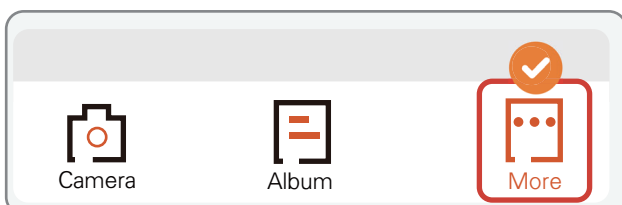

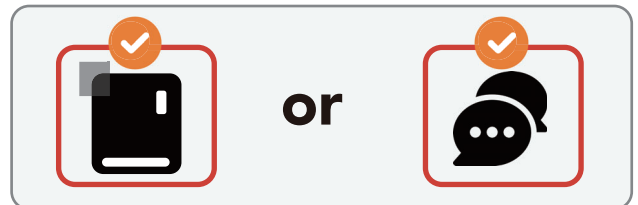

This 4 channel dash cam records the front/rear/left/right side of your car all together without any blind spot and equipped with plenty of practical functions, we hope he can accompany you to reach the destination safely again and again.

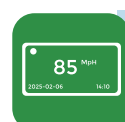

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MUST READ



For your quick start and make sure your R4-4K dash cam works properly, please read the following notice carefully.



Power Issues

Please keep the R4-4K dash cam connected to the provided cigarette lighter charger for daily use, as it is not a battery-powered camera. If your car does not have a cigarette lighter port, please **contact us** for a compatible USB TYPE C cable and connect to the power port that can reach 5V/2A output, otherwise, issues may occur to this dashcam.



'Please format the SD card'

A 128GB SD card is included in this package. The SD card is already inserted into the R4-4K dashcam by default, if yours does not have an SD card, please reach us for replacement.

For the first time boot up, R4-4K dashcam will prompt 'Please format the SD card', please single press Power BUTTON  or connect the app to process the format then the camera will start recording automatically.



GPS Signal

When powering on for the first time or after a long period of inactivity, the GPS signal search may take longer than usual. Please be patient while waiting for the GPS signal to be located.

When the vehicle is driven into underground parking lots, tunnels, or other places with obstructions above the vehicle, the GPS signal will fail (just like the GPS navigation on a mobile phone). The signal will be restored when driving back to the open-air road.



WiFi Connect

The WiFi of R4-4K dash cam will turn on as the dash cam power on, please join the WiFi hotspot of the R4-4K dash cam following the information bellow:

Stop Recording in Parking Mode?

Some customer found their R4-4K dash cam stops recording even with parking mode engaged, that's because when the voltage of your car's battery drops, the hardwire will cut off the power supply of the R4-4K dashcam to ensure that you can start the ignition the next time you enter the car again. This is a function to protect your battery to avoid the trouble of your car not starting. In other words, the larger the battery capacity of your car, the longer it can support the R4-4K parking mode. For ordinary cars, their battery capacity can support the R4-4K dashcam recording for more than 10 hours. If you drive every day, you won't have to worry about this issue.

MUST READ



WiFi Disconnect?

This issue may happen to iOS Carplay / Android Auto users- by default, the mobile phone prioritizes the connection with Carplay or Android Auto, making it challenging to establish a connection with the camera. To successfully connect the camera, please follow these steps:

1. Disable your mobile phone's Bluetooth.
2. Disconnect from any existing WiFi connections.
3. Turn off your car and ensure your mobile phone is no longer linked to Carplay or Android Auto.
4. Restart your car and then connect the camera with your phone.

Generally, it's advisable to maintain the priority connection with Carplay or Android Auto. The dash cam will continue recording automatically without needing to connect to your cellphone's WiFi, functioning as long as it has a power source.



No internet?

Once you connect to Peztio-R4-**** WiFi, it will say 'No internet connection', which is fine and please select 'Keep trying wifi'. But you can not use the internet data at this moment, if you want to use the phone network,(for music, navigation etc.) just disconnect the camera WiFi. **The camera will continue to record even when it is not connected to your cellphone. In other words, you don't need to connect to the dash cam WiFi all the time.**



No Rear Image

If the rear camera video can not show up when you using the app, please make sure the socket is completely inserted into the main camera, if you have not completely insert the plug into the main camera, the rear image will show black screen, **contact us** if it still not working.



Drain My Car's Battery?

Some customers(using the provided car charger) may find the R4-4K dash cam will drain their cars' battery after they park the car for a whole night, this issue happens when your car does not cut the power supply after you shut down the car (while other models do). So we recommend you connect the dashcam charger with another port from your car that can cut the power after your key is off in this situation. **If there is no ideal port from your car, please contact us for a hardwire kit as this kit can cut the power to the dash cam when it detects the battery voltage drop and retain enough power for the next start.**



Video Miss?

- (1) R4-4k dashcam has a Loop Recording function, it will delete the oldest files and record newer files when the SD card is full except for the locked video files. **We recommend you single press Power BUTTON  to lock the video manually when an event happens in case the event does not trigger the Gravity Sensor from locking, R4-4K will prompt 'Video Locked' when it does.**
- (2) For the event video lock by you manually or by the Gravity Sensor, it will be saved in the folder named 'Locked' from app, please pay attention to that as you can not find the event videos from normal recording folder.



Can't find the WiFi

R4-4K dash cam by default will give 5.8GHz WiFi signal, which some old version cellphone may not support, if you can not find the R4-4K WiFi, please hold the POWER BUTTON  for around 6 seconds then release, the R4-4K WiFi switch to 2.4GHz (will show on the display logo **2.4G**) signal and with a voice notification 'Swith to 2.4G WiFi'. Now it is compatible with old version cellphone, but the data transfer speed will decrease comparing to 5.8GHz signal.

