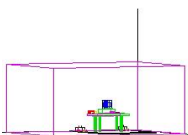

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1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Scope

Measurement and determination of electromagnetic emissions (EMC) of radio frequency devices including intentional and/or unintentional radiators for compliance with the technical rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission and the Industry Canada Certification and Engineering Bureau.

1.2 PCTEST Test Location

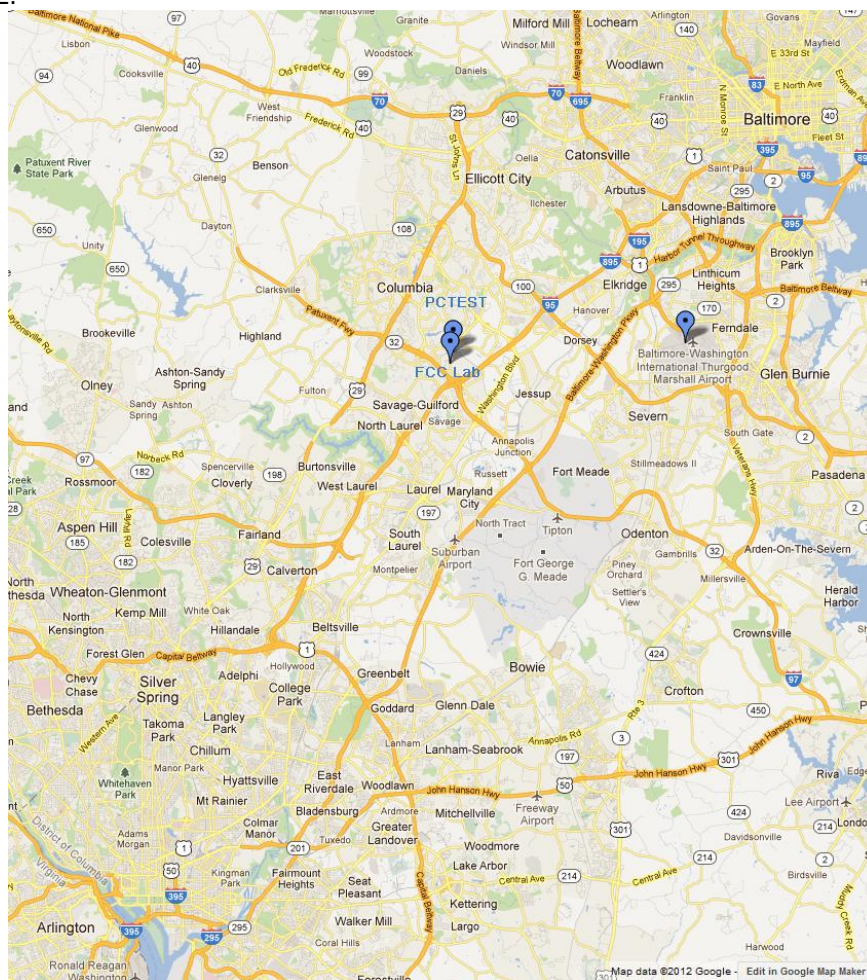


Figure 1-1. Map of the Greater Baltimore and Metropolitan Washington, D.C. area

The map below shows the location of the PCTEST LABORATORY, its proximity to the FCC Laboratory, the Columbia vicinity, the Baltimore-Washington Intern'l (BWI) airport, the city of Baltimore and the Washington, DC area. (See Figure 1-1).

These measurement tests were conducted at the PCTEST Engineering Laboratory, Inc. facility located at 7185 Oakland Mills Road, Columbia, MD 21046. The site coordinates are 39° 10'23" N latitude and 76° 49'50" W longitude. The facility is 0.4 miles North of the FCC laboratory, and the ambient signal and ambient signal strength are approximately equal to those of the FCC laboratory. The detailed description of the measurement facility was found to be in compliance with the requirements of § 2.948 according to ANSI C63.4-2009 on February 15, 2012.

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2.0 PRODUCT INFORMATION

2.1 Equipment Description

The Equipment Under Test (EUT) is the **LG Portable Handset FCC ID: ZNFLS885**. The test data contained in this report pertains only to the emissions due to the EUT's UNII transmitter.

2.2 Device Capabilities

This device contains the following capabilities:

850/1900 CDMA (BC0, BC1, BC10), Band 25 (3, 5, 10MHz BW), 41 (10, 15, 20MHz BW), 26 (1.4, 3, 5, 10MHz BW) LTE, 802.11a/b/g/n WLAN, 802.11a/n UNII, Bluetooth (1x, EDR, LE)

Note: 5GHz WLAN (DTS/NIJ) operation is possible in 20MHz, and 40MHz channel bandwidths. The maximum achievable duty cycles for all modes were determined based on measurements performed on a spectrum analyzer in zero-span mode with RBW = 8MHz, VBW = 50MHz, and detector = peak per the guidance of Section B)2)b) of KDB 789033. The RBW and VBW were both greater than 50/T, where T is the minimum transmission duration, and the number of sweep points across T was greater than 100. The duty cycles are as follows:

- 802.11a/n 20MHz Bandwidth – 96.1 %
- 802.11n 40MHz Bandwidth – 91.9 %

2.3 Test Configuration

The LG Portable Handset FCC ID: ZNFLS885 was tested per the guidance of KDB 789033 v01r03. ANSI C63.10-2009 was used to reference the appropriate EUT setup for radiated spurious emissions testing and AC line conducted testing. See Sections 3.2, 3.3, and 6.1 of this test report for a description of the AC line conducted emissions, radiated emissions, and antenna port conducted emissions test setups, respectively.

2.4 EMI Suppression Device(s)/Modifications

No EMI suppression device(s) were added and/or no modifications were made during testing.

2.5 Labeling Requirements

Per 2.1074 & 15.19; Docket 95-19

The label shall be permanently affixed at a conspicuous location on the device; instruction manual or pamphlet supplied to the user and be readily visible to the purchaser at the time of purchase. However, when the device is so small wherein placement of the label with specified statement is not practical, only the trade name and FCC ID must be displayed on the device per Section 15.19(a)(5). 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3.0 DESCRIPTION OF TEST

3.1 Evaluation Procedure

The measurement procedures described in the American National Standard for Testing Unlicensed Wireless Devices (ANSI C63.10-2009) and the guidance provided in KDB 789033 v01r03 were used in the measurement of **LG Portable Handset FCC ID: ZNFLS885**.

3.2 AC Line Conducted Emissions

The line-conducted facility is located inside a 10'x16'x9' shielded enclosure. The shielded enclosure is manufactured by ETS Lindgren RF Enclosures. The shielding effectiveness of the shielded room is in accordance with MIL-Std-285 or NSA 65-5. A 1m x 1.5m wooden table 80cm high is placed 40cm away from the vertical wall and 80cm away from the sidewall of the shielded room. Two 10kHz-30MHz, 50Ω/50μH Line-Impedance Stabilization Networks (LISNs) are bonded to the shielded room floor. Power to the LISNs is filtered by external high-current high-insertion loss power line filters. The external power line filter is an ETS Lindgren Model LPRX-4X30 (100dB Attenuation, 14kHz-18GHz) and the two EMI/RFI filters are ETS Lindgren Model LRW-2030-S1 (100dB Minimum Insertion Loss, 14kHz – 10GHz). These filters attenuate ambient signal noise from entering the measurement lines. These filters are also bonded to the shielded enclosure.

The EUT is powered from one LISN and the support equipment is powered from the second LISN. If the EUT is a DC-powered device, power will be derived from the source power supply it normally will be powered from and this supply line(s) will be connected to the second LISN. All interconnecting cables more than 1 meter were shortened to a 1 meter length by non-inductive bundling (serpentine fashion) and draped over the back edge of the test table. All cables were at least 40cm above the horizontal reference groundplane. Power cables for support equipment were routed down to the second LISN while ensuring that that cables were not draped over the second LISN.

Sufficient time for the EUT, support equipment, and test equipment was allowed in order for them to warm up to their normal operating condition. The RF output of the LISN was connected to the spectrum analyzer and exploratory measurements were made to determine the frequencies producing the maximum emission from the EUT. The spectrum was scanned from 150kHz to 30MHz with a spectrum analyzer. The detector function was set to peak mode for exploratory measurements while the bandwidth of the analyzer was set to 10kHz. The EUT, support equipment, and interconnecting cables were arranged and manipulated to maximize each emission. Each emission was also maximized by varying: power lines, the mode of operation or resolution, clock or data exchange speed, scrolling H pattern to the EUT and/or support equipment whichever determined the worst-case emission. Once the worst case emissions have been identified, the one EUT cable configuration/arrangement and mode of operation that produced these emissions is used for final measurements on the same test site. The analyzer is set to CISPR quasi-peak and average detectors with a 9kHz resolution bandwidth for final measurements.

Line conducted emissions test results are shown in Section 6.10. Automated test software was used to perform the AC line conducted emissions testing. Automated measurement software utilized is Rohde & Schwarz EMC32, Version 8.51.0.

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3.3 Radiated Emissions

The radiated test facilities consisted of an indoor 3 meter semi-anechoic chamber used for final measurements and exploratory measurements, when necessary. The measurement area is contained within the semi-anechoic chamber which is shielded from any ambient interference. For measurements above 1GHz absorbers are arranged on the floor between the turn table and the antenna mast in such a way so as to maximize the reduction of reflections. For measurements below 1GHz, the absorbers are removed. An ETS Lindgren Model 2188 raised turntable is used for radiated measurement. It is a continuously rotatable, remote-controlled, metallic turntable and 2 meters (6.56 ft.) in diameter. The turn table is flush with the raised floor of the chamber in order to maintain its function as a ground plane. A 78cm high PVC support structure is placed on top of the turntable. A ¾" (~1.9cm) sheet of high density polyethylene is used as the table top and is placed on top of the PVC supports to bring the total height of the table to 80cm.

For all measurements, the spectrum was scanned through all EUT azimuths and from 1 to 4 meter receive antenna height using a broadband antenna from 30MHz up to the upper frequency shown in 15.33(b)(1) depending on the highest frequency generated or used in the device or on which the device operates or tunes. For frequencies above 1GHz, linearly polarized double ridge horn antennas were used. For frequencies below 30MHz, a calibrated loop antenna was used. When exploratory measurements were necessary, they were performed at 1 meter test distance inside the semi-anechoic chamber using broadband antennas, broadband amplifiers, and spectrum analyzers to determine the frequencies and modes producing the maximum emissions. Sufficient time for the EUT, support equipment, and test equipment was allowed in order for them to warm up to their normal operating condition. The test set-up was placed on top of the 0.8 meter high, 1 x 1.5 meter table. The EUT, support equipment, and interconnecting cables were arranged and manipulated to maximize each emission. Appropriate precaution was taken to ensure that all emissions from the EUT were maximized and investigated. The system configuration, clock speed, mode of operation or video resolution, if applicable, turntable azimuth, and receive antenna height was noted for each frequency found.

Final measurements were made in the semi-anechoic chamber using calibrated, linearly polarized broadband and horn antennas. The test setup was configured to the setup that produced the worst case emissions. The spectrum analyzer was set to investigate all frequencies required for testing to compare the highest radiated disturbances with respect to the specified limits. The turntable containing the EUT was rotated through 360 degrees and the height of the receive antenna was varied 1 to 4 meters and stopped at the azimuth and height producing the maximum emission. Each emission was maximized by changing the orientation of the EUT through three orthogonal planes and changing the polarity of the receive antenna, whichever produced the worst-case emissions. For the EUT positioning, "H" is defined with the EUT lying flat on the test surface, "H2" is defined with the EUT standing up on its side, and "V" is defined with the EUT standing upright.

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4.0 ANTENNA REQUIREMENTS

Excerpt from §15.203 of the FCC Rules/Regulations:

“An intentional radiator antenna shall be designed to ensure that no antenna other than that furnished by the responsible party can be used with the device. The use of a permanently attached antenna or of an antenna that uses a unique coupling to the intentional radiator shall be considered sufficient to comply with the provisions of this section.”

- The antennas of the Portable Handset are **permanently attached**.
- There are no provisions for connection to an external antenna.

Conclusion:

The **LG Portable Handset FCC ID: ZNFLS885** unit complies with the requirement of §15.203.

Notes:

- 1) All channels, modes, and modulations/data rates were investigated among all UNII bands. The test results shown in the following sections represent the worst case emissions.
- 2) The analyzer plots shown in this section were all taken with a correction table loaded into the analyzer. The correction table was used to account for the losses of the cables and attenuators used as part of the system to connect the EUT to the analyzer at all frequencies of interest.
- 3) All antenna port conducted emissions testing was performed on a test bench with the antenna port of the EUT connected to the spectrum analyzer through calibrated cables and attenuators.
- 4) For conducted spurious emissions, automated test software was used to measure emissions and capture the corresponding plots necessary to show compliance. The measurement software utilized is PCTEST "UNII Automation", Version 2.7.

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6.2 26dB Bandwidth Measurement – 802.11a/n

Test Overview and Limit

The bandwidth at 26dB down from the highest in-band spectral density is measured with a spectrum analyzer connected to the antenna terminal while the EUT is operating at its maximum duty cycle, at its maximum power control level, as defined in KDB 789033 v01r03, and at the appropriate frequencies. The spectrum analyzer's bandwidth measurement function is configured to measure the 26dB bandwidth. An offset was added for emissions transmitting below 98% duty cycle.

The 26dB bandwidth is used to determine the conducted power limits.

Test Procedure Used

KDB 789033 v01r03 – Section C

Test Settings

1. The signal analyzers' automatic bandwidth measurement capability was used to perform the 26dB bandwidth measurement. The "X" dB bandwidth parameter was set to $X = 26$. The automatic bandwidth measurement function also has the capability of simultaneously measuring the 99% occupied bandwidth. The bandwidth measurement was not influenced by any intermediate power nulls in the fundamental emission.
2. RBW = approximately 1% of the emission bandwidth
3. $VBW \geq 3 \times RBW$
4. Detector = Peak
5. Trace mode = max hold

The EUT and measurement equipment were set up as shown in the diagram below.

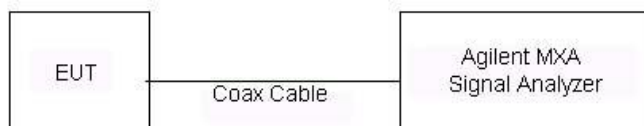


Figure 6-1. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup

Test Notes

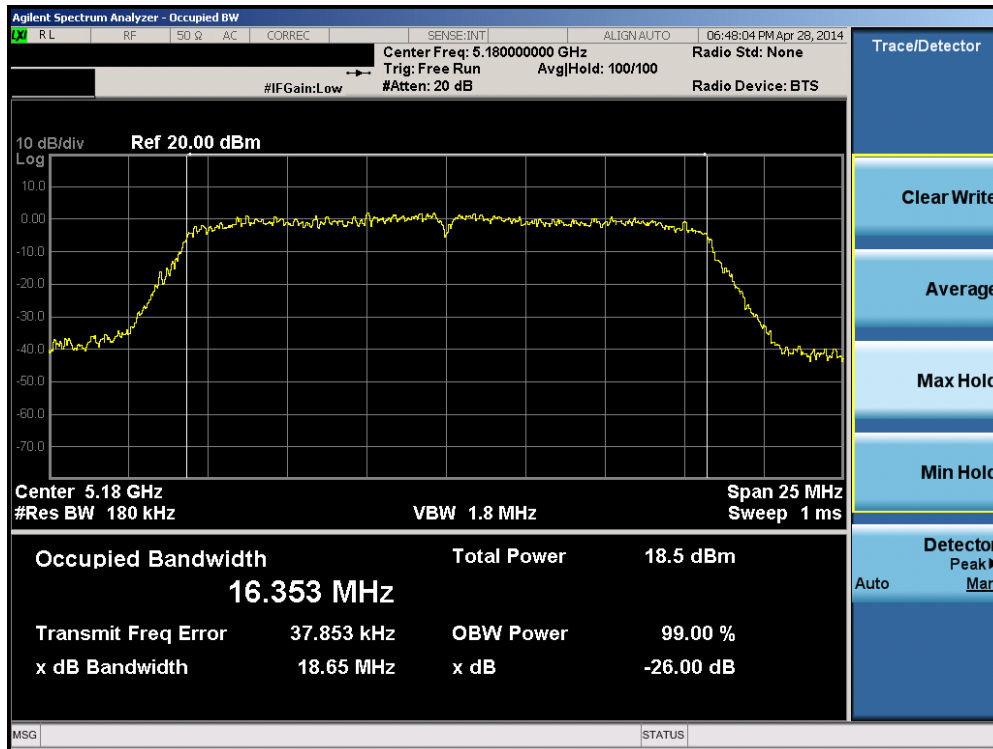
Per KDB 644545 v01r01 and 15.215(c), a 20dB bandwidth measurement can be performed to demonstrate that the entire emission of one channel lies solely within a particular band. 20dB bandwidth plots are included at the end of this section to show that the DFS requirements are not applicable in UNII Band 1 since the Band 1 channel does not cross over into Band 2A. Another 20dB bandwidth plot is also included to show that no emissions are present within the 5600 – 5650MHz TDWR band.

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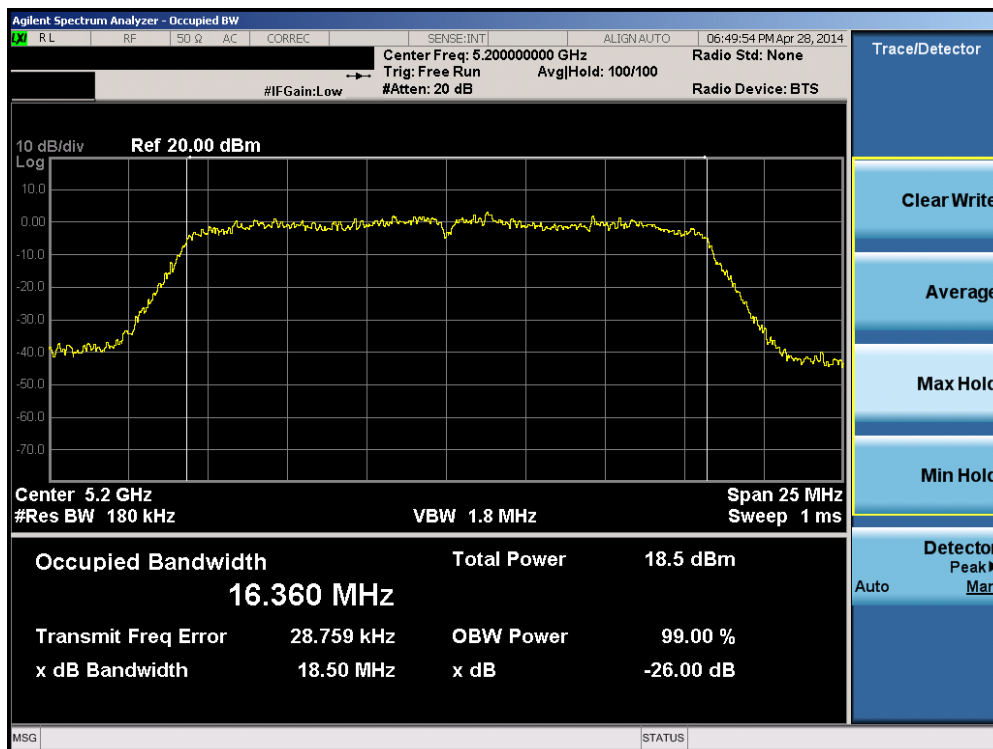

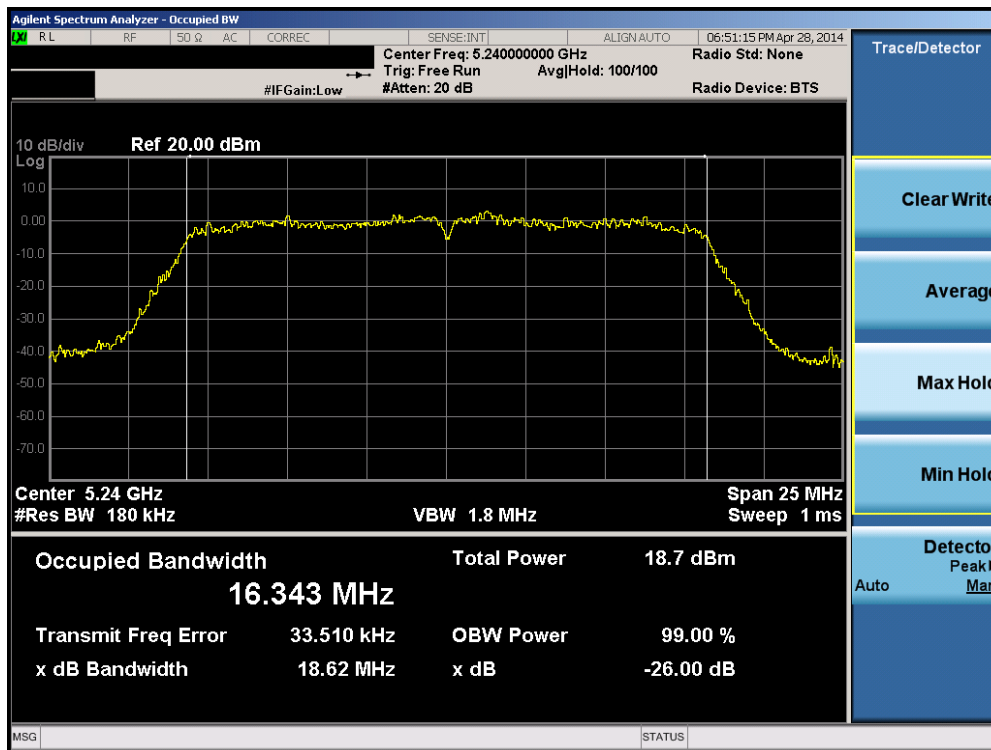


Plot 6-1. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 36)

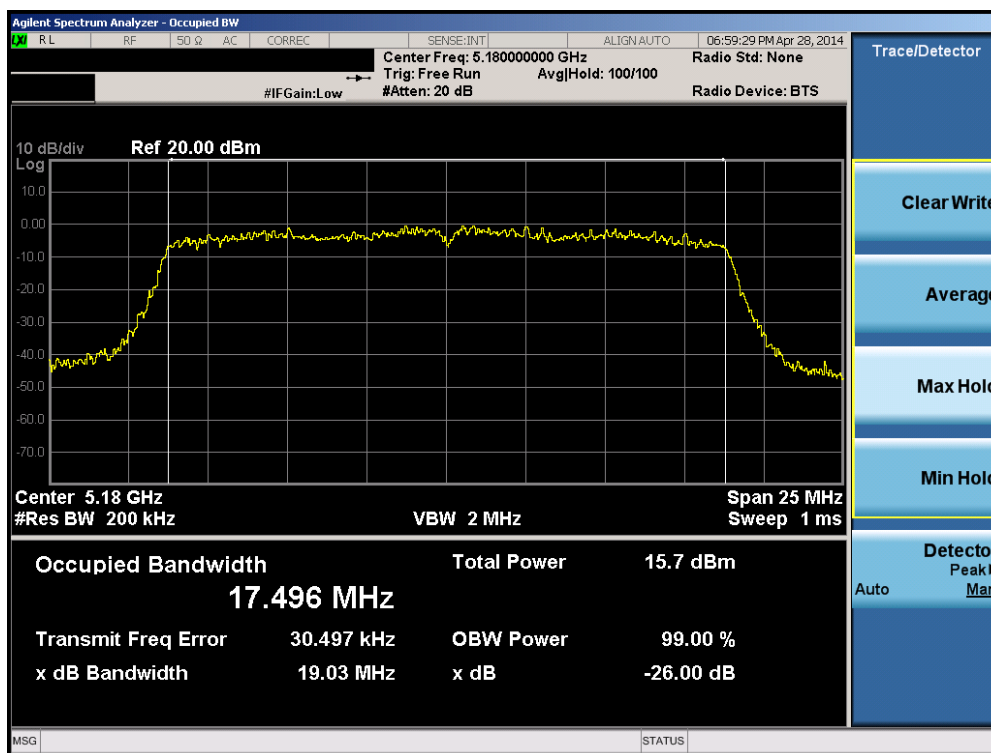


Plot 6-2. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 40)

