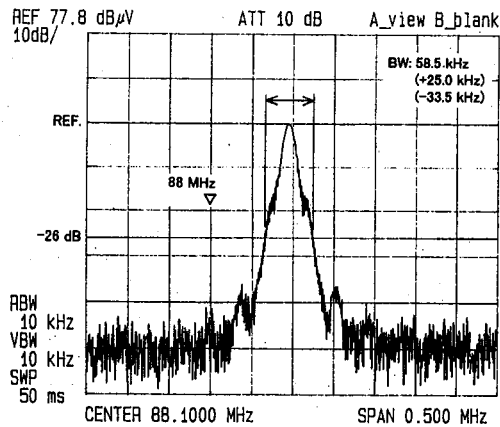

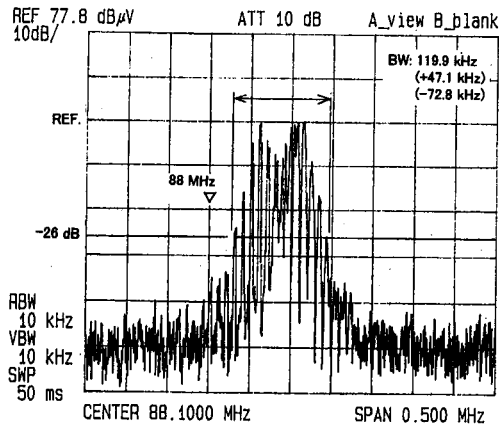

No Audio signal