MUST READ



App says 'Connect Failed'

The issue you're experiencing could be linked to your phone's settings. please trouble shoot as below:

1.VPN:

Is your phone's VPN turned on? If yes, please turn it off temporarily.

2.CarPlay:

Is your phone connected to CarPlay? If so, please disconnect it fully.

3.Local Network Access:

Make sure the Peztio app has local network access enabled in your phone's settings.

4.Restart Your iPhone:

Restart your phone and then try reconnecting to the camera's WiFi. This has helped many customers after updating to iOS 18.

5.Reset Network Settings :

Go to Settings > General > Transfer or Reset iPhone > Reset > Reset Network Settings.

If the issue is not related to above, please contact us for further support.



Constantly on & off

If the recorded videos are freezing, lagging, or the R4 only recording video for a few seconds then power off, this is the SD card issue(defective / low speed card), NOT the camera issue. Please format the SD card to have a try (**see page**). If the issue remains after you get the SD card formatted, please replace the SD card with a new one as it may reach its life span after so many times erasing and loading data by the R4 dashcam. If you have no idea how to get resolve, please feel free to contact us.

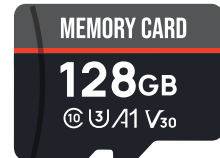

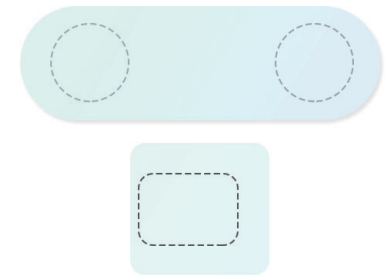

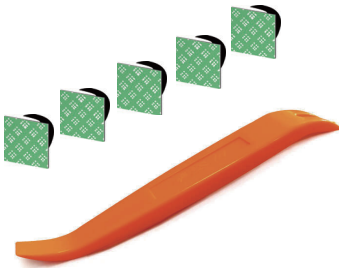

1. A 128GB SD card is included we have inserted it into the R4 dash cam in advance. If you want to replace it with an SD card that has larger storage, please make sure the new SD card is a SAMSUNG or PNY Class 10, U3 speed Micro SD card, GB Max(check page).

2. If there is no cigarette lighter port in your car, please contact us to get a USB C cable from us.

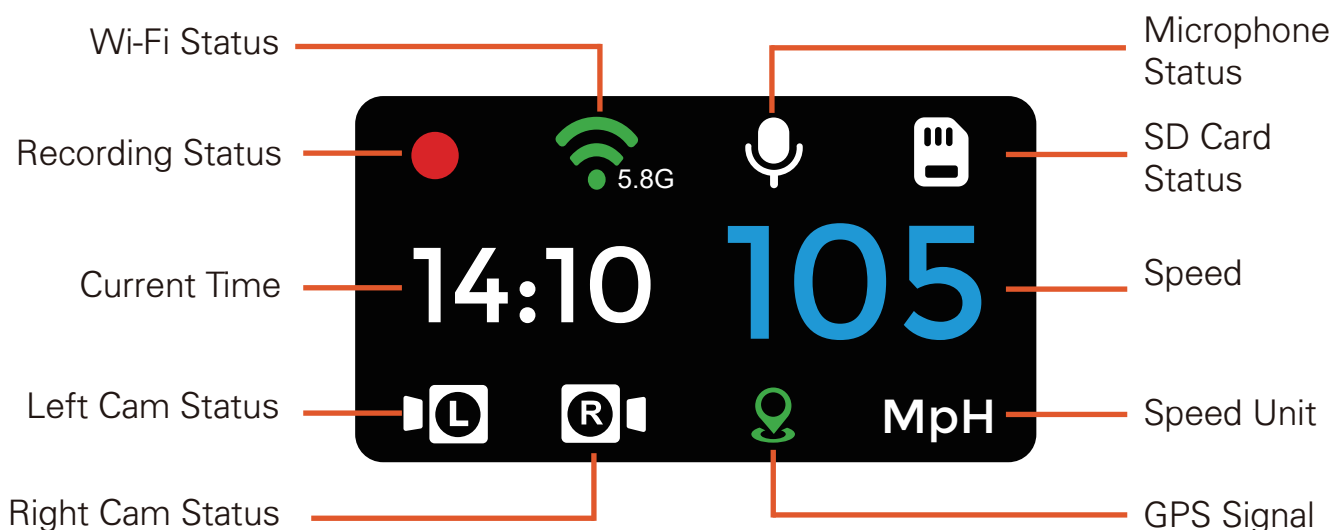
- 1 Single Press While Recording- to Lock the Current Video.
 - 2 Hold for 6 Seconds with a beep sound then release: Switch the WiFi Signal between 5.8GHz / 2.4GHz.
 - 3 Hold for 10 Seconds: Restore the setting to factory default.
-  Single Press to process format when the R4-4K prompts 'Please format the SD card'.

Our default settings of the R4 dashcam allow you to use the camera as soon as you get it without modifying any settings. You can also scan the code on the right to watch the installation video guidance for your R4 dashcam(will redirect to YouTube).

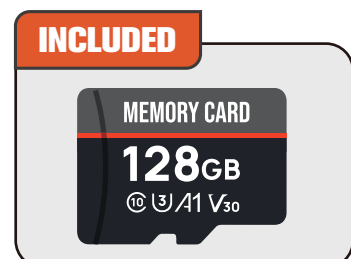


Power Requirement

As this R4 dashcam with high resolution of 2160P Front +1080P Rear dual channel, along with 5G WiFi function, it requires a more powerful power source to drive this system(compared to a normal 5V/1A). **We strongly recommend you use the car charger that comes with this package.** If your car does not have a cigarette lighter port, please **contact us** to get a TYPE C cable and insert it into a 5V/2A USB port. If you use a normal 5V/1A port to power this camera, issues may occur.

