- 1) Where is the 2 part statement of 15.19(a)(3) found. This must be shown either on the device or in the manual. Please correct.
- 2) Schematics still appear to show components for 300 MHz. A 310 MHz version must be provided.
- 3) Your response does not appear to explain how the device meets the 5 second holdover/shutoff requirement by the FCC. Please explain compliance to the FCC 5 second rule for manually activated transmitter. When the button is released, how long does the transmitter continue to TX?
