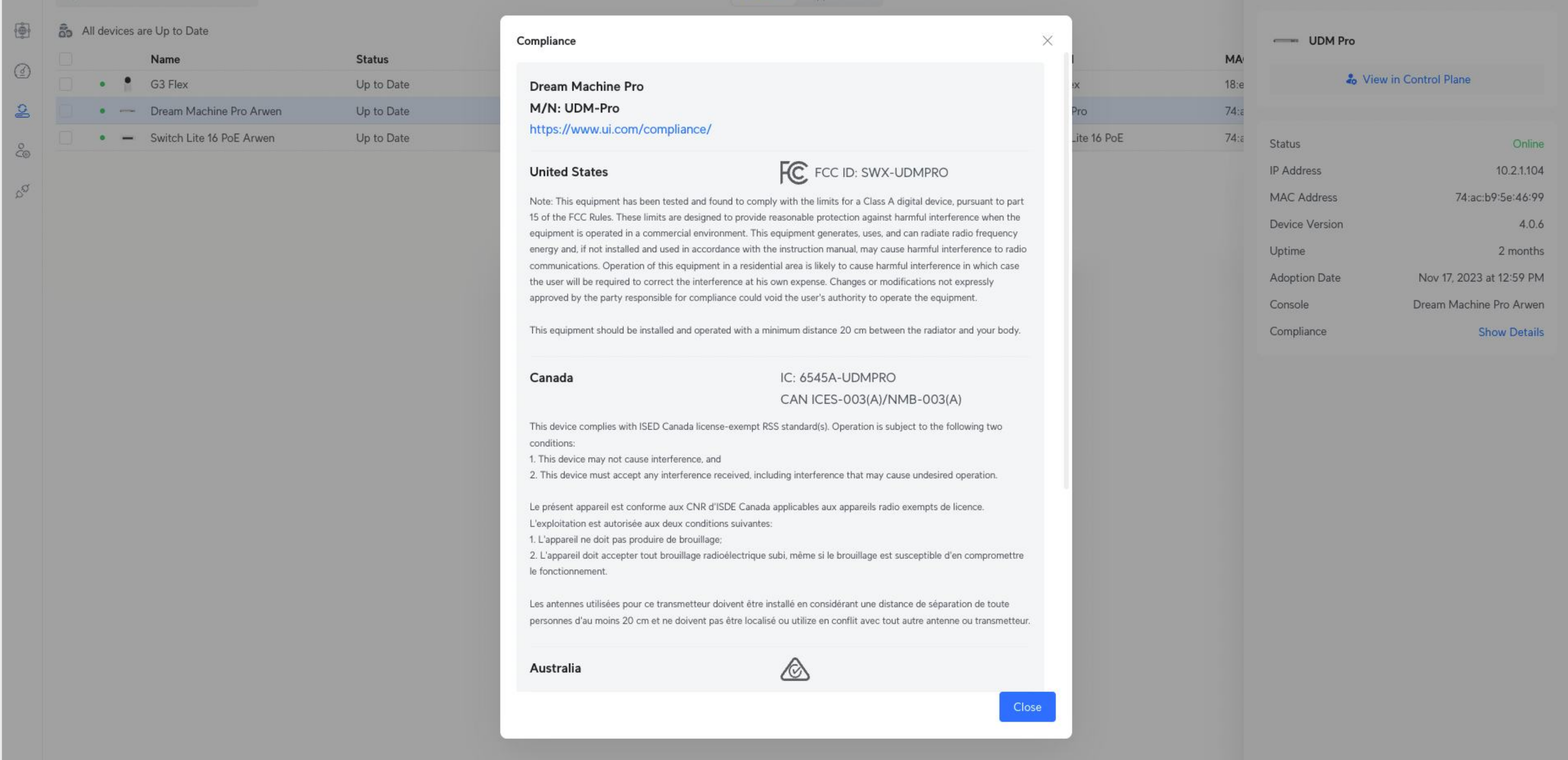

Click on the specific device for which you need information; details will appear in a side panel.