SD Card Installation / Removal

A 128GB SD card is included and inserted in to the camera in advance. **You can skip this step directly.** If yours does not have an SD card, please **reach us** for an SD card replacement.



1 SD Card Installation

Turn off the R4 dashcam before inserting the SD card. Place the SD card with the metal contact facing downwards. Then push the memory card into the card slot, until a "click" sound is heard in the card slot, indicating that the memory card is inserted properly.



2 Remove the SD Card

To remove the SD card, please gently push its edge inward until it clicks first, after it pops out, please pull it out of the slot.



1. Never remove the SD card while the camera is on, the camera will stop recording immediately and may cause video damage.
2. Please note that every SD card has its life span, when your R4 keeps turning on/off frequently and the videos are not saved, your SD card may reach its life span, please replace a new SD card.



Extend with a Larger SD Card

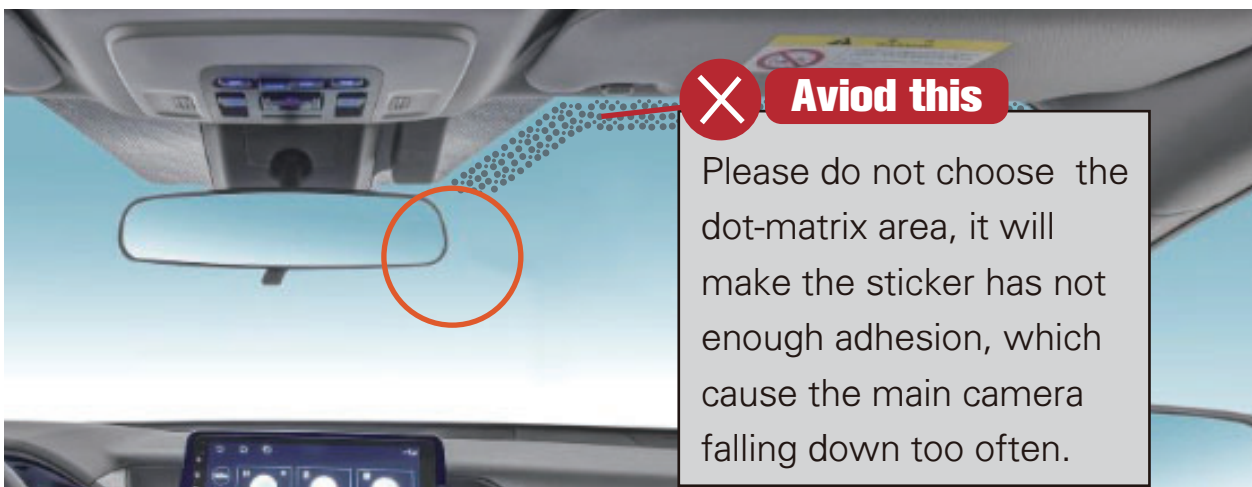
If you consider the provided SD card's capacity is too small, you can extend the memory with a larger one from Amazon. This R4 dashcam can support up to 512GB memory. We recommend you select a SAMSUNG brand, Class 10, U3 speed Micro SD card. We recommend you search **B0CWPPMD8W** on Amazon.



Install the Main Camera

1 Main Cam Installation Area

Most of our customers choose to install their R4 dashcam next to the rear view mirror and close to the passenger side. Park your car in a safe and well-lit area before you start the installation(avoid dot-matrix area).



2 Clean the Area and Stick the Electrostatic Film

Please use wet & dry tissues to repeatedly wipe the place you choose to install the recorder in order to clean the dust particles on the windshield and the grease evaporated. Then stick the electrostatic film on the place. Please make sure the electrostatic film fits the glass completely and there are no bubbles.

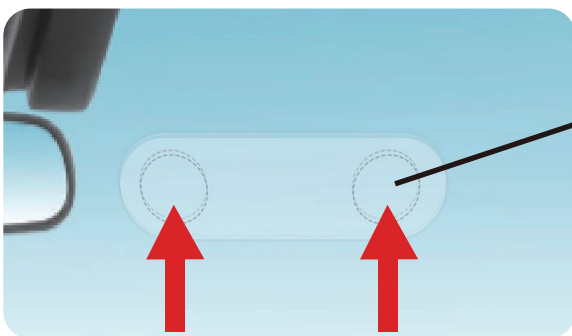
Electrostatic Film

(1) We design the electrostatic sticker to attach to the windshield first, then stick the bracket with 3M Adhesive on the electrostatic sticker. You can easily readjust location by sticking the 3M Adhesive on electrostatic sticker and peel it off.

(2) Re-sticking may weaken the adhesive strength of the tape and cause it to fall off. If you need more accessories, please CONTACT US.

3 Stick R4 Camera on the Electrostatic Films

Peel off the films of the 3M tape of the R4 camera, and stick it on the electrostatic film you just stuck on the windscreen. Please stick the 3M adhesive tape on the bracket according to the area indicated on the electrostatic film.

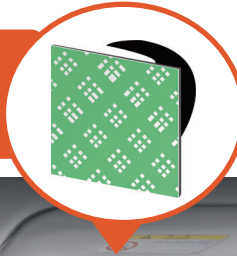


Please stick the left and right adhesive strips of the bracket to the dotted area on the static film.

4 Connect the Power Cable

Use the power cord to connect the TYPE C Power Port of the product to the car's cigarette lighter socket with the package to run the cable through the A-Pillar. The cigarette lighter port usually is in the glove box of your car. You can use the wiring straps to help you run your cable on the front windscreen.

Stick it on the windscreen, and fasten the wire harness underneath.