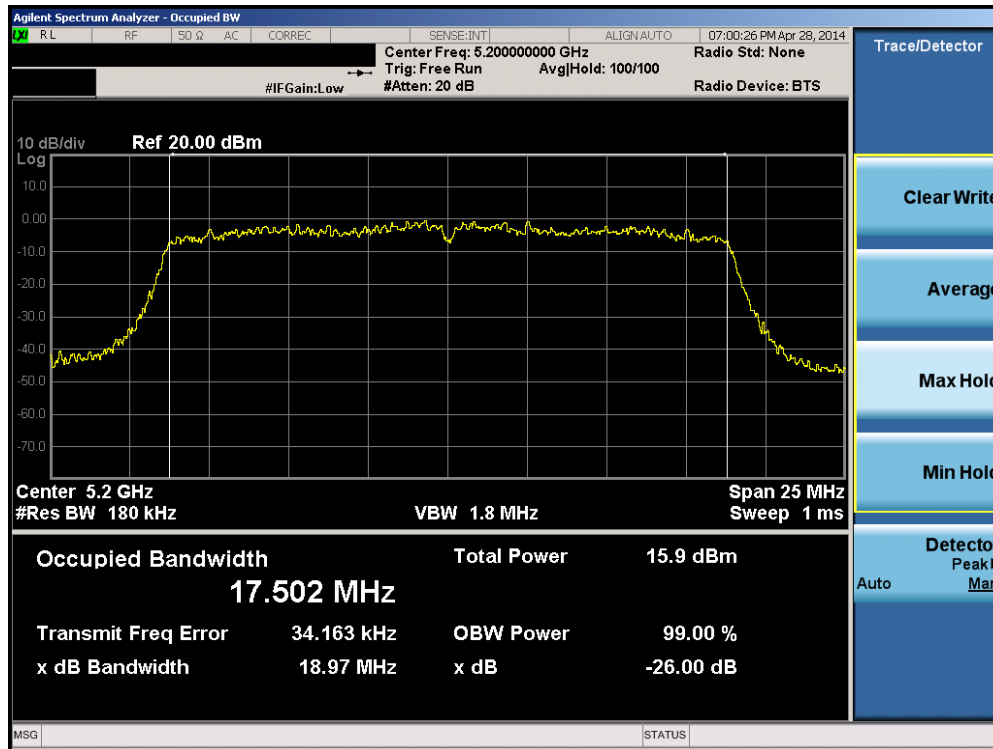


Plot 6-3. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 48)

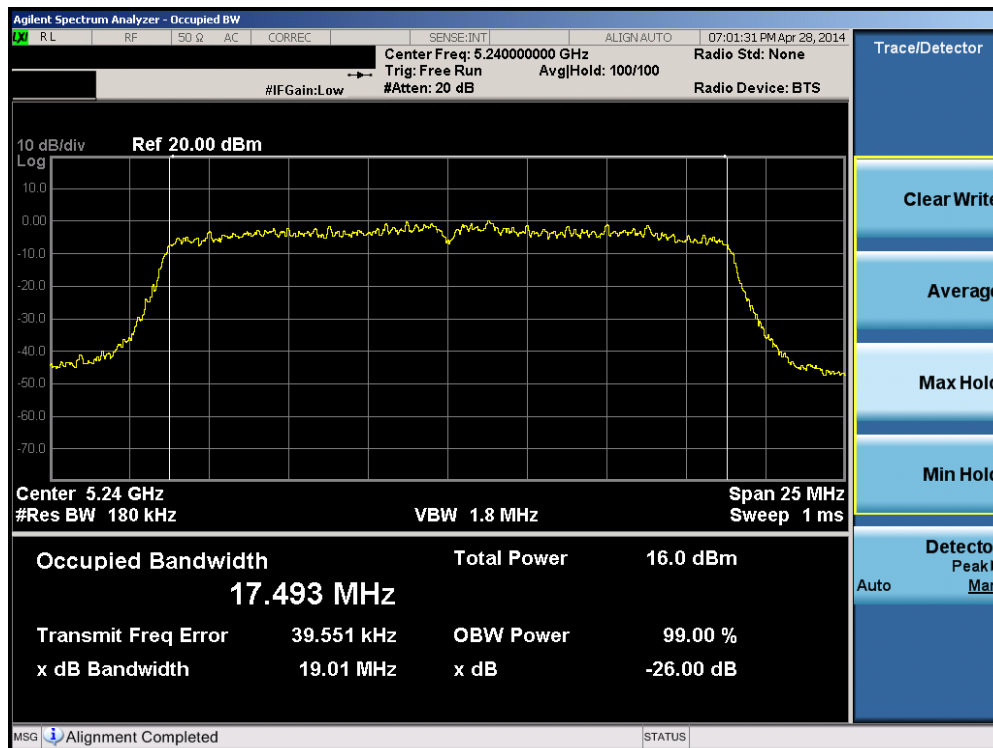


Plot 6-4. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 36)

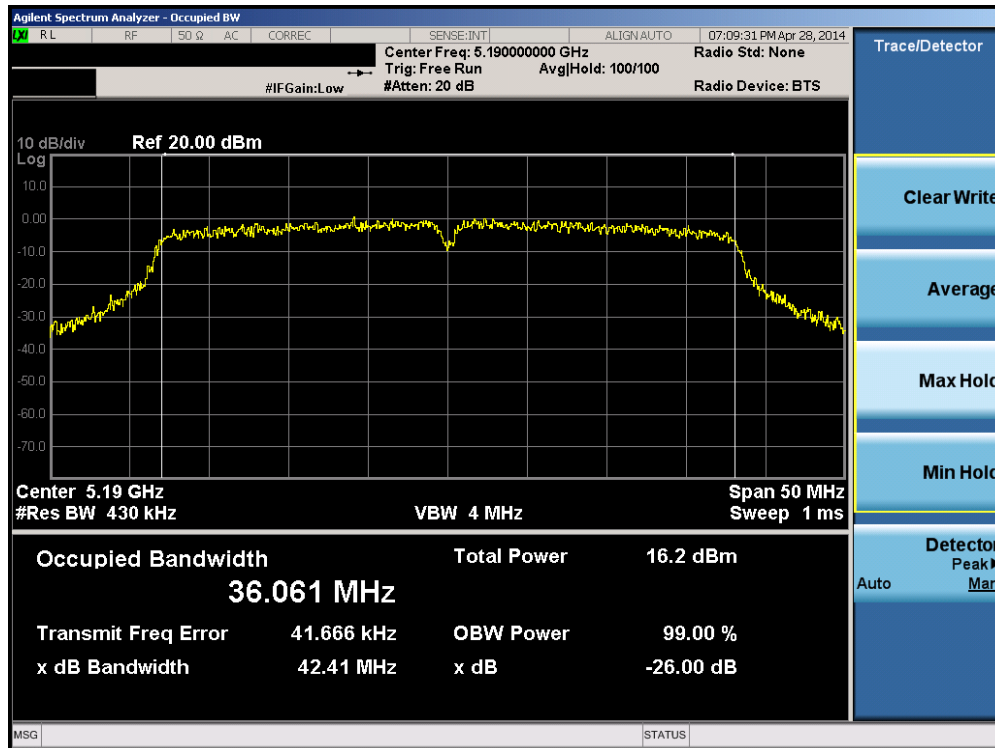


Plot 6-5. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 40)

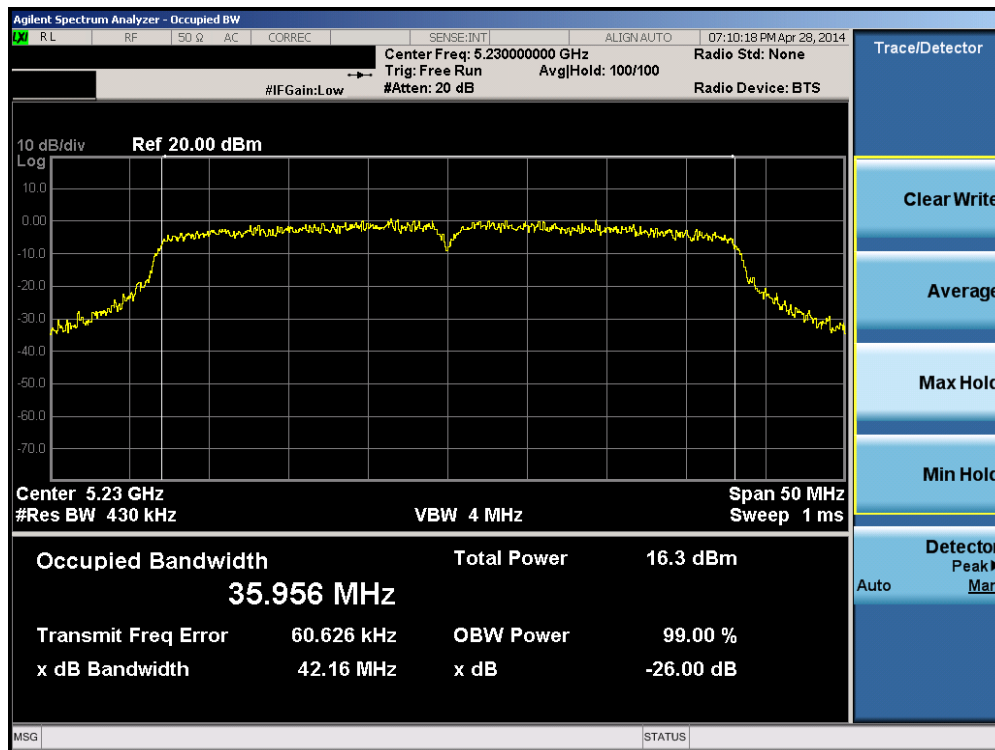


Plot 6-6. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 48)

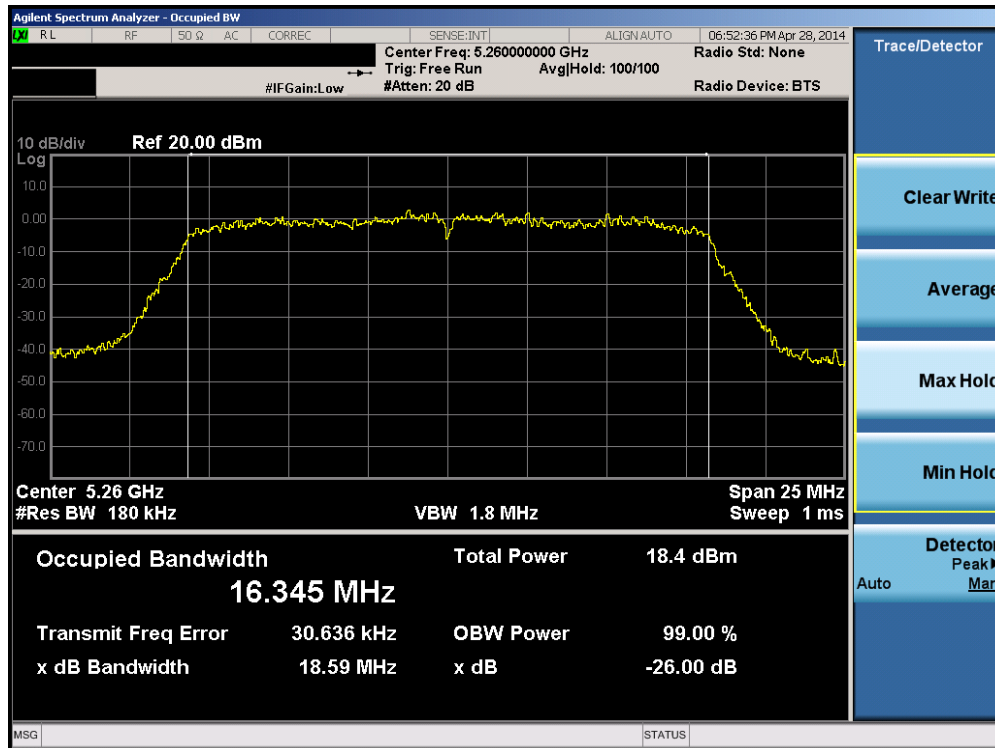


Plot 6-7. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 38)

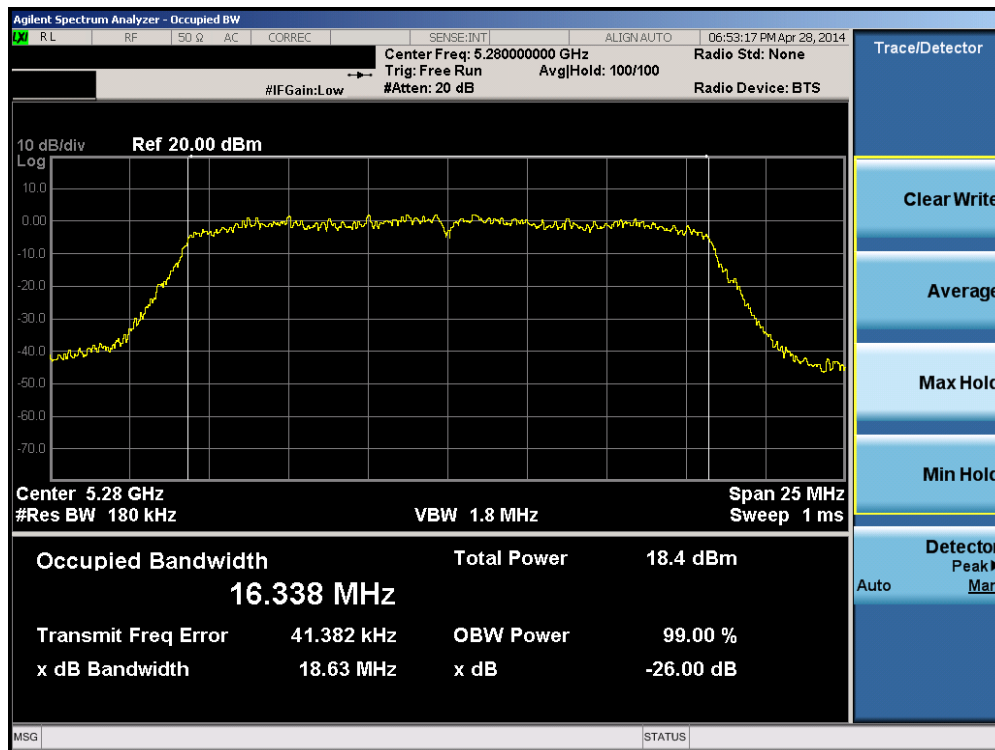


Plot 6-8. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 46)

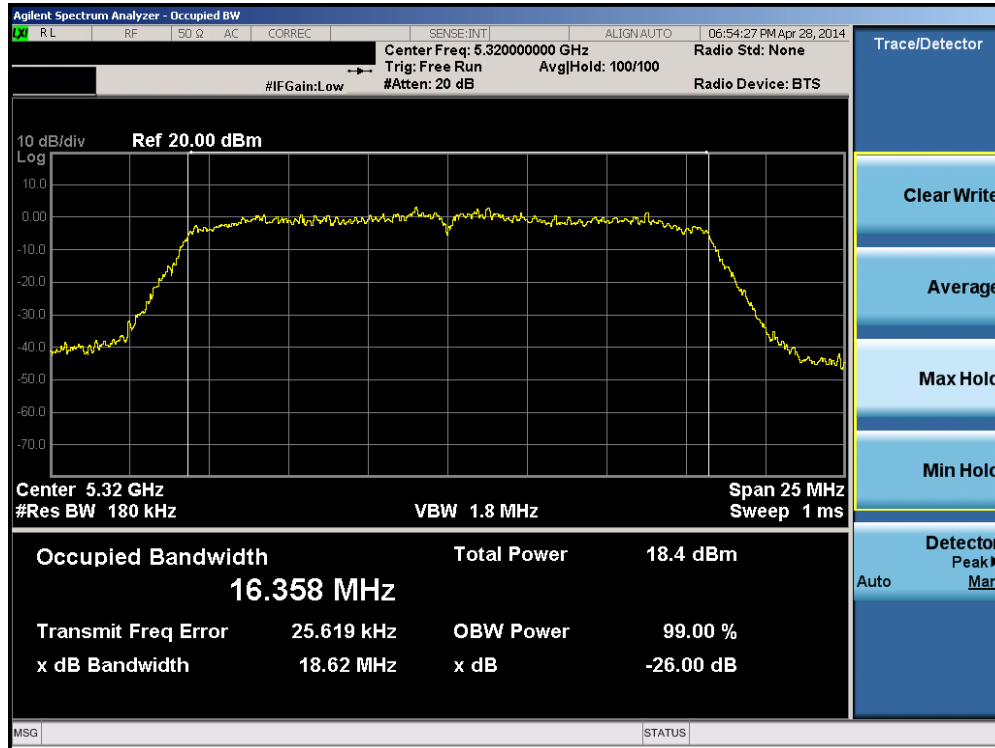


Plot 6-9. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 52)

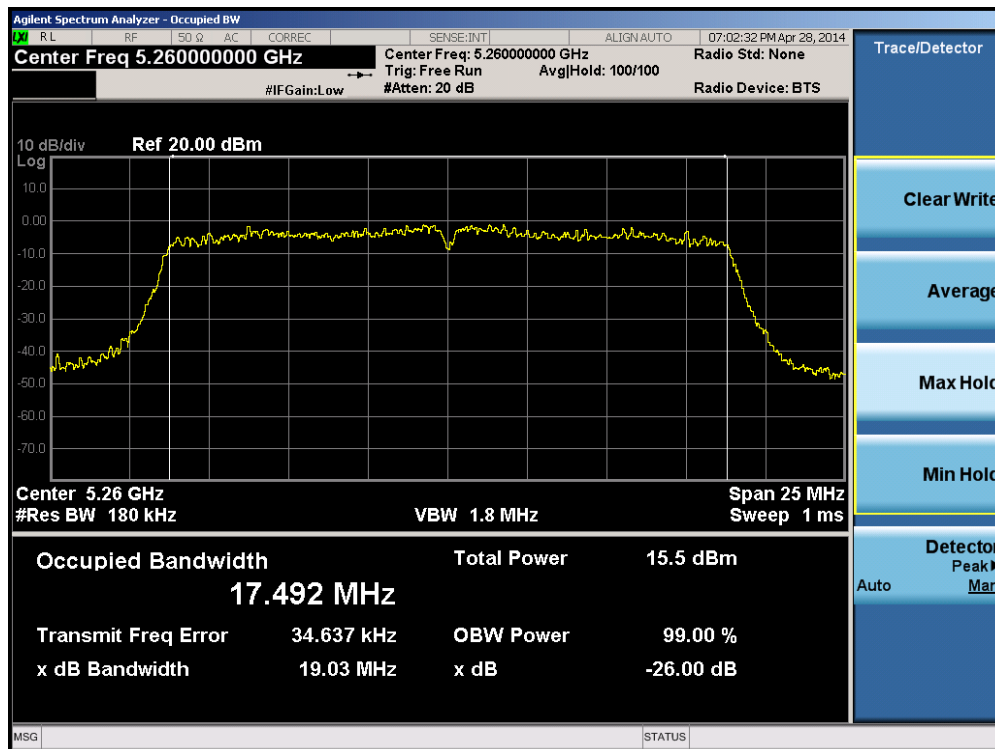


Plot 6-10. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 56)

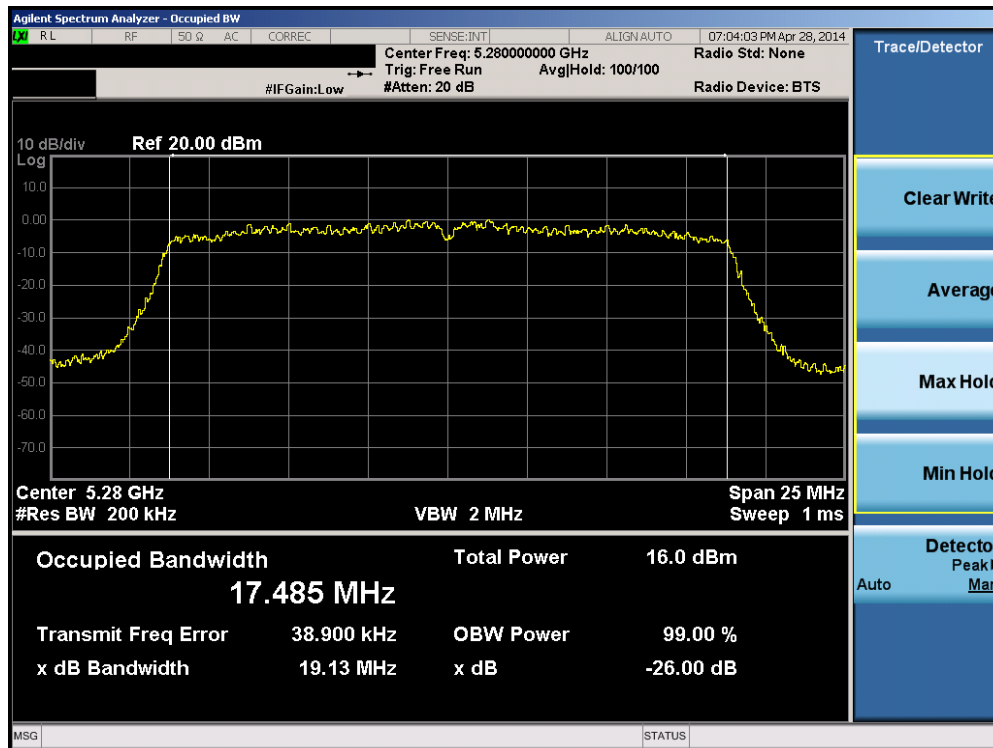


Plot 6-11. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 64)

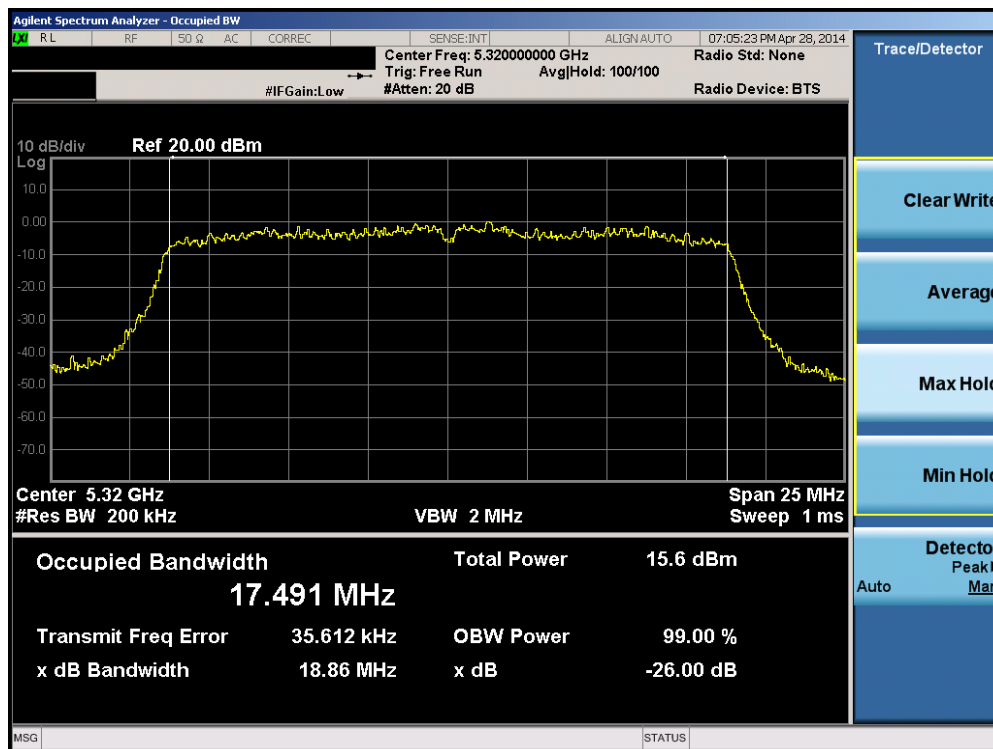


Plot 6-12. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 52)

