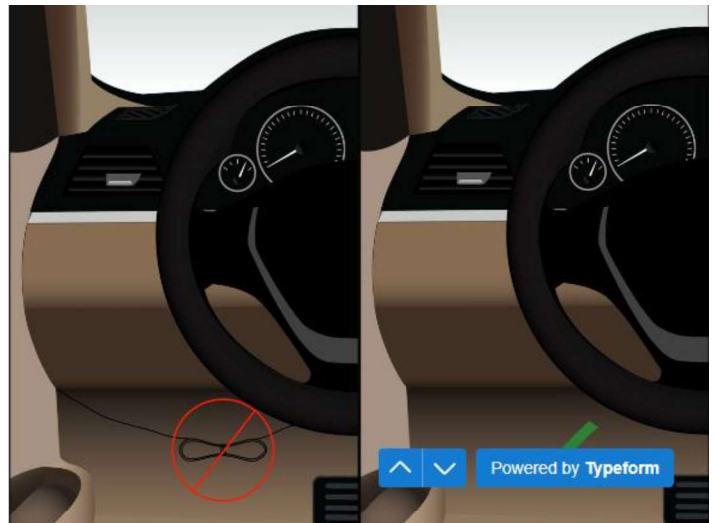
press Enter ↵





If required, bundle the additional cable being cautious not to pinch the wire. Using cable ties or zip ties can be helpful. DO NOT leave the cable hanging down; tuck and secure it under the dash where there is room.

Continue press Enter ↵



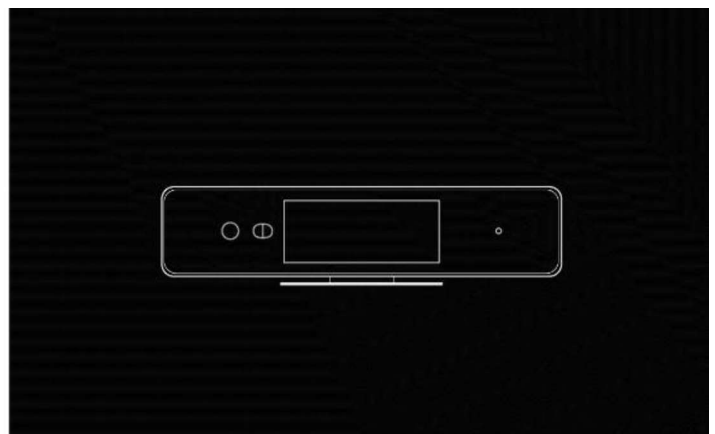
Download the app by going to the ravenconnected.com/download or searching 'Raven Connected' in the Google Play or App Store, then follow the set-up instructions.
