- Panic alarm.

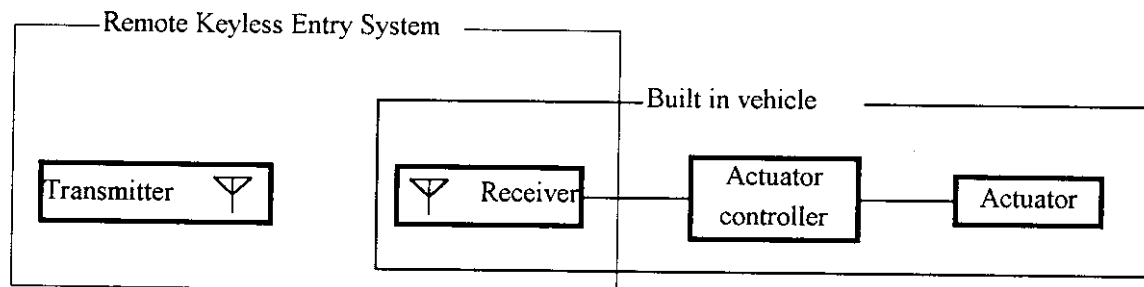


Fig.1 Outline of the System

Transmitter send a signal if the following buttons are pushed.

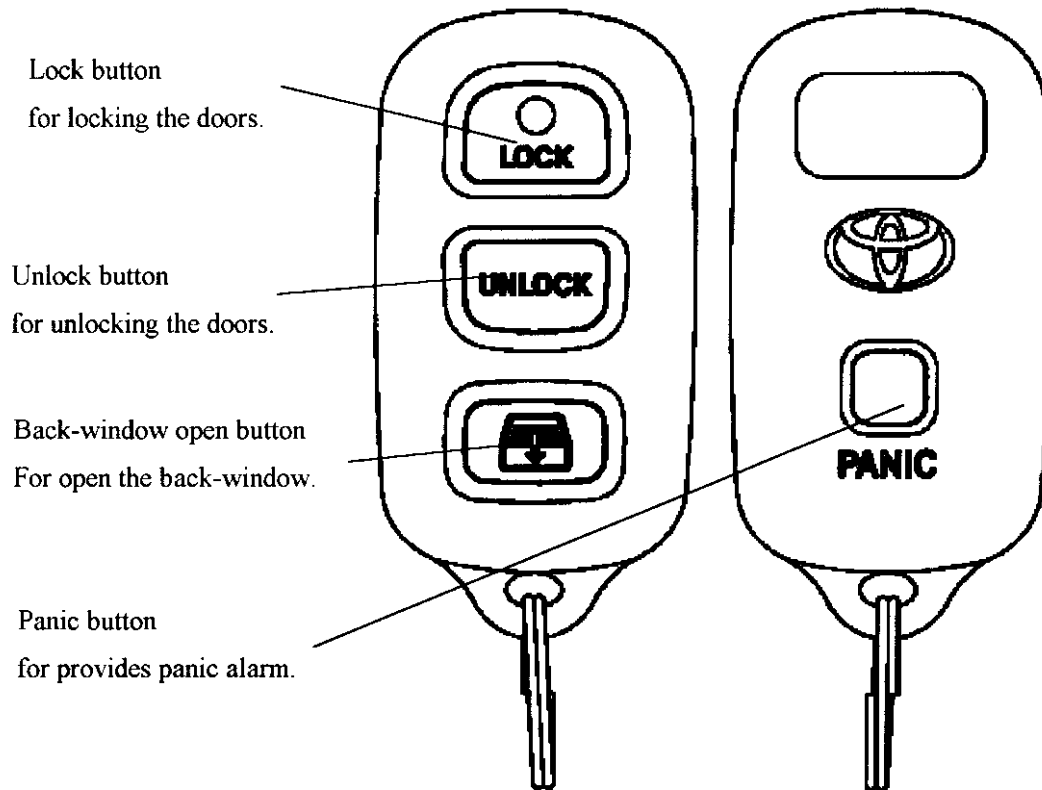
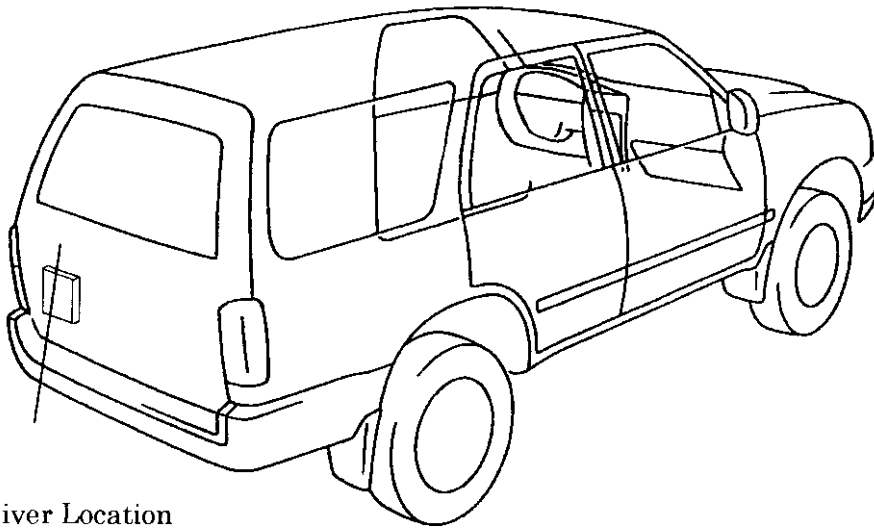


Fig.2 Appearance of transmitter