Pay Attention to the Airbags

For the car has side curtain airbags, please run the cable along the window carefully. Please make sure your cable won't obstruct the airbags take effect.

Install the Rear Camera

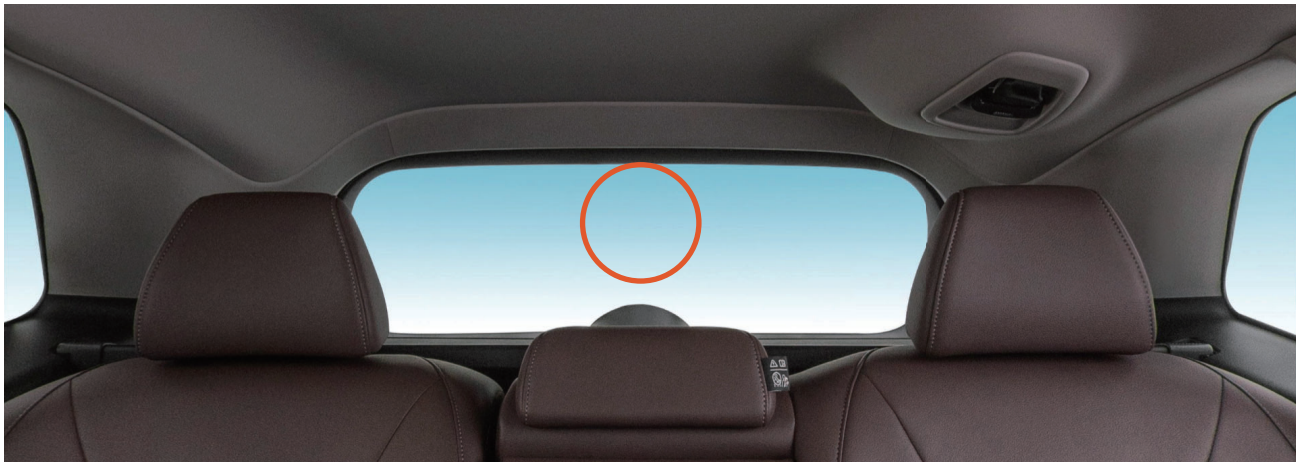


Rear Camera: Optional Installation

The rear camera of this R4 dashcam is not waterproof/dustproof, please be sure that it is installed on the back windscreen of your car. This rear camera installation is optional, if you choose not to install the rear camera, the main camera can still work.

1 Main Cam Installation Area

Please install the rear camera in the upper middle of the rear windshield in the car. This will make it easier to arrange the wiring harness and will not obstruct you from viewing the rear through the rearview mirror.



2 Clean the Area and Stick the Electrostatic Film

Please use wet & dry tissues to repeatedly wipe the place you choose to install the recorder in order to clean the dust particles on the windshield and the grease evaporated. Then stick the electrostatic film on the place. Please make sure the electrostatic film fits the glass completely and there are no bubbles.

3 Stick the Rear Camera

Remove the film of the glue then you can stick it on the rear camera electrostatic film. **Please keep the sticky pad upward, otherwise, the rear videos you record will be upside down.**

4 Connect the Cable to Front Camera

Run the rear cable through the C-pillar, B-pillar, and A-pillar of the car body, and finally reach the main lens. The straps and crowbar came with the package can help you manage the cable. With rear cable well wired, please insert the rear plug into the main camera. **Note: If you insert the rear camera plug when the main camera is on, it will reboot and start recording in 2-channel mode.**

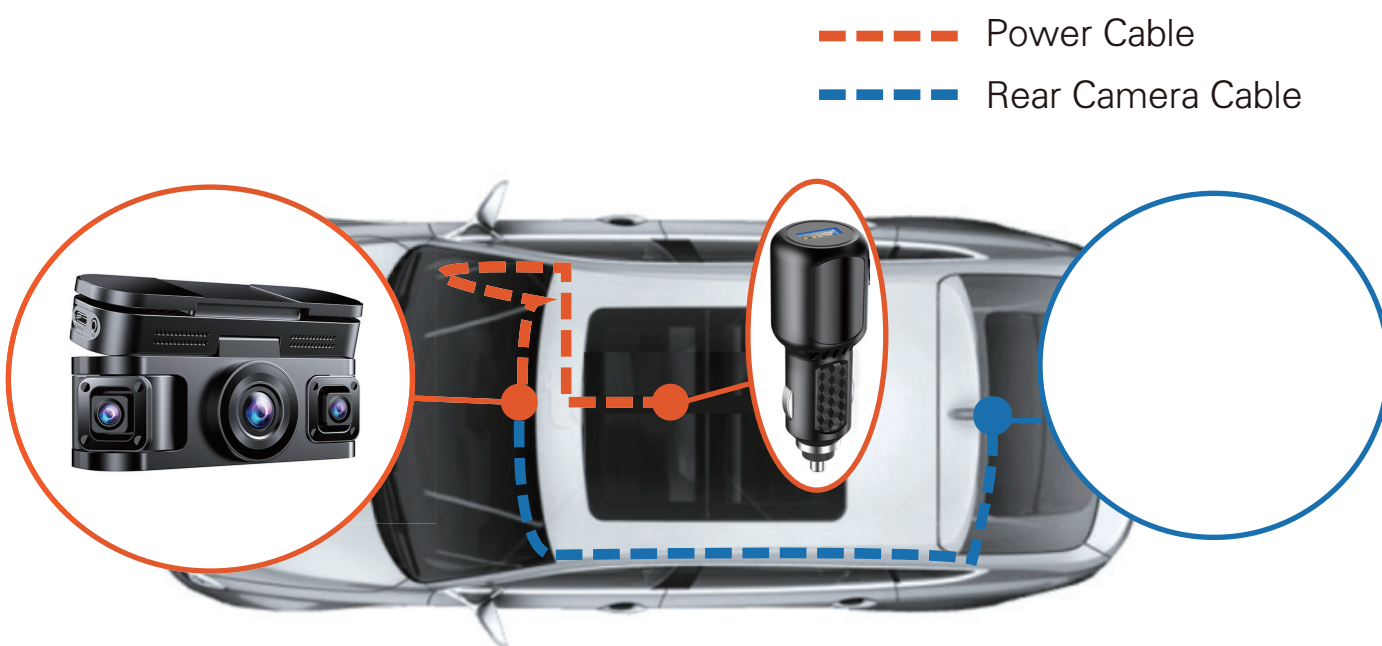


i Please fully insert the rear camera socket into the 'rear camera' port from the main camera to ensure the videos from rear camera can be received.

