Overview of the turntable



④ PLATTER

- The position to place a vinyl record.

⑤ CENTER SPINDLE

- The spindle holds the turntable platter stable and centered.

⑥ BUTTON

- Press to power on and go to last source.
- Press and hold to turn on/off clock display.

⑦ COUNTERWEIGHT

- Balance the stylus pressure.

⑧ ANTI-SKATING KNOB

- The anti-skating apply inward force to the tone arm to prevent outward skipping across the record due to the centrifugal force cause by platter rotation.

⑨ TONE ARM LIFT LEVER

- Used to control the tone arm to rise from/fall on a record surface without endangering the surface of the record and the stylus.

⑩ TONE ARM CLIP

- Fix the tone arm for protection during non-use.

⑪ TONE ARM REST

- Use this rest to hold the tone arm during non-use.

⑫ SPEED ROTARY KNOB

- Switch speed (33-1/3 & 45 RPM).

⑬ TONE ARM

- Drive the stylus to slide above the record.

- ⑭ **HEADSHELL AND CARTRIDGE**
- The cartridge (AT3600LA) is attached to the headshell.

⑮ **FINGER LIFT**

⑯ **PAIRING/↻**

- Press to switch source (Phono/Bluetooth/CD).
- Press and hold (>3 seconds) for Bluetooth pairing.
- Press and hold (>8 seconds) to clear Bluetooth pairing history.

⑰ **BT OUT**

- Press to enable to BT Out.
- Press and hold to disable to BT Out.

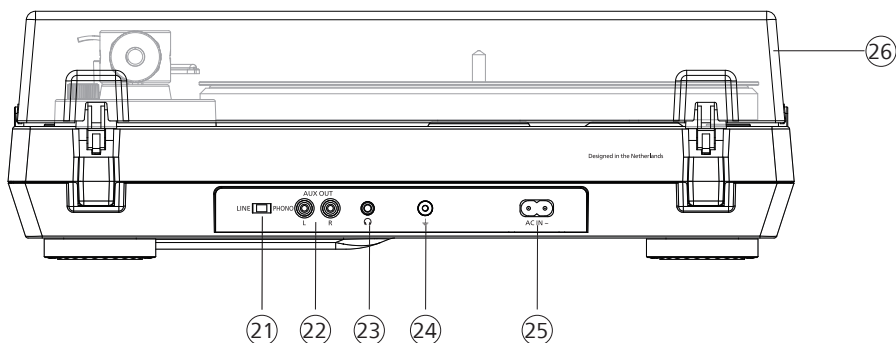
- Press to play/pause.
- Press twice to go to next track.
- Press and hold to go fast forward.

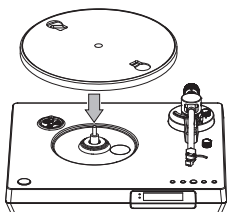

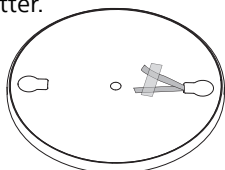

Assemble the turntable

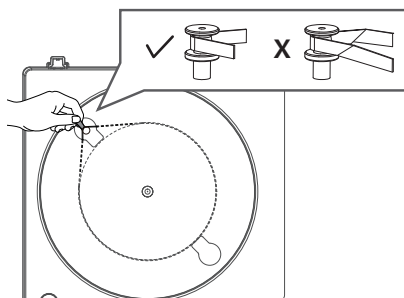
- 1 Assemble the platter on the unit.



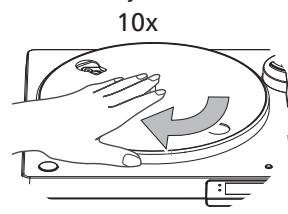
- 2 The belt is pre-installed under the platter.



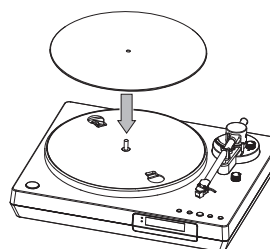
- 3 Turn the platter upside down, pull the belt over the motor pulley. Release your hand from the belt once the belt is on the motor pulley.



