User Manual

Download the App



The **SMART-TIME PRO** app is required to use your watch.

To get the SMART-TIME PRO app you have several options:

- Scan the QR code located in this manual (above).
- Find and scan the QR code in the Functions Menu.

- Download the app from the Apple App Store (if you have an iPhone).
- Download it from Google Play (if you have an Android phone).

Setting Up the App

As part of the setup process, you'll have to grant certain permissions to be able to use your watch normally. It's suggested that you tap **"Allow"** for all requested permissions.

You will have 3 options for using the app: Login with your Google account, use your

"Device" tab on the bottom of the screen.

2. At the top of the next screen, tap **"Add Device."**
3. If prompted to allow the app to access your location, select **"While using the app"** or **"Only this time."**
4. If prompted to update location settings, follow the prompts to allow the app the right permissions.
5. Return to the app and tap **"Search Again"** and your Smartwatch will show up as **"iTIME"** in the device

list.

6. Tap **"iTIME"** to begin binding.
7. You're Smartwatch will ask you to confirm the binding request. Tap the green checkmark to confirm.
8. Back inside the app, you will be presented with a swipe deck of prompts that walk you through the app's settings. When you get to **"Call Function"** tap **"To Bind"** to complete the second part of the binding process.

9. When prompted, select **"Pair."** Finish making adjustments to settings and your Smartwatch is now ready to use.

FOR APPLE

1. As part of the initial app set up, SMART-TIME PRO will request permission to use Bluetooth. Tap **"Allow."**
2. After following all prompts and granting necessary permissions, proceed with binding.
3. Inside the app, tap the **"Device"** tab at the bottom of the screen.

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4. At the top of the next screen, tap **"Add Device."**
5. Your Smartwatch will show as **"iTIME"** in the device list. Tap to select it.
6. Your Smartwatch will prompt you to confirm the binding request. Click the green checkmark to continue.
7. If prompted, tap **"Allow"** for any addition permissions needed, and the pairing process will be complete.

Quickfit Wrist Straps



Your Smartwatch comes with two removable wristband straps. To remove either strap, lay your watch face down on a soft cloth, and use a spring bar tool to slide the small metal pin inward and pull the strap loose.

To prevent damage we suggest having this service performed by a professional jeweler.

Your Smartwatch features dual support for Bluetooth 3.0 and 5.3.

Your Smartwatch can only pair with one device at a time. To unpair from a device go to the "Device" tab within the app, scroll to the bottom of the screen and tap **"Unpair."**

iTime Smartwatch Functions

Change Watch Face



Change the watch face by pressing the Dial Button located right side of your Smartwatch and turning it up or down.

Access Functions & Features

To access your watch's menu of functions, press the Dial Button on the right side of the watch

face once, then make a selection.

Menu Shortcuts

To quickly access **Flashlight**, **Do Not Disturb**, **Voice**, **Brightness**, and **Battery Life**, swipe your watch face Down ↓.

To access **Contacts**, **Call History**, and the **Dial Pad**, swipe Right →.

To access **Messages** and **Notifies**, swipe Up ↑.

Power On/Off

To power your Smartwatch on or off, hold down the Dial Button

on the right side of the watch face.

Sports Mode



Your Smartwatch supports 100+ sports and fitness modes, including: Running, Walking, Climbing, Cycling, and Yoga. You can add custom categories by tapping the **"Sport"** tab in the mobile app and tapping the flag icon to set specific goals.

Activity Tracker
This feature allows you to keep track of how well you're meeting your sport and fitness goals.

Heart Rate
Use this function to get a real-time reading of your beats-per-minute. To get the best reading, wear your watch so it fits snugly, but comfortably, and no green light is visible from the back of the watch.

Stress
This function measures Heart Rate Variability (HRV) to help you monitor your body's stress levels.

Blood Oxygen
This function allows you to take a manual blood oxygen reading.

Sleep
The Sleep function allows you to track the quality of your sleep, including the amount of time you slept

versus the amount of time you were awake during the night.

Dial Pad
Your watch supports making Bluetooth calls, as well as making and rejecting calls.

Notifications & Messages

Your watch can display calls, messages, social media and app notifications from your mobile device. Your watch and mobile device must be within Bluetooth range of each other for this function to work.

