

The E-label information

A. Access to the required information on the e-label

1. Users are able to access the information in no more than three steps in a device's menu. The actual steps are:

To access the e-label information, in the device,

Choose: Settings > About phone > Authentication information

No special access codes or permissions are required to go through the above steps beyond entering a user defined password to protect against unauthorized access to the device.

2. The information is stored on the device, no special accessories or supplemental plug-ins (e.g., a SIM/USIM card) are required to access the information.

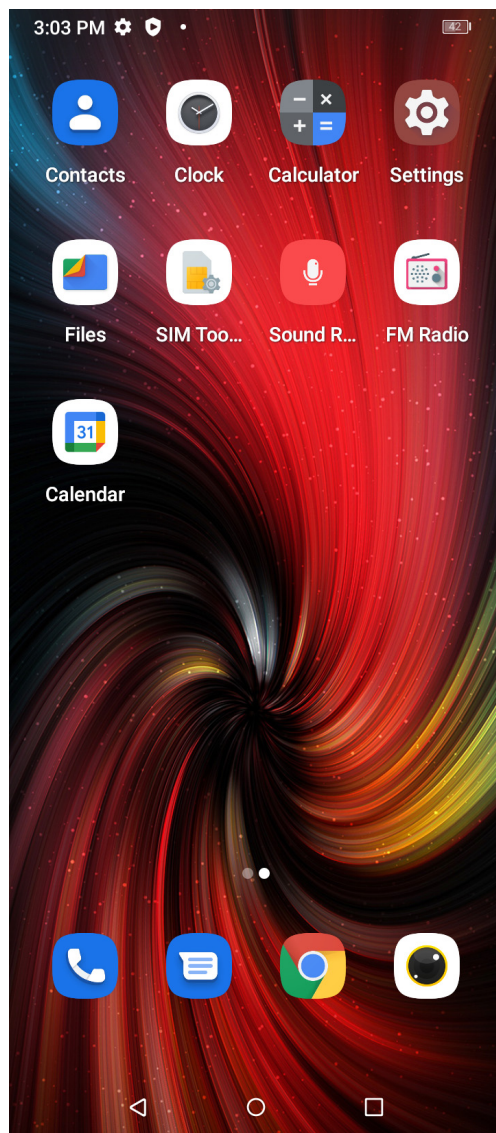

3. Users are provided specific instructions on how to access the information.

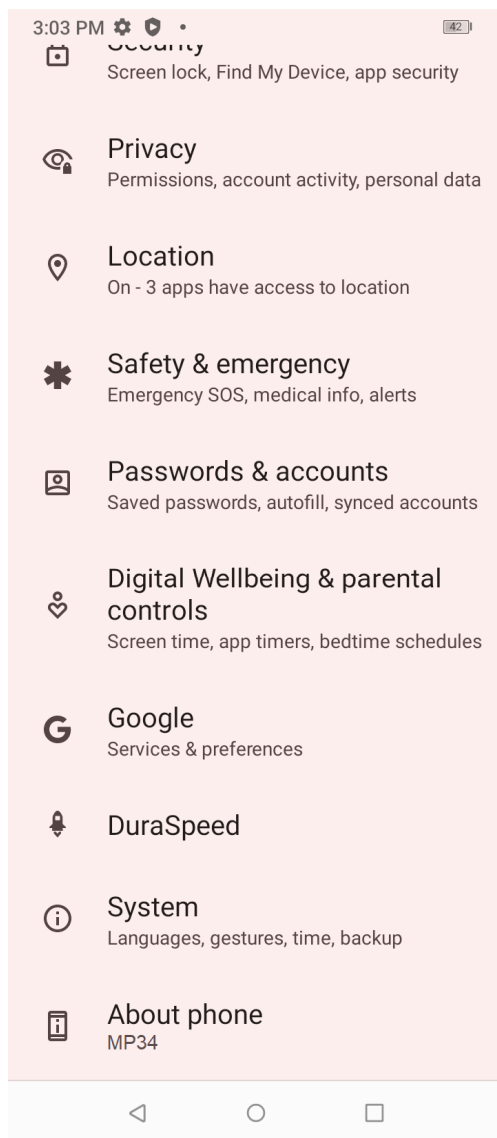
The information to the user is provided in the E-label Info document.

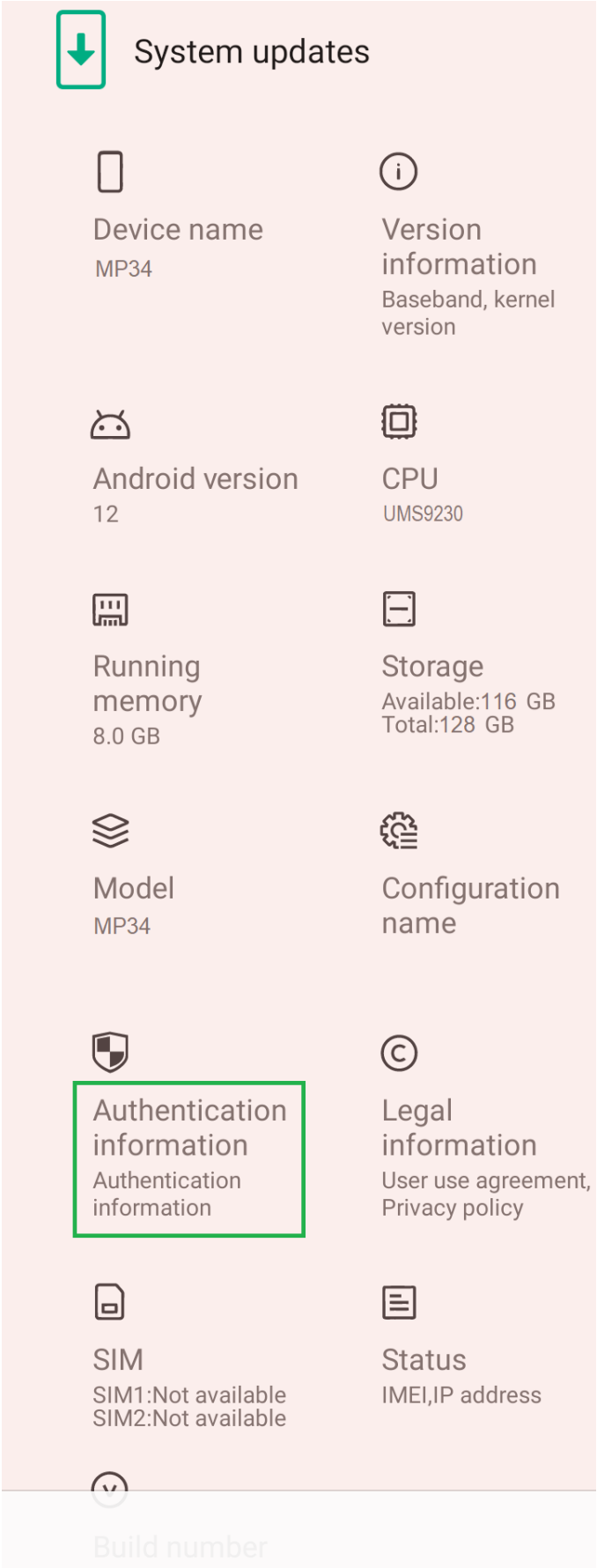
Scroll through the menu to find and select Settings

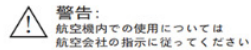