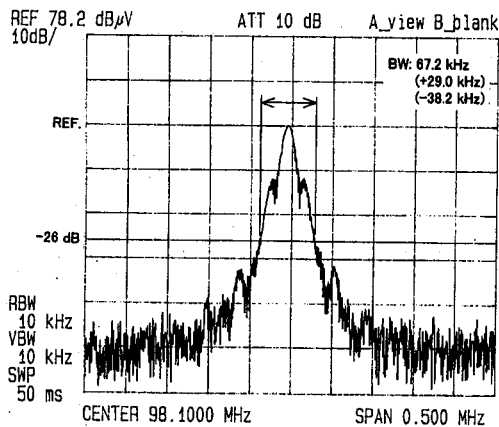


Audio input 1 kHz +8 dBV

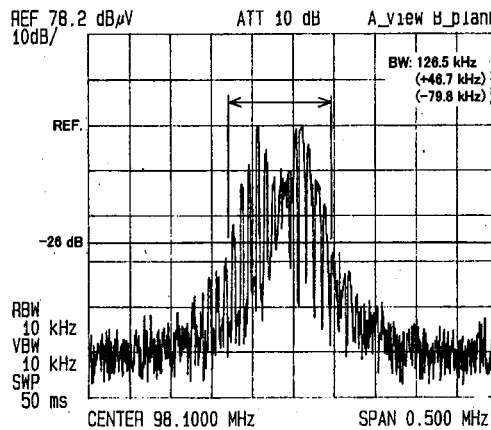


98.1 MHz

No Audio signal