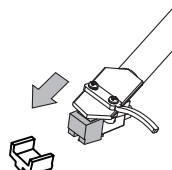
- Slowly rotate the platter about ten times by hand in the direction of the arrow. Get rid of any twists in the belt and make sure the belt rides smoothly.



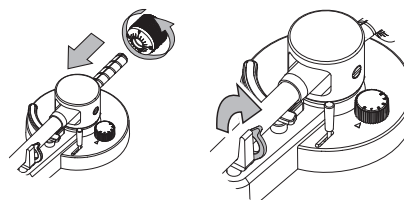
- 4 Place the slip mat on the platter.



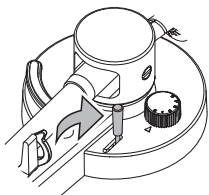
- Gently parallelly pull the stylus cover forward to remove.



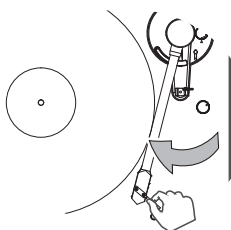
- 5 Insert the counterweight into the tone arm in the direction of the arrow. Unlock the tone arm clip.



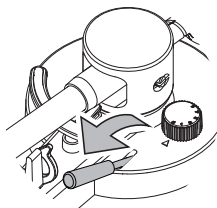
- Use the lift lever to raise the tone arm.



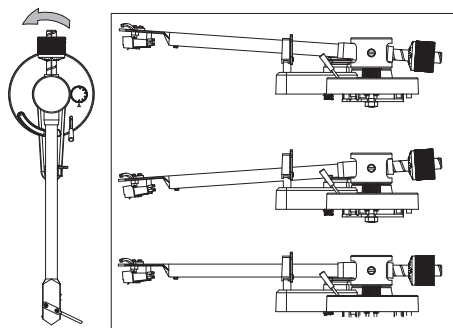
- 6 Use the finger lift to align the stylus over the record.



- Use the lift lever to lower the tone arm on the record to begin playing.



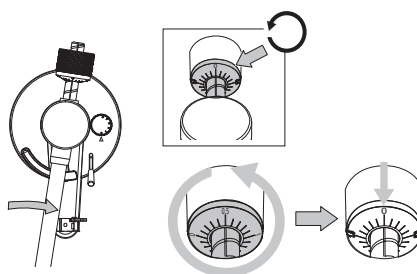
- 7 Turn the counterweight on the back of tone arm until the tone arm is flat and balanced.



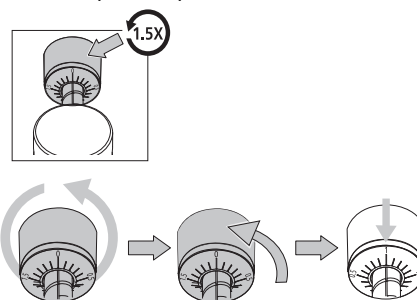
- 8 Move the tone arm back to the tone arm rest. ONLY turn the number ring in the direction of the arrow, until the number '0' is in the top most position.

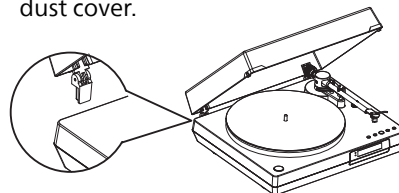
- The number ring and counterweight move separately from each other. Do not turn the counterweight in this step.



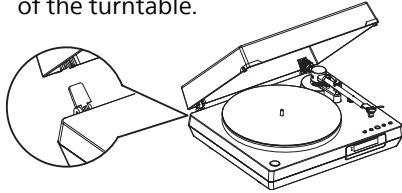
- Hold and rotate both the number ring and the counterweight in the direction of the arrow 1 1/2 rotations until the number '1' is in the top most position.