4 Effect of Full Installation

Congratulations, you have now completed the wiring of the R4 dashcam. Please refer to the picture below to confirm again whether your wiring is correct.



Power on and Format the SD Card



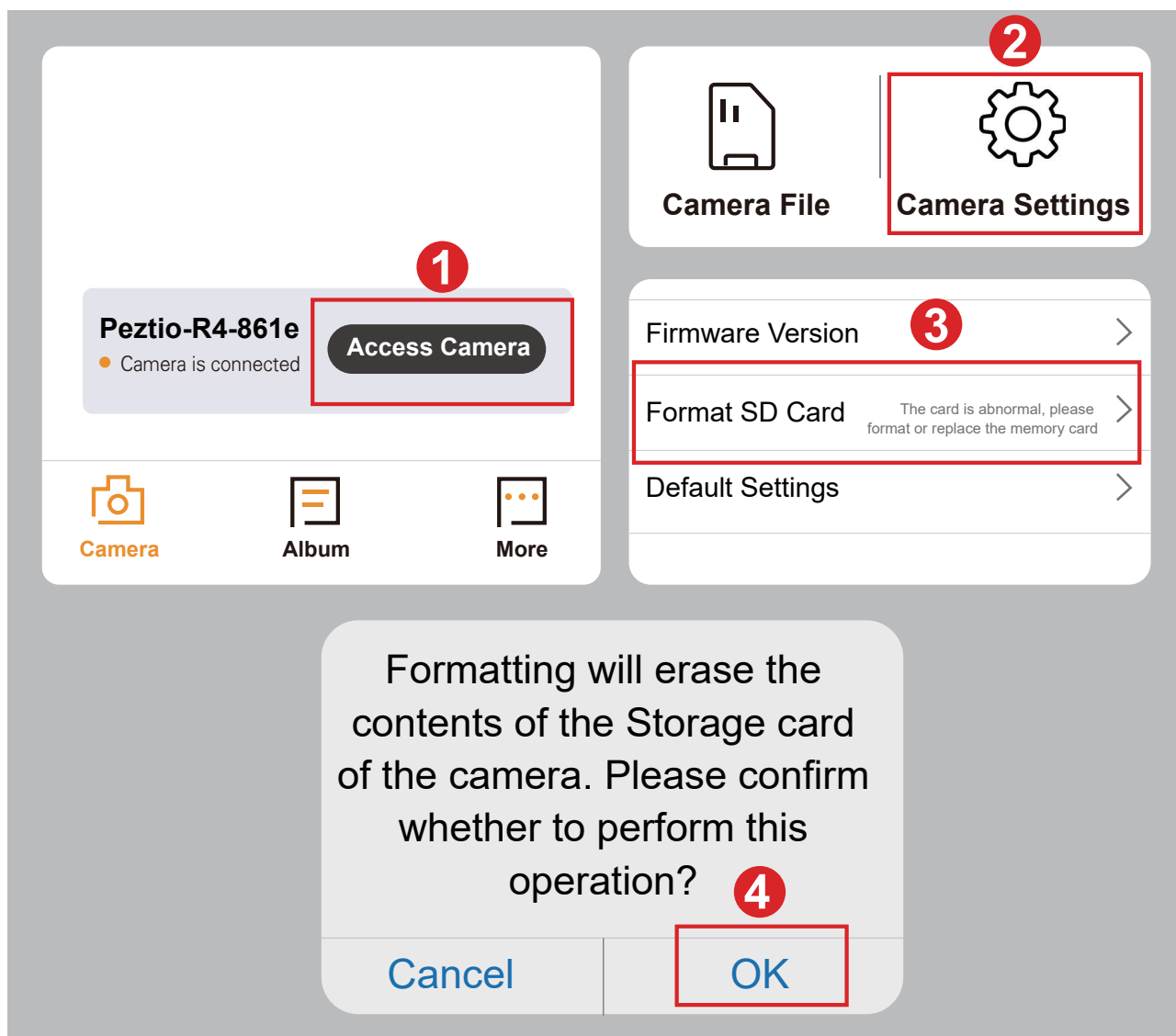
For the SD card inserted into the R4 dashcam for the first time (or the first time boot up you just take it out from the package), the R4 dashcam will keep prompting 'Please format the SD card' and the recording dot not flashing, you can choose any one of the following 2 methods to process the format and get the R4 camera start recording.

1 Single Press Power Button to Format

Single Press the POWER BUTTON  to process format then wait for seconds, the R4 dashcam will prompt 'Start Recording' after the format processed.

2 Format From App

- Connect Peztio APP and Access Camera ().
- Click the "Camera Settings"
- On camera settings page, scroll down until you see "FORMAT SD Card", then choose "Format SD Card", and click "OK" to confirm to format the memory card.



INSTALLATION



Slow Card / Card Error?