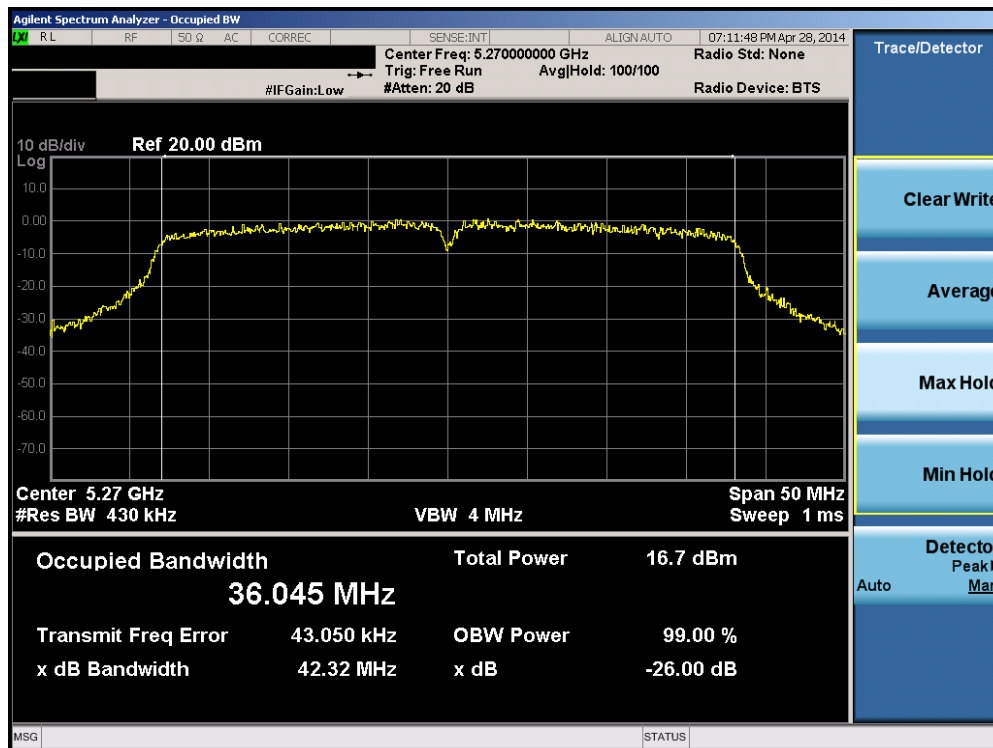


Plot 6-13. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 56)

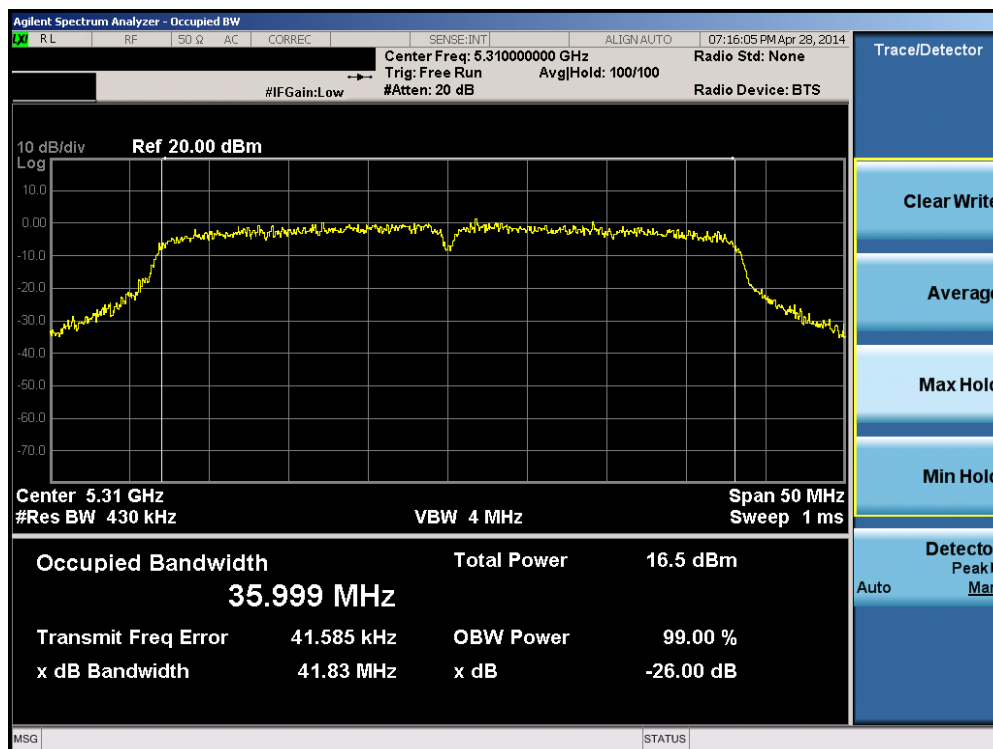


Plot 6-14. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 64)

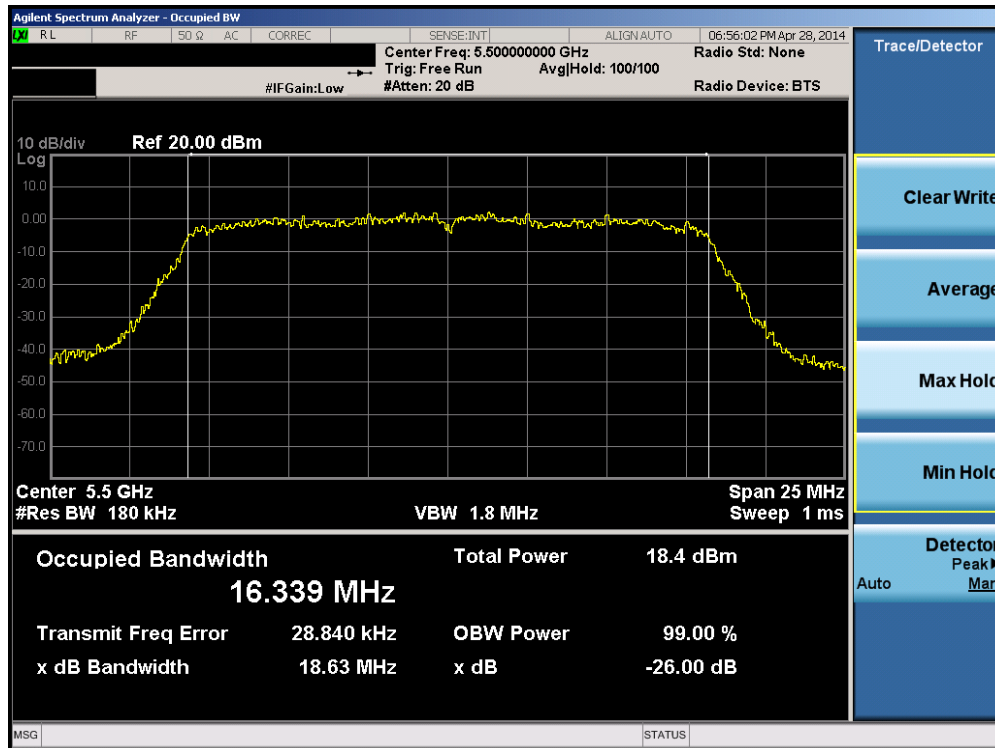


Plot 6-15. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 54)

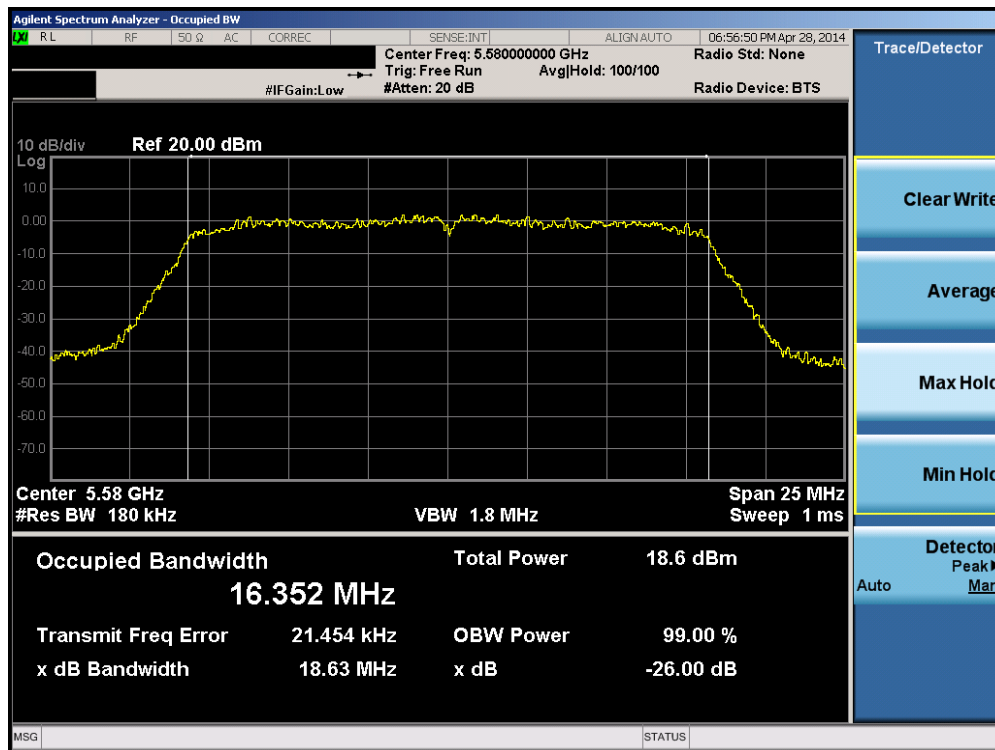


Plot 6-16. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 62)

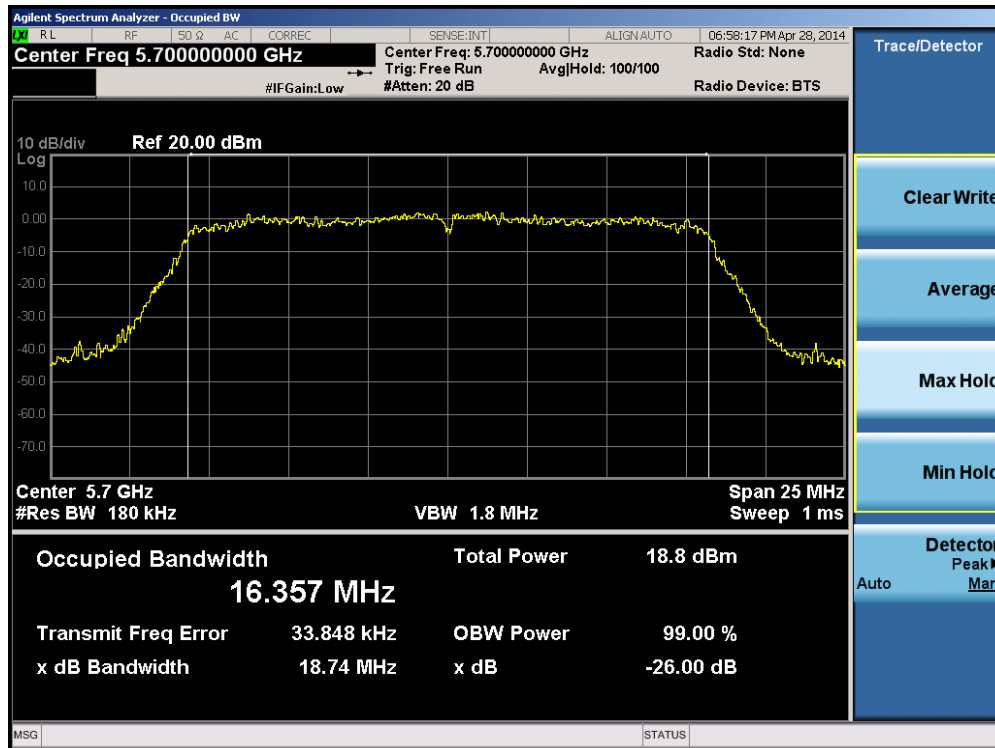


Plot 6-17. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 100)

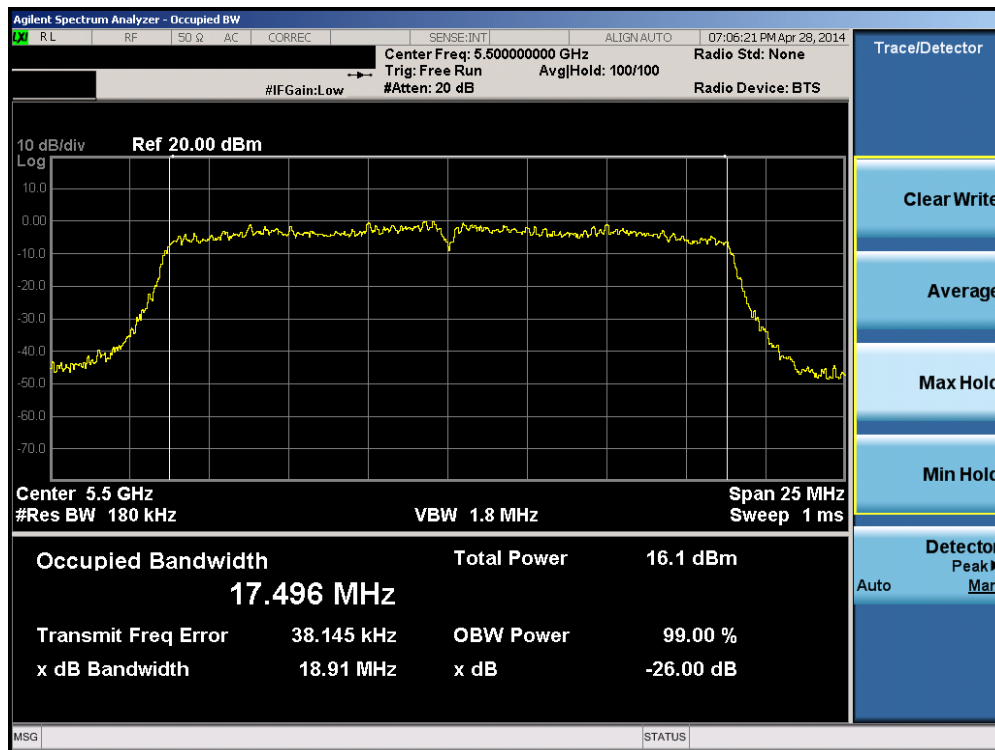


Plot 6-18. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 116)

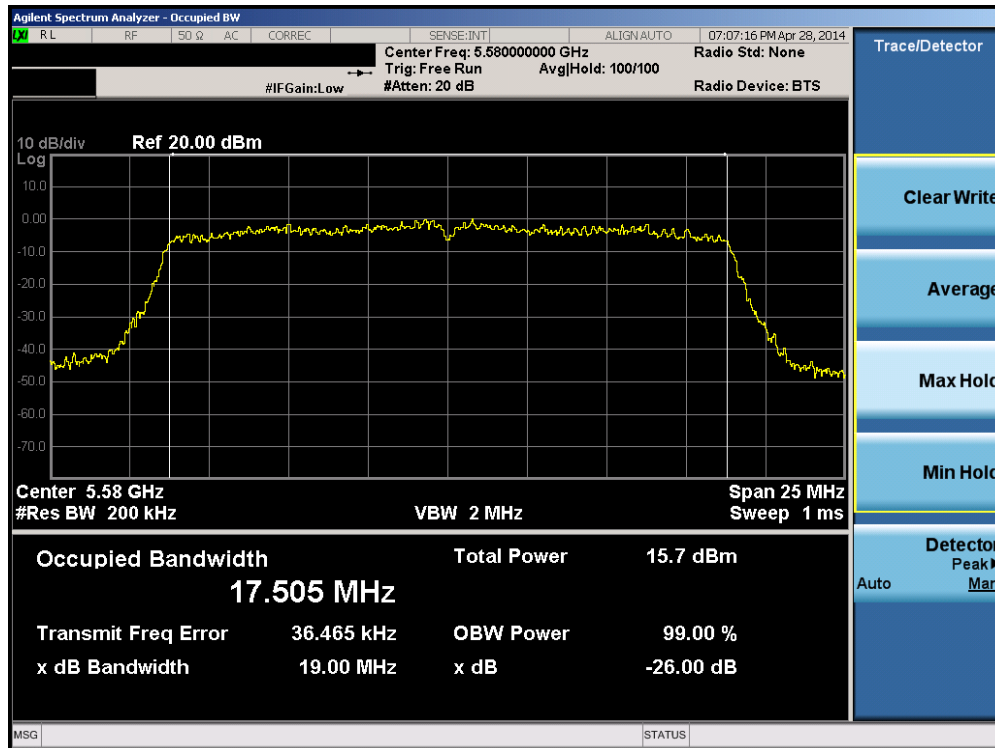


Plot 6-19. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 140)

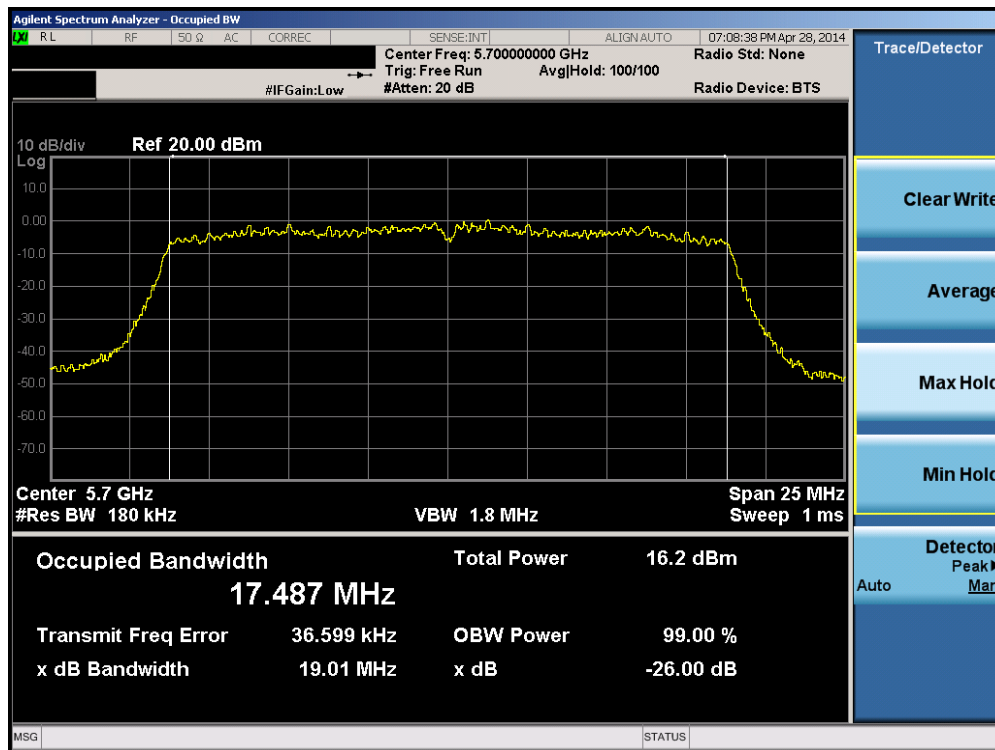


Plot 6-20. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 100)

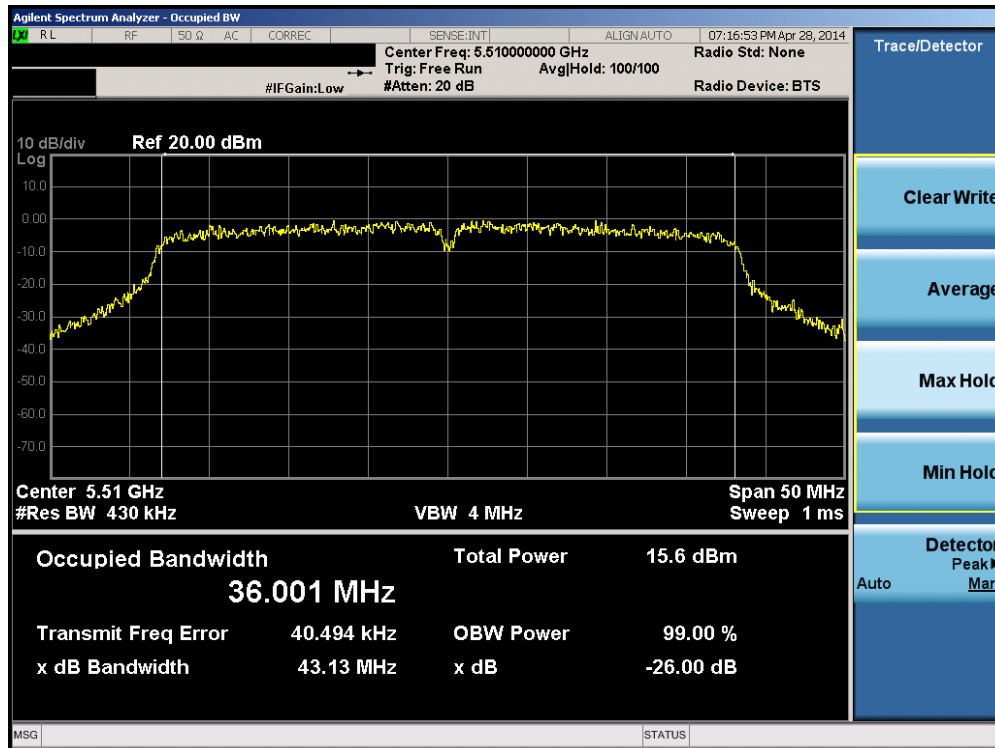


Plot 6-21. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 116)

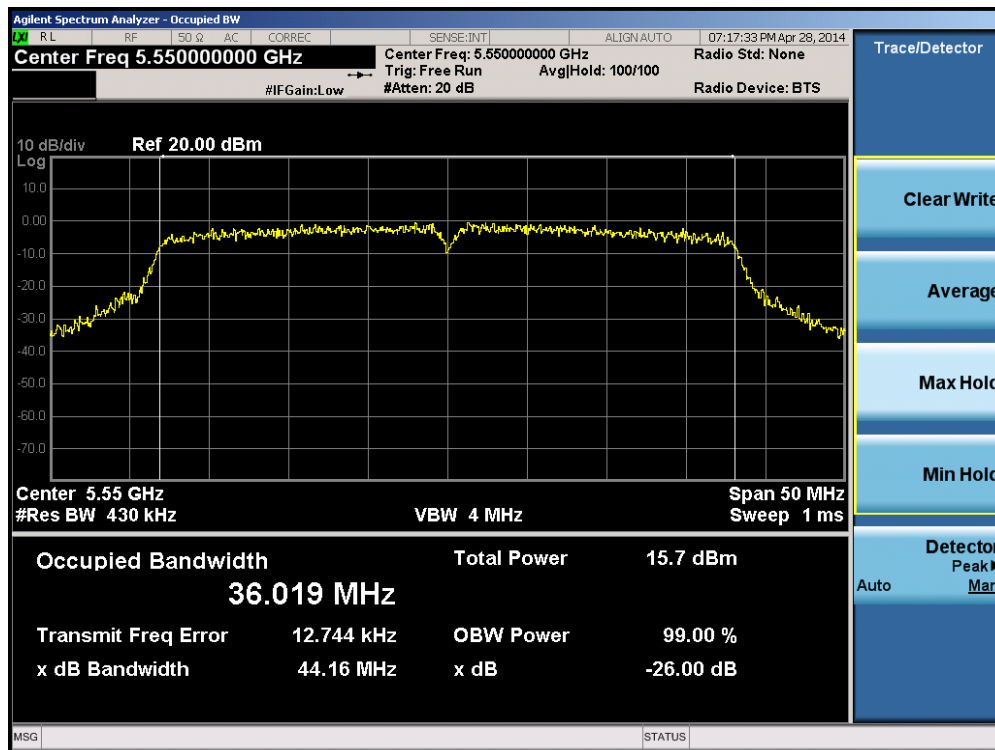


Plot 6-22. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 140)

