I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that the plot on page 7 of the 1900MHz report "EXHIBIT_06_DTX12347-EN_QVVRH-68" shows that the signal is above the top graticule of the analyzer. This usually means that compression of the analyzer may be happening. This then may cause splatter and other errors in the reading. While it does not appear that splatter or other compressions errors are occurring, please confirm and show evidence that the signal is not being compressed and possibly causing erroneous readings.
2. Please specify the resolution and video bandwidths used in actual test data plots on page 9 of the above mentioned report.
3. Please note that the plot on page 7 of the 850MHz report "EXHIBIT_06_DTX12348-EN_QVVRH-68" shows that the signal is above the top graticule of the analyzer. This plot clearly show that the signal is being compressed and the results are thus in question. Please provide a plot of the signal that is not being compressed.