For most situations, the R4 dashcam will auto-start recording after it finishes the SD card format. But if you insert a defective SD card or a low-speed card that can not reach Class 10 U3 speed, the R4 dashcam will prompt 'Memory Card Error' after the format finishes. Please replace an SD card that works well and reaches Class 10, U3 speed(Max) in this situation.

Final Adjustment

1 Adjust the Camera Angle

Adjust the angle of the 4 cameras to make sure that the camera can capture the full image and is not obstructed by window tint or any other objects, we recommend you connect the R4 dashcam to your cellphone app first, then adjust the angle of each camera with reference to the live video.



2 Adjust the Date & Time

After you successfully connect the R4 with Peztio app, R4 dashcam will auto sync the time with your cellphone, and you don't need to set the time via the dash cam yourself.

3 How to Remove the R4 from Car

For the situation when you want to remove the R4 dash cam from the windshield, please hold the camera and disassemble it from the mount.



Thanks to this removable bracket stand design, you can install the R4 dash cam to another car when you have another bracket. Please kindly **contact us** for spare stand if you need it.

Understand Wi-Fi Function

R4 dashcam has built-in WiFi module, so you can use your mobile phone to wirelessly pair with the camera through the WiFi, and instantly get the video from the dash cam. Apart from that, you can easily watch the live feed, view, download and share videos with family and friends. In summary, just like you connect a Bluetooth speaker to your smartphone for wireless music playback, the dash cam uses a WiFi signal (instead of Bluetooth) to pair your smartphone to the R4 dashcam in the same way.

NOT Support Remote Monitoring

R4 dashcam does NOT support remote monitor. Because the WiFi signal will not be turned on when the car is not powered on and the valid range of WiFi is 10FT. Therefore, the remote monitor function cannot be realized if both above conditions are not met.

Not Need Always to Connect

R4 dashcam will auto start recording and save the videos in the SD card once it is powered on. You don't have to connect the R4 dashcam all the time while you are driving. In reverse, you are not able to use the navigation or listen to the music from online app if you connect the R4 dashcam with your cellphone. So you don't have to connect the R4 dashcam with your cellphone all the time.

1 Download 'Peztio' App

Please scan the QR code of the relevant version below to download the APP and install it. Or search for 'Peztio' in App Store or Google Play Store to download and install it on your phone.



Always Connect to Power

Please remain the R4 connected to the power while you are operating the WiFi function, otherwise the dash cam WiFi will become offline.

2 Authorize Permissions to Peztio App

Just open the "Peztio" app you've downloaded, and authorize the permissions as below. When opening the app for the first time, please make sure to authorize the App with album, location, WLAN & cellular data, otherwise the Peztio app won't work correctly.

