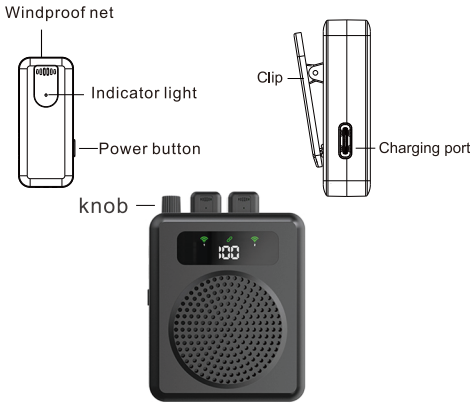

Product Introduction



- ① Take out the microphone or press the power button briefly for 2 second to turn on the device. The indicator lights will flash green. After automatic connection, the green light will remain on, indicating that the device is ready for use
- ② Rotate the knob clockwise to turn on the device, click the mode button to search for Bluetooth “R11” and connect it

Power on	Inside the host	Remove TX	/	Green light flashing
	Outside the host	Long press the TX power button for 2 seconds	/	Green light flashing
Power off	Outside the host	Insert into the host	/	The red light stays on for a long time
	Outside the host	Long press the TX power button for 3 seconds	/	No flashing lights
	Outside the host	Automatic shutdown if not connected for 1 minute	/	No flashing lights
Pair with RX	Inside the host	Auto pairing	/	After connection, the TX green light remains on and the host green light remains on
Mute	Connection status	Short press the power button	/	The red light is always on
Lock	Connection status	Three clicks on the power button	/	The red light flashes twice
Unlock	Power on status	Three clicks on the power button	/	The red light stays on for 2 seconds
Disconnect	Standby	Turn off the host or TX shutdown	/	Disconnect, TX green light flashes, host green light flashes
Low electricity	Power on status	The battery voltage is below 3.3V	/	Red light flashing
Low power shutdown	Power on status	The earphones automatically shut down when the battery voltage drops below 3.1V	/	No flashing lights
Charge	Power on status	Insert into the host	/	The charging red light is always on, and the fully charged light is off

Power off	Power on status	Turn to the OFF position	/	All lights off
Pair with TX	Shutdown status	Automatic connection	/	TX green light is always on, host green light is always on
Disconnect	Standby	Shutdown	/	TX green light flashing, host green light flashing

Power on	Shutdown status	Turn the knob to ON and click the M key	Bluetooth mode	The Bluetooth indicator light is flashing green
Power off	Power on status	Click the M button to turn the cargo knob to OFF	/	The Bluetooth indicator light is off
Pair with mobile phone	Shutdown status	Turn the knob to ON, click the M key, and search for R11 pairing connection on your phone	Bluetooth mode - Bluetooth connected	After connection, the Bluetooth indicator light remains green
Disconnect	Standby	Turn off Bluetooth on your phone	Bluetooth disconnected	Bluetooth indicator green light flashing
