SlimStar 8230/K説明書

1 Remove the battery cover from the mouse. Install one AA battery into the mouse.

2 Remove the battery cover from the keyboard. Install one AA batteries into the keyboard.

Hardware Installation:
1. Install one AA battery into the mouse and one AA battery into the keyboard.
2. Remove the Pico receiver from the mouse and plug it into a USB port on your PC.

BT1 / BT2 / 2.4GHz Keyboard mode switches and pairing

Model	Function	Operation description
Bluetooth (BT1)	FN + 1	Press [FN+1] keys to enter BT1 (1) mode. [NUM] blue LED flashes slowly (4), and then long press [FN+P] keys for 2 seconds into pairing mode. [Bluetooth pairing name: SlimStar S230 / K1]. The blue LED (4) flashes quickly. After pairing successfully, the blue LED (4) goes out.
Bluetooth (BT2)	FN + 2	Press [FN+2] keys to enter BT2 (2) mode. [CAPS] blue LED flashes slowly (5), and then long press [FN+P] keys for 2 seconds into pairing mode. [Bluetooth pairing name: SlimStar S230 / K2]. The blue LED (5) flashes quickly. After pairing successfully, the blue LED (5) goes out.
2.4GHz	FN + 3	Press [FN+3] keys to enter 2.4G mode (3). Low battery indicator red LED flashes slowly (6), and then long press [FN+P] keys for 2 seconds into pairing mode. The red LED (6) flashes quickly. After pairing successfully, the red LED (6) goes out. Default mode: 2.4G mode (No need to pair).