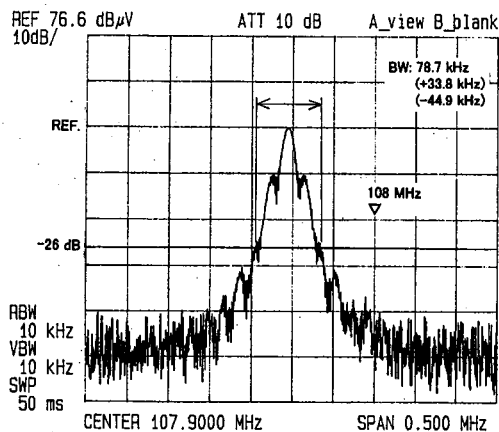


Audio input 1 kHz +8 dBV

Audio input 1 kHz +8 dBV

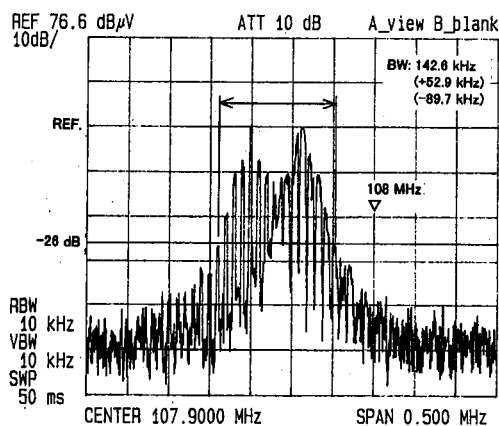

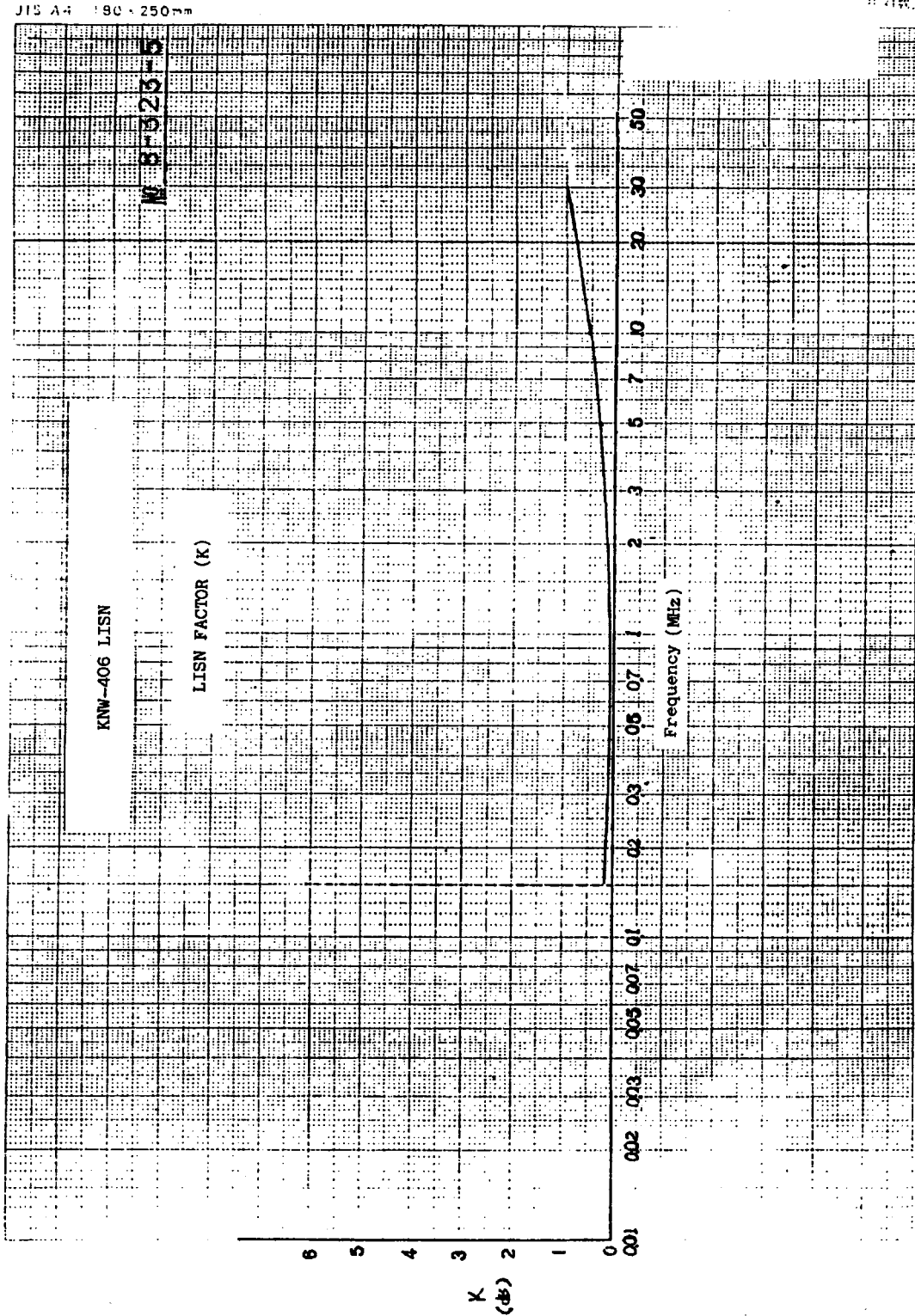

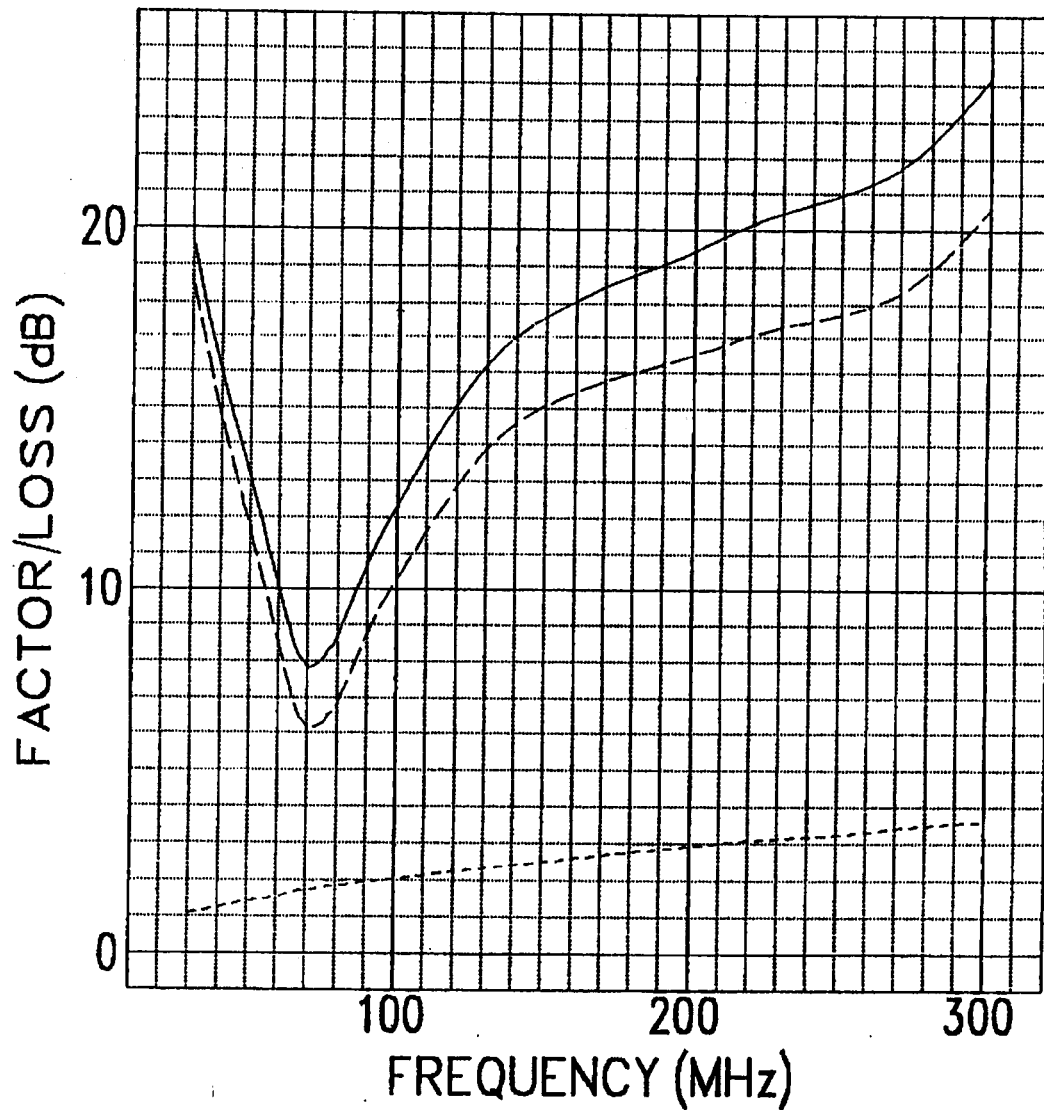

