After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) Please provide a photograph that shows the antenna.
- 2) This device may be directly plugged directly into any standard USB port. Other uses other than desktop computers (i.e. laptop use) becomes a portable RF Exposure condition. This condition exists because of the following:
 - a) the antenna is integrated into the EUT
 - b) If the device were to be directly plugged into the USB ports on a laptop, the antenna will be closer than the 20 cm distance if the user chooses to use the laptop in their lap.

This same condition exists with PCMCIA Cards. However, this device appears to include a USB extension cable. This cable must be included with the product. Using this extension cable will ensure that the device will be used and installed in the proper manner. However, the users manual does not clearly instruct the user that this cable MUST be used. Sections of the manual that discuss the cable (section 3) and installation of the device (section 6) should clearly instruct the user that this cable must be used and how the device must be placed to meet the RF exposure requirements. Please provide an updated users manual.
