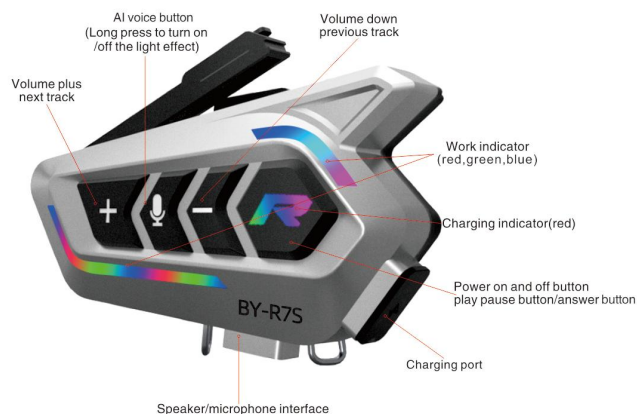

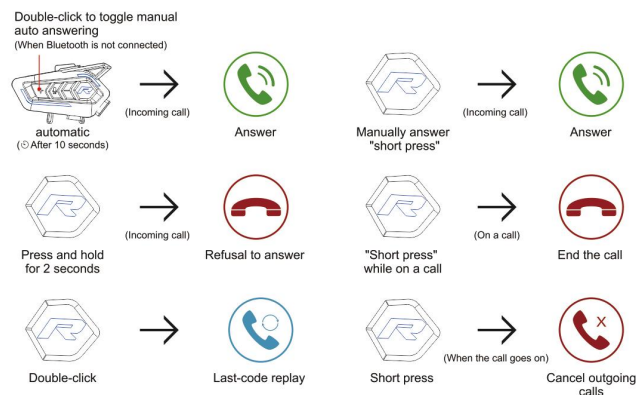

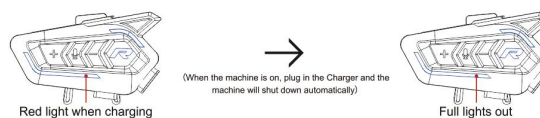
Important Notice:

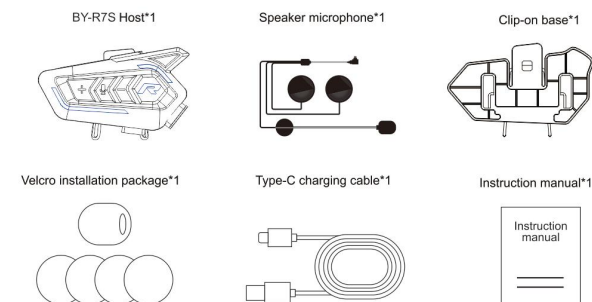

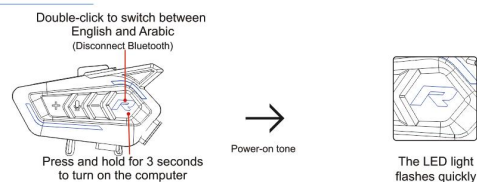

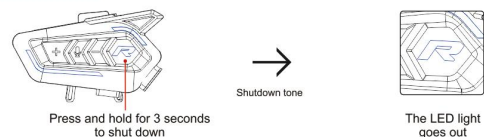
1. Do not put the product into the open flame to avoid explosion;

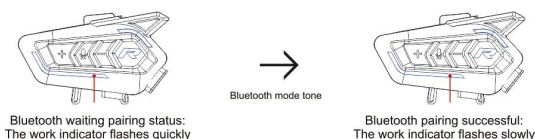

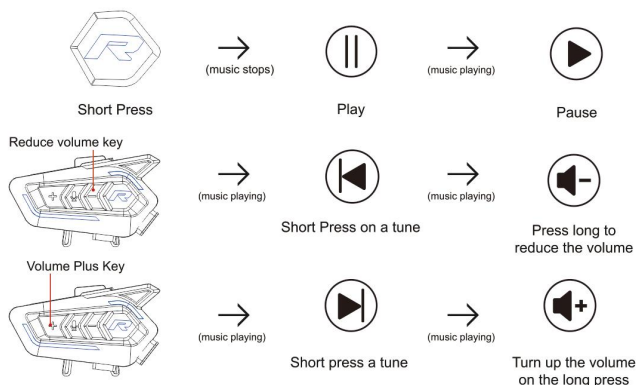

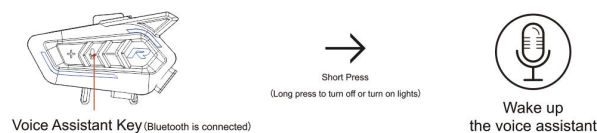