- 9 Insert the dust cover hinges into the hinge pockets at two sides of the dust cover.



Insert the hinges completely into the hinge bases located at the back of the turntable.



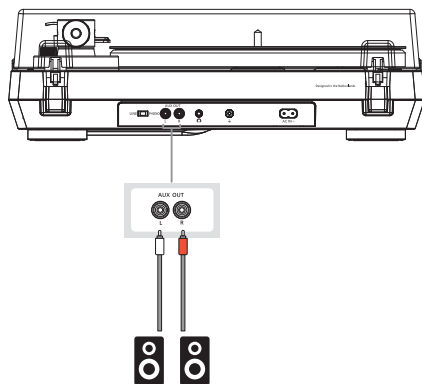
Note

To remove the dust cover, grasp the two sides of the dust cover and slowly lift upward to remove the cover together with its hinges.

Connect via the RCA audio cable

Connect the RCA cable (not included) to the external speaker.

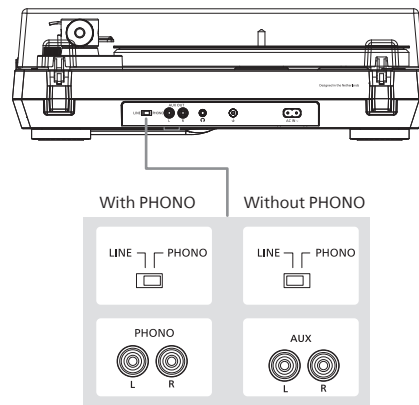
- ↳ RED plug - Plug into the R-channel output.
- ↳ WHITE plug - Plug into the L-channel output.



This product has a built-in phono equalizer feature. You can use the product even if you do not have a built-in phono amplifier. Use the pre-amplifier selector switch on the back of the turntable to set the output as below.

If the audio device has a PHONO input jack, set the switch to PHONO. An audio signal from the MM cartridge is output from the audio cable without passing through the phono preamp from the turntable. The phono preamp for the audio device is used.

If the audio device does not have a PHONO input jack, set the switch to LINE. The audio signal that passes through the phono preamp from the turntable is output from the audio cable.

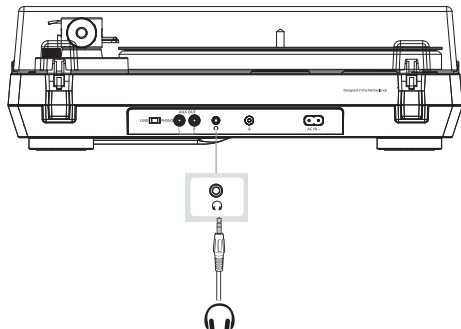

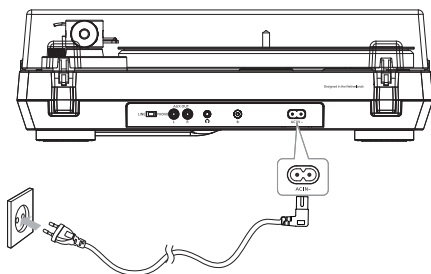
Connect the headphone

Connect the headphone/ earphone through the headphone jack on the back of your turntable.



Connect power

Connect the power adapter to the wall outlet.

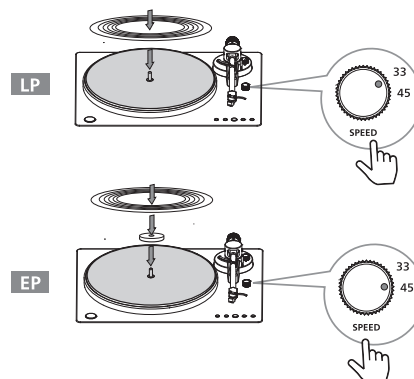

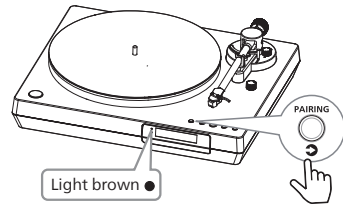
Play from vinyl records

- 1 Place the unit on a flat and level surface.
- 2 Place the slipmat on the platter before placing the vinyl record.
- 3 Use the speed switch next to tone arm to adjust the speed (33-1/3, 45 RPM) to match the record.