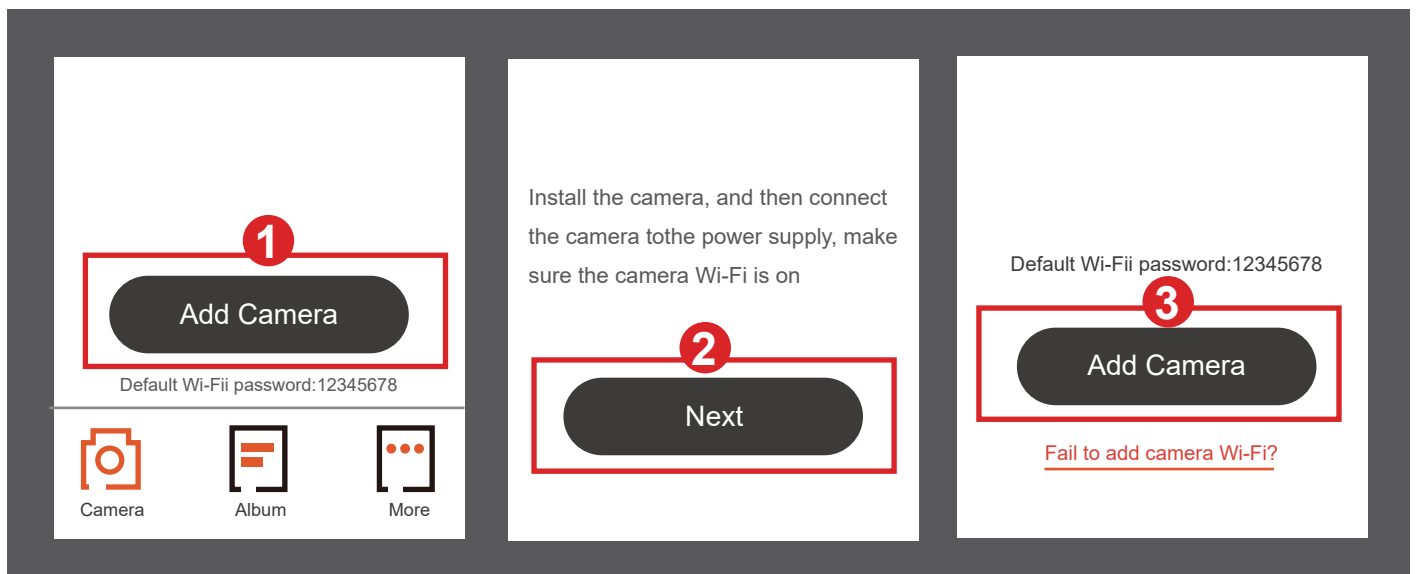

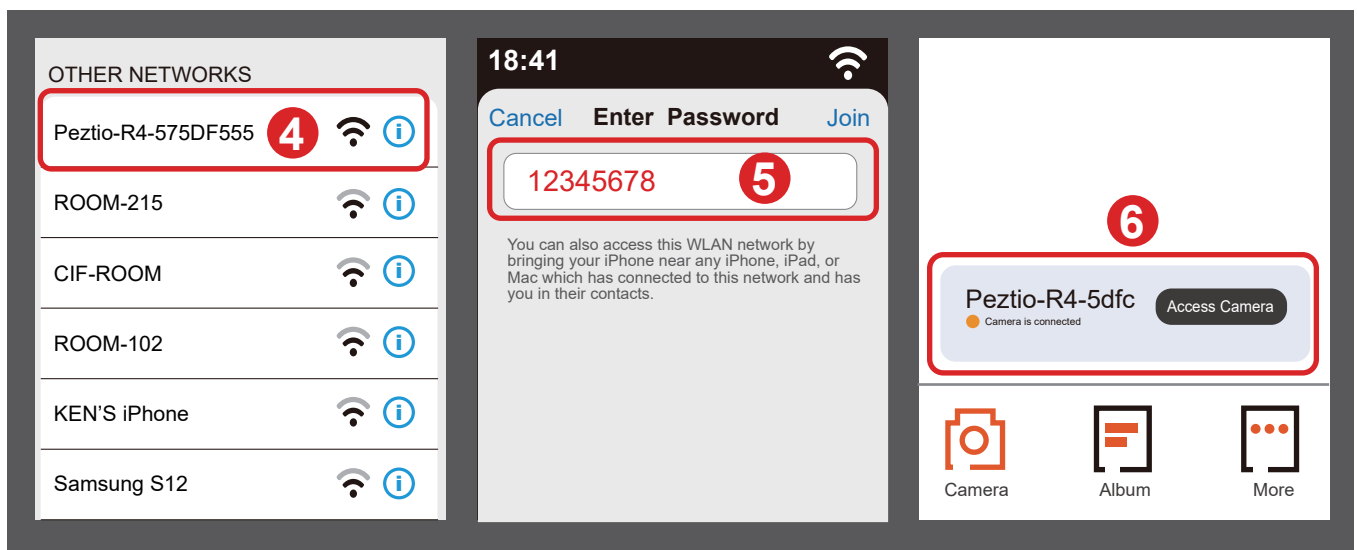
3 Add R4 Camera to Peztio App

Once the R4 dash cam power on, it will boardcast Wi-Fi signal immediately, that mean you don't need to turn on the Wi-Fi of R4 camera. Please follow the guide of app to add the R4 camera