E : Field Strength

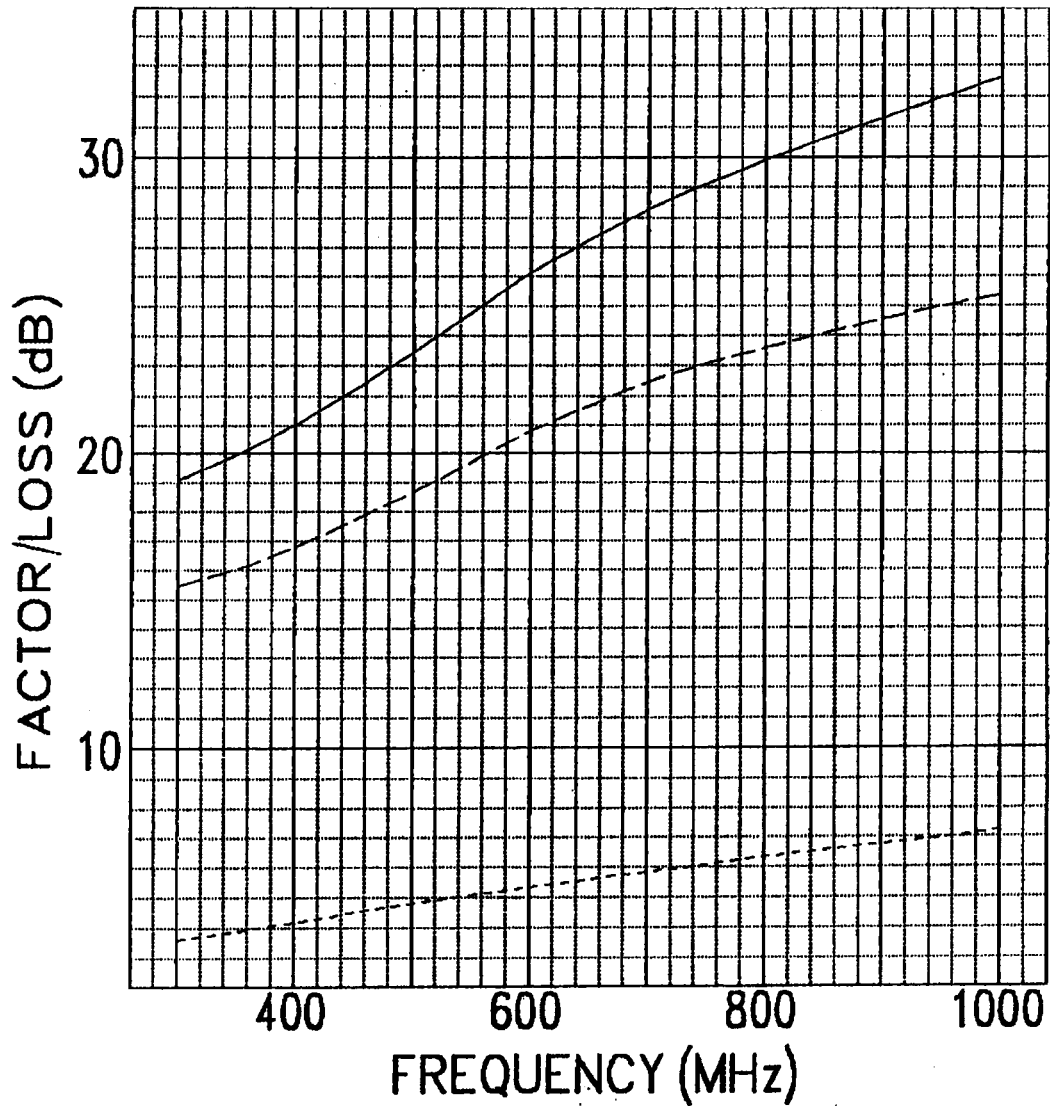

E : Field Strength

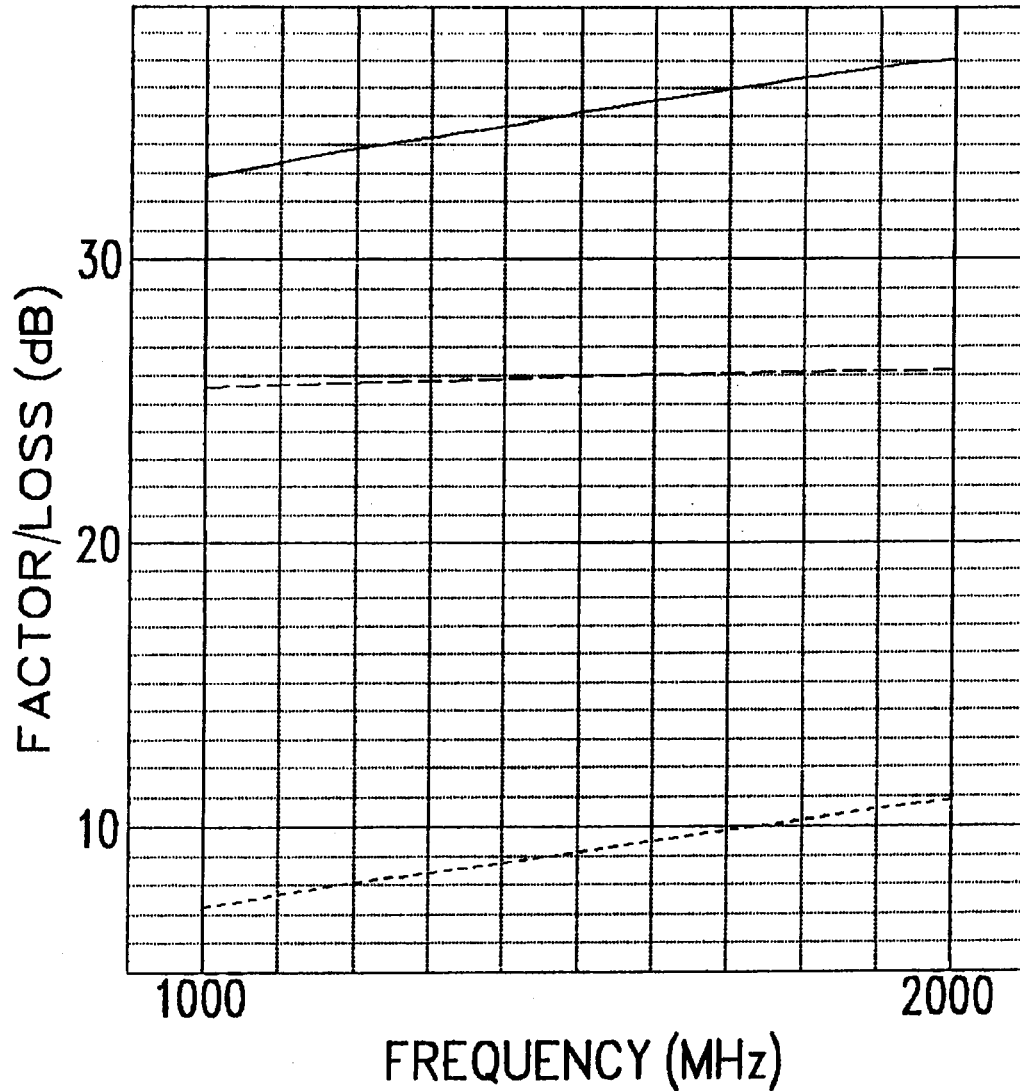