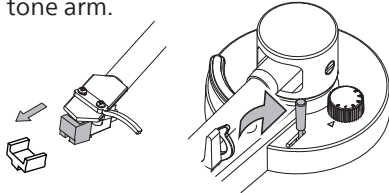


- 4 Press **PAIRING/** button to Phono source.

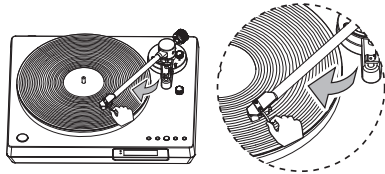
↳ LED 1 turns solid light.



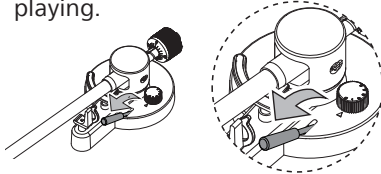
- 5 Gently parallelly pull the stylus cover forward to remove before playing. Unlock the tone arm clip, and use the lift lever to raise the tone arm.



- 6 Use the finger lift to align the stylus over the record.



- 8 Use the lift lever to lower the tone arm on the record to begin playing.

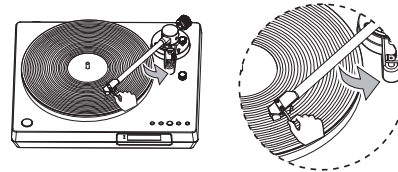
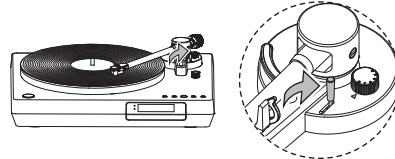

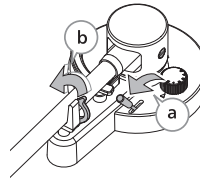
- Do not bend or force the stylus into the cartridge.
- Do not touch the stylus tip to avoid injury to your hand.
- Turn off the unit's power before you replace the stylus.

Stop playing vinyl records

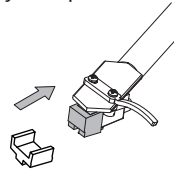
- 1 Use the lift lever to raise the tone arm, and use the finger lift to move the tone arm back on the tone arm rest.



- 2 Lower the lift lever, and lock the tone arm clip to fix it.



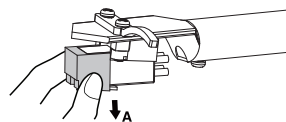

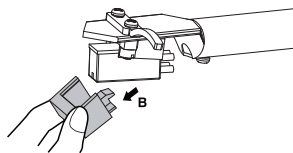
Replace the stylus

Removing the stylus from the tone arm:

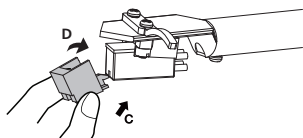
- 1 Place your fingers at the tip of the stylus and push down to the direction 'A'.



- 2 Pull the stylus out toward the direction 'B'.

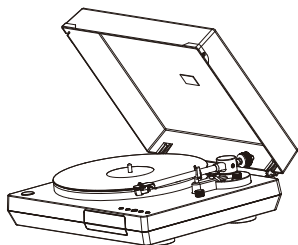


- 3 Hold the tip of the stylus and insert the other edge by pressing toward direction 'C', and push the stylus up toward direction 'D' until it locks at the tip.
Stylus model: AT3600 (not included).

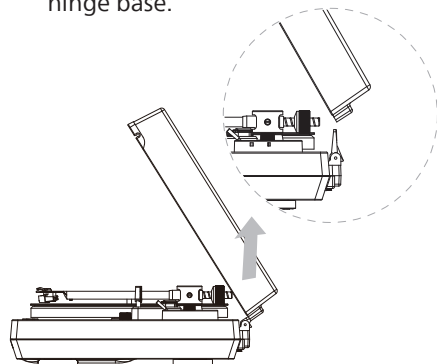


Remove the dust cover

- 1 Open the dust cover.