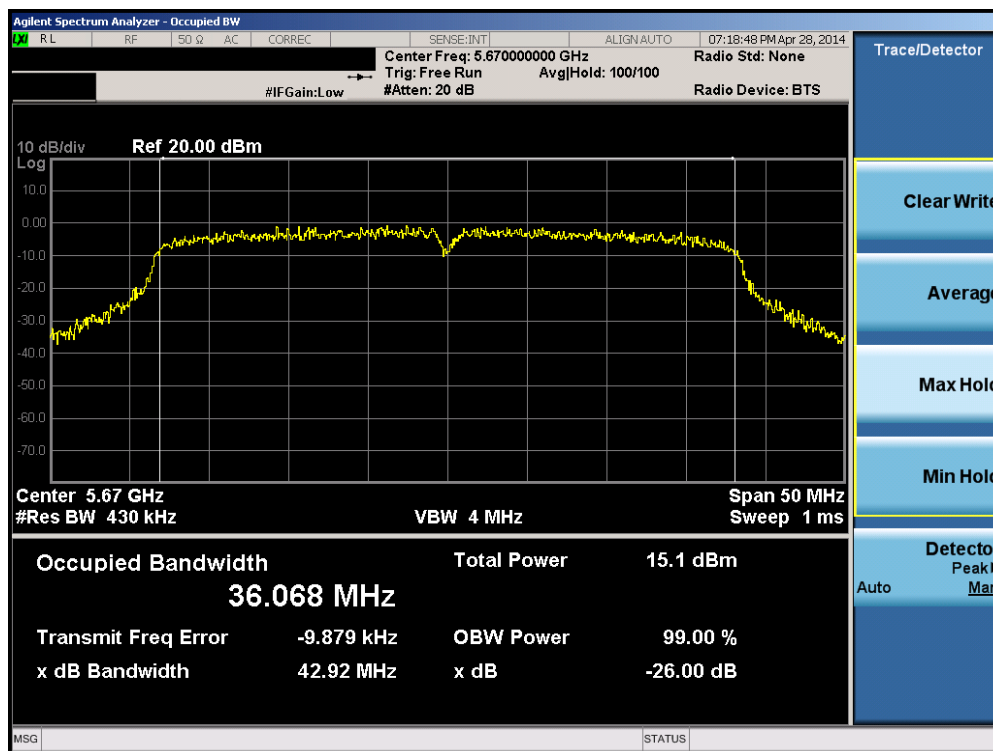


Plot 6-23. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 102)

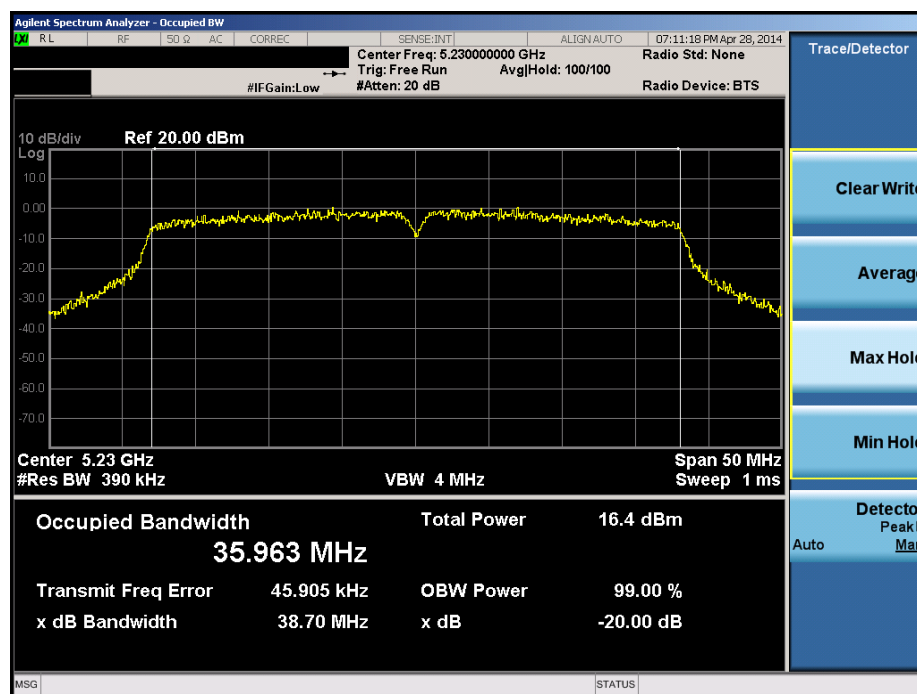


Plot 6-24. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 110)

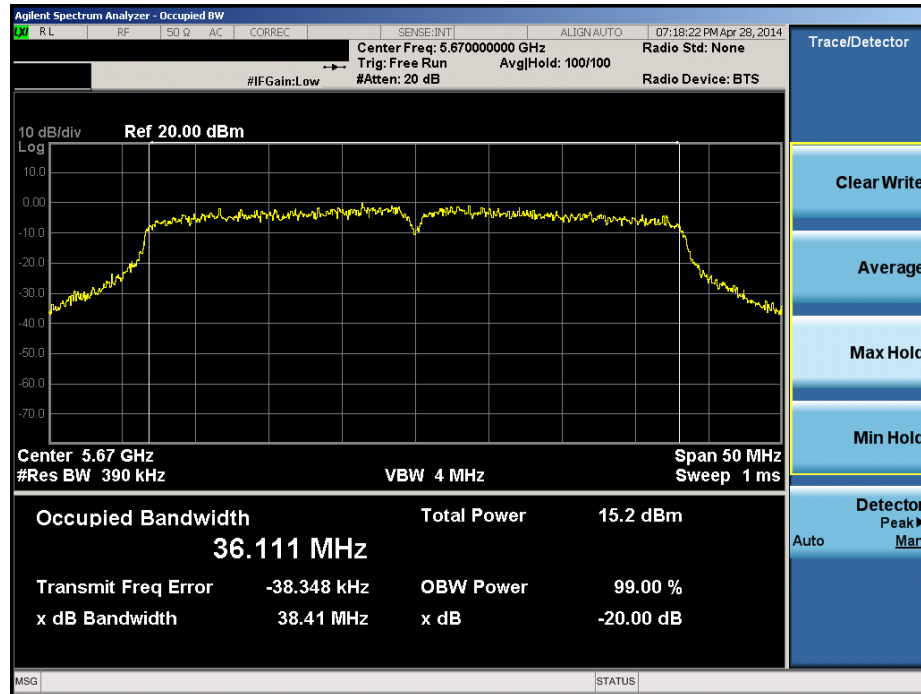
Plot 6-25. 26dB Bandwidth Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 134)

6.3 UNII Output Power Measurement – 802.11a/n §15.407 (a.1)

Test Overview and Limits

A transmitter antenna terminal of the EUT is connected to the input of an RF pulse power sensor. Measurement is made using a broadband average power meter while the EUT is operating at its maximum duty cycle, at its maximum power control level, as defined in KDB 789033 v01r03, and at the appropriate frequencies.

In the 5.15 – 5.25GHz band, the maximum permissible conducted output power is the lesser of 50mW (16.99dBm) and $4 \text{ dBm} + 10\log_{10}(26\text{dB BW}) = 4 \text{ dBm} + 10\log_{10}(18.50) = 16.67\text{dBm}$.

In the 5.25 – 5.35GHz band, the maximum permissible conducted output power is the lesser of 250mW (23.98dBm) and $11 \text{ dBm} + 10\log_{10}(26\text{dB BW}) = 11 \text{ dBm} + 10\log_{10}(18.59) = 16.69\text{dBm}$.

In the 5.47 – 5.725GHz band, the maximum permissible conducted output power is the lesser of 250mW (23.98dBm) and $11 \text{ dBm} + 10\log_{10}(26\text{dB BW}) = 11 \text{ dBm} + 10\log_{10}(18.63) = 16.70\text{dBm}$.

Test Settings

Average power measurements were performed only when the EUT was transmitting at its maximum power control level using a broadband power meter with a pulse sensor. The power meter implemented triggering and gating capabilities which were set up such that power measurements were recorded only during the ON time of the transmitter. The trace was averaged over 100 traces to obtain the final measured average power.

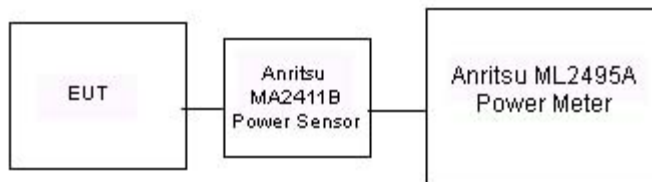


Figure 6-2. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup

6.4 Peak Power Spectral Density – 802.11a/n §15.407(a.1)(2.5)

Test Overview and Limit

The spectrum analyzer was connected to the antenna terminal while the EUT was operating at its maximum power control level, as defined in KDB 789033 v01r03, and at the appropriate frequencies. Method SA-2, as defined in KDB 789033 v01r03, was used to measure the power spectral density. An offset was added for emissions transmitting below 98% duty cycle.

In the 5.15 – 5.25GHz band, the maximum permissible power spectral density is 4dBm/MHz.

In the 5.25 – 5.35GHz and the 5.47 – 5.725GHz bands, the maximum permissible power spectral density is 11dBm/MHz.

Test Procedure Used

KDB 789033 v01r03 – Section F

Test Settings

1. Analyzer was set to the center frequency of the UNII channel under investigation
2. Span was set to encompass the entire emission bandwidth of the signal
3. RBW = 1MHz
4. VBW = 3MHz
5. Number of sweep points $\geq 2 \times (\text{span}/\text{RBW})$
6. Sweep time = auto
7. Detector = power averaging (RMS)
8. Trigger was set to free run, and an offset was added for duty cycles <98%.
9. Trace was averaged over 100 sweeps
10. The peak search function of the spectrum analyzer was used to find the peak of the spectrum.

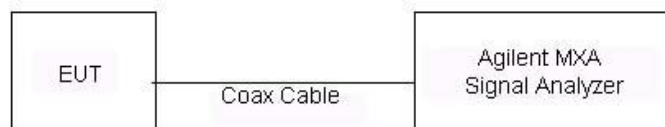


Figure 6-3. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup

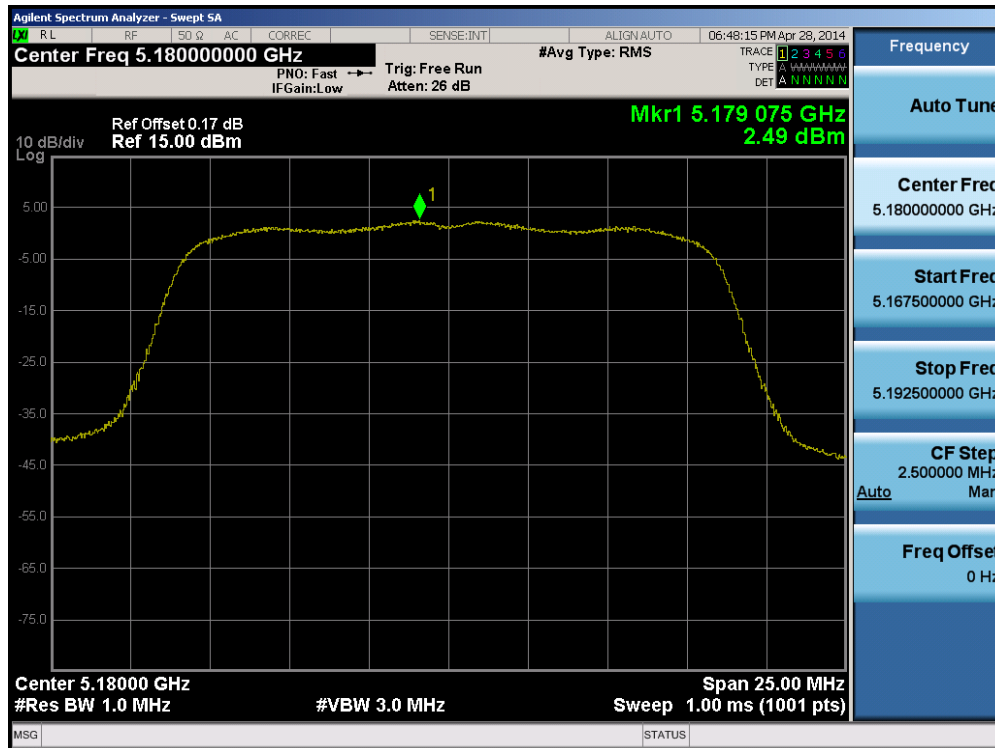

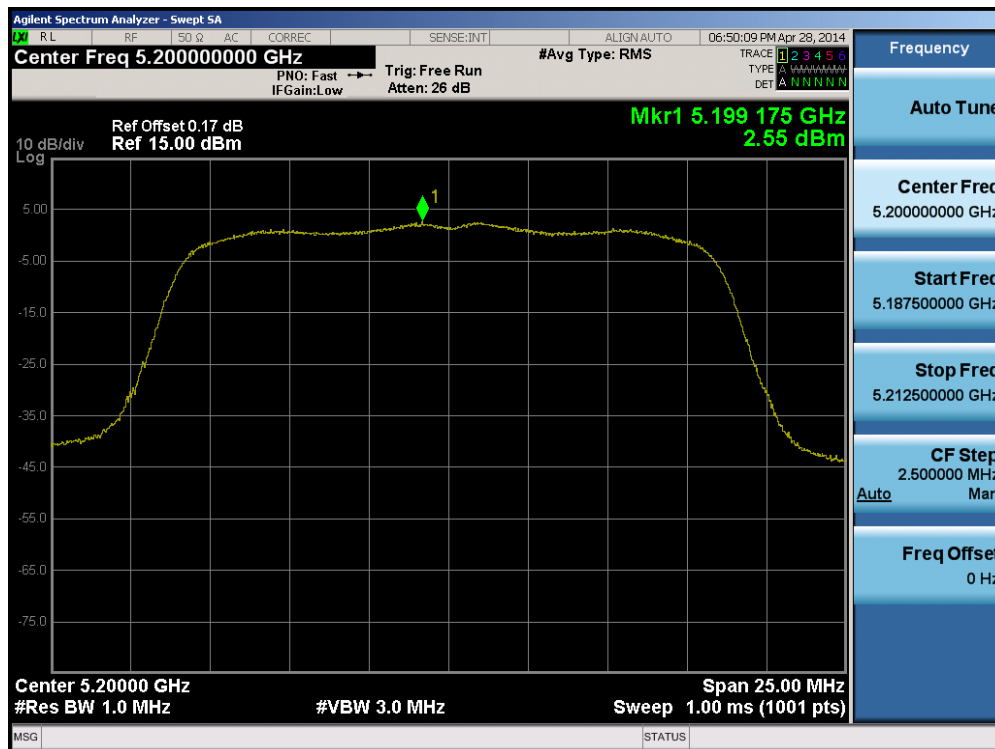

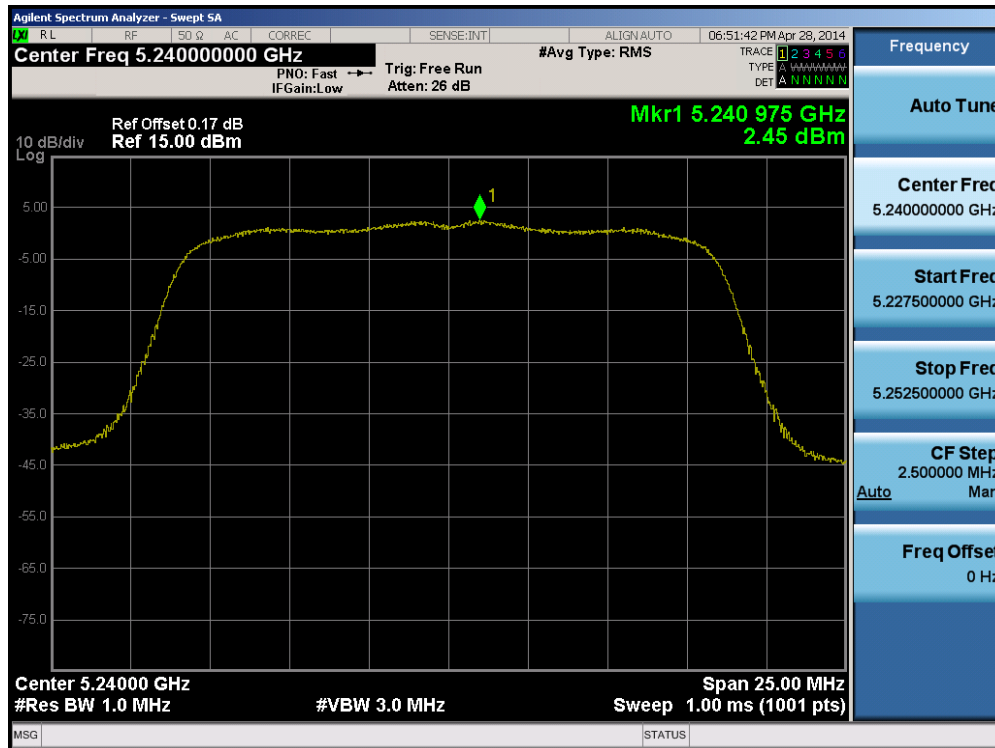


Plot 6-28. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 36)

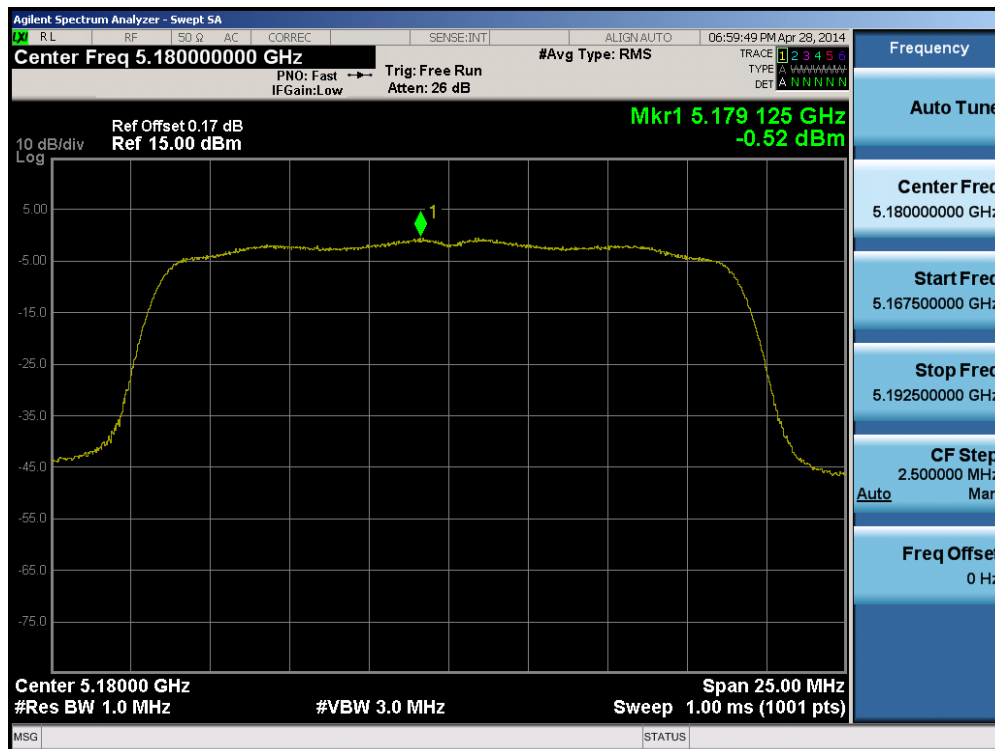


Plot 6-29. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 40)

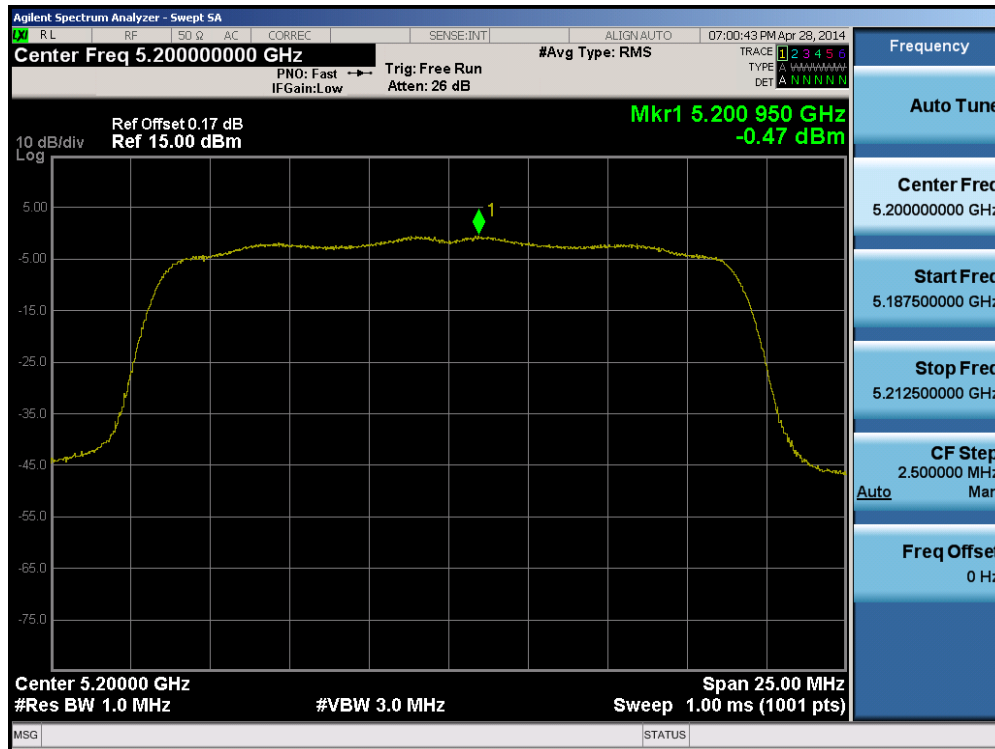


Plot 6-30. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 48)

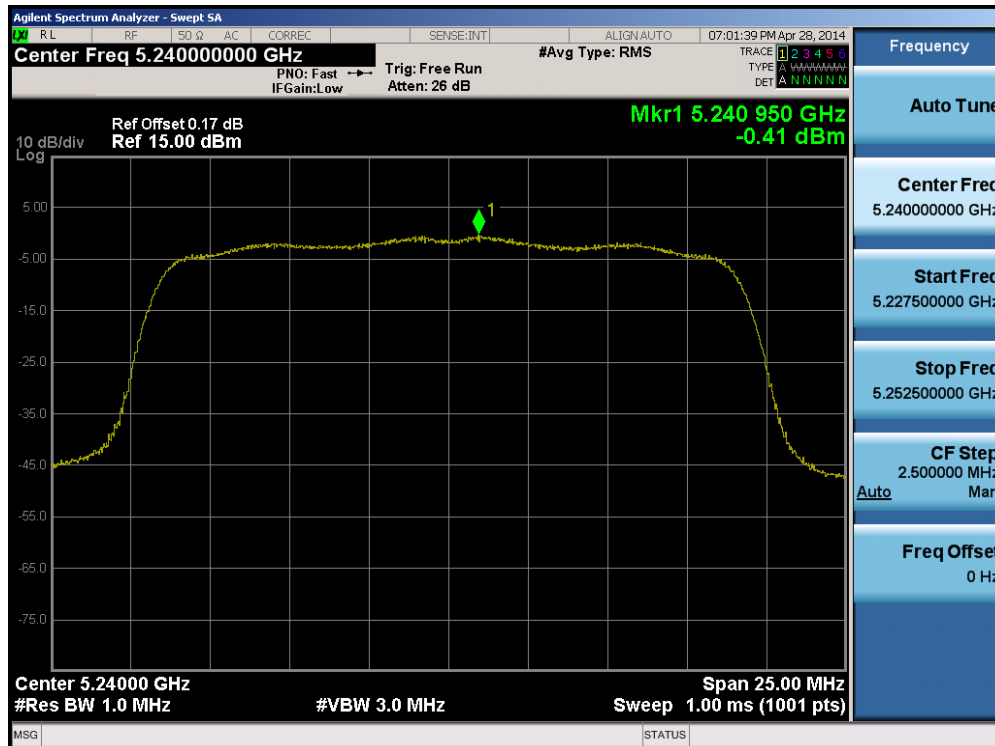


Plot 6-31. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 36)