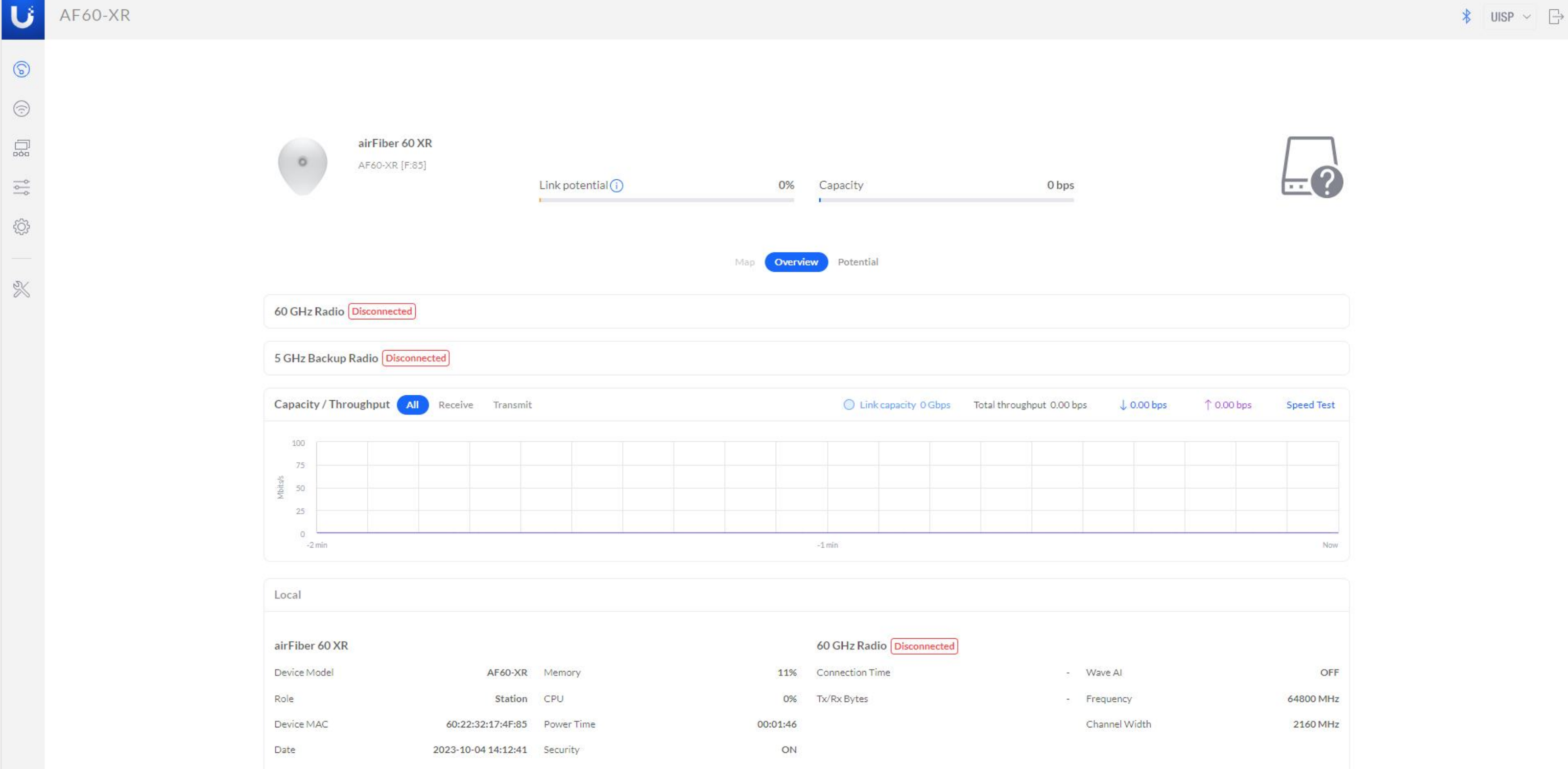

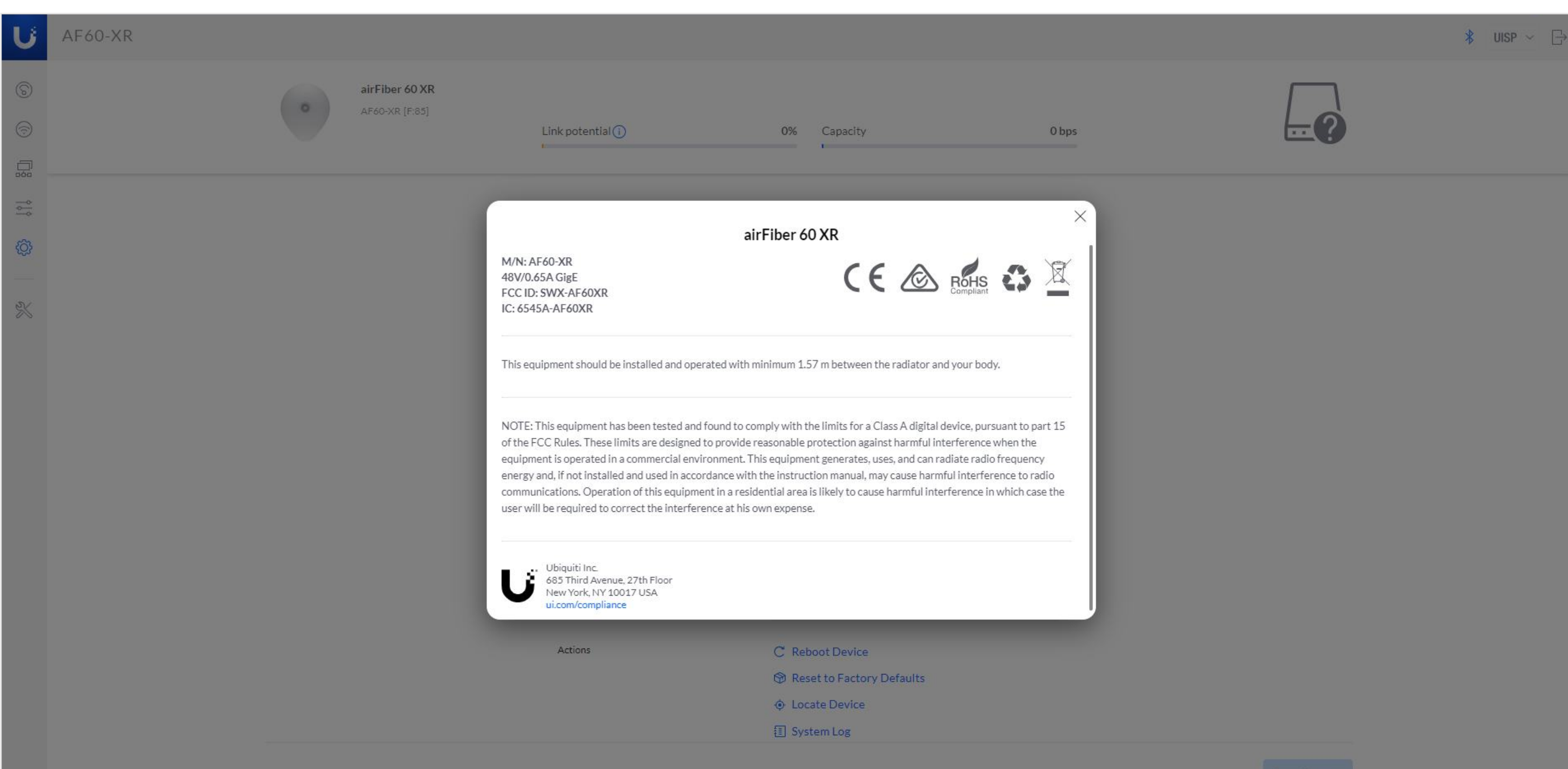
To start, log in to the device using the device IP address.
