CPI ADJUSTABLE

Press the CPI +/- button to switch between the default resolutions: 400, 800, 1000, 1200, 1600, 2000 CPI.
Adjustable via software: 50 ~ 20,000 CPI.

The mouse will switch from wireless to wired mode when the USB Type-C cable is connected.
Note: While in wired mode, the mouse charges simultaneously.