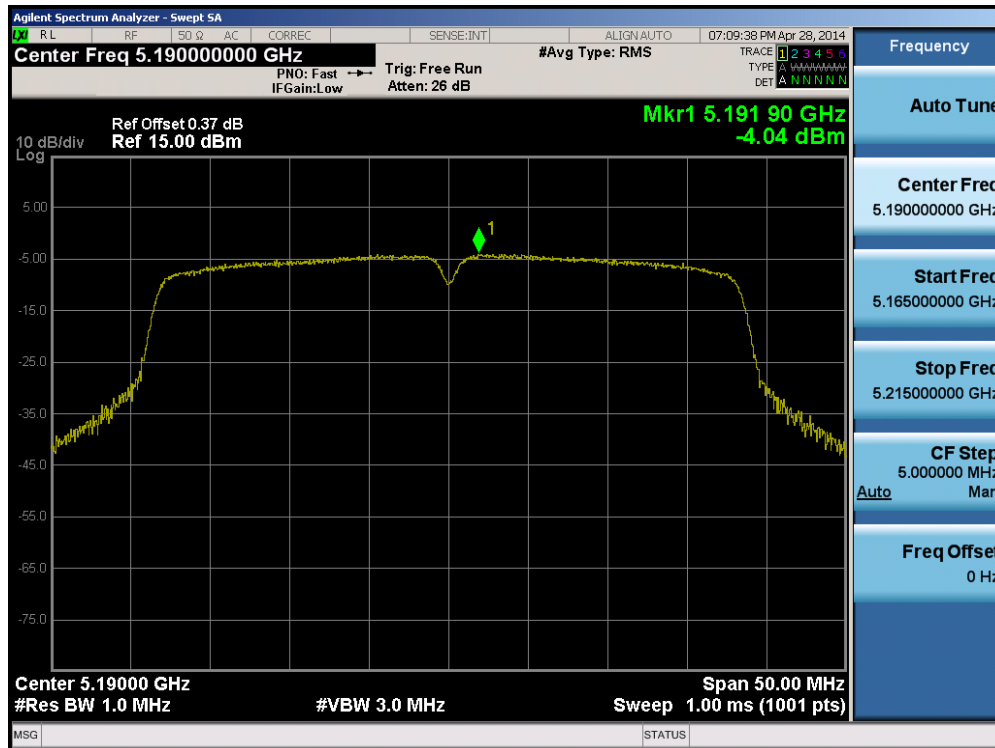


Plot 6-32. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 40)

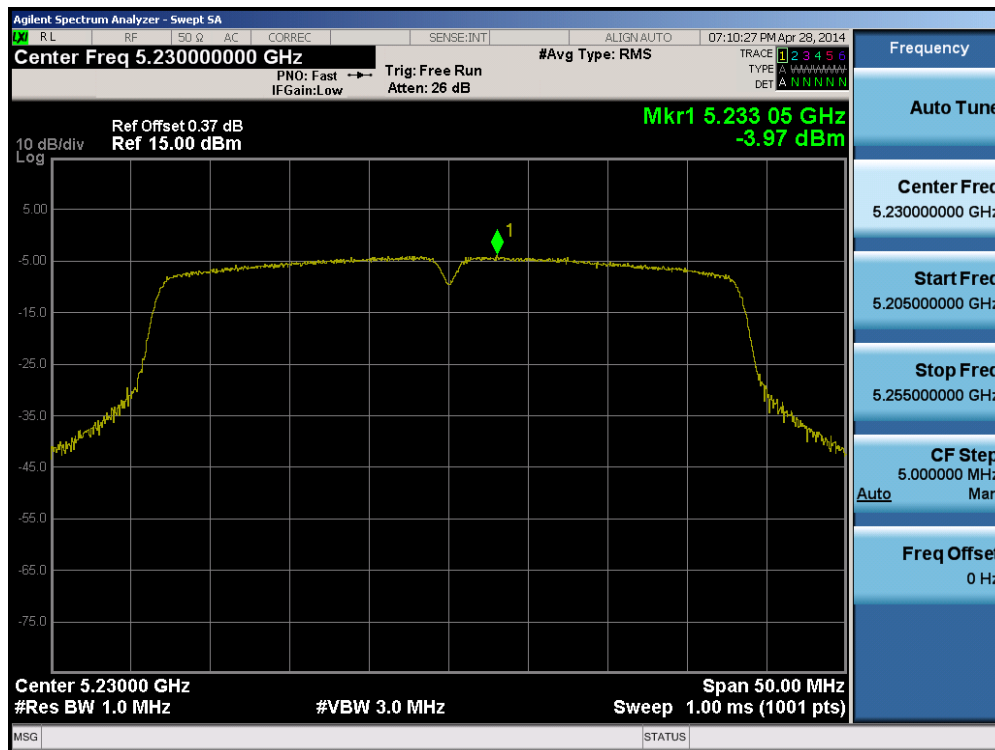


Plot 6-33. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 48)

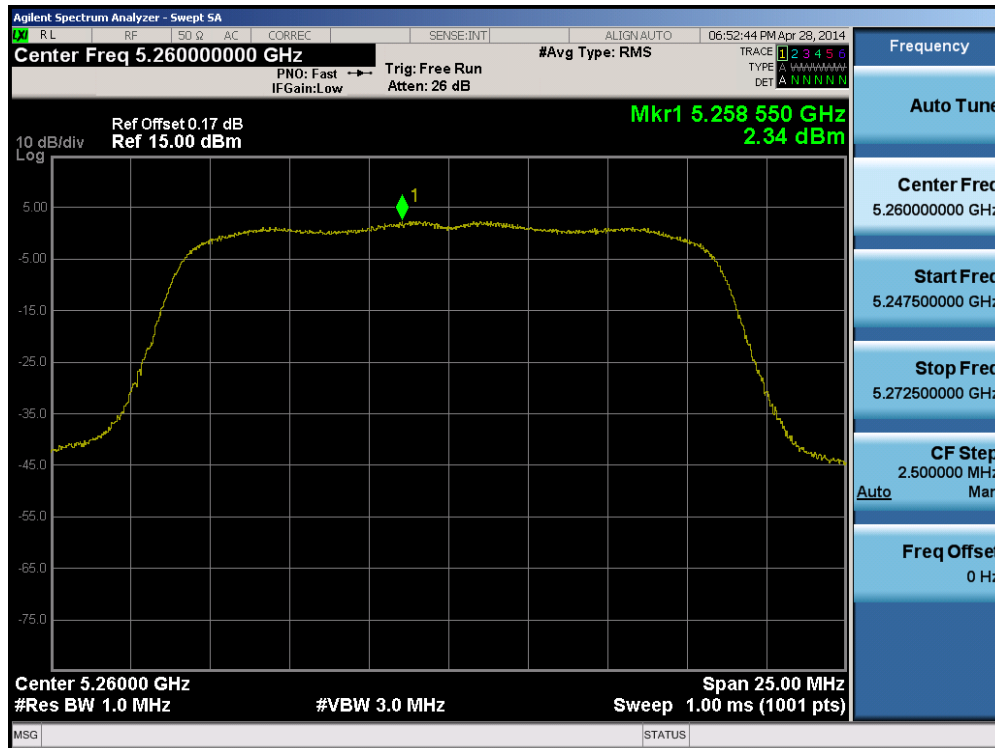


Plot 6-34. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 38)

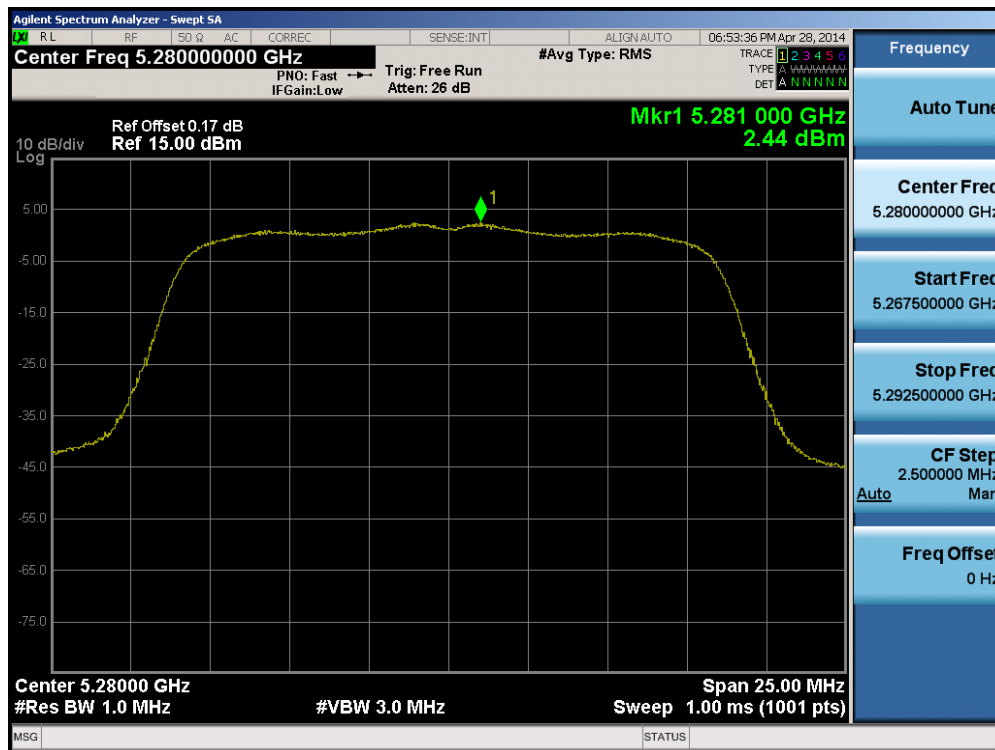


Plot 6-35. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 1) – Ch. 46)

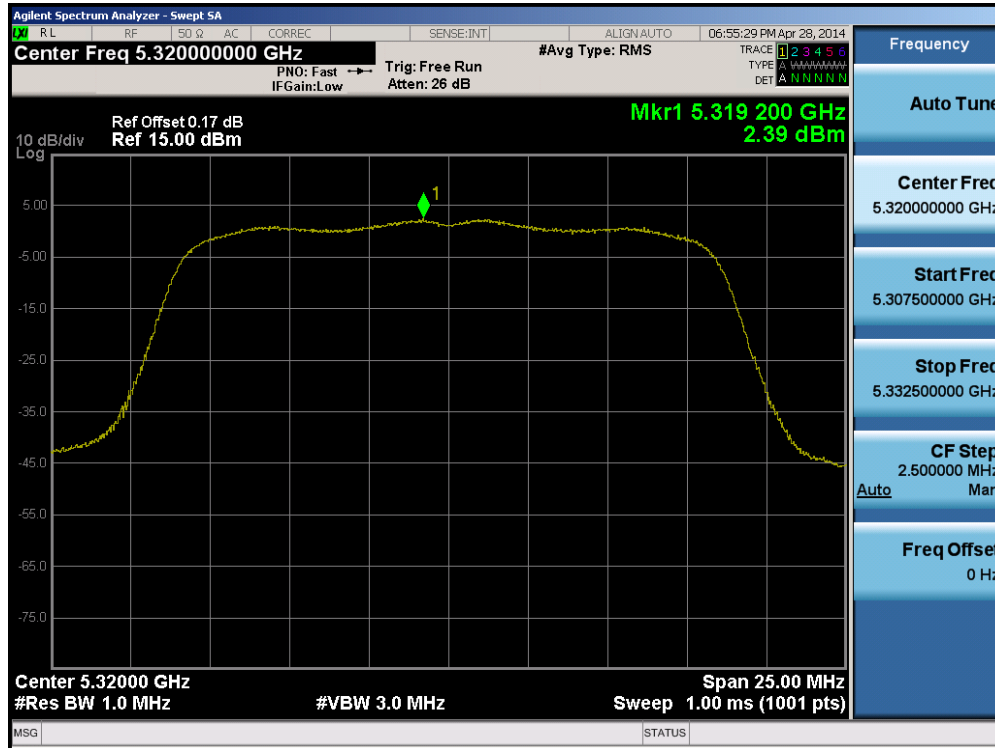


Plot 6-36. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 52)

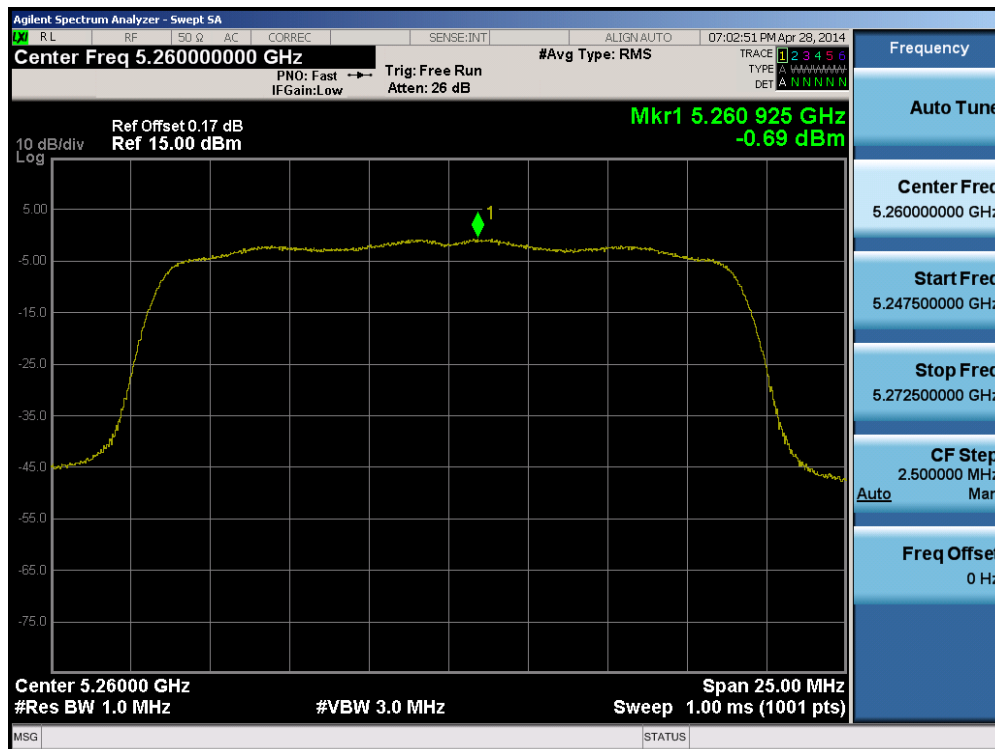


Plot 6-37. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 56)

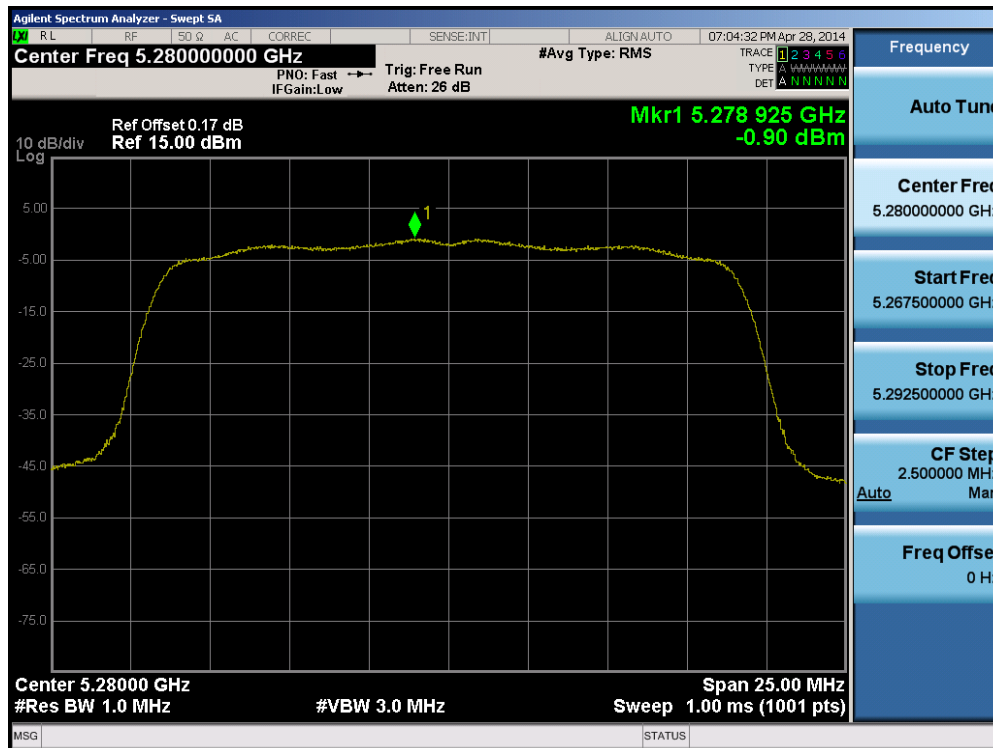


Plot 6-38. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 64)

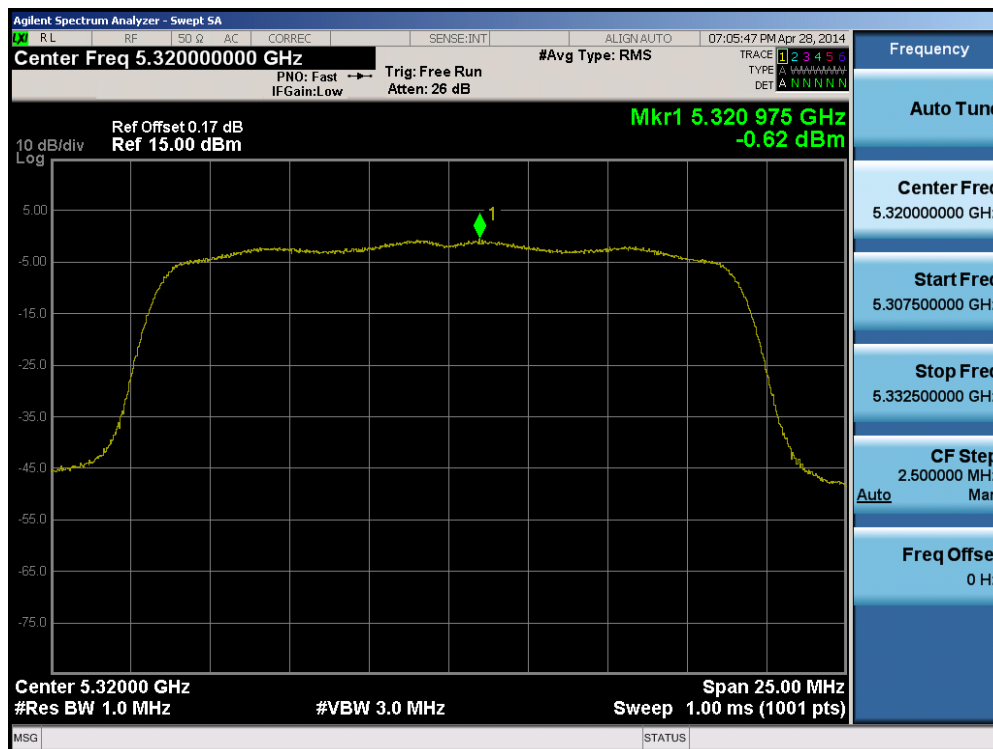


Plot 6-39. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 52)

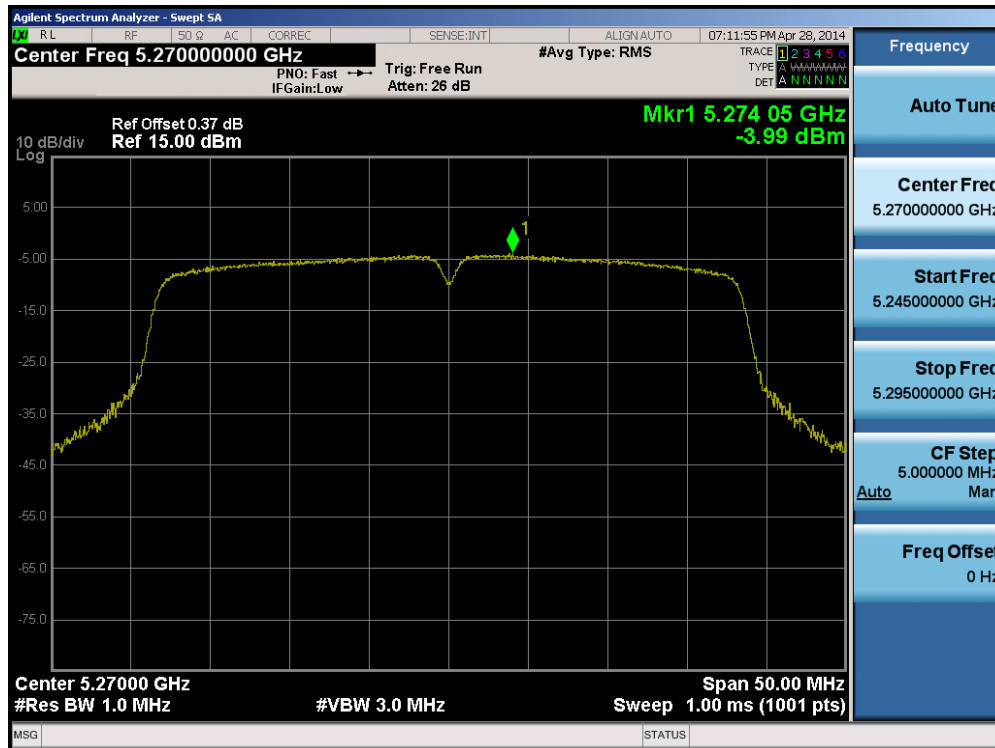


Plot 6-40. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 56)

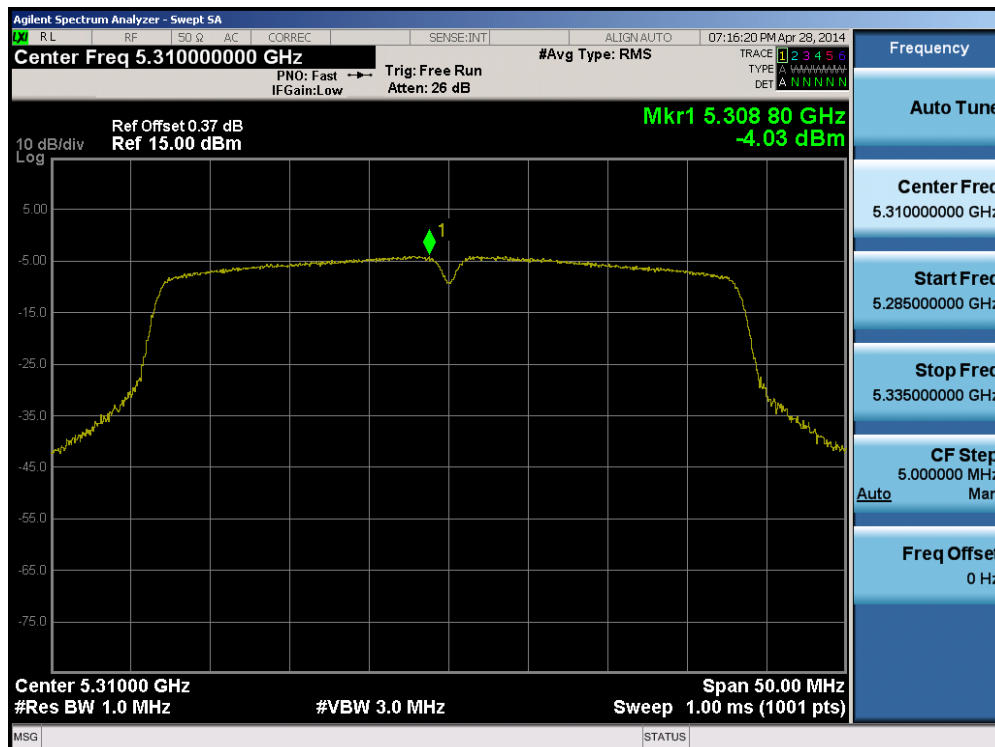


Plot 6-41. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 64)