Getting Started

Welcome to your new iTime Smartwatch! Your package should include the following:

- 1 x iTime Smartwatch
- 2 X Detachable Watch Straps
- 1 x User manual
- 1 X USB Magnetic Charging Disc

IMPORTANT! Enabling Bluetooth calls from your watch requires a two part pairing process. See details on page 5.

Charging Your Watch

Plug the USB end of the charger into a laptop or desktop and connect the magnetic disc to the back of your Smartwatch. This automatically turns on the watch. The charging disc has a smooth and depressed side. The depressed side is the correct



surface to attach to your watch. Charging fully takes 2-3 hours.

Binding/Pairing Your Watch to a Mobile Device

IMPORTANT: Binding & pairing is a two-part process, if not completed you will not be able to make calls from your watch.

FOR ANDROID

1. In the SMART-TIME PRO app, navigate to the

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Music Player

Use this function to select and play songs using the music player on your phone or mobile device.



Find Phone

Tap "Find Phone" and your phone will ring to help you locate it.



Remote Camera

Take pictures remotely using your phone or tablet. To activate, go to the "Device" in the mobile app and tap "Camera."

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Alarm

Set up to 5 custom alarms in the mobile app and the watch will vibrate to alert you.



Weather

Swipe right twice on your Smartwatch to access a forecast for your location.



Settings

Control settings like Brightness, Theme, Language, Power On or Off, and more. You can also

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access these settings by going to the "Me" tab in the mobile app.

Other Features

Stock Market

Track individual stocks by tapping "Device" in the mobile app → "Stock Market" → "Add."

Voice Assistant

Wake your watch and give it voice commands.

World Clock

Add regional time zones by going to "Device" in the

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mobile app → "World Clock" → "Add."

Stopwatch

A digital stopwatch that allows you to record multiple performance times.

Troubleshooting

Can't Pair With Mobile Device

If your Smartwatch cannot pair with your mobile device, go to "Settings - >Bluetooth" in your phone or tablet and try deactivating and reactivating this function. Additionally, make certain you've completed the double pairing process as described on page 6 and 7 of this user guide.

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Smartwatch Won't Charge

Make sure you've cleaned the sensors on the back of your watch that attach to your magnetic charger. If not cleaned regularly with rubbing alcohol, they can become covered with oil and sweat. Also, make certain that you've attached the depressed side of the charger to your watch.

Caring For Your Device

Moisture Exposure

Your device is water-resistant, which means it's rain-proof and splash-proof and can stand up to even the sweatiest workout. However, please note:

- Do not immerse your Smartwatch in water.
- Do not swim with your Smartwatch.
- We also recommend not showering while wearing your watch.
- Whenever you get your watch wet, dry it thoroughly before putting it back on.
- Remember to periodically clean the sensors on the back of your watch to keep them free of sweat and oil.

Ideal Operating Temperature

Avoid exposing your Smartwatch to environments that are excessively hot or cold. Below are your watch's ideal operating temperature ranges, and ranges that should be avoided.

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Operating temperature:
14°F to 122°F (-10°C to 50°C)

Non-operating temperature:
-4°F to 140°F (-20°C to 60°C)

Disposal and Recycling

Once your Smartwatch has reached the end of its usable life, please make certain to dispose of it responsibly.

Do not throw away your watch with common household waste. It's considered electronic waste and should be disposed of at your local electronic equipment collection facility. For more information, please contact your local electronic equipment waste management authority or the retailer where you bought the product.

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- Do not dispose of batteries in a fire, batteries may explode or leak.
- Do not replace this watch's battery. Send it to our service center for battery replacement.
- Discontinue use if watch is immersed in water.

Health and Safety

Wearing a watch too tightly can cause skin irritation. Make sure to not over tighten the strap. Your watch band should be fitted firmly but comfortably and allow enough space for 1-2 fingers to fit underneath the watch face while it's being worn.

We suggest cleaning your watch

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immediately after a strenuous workout. Use rubbing alcohol and a cotton swab or dry paper towel to wipe down the back of the watch and bands. Allow the watch to sit for 15 to 20 minutes to dry completely before reapplying to your wrist.

Consult a physician if you suffer from eczema or any related skin condition before wearing a Smartwatch.

If upon wearing your watch if you experience any irritation or rashes, remove it immediately.

Do not use this watch if the case back is missing.

This item is NOT A TOY, suitable for ages 6 and up.
