The following figures show the intended placement of the label on the TRACER Baseband Processor and RFC sections.

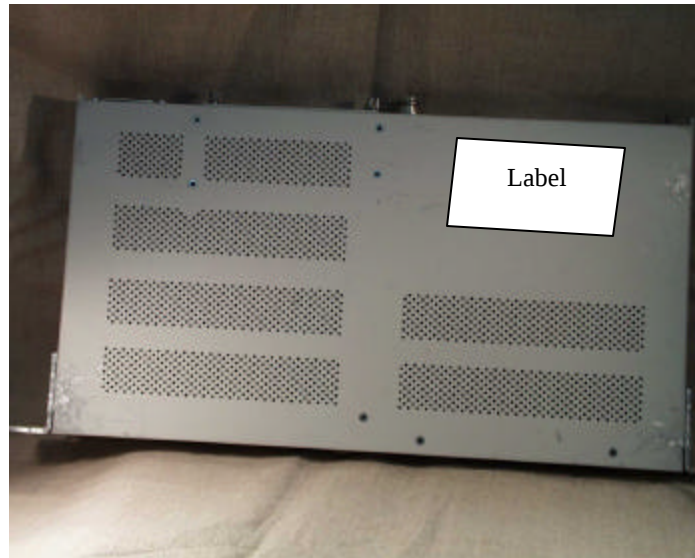


Figure 10: Label Location – BBP

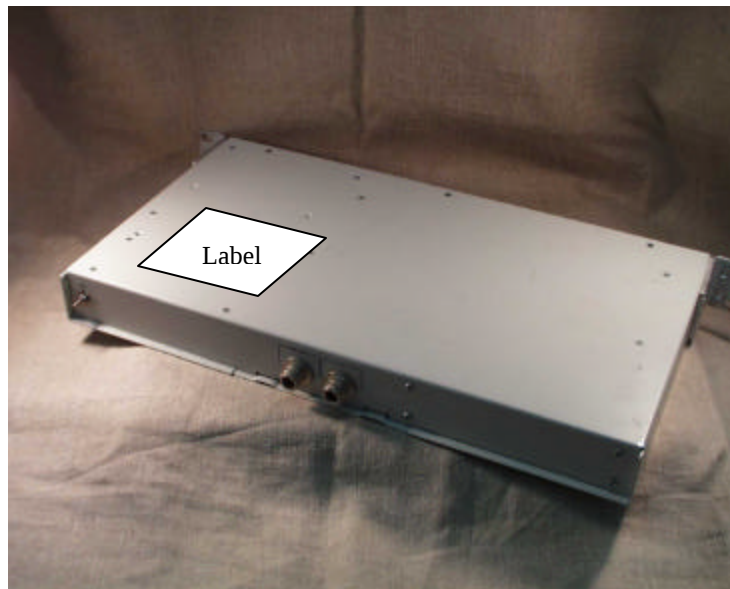


Figure 11: Label Location – RFC