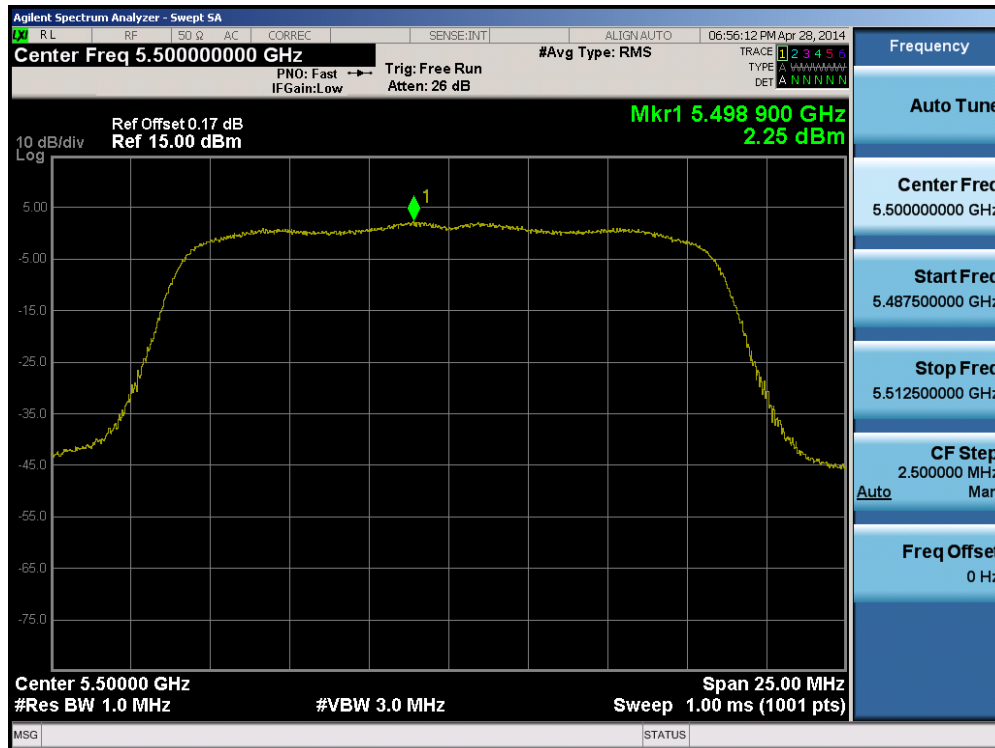


Plot 6-42. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 54)

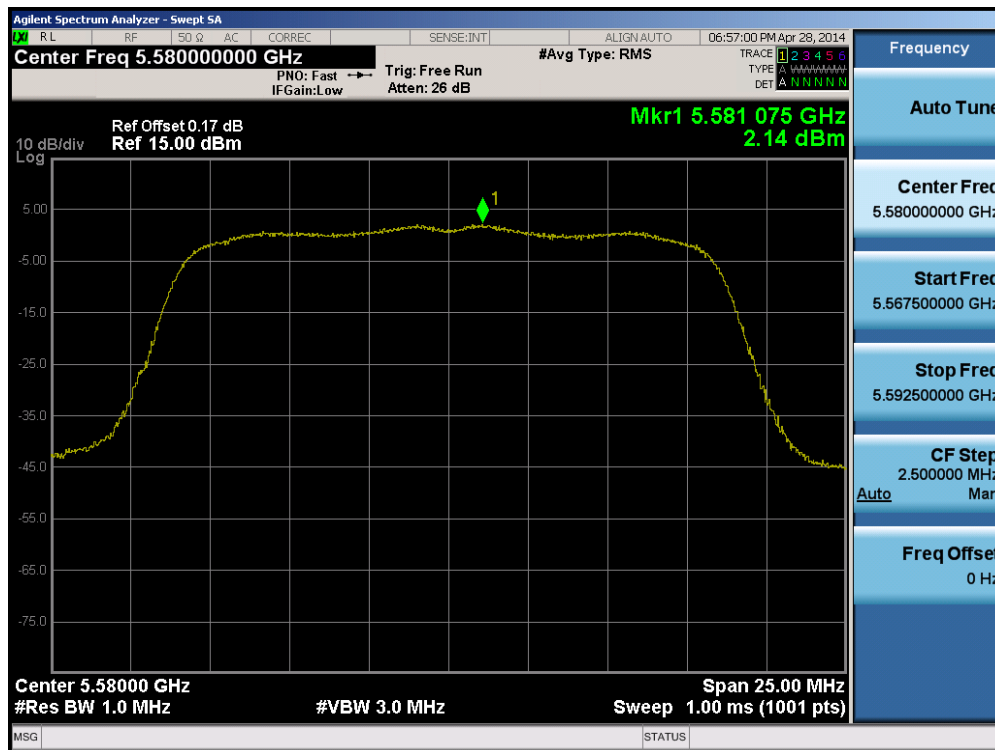


Plot 6-43. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2A) – Ch. 62)

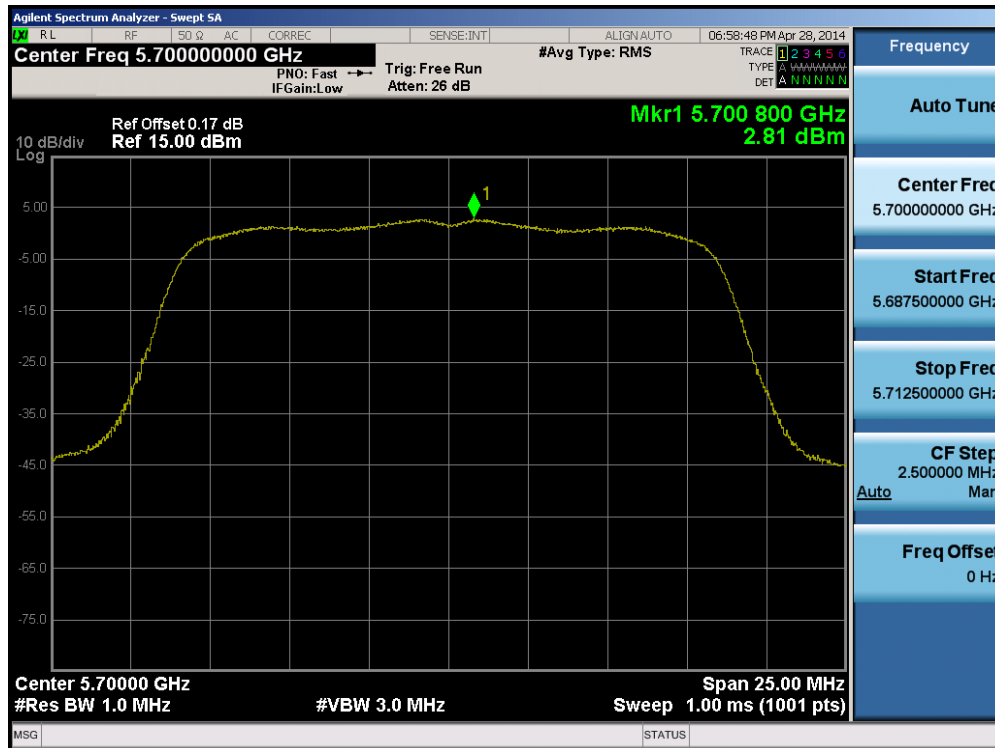


Plot 6-44. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 100)

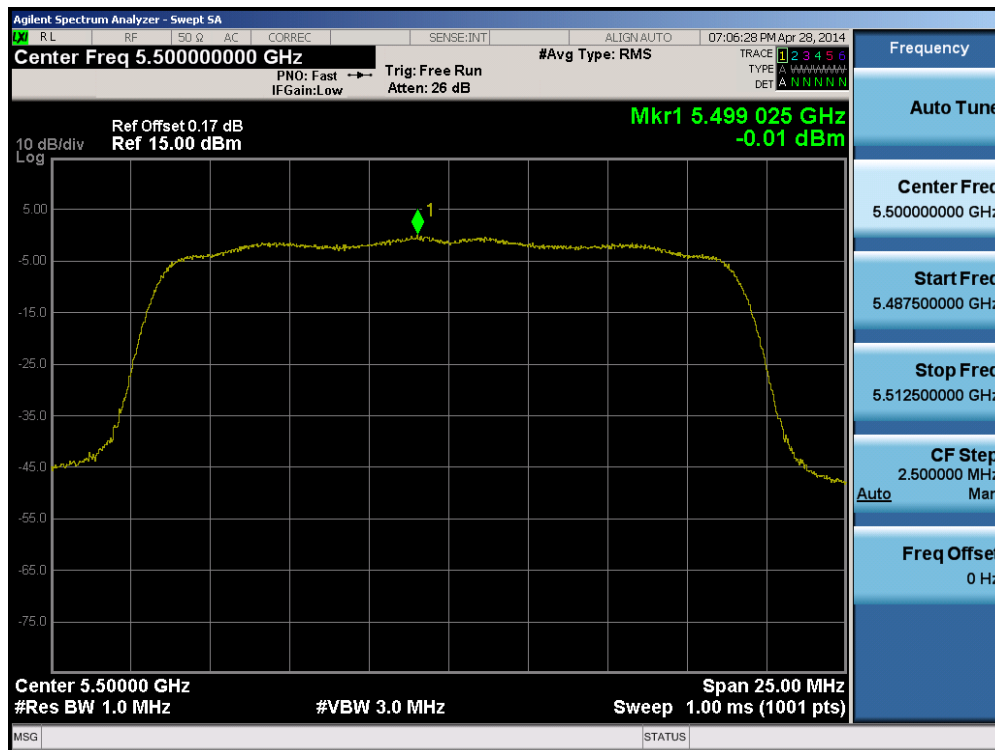


Plot 6-45. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 116)

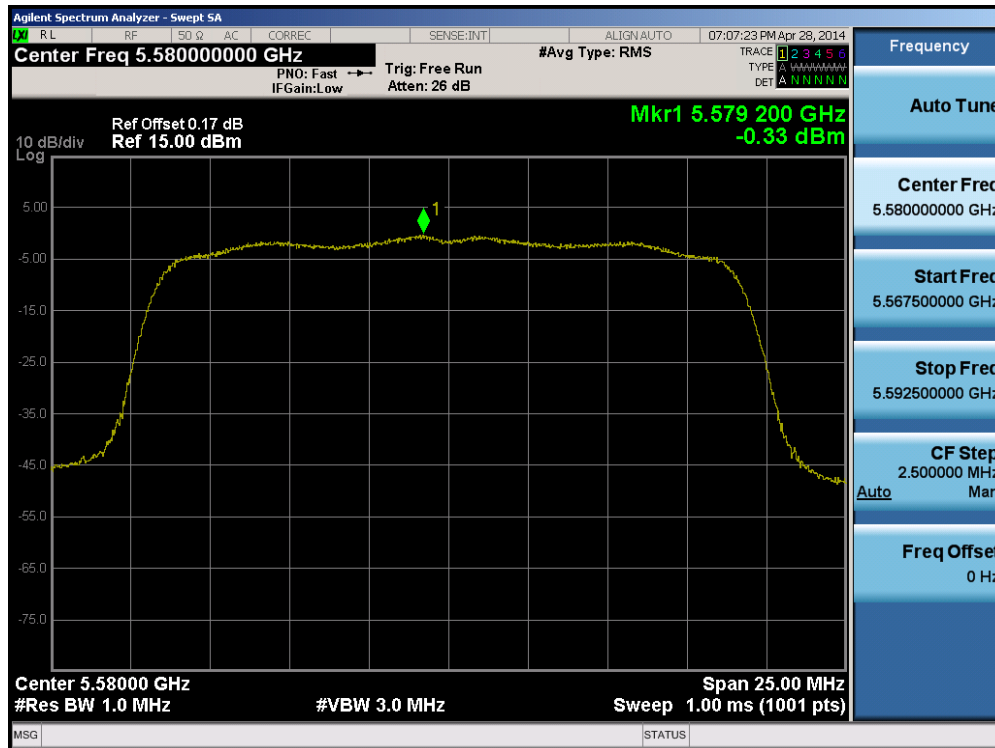


Plot 6-46. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 140)

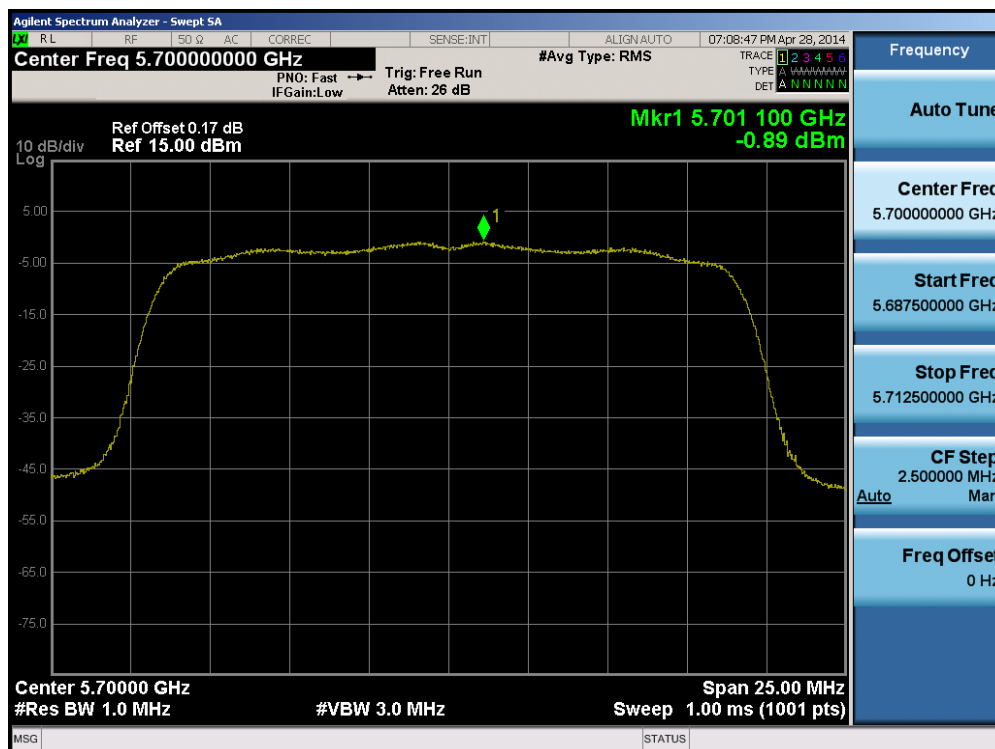


Plot 6-47. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 100)

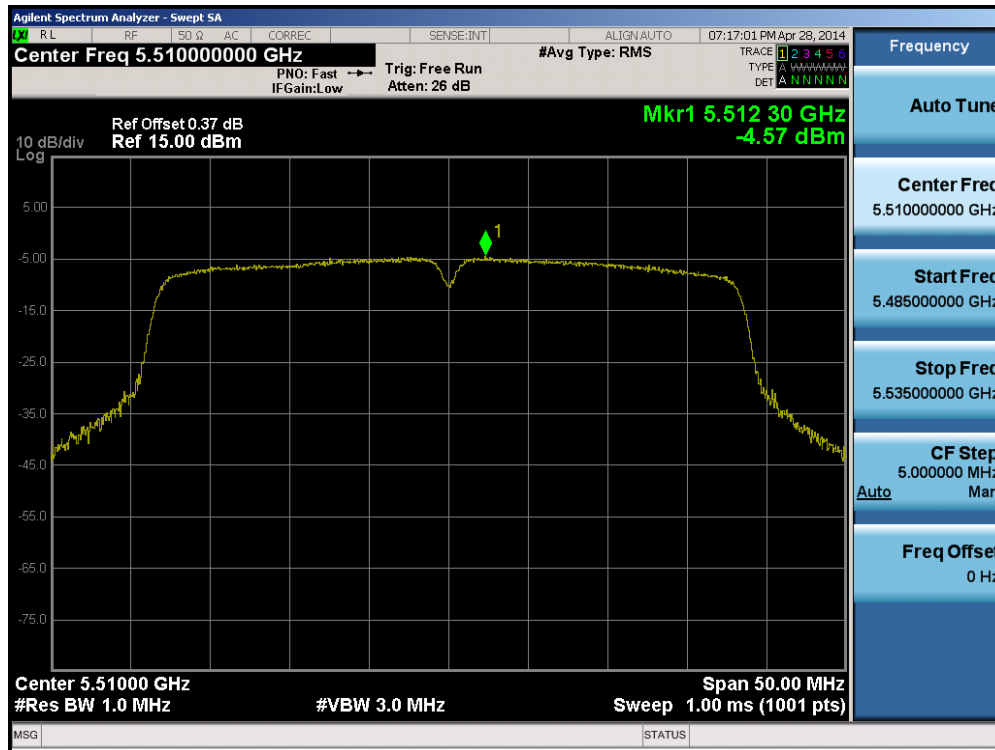


Plot 6-48. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 116)

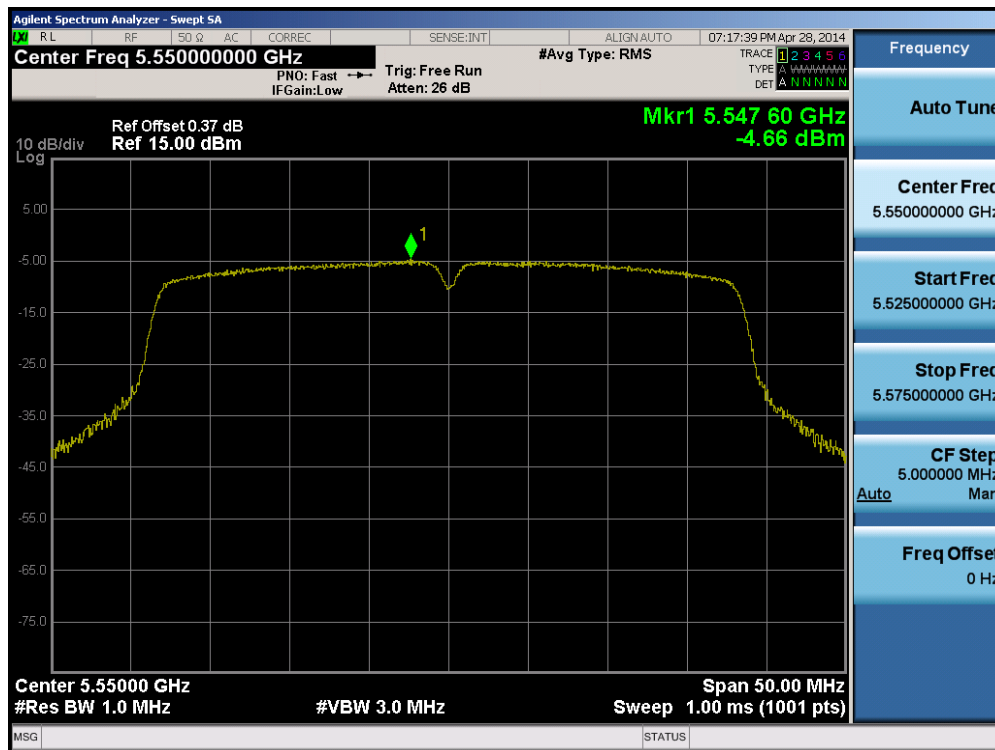


Plot 6-49. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (20MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 140)

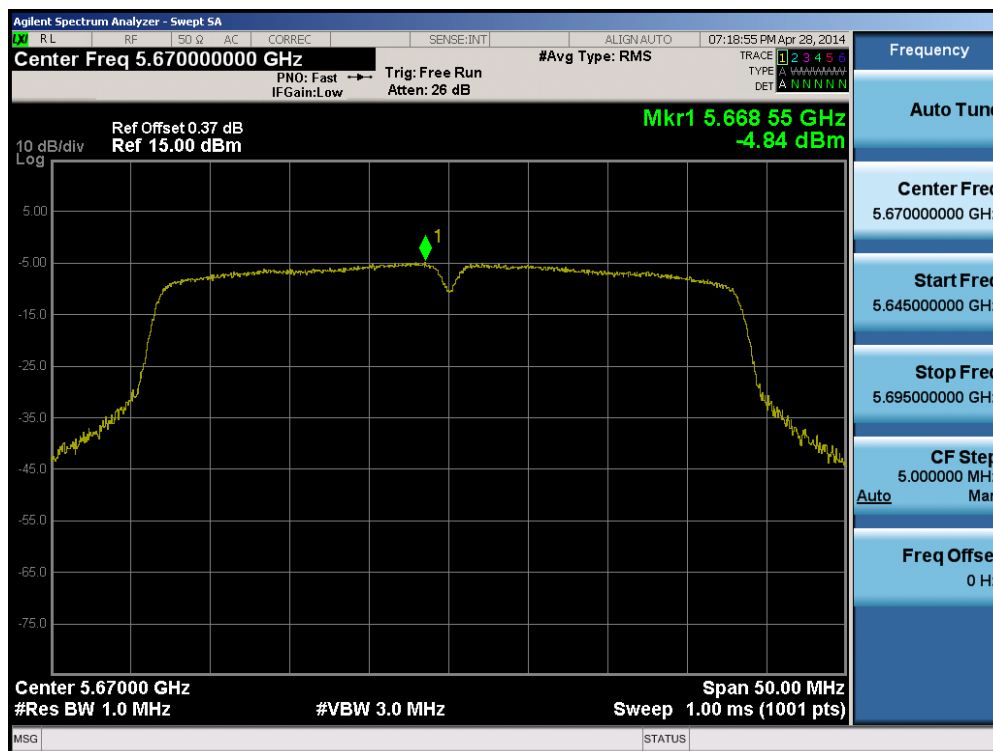


Plot 6-50. Peak Power Spectral Density Plot (40MHz BW 802.11n (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 102)

6.5 Peak Excursion Ratio – 802.11a/n §15.407(a.6)

Test Overview and Limit

The spectrum analyzer was connected to the antenna terminal while the EUT was operating at its maximum power control level, as defined in KDB 789033 v01r03, at its maximum power control level, as defined in KDB 789033 v01r03, and at the appropriate frequencies. Method SA-2, as defined in KDB 789033 v01r03, was used to capture the average trace used to make the peak excursion measurement. An offset was added for average emissions transmitting below 98% duty cycle.

The largest permissible difference between the modulation envelope (measured using a peak hold function) and the maximum power spectral density is 13 dBm/MHz.

Test Procedure Used

Test Settings

1. Analyzer was set to the center frequency of the UNII channel under investigation
2. Span was set to encompass the entire emission bandwidth of the signal
3. RBW = 1MHz

8. The peak search function of the spectrum analyzer was used to find the peak of the spectrum. This level was compared to the peak power density level found from the previous section to determine the peak excursion.

