Statement of Compliance with Electrical Serial Number (ESN) Regulations

The Electrical Serial Number (ESN) is encrypted and stored in a non-volatile memory location. A non encrypted version of the ESN is stored in a separate location in the memory. Upon power up the software decrypts the encrypted ESN, using a key known only to Wireless Link, and compares it to the non-encrypted version of ESN. If they do not match, the board sets ESN to all zeros and powers the board down.

The ESN is set only by Wireless Link factory and cannot otherwise be altered, transferred or removed. Any attempts to manipulate the ESN will render the phone inoperative.
