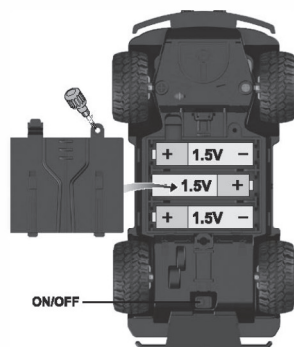

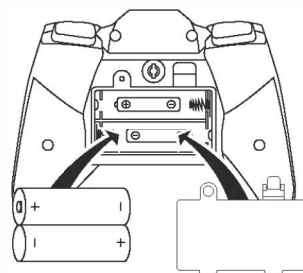
Battery Installation

VEHICLE BATTERIES



Use a screwdriver to remove the screw. Insert 3 x AA 1.5V Batteries (not included)

TRANSMITTER BATTERIES



Use a screwdriver to remove the screw. Insert 2 x AA 1.5V Batteries (not included)

BATTERY SAFETY

The placement or replacement of batteries is to be performed by an adult.
Remove the rechargeable battery from the chassis before charging.
Always remove exhausted batteries from the car and the transmitter.
Make sure the main switch is set to OFF before installing the battery pack into the car body.
Batteries must be inserted with the correct polarity.
Non chargeable batteries shall not be recharged.
Do not short-circuit the batteries.
Always remove the batteries from the car and the transmitter after playing.
Never throw the batteries into fire to avoid explosion or leakage.
Do not mix batteries from different producers or new and old batteries.

Keep this manual for future reference as it contains important information about this product.

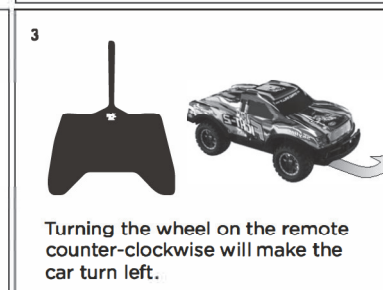
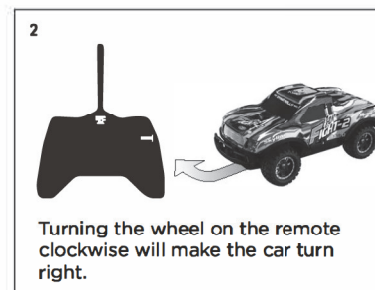
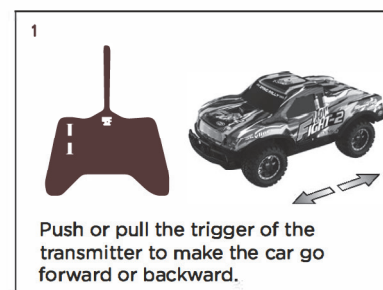
Operating The Product

USE PROVIDED RC WITH CORRECT FREQUENCY

The Radiator Truck uses 27MHz

Buggin RC uses 49 mHz

To ensure interoperability make sure to use the correct RC for each vehicle.



OPERATING CAUTIONS

When the car is in motion, do not touch the wheels by hand to avoid damages to the car / injury.

When there's more than one car playing in the same place, set the cars to different frequency to avoid mutual interference.

Do not bend the antenna or point it at other people or articles to avoid injury.

Do not play in a place with puddles, mud or sand.

Do not play on the roads or in any other dangerous places to avoid accidents.

For best performance, make sure the tyres are clean. If the tyres are dirty, gently wipe it with a clean damp cloth. Do not soak toys in water.