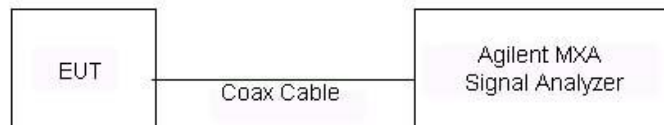


Figure 6-4. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup

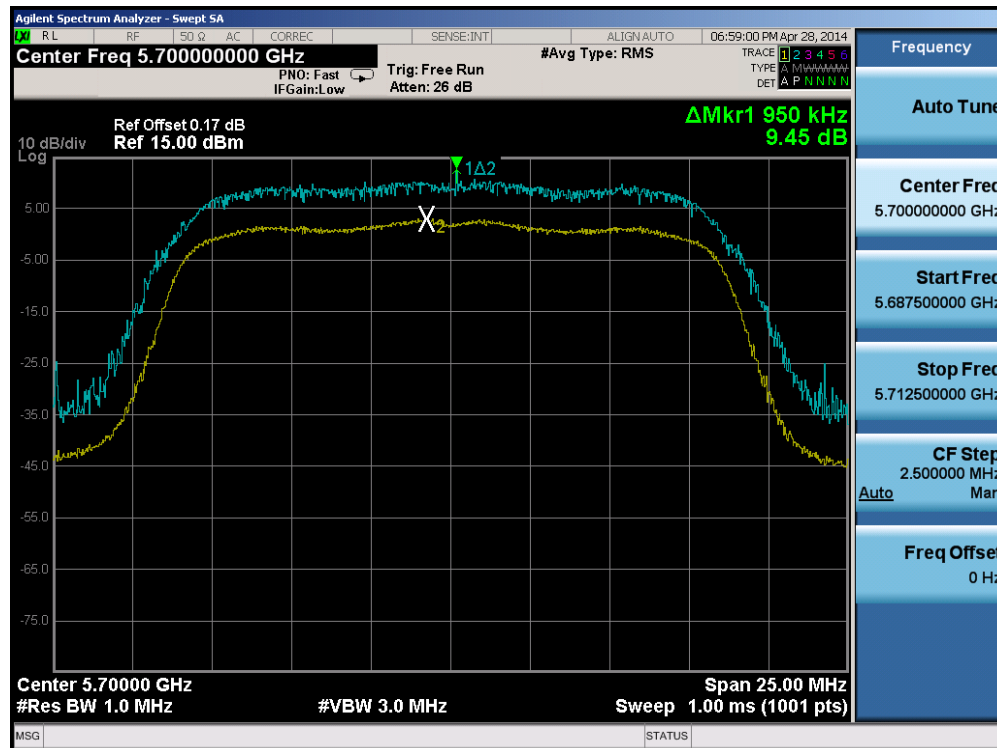

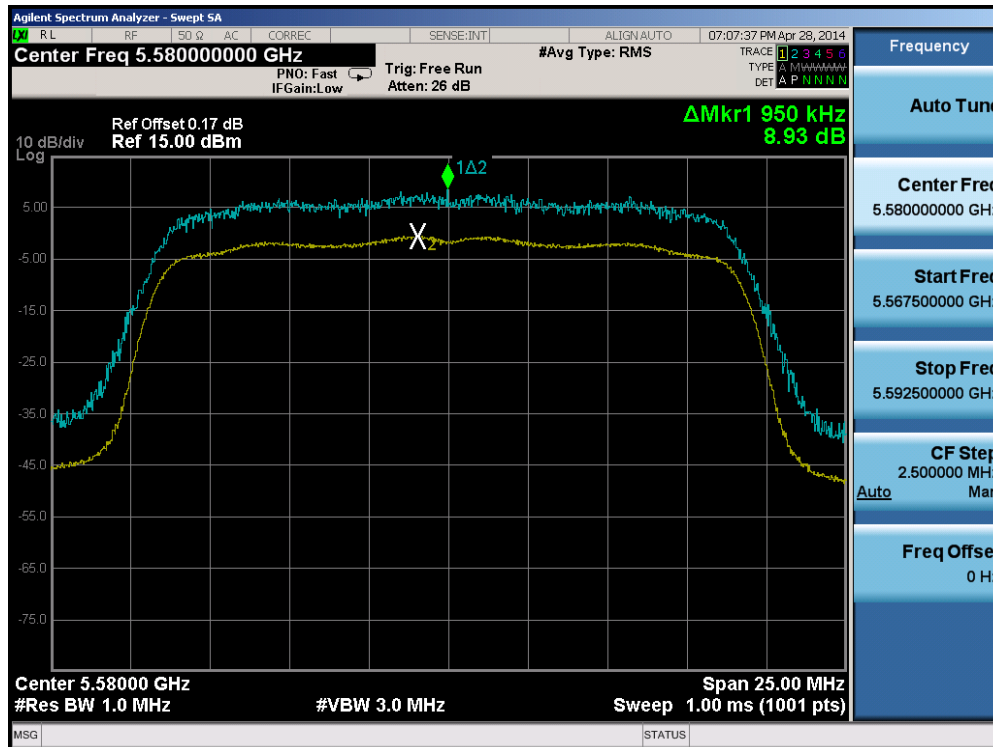

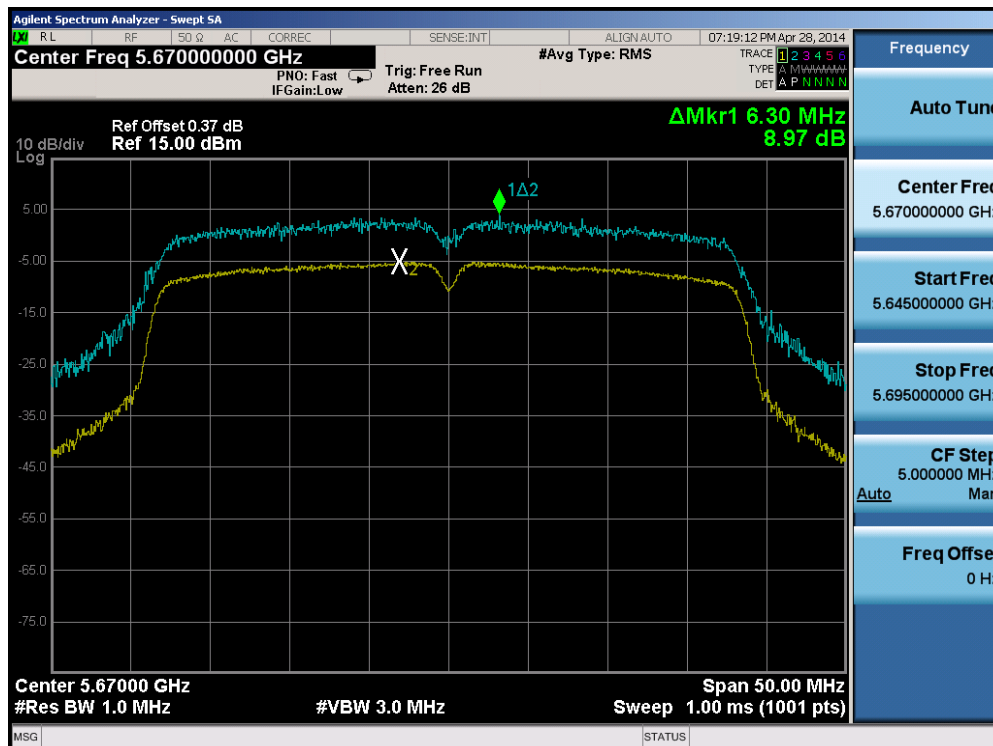


Plot 6-53. Peak Excursion Ratio Plot (802.11a (UNII Band 2C) – Ch. 140)

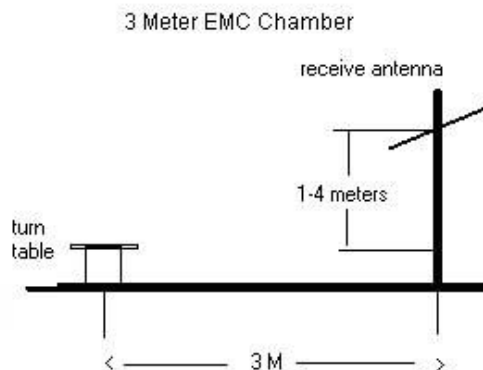


Figure 6-5. Test Instrument & Measurement Setup

All spurious emissions that do not lie in a restricted band are subject to a peak limit of -27dBm/MHz. 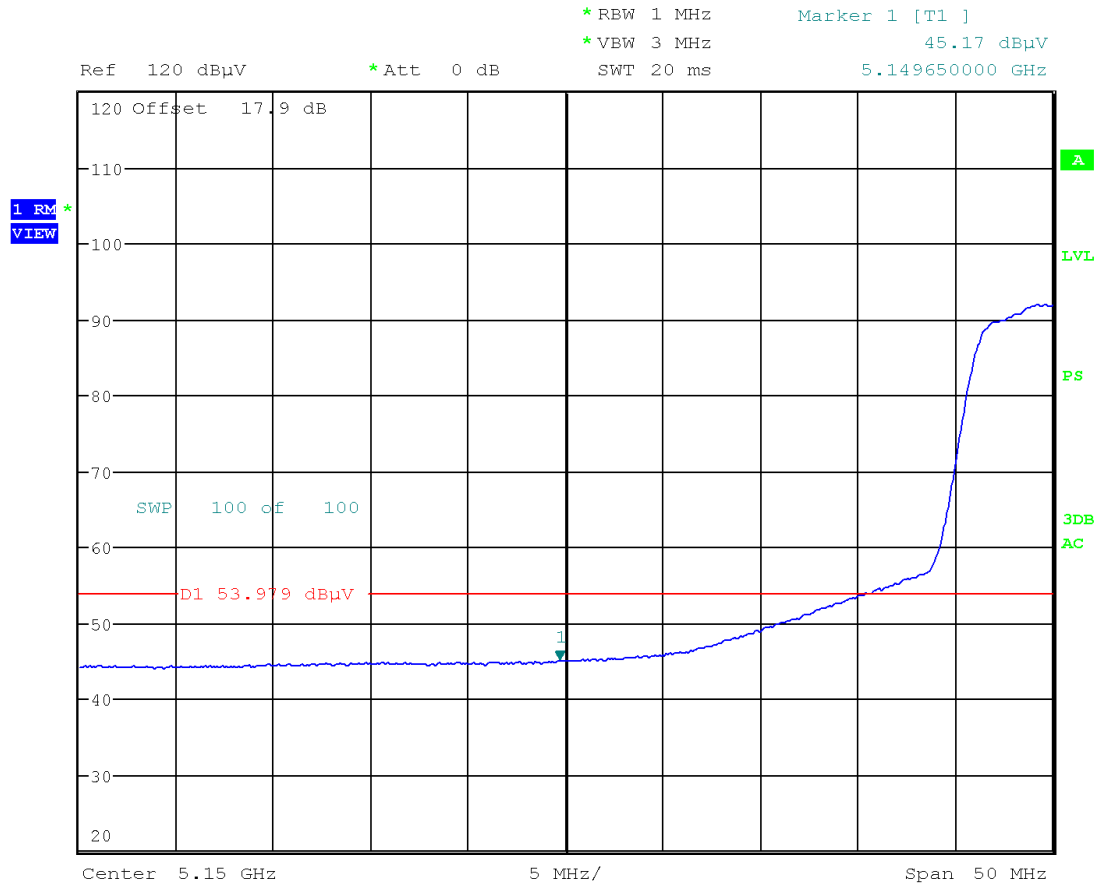

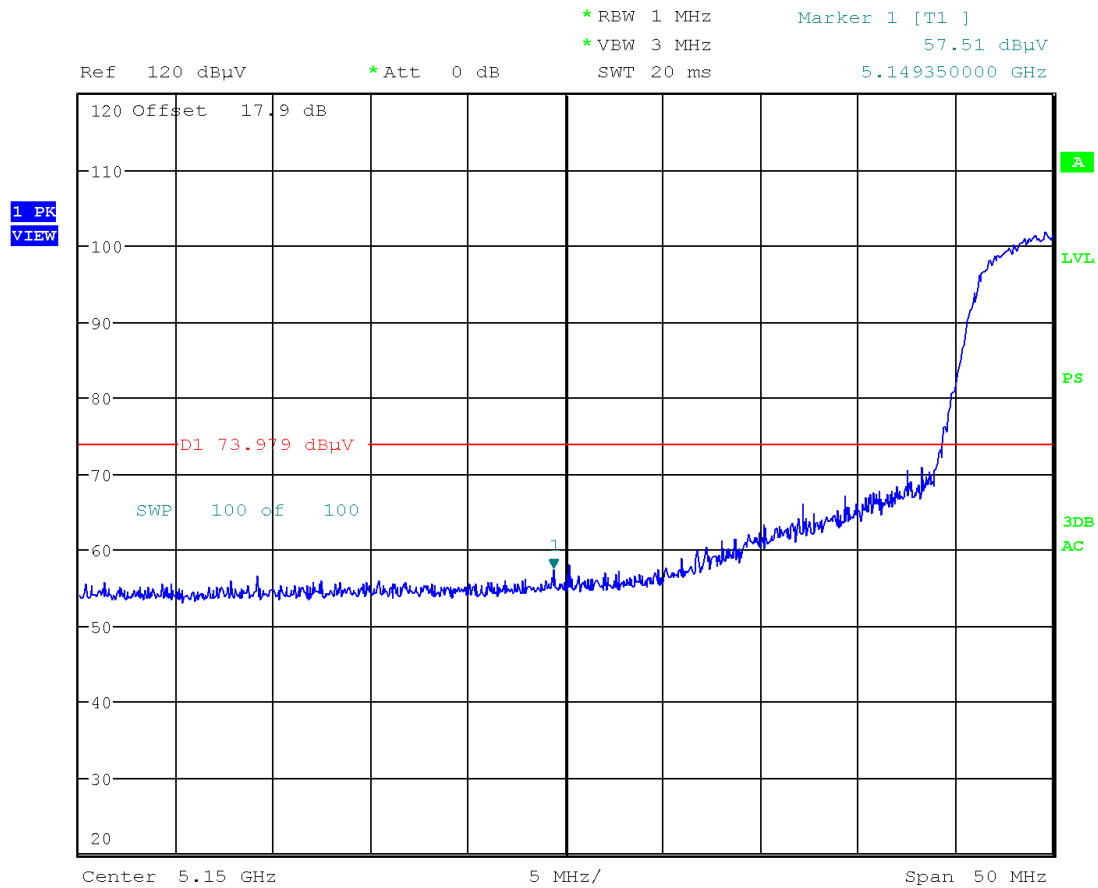


Plot 6-56. Radiated Restricted Lower Band Edge Plot (Average – UNII Band 1)

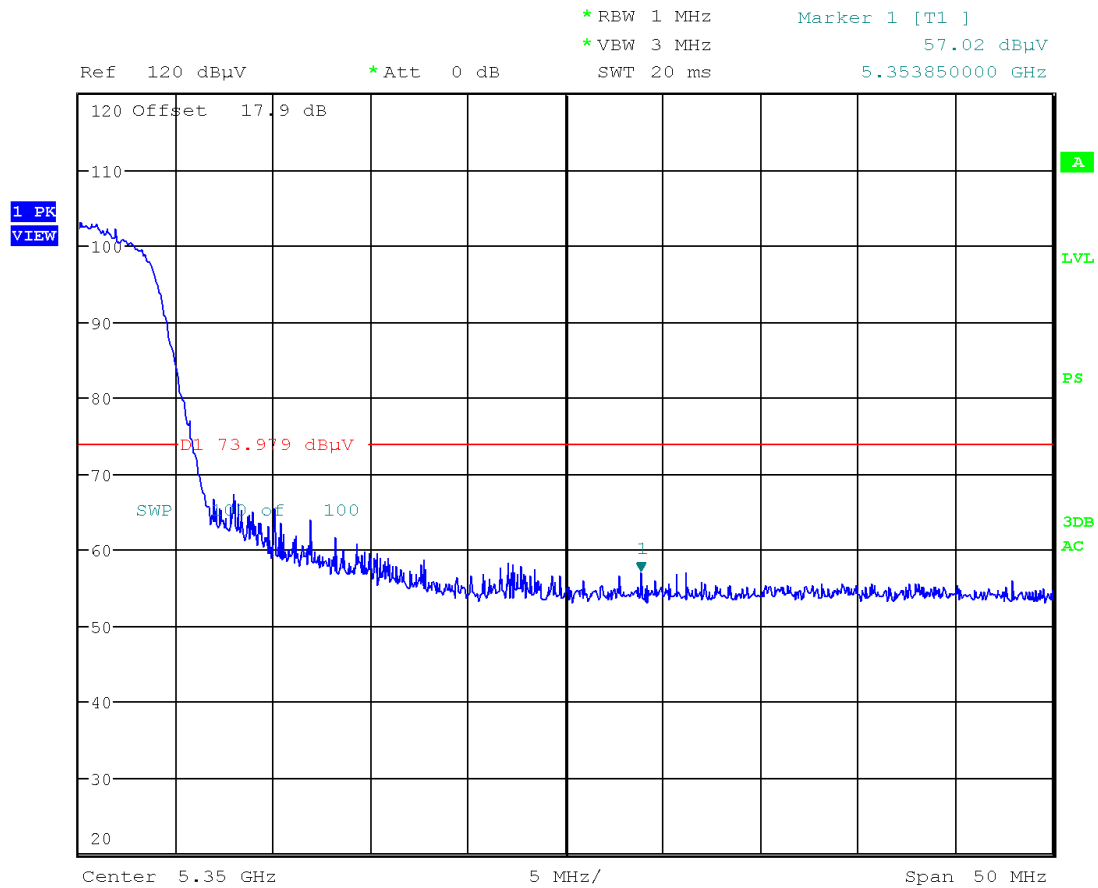


Plot 6-57. Radiated Restricted Lower Band Edge Plot (Peak – UNII Band 1)

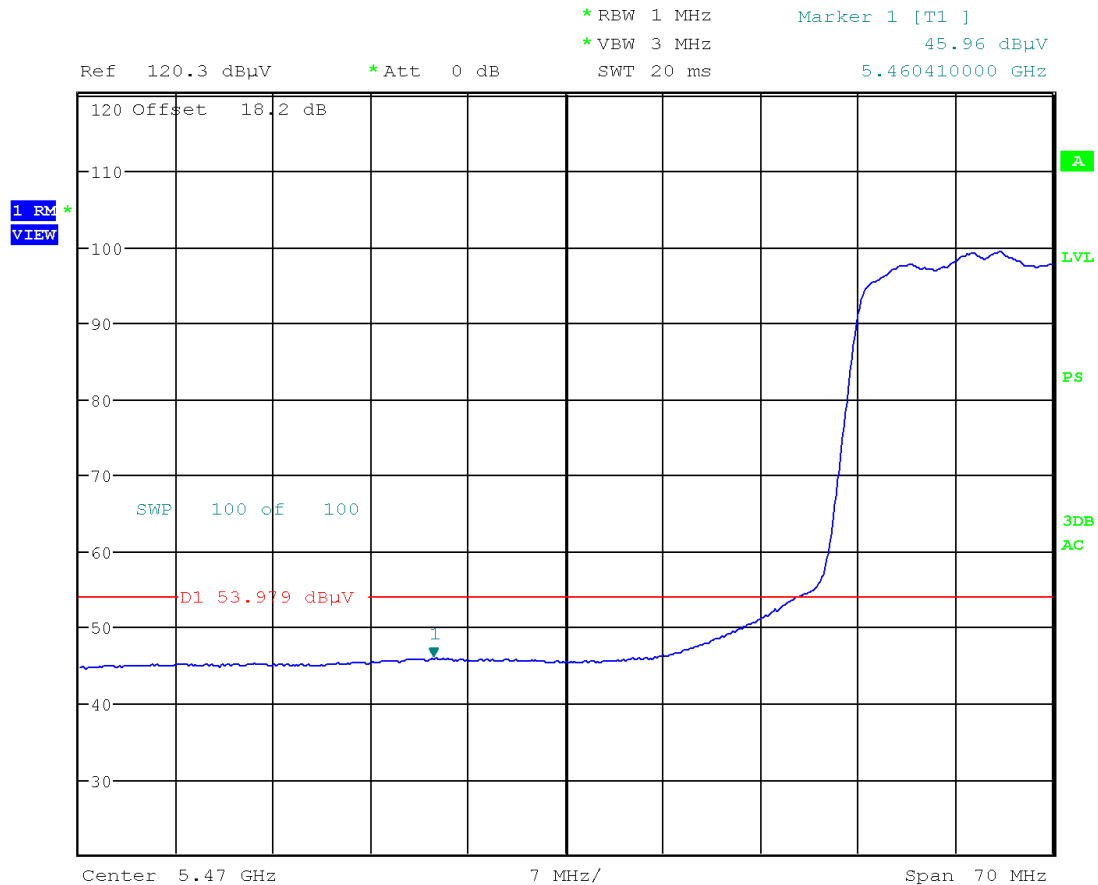

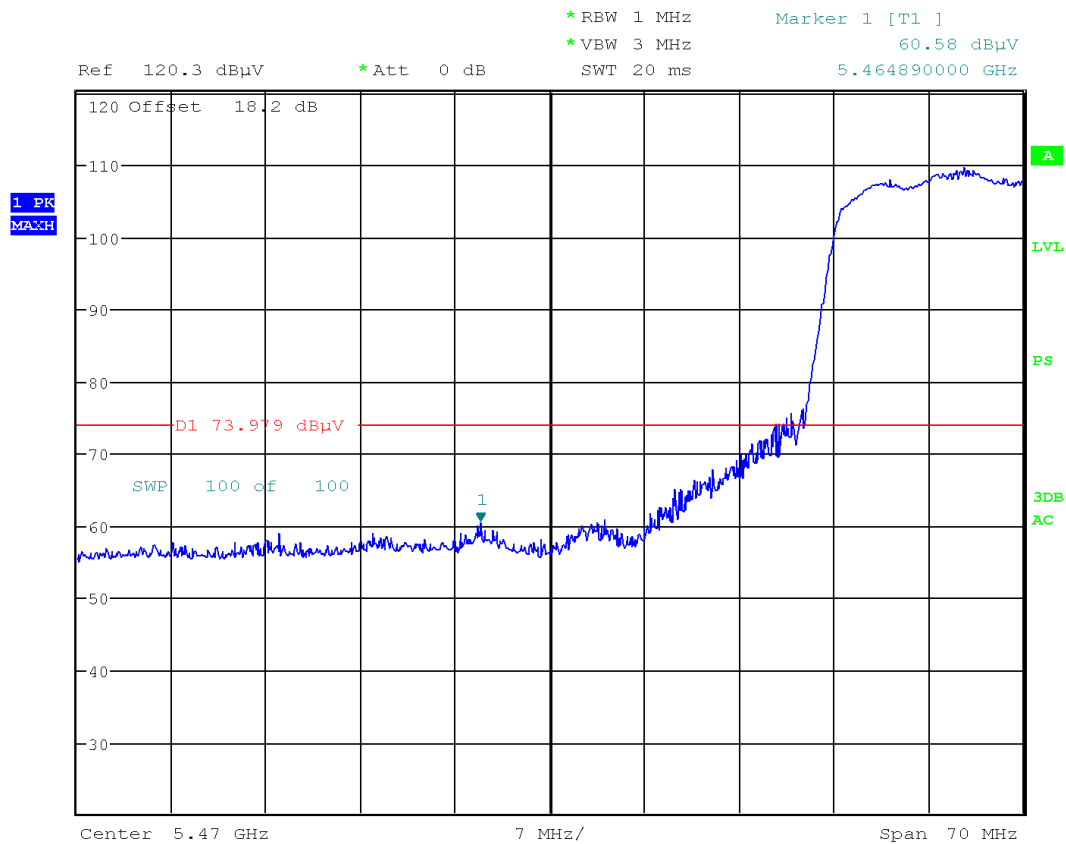


Plot 6-60. Radiated Restricted Lower Band Edge Plot (Average – UNII Band 2C)

