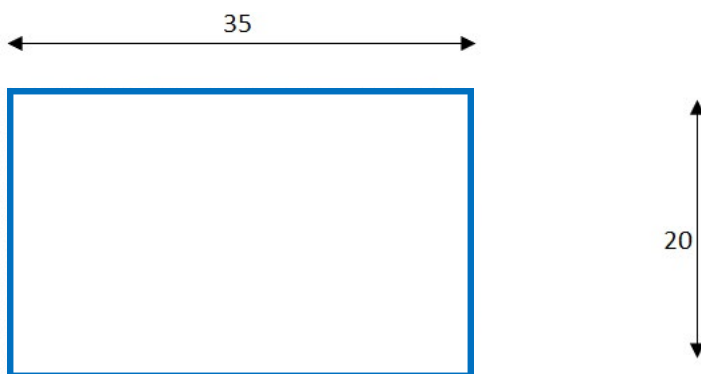


FCC ID and Label location

The approval label should be placed away from the components on the board and control numbers and mark. In addition, the label needs to avoid the vicinity of radio circuits because they affect performance at high frequencies. For these reasons, considering the following minimum label size, there is no place to put the label on the module product, and we comply with the FCC's label requirement by putting the label on the final host and indicating on the box(tray) carrying the modules as follows in accordance with §2.925(f) and KDB784748 D01, Session 3.

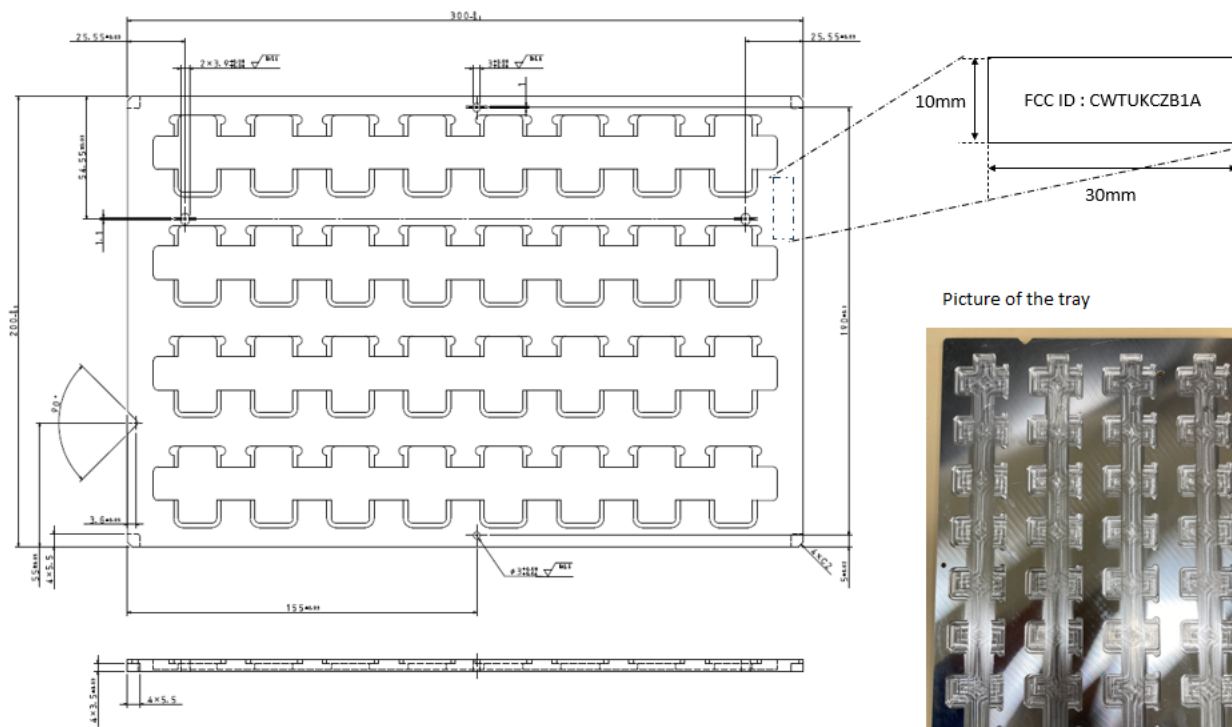
1. List of applicable FCC rules.

This module operates under the provisions of FCC Part 15.255 for unlicensed millimeter wave devices.

2. Summarize the specific operational use conditions.

This transmitter is approved to operate only with the antenna integrated into the module. Use of other antennas is prohibited without additional FCC authorization. The device must be installed to ensure a minimum separation distance of 20 cm from users. Co-location with other antennas or transmitters is not permitted. No professional installation is required unless specified.
