I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that for the BT device a restricted band begins at 2483.5MHz. Please note that the level of radiated emissions at this frequency must be 54dBuV/m average and 74dBuV/m peak. Please note that page 20 of the Bluetooth report shows a peak reading of 84+dBuV/m at 2484MHz. As this is in the restricted bands the device is not compliant and thus cannot be certified as presented. Please provide test data for a device that is compliant for both the peak and averaged radiated emissions requirements of 47CFR.
2. Please note that the number of hopping frequencies for a BT device operating under both 8DPSK and GFSK should be 79. Please note that the reported number of hopping frequencies for 8DPSK is only 24. Please re-measure this to account for the proper number of hopping frequencies (i.e. 79).