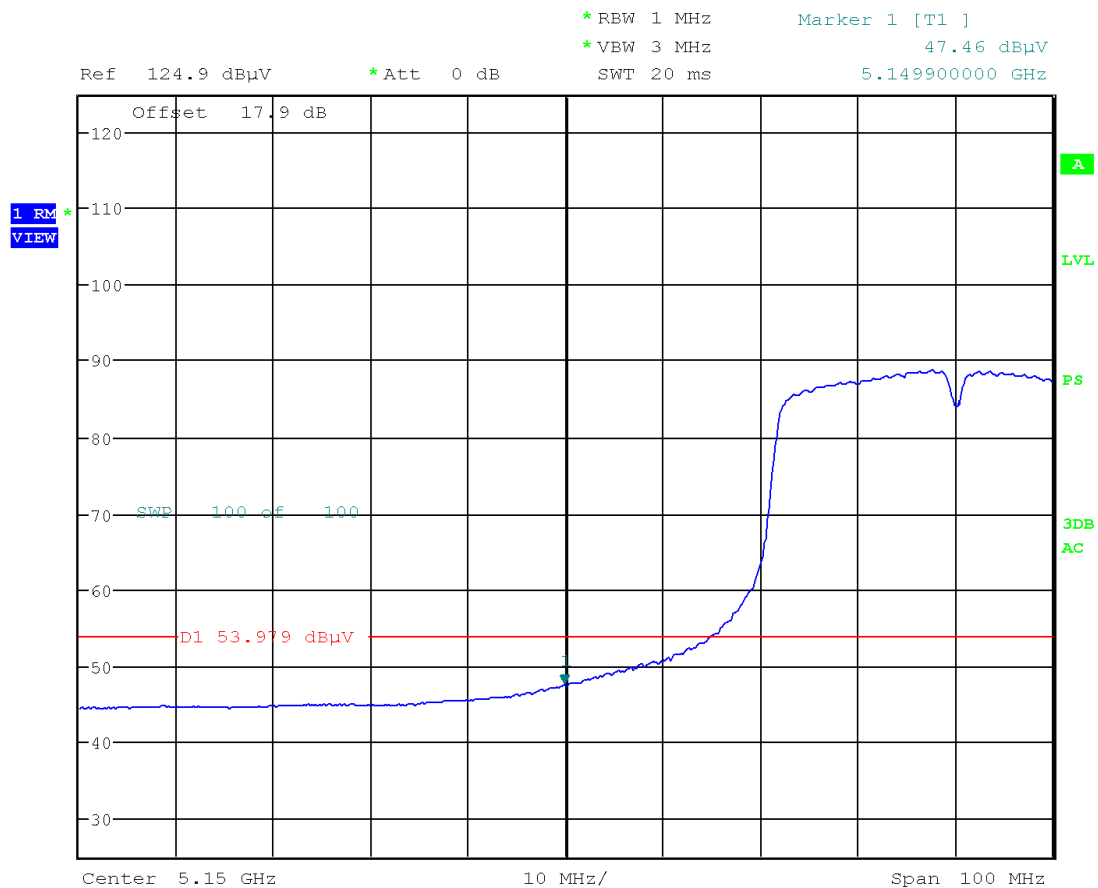

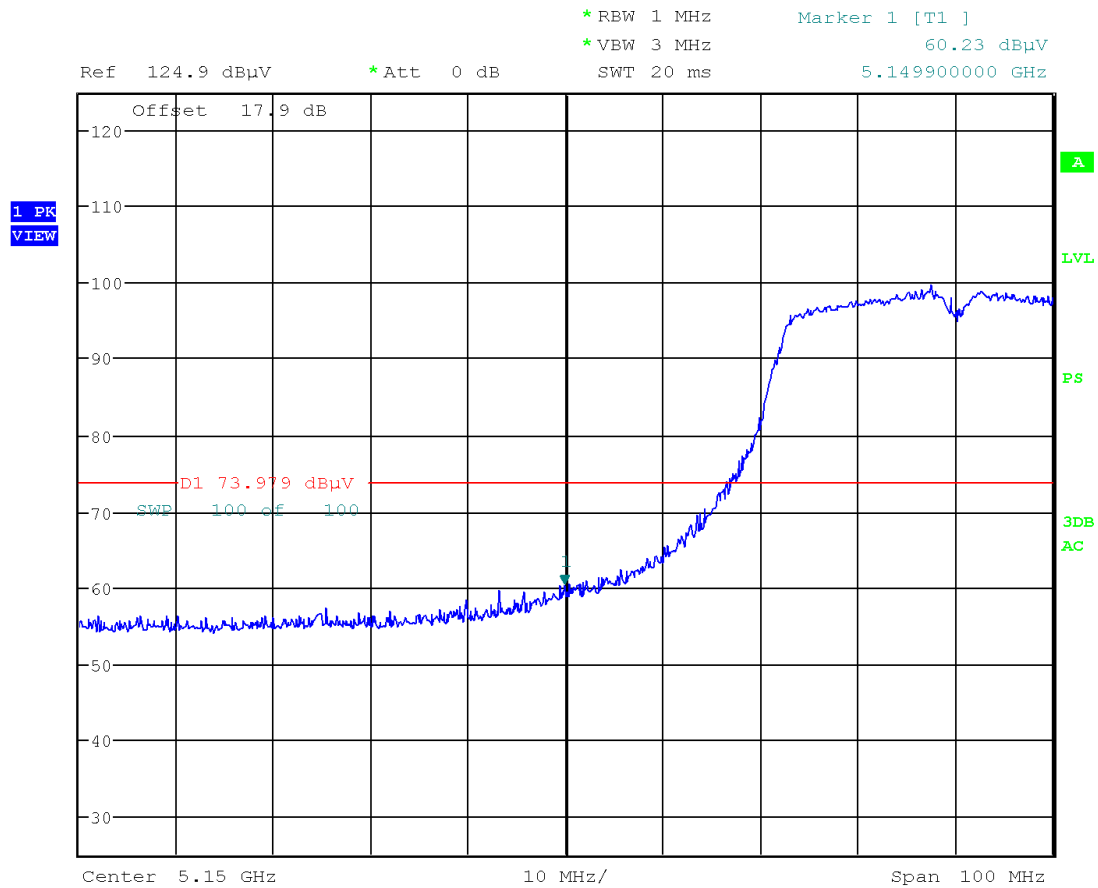


Plot 6-63. Radiated Restricted Lower Band Edge Plot (Average – UNII Band 1)

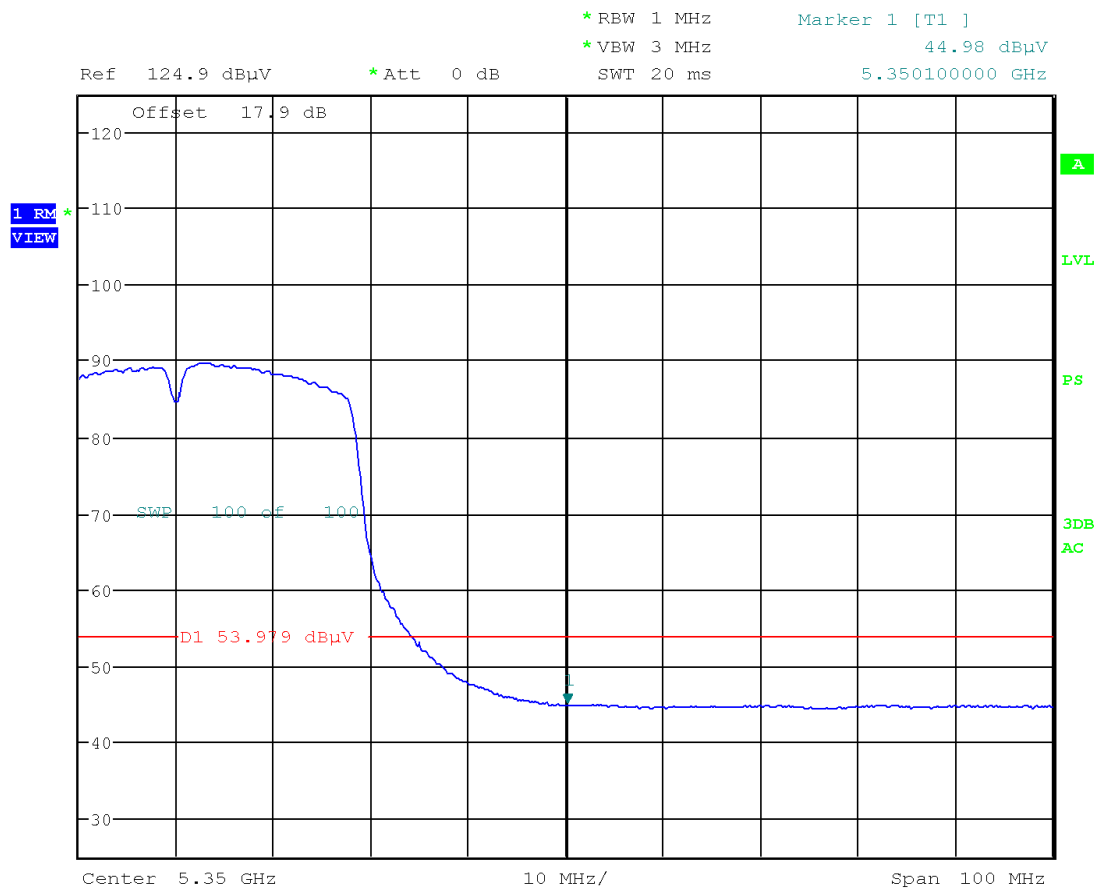

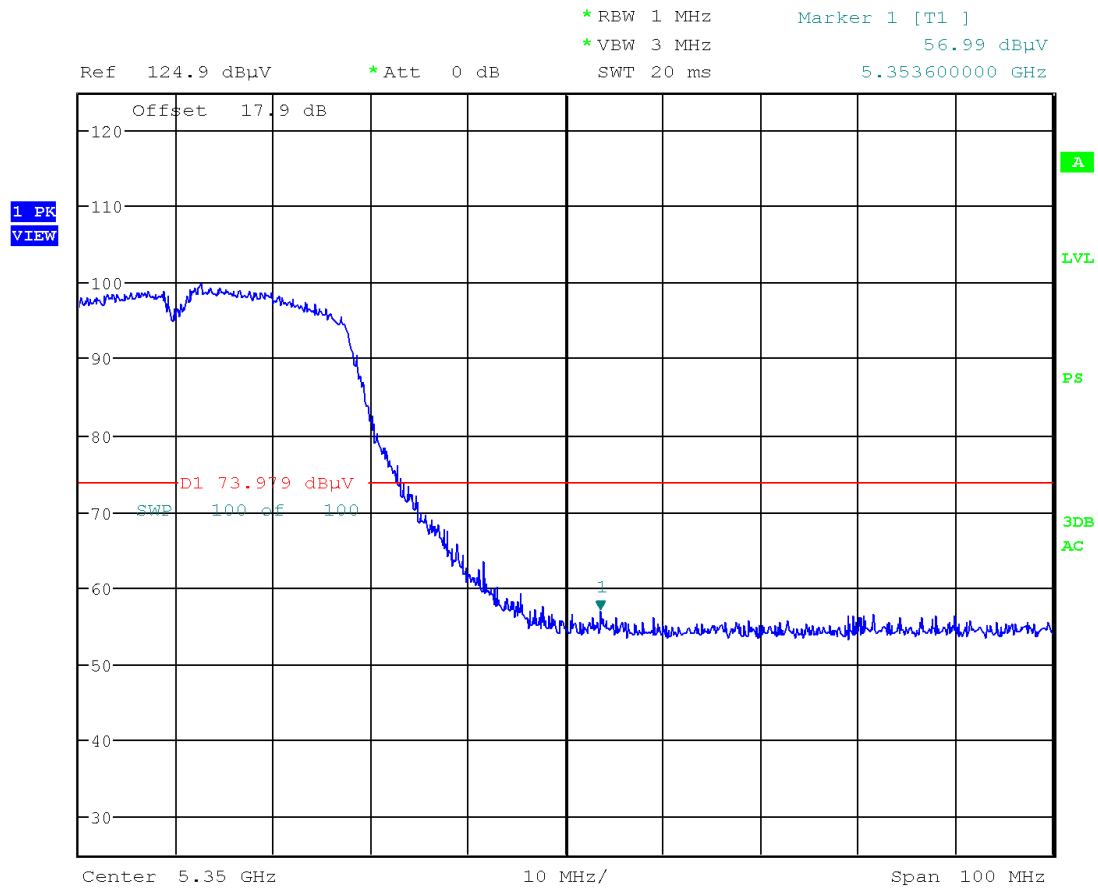


Plot 6-65. Radiated Restricted Upper Band Edge Plot (Average – UNII Band 2A)

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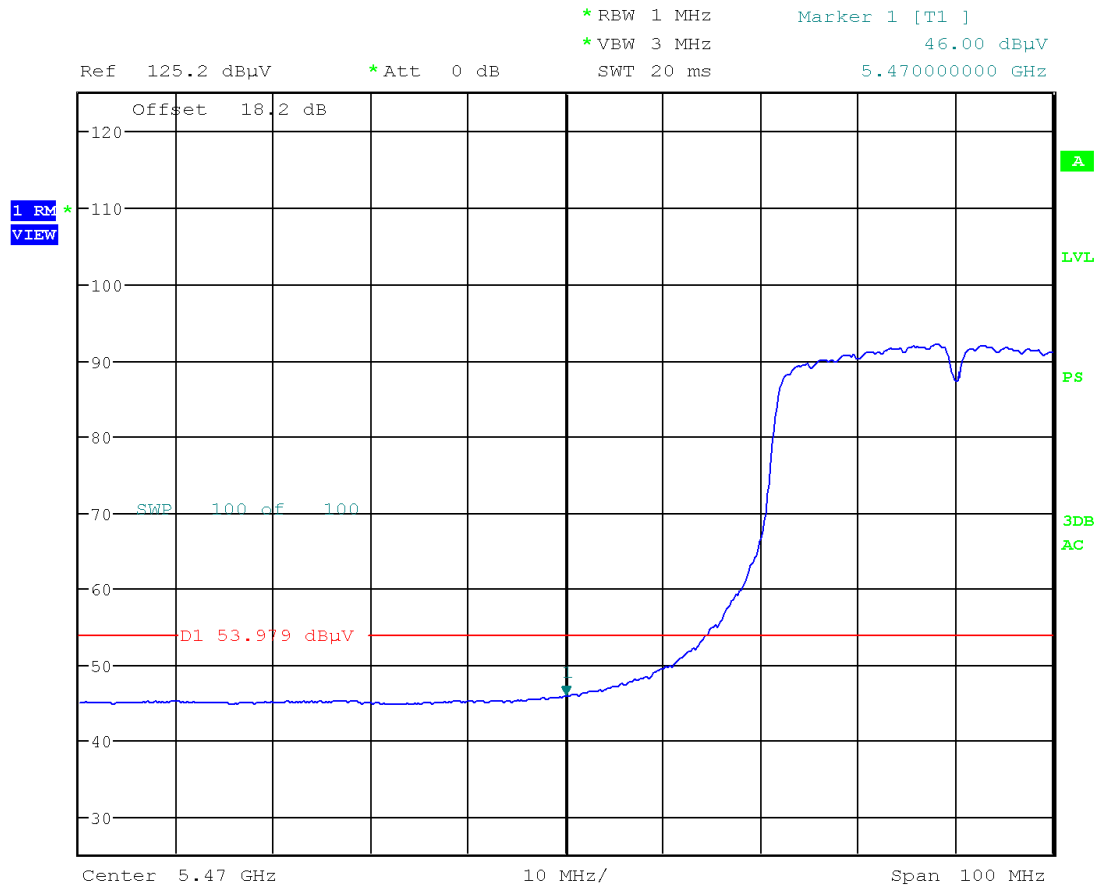

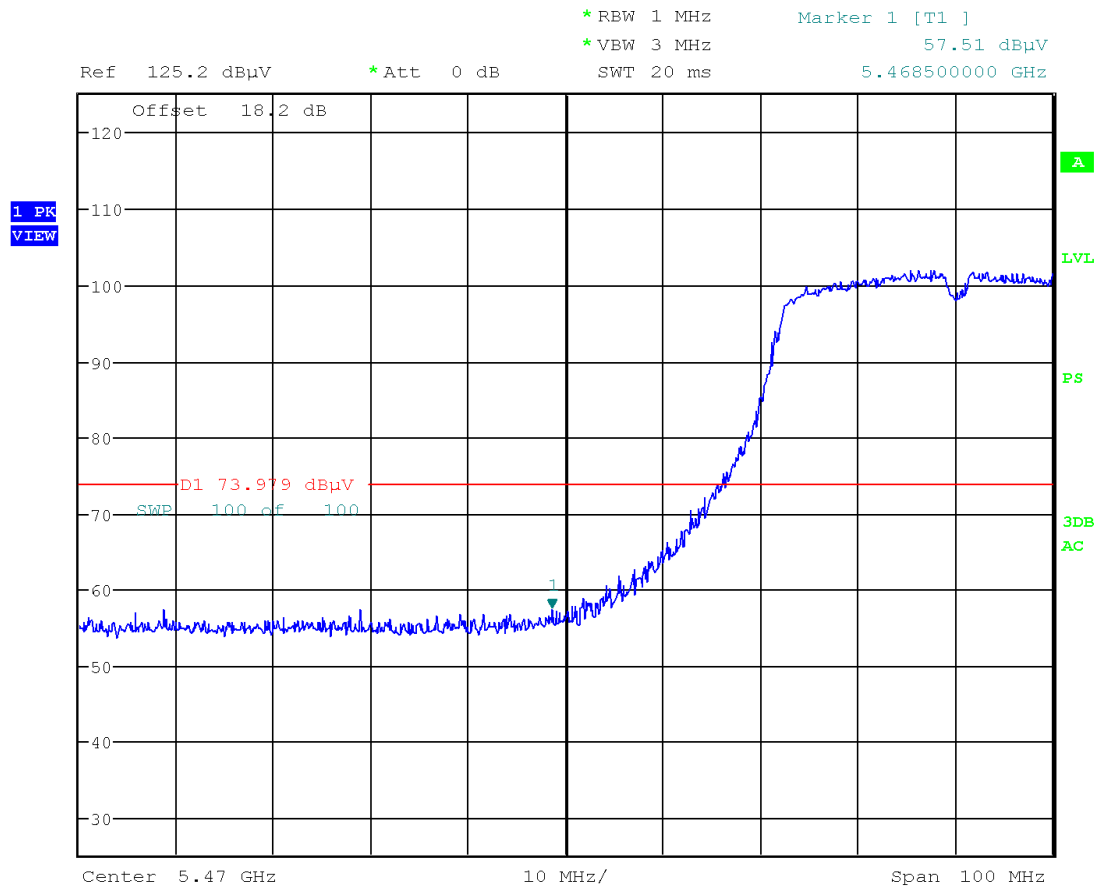


Plot 6-67. Radiated Restricted Lower Band Edge Plot (Average – UNII Band 2C)

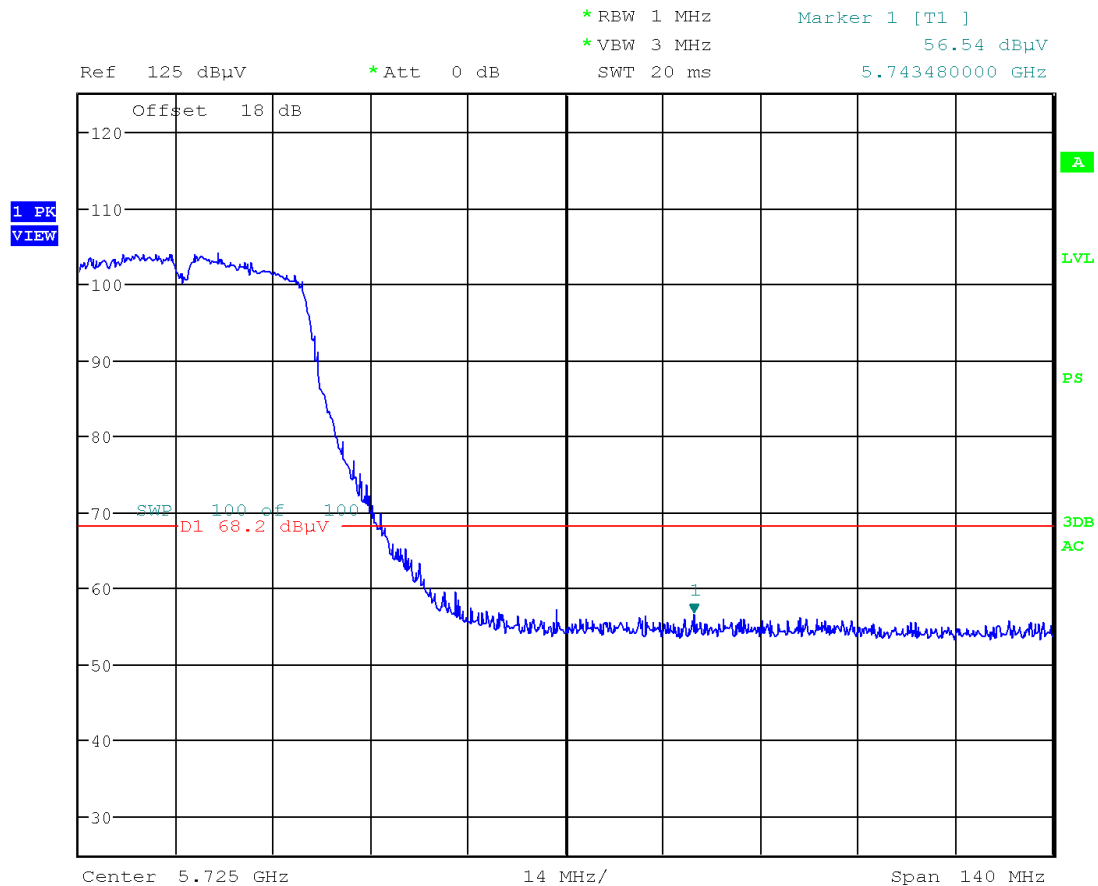

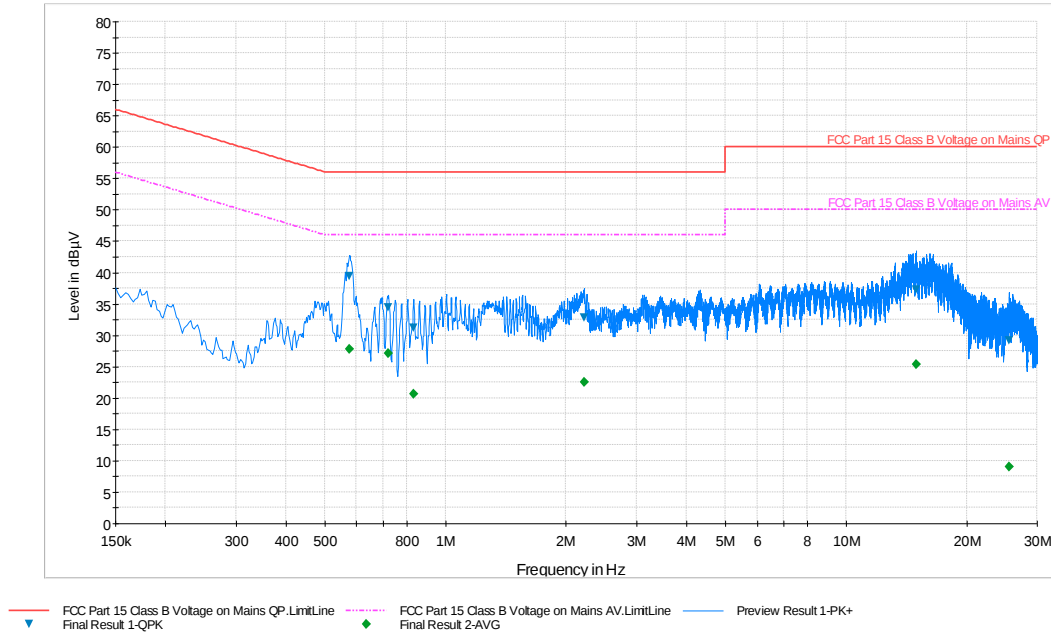


Plot 6-69. Radiated Upper Band Edge Plot (Peak – UNII Band 2C)

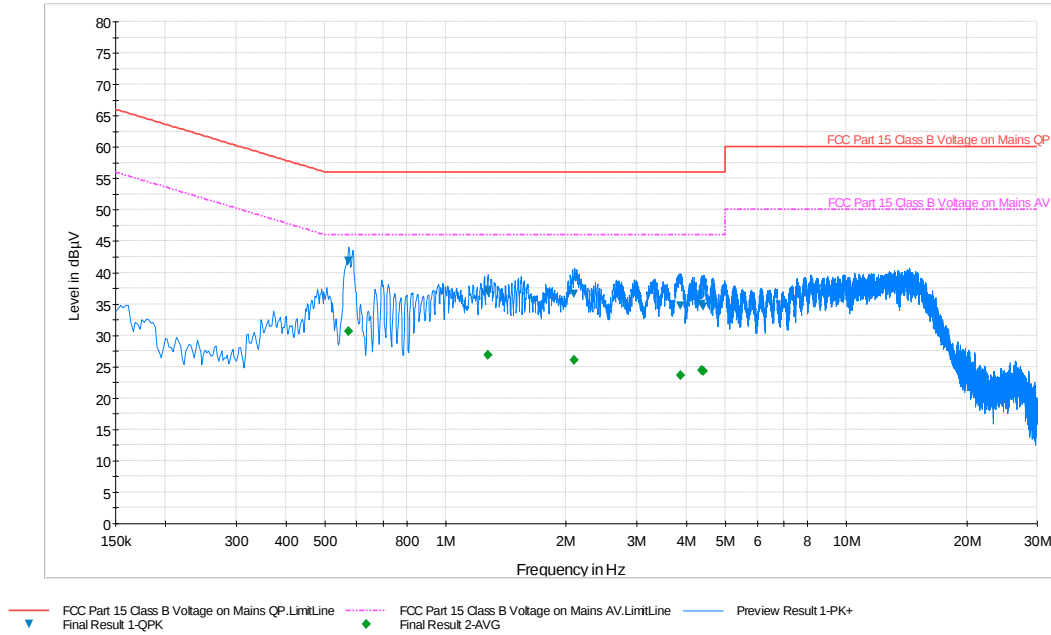