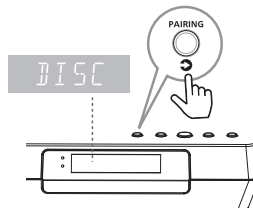

- ↳ Press the **▶||** button twice on the product to the skip to next track.

On Philips Entertainment App, enter General Settings, select **Public** (unencrypted broadcast) or **Personal** (encrypted broadcast) from Auracast™ broadcaster.

- When unencrypted broadcast is selected, LED 2 turns solid purple and you will hear the prompt sound from your turntable.

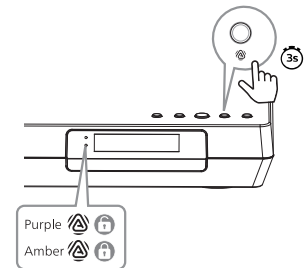
A Auracast™ connection

FT1

- 1 Press the **PAIRING/** button to switch to Phono/Bluetooth/Disc source.



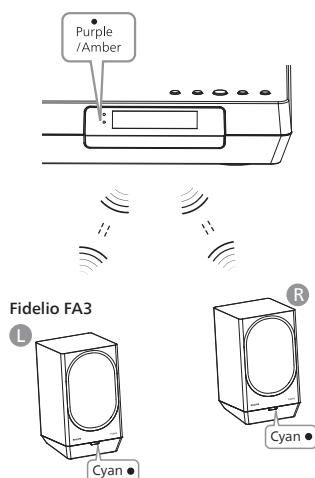
- 2 In Phono/Bluetooth/Disc source, press and hold the button on your turntable for 3 seconds or select **Source Control** on Philips Entertainment App (/Auracast™ broadcast) to enter into Auracast™ broadcast.



On Philips Entertainment App, enter **General Settings**, select **Public** (unencrypted broadcast) or **Personal** (encrypted broadcast) from Auracast™ broadcaster.

- When unencrypted broadcast is selected, LED 2 turns solid purple and you will hear the prompt sound from your turntable.

- When encrypted broadcast is selected, LED 2 turns solid amber and you will hear the prompt sound from your turntable.
- 3 You can broadcast to any number of Auracast™ enabled products. Follow the instruction to enable Auracast™ connection.

11 Troubleshooting



Warning

- Never remove the casing of this device.

To keep the warranty valid, never try to repair the system yourself. If you encounter problems when using this device, check the following points before requesting service. No power

- Check if power adaptor of the unit is connected improperly.
- Check if there is power at the AC outlet.

No sound

- Check the volume.
- Check if the source is selected properly.
- Check if connecting cable is connected properly.

No response from the unit

- Disconnect and reconnect the power adaptor, then turn on the unit again. As a power-saving feature, the system switches off automatically 15 minutes after track play reaches the end and no control is operated.

Record sounds too fast or too slow

- Check if the speed is selected properly to match the vinyl record.

Turntable is spinning, but no sound

- Check the volume.
- Check if the source is switched to the Phono properly.
- Check if the stylus cover is removed properly.
- Check if the tone arm lift lever is already pushed down to make it fall on the record.

The audio quality is poor after connection with a Bluetooth-enabled device.

- The Bluetooth reception is poor. Move the device closer to this unit or remove any obstacle between them.

Decline in turntable audio performance

- Check if the turntable stylus is worn out. Replace the stylus.

Bluetooth device cannot be connected with this unit.

- Check if the device does not support the profiles required for this unit.
- Check if Bluetooth function of the device is not enabled. Refer to the user manual of the device to find out how to enable the function.
- Check if this unit is not in pairing mode.
- Check if this unit is already connected with another Bluetooth-enabled device. Disconnect that device and then try again.



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