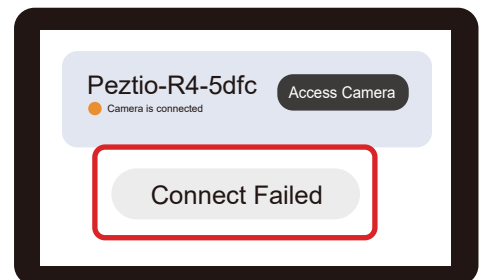

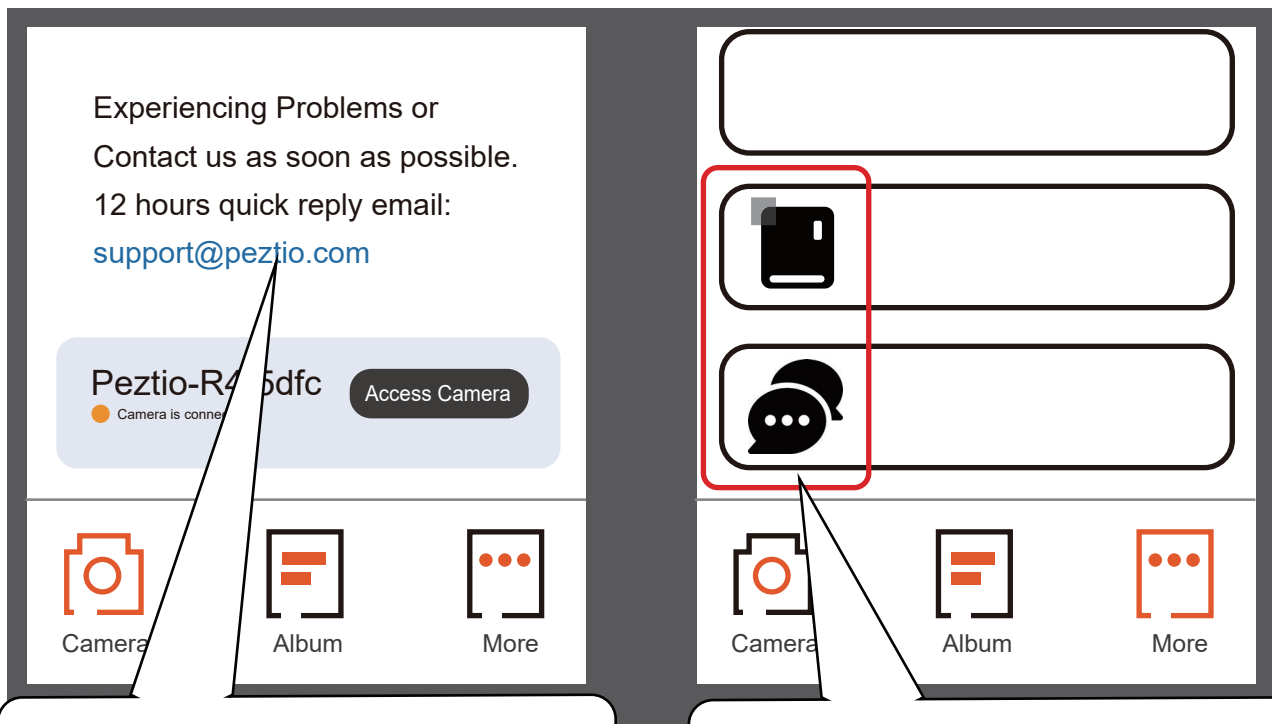
For Best 4K Experience

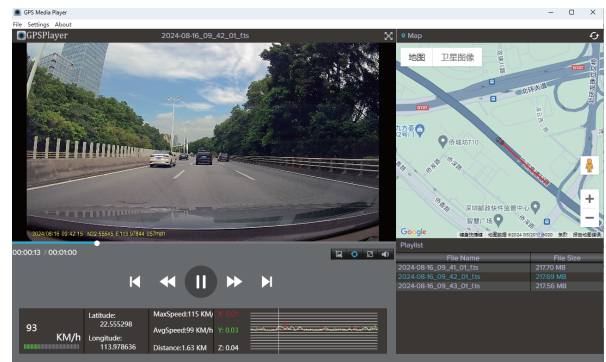

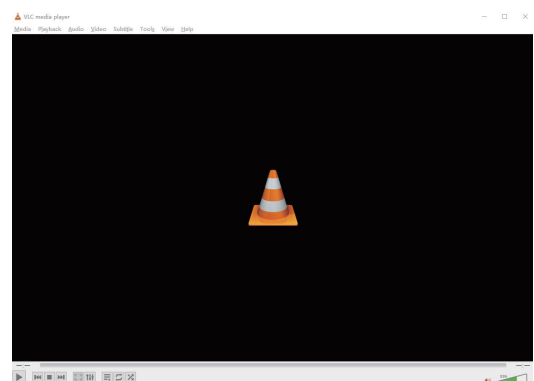

Loop Record Options

The duration of each recorded video will be saved in the normal video folder according to the loop recording time you set. When the capacity of the normal video folder reaches 70% of the total, new loop recording files will automatically overwrite original loop recording files. After this function is enabled, the video file will automatically overwrite the loop, so as not to stop recording during the driving process.

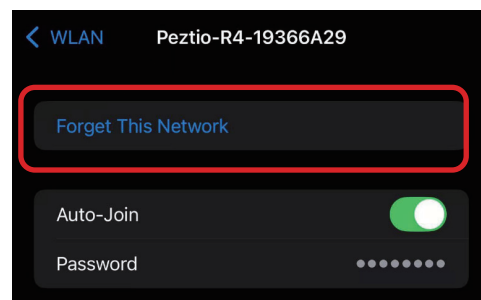

Frequently Asked Questions

1 Do I have to connect the R4 dashcam WiFi each time I drive in order to record the videos?

No, the dash cam will automatically record without connecting to your cellphone wifi. Camera will record as long as it has power.

2 Encountering issues connecting the camera while using Carplay/Android Auto?

This is because by default, the mobile phone prioritizes the connection with Carplay or Android Auto, making it challenging to establish a connection with the camera. To successfully connect the camera, please follow these steps:

1. Disable your mobile phone's Bluetooth.
2. Disconnect from any existing WiFi connections.
3. Turn off your car and ensure your mobile phone is no longer linked to Carplay or Android Auto.
4. Restart your car and then connect the camera with your phone.

Generally, it's advisable to maintain the priority connection with Carplay or Android Auto. The dash cam will continue recording automatically without needing to connect to your cellphone's WiFi, functioning as long as it has a power source.

3 Can't use navigation / listen music with online app while driving?

Once you connect to Peztio-R4-**** WiFi, it will say 'No internet connection', which is fine and please select 'Keep trying wifi'. If you want to use the phone network,(for music, navigation etc.) just disconnect the camera WiFi. **The camera will continue to record even when it is not connected to your cellphone. In other words, you don't need to connect to the dash cam WiFi all the time.**

4 The camera does not power off even when the car is off and drains my battery?

This issue happens when your car does not cut the power supply after you shut down the car (while other models do). So we recommend you replace the dashcam charger with another port from your car that can cut the power after your key is off. **If there is no ideal port from your car, please contact us for a hardwire kit as this kit can cut the power to the dash cam when it detects the battery voltage drop and retain enough power for the next start.**

5 Not Showing rear video?

If the rear video is not shown on the display even if you have inserted the plug of the rear camera into the main camera, please push the plug into the socket harder as this problem is caused by the incomplete insertion of the rear plug. If you are sure the plug is firmly inserted in to the main camera and the issue is still, please contact us immediately.

6 Loop recording doesn't work.

(1) Please check your SD card version, this loop recording function requires a Class 10, U3 SD card within 256GB, otherwise your videos can't be saved or overwrite.

(2) Make sure your loop recording is on and format your SD card, then set the G-Sensor at low sensitivity, your SD card may have too much locked videos and loop recording can't overwrite with these videos.

7 How to use the parking mode function?

To enable the 24 hours parking monitoring function on the R4 dashcam, you will require a Type C hardwire kit (NOT included in the package). You can find the recommended kit on Amazon by searching for . if you genuinely need this parking mode function, please feel free to reach out to us via WhatsApp or email.

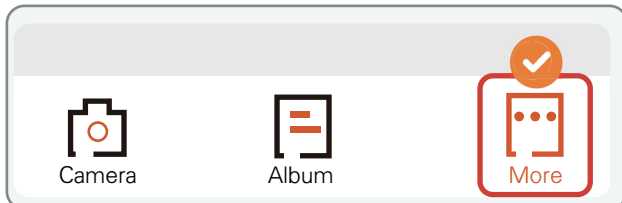

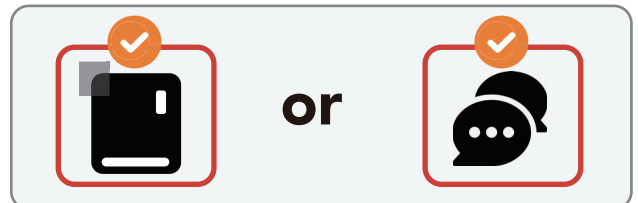
